


Tropical Outlook - Five Day




Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Formation chance 48 hour: Low (near 0%); 5 days: Low (20%)








National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Forecast Snowfall
