

- Formation chance 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 5 days: Low (20%)















# **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






#### **Forecast Snowfall**






#### Long Range Outlooks - Nov 30 - Dec 4



6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




