

<u>Tropical Depression Twenty-E:</u> (Advisory #4 as of 4:00 a.m. ET)


- Located 1,080 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving NW at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds are 35 mph
- Some slight strengthening is possible over the next day or so, followed by weakening becoming a remnant low this weekend

#### Disturbance 1: (As of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central subtropical Atlantic
- The chances of subtropical or tropical development should end Sunday
- Formation chance: 48-hour Low (30%);7-day low (30%)




