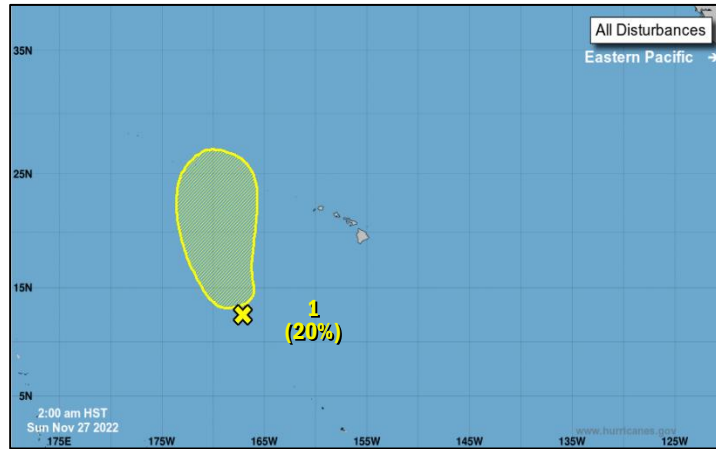

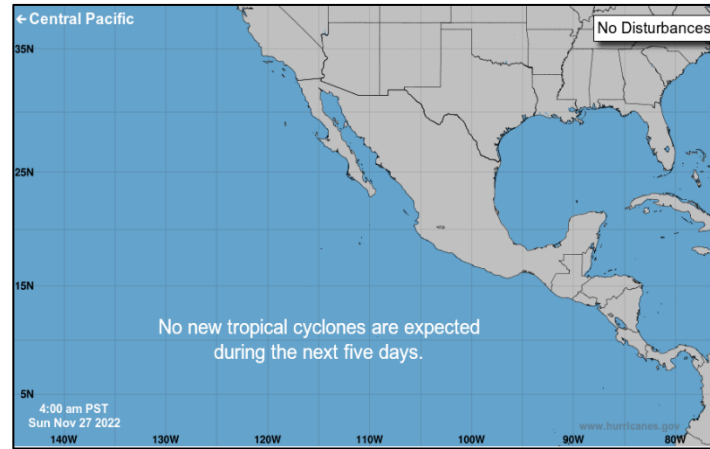
Central Pacific

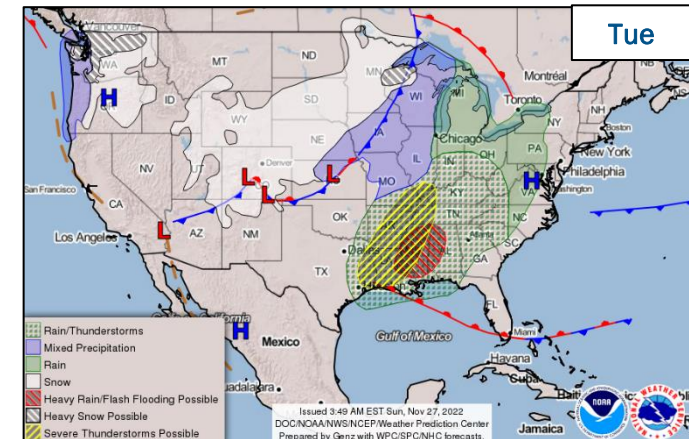

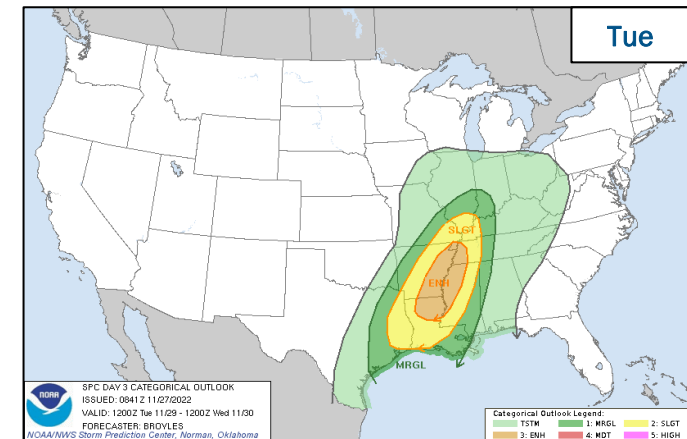
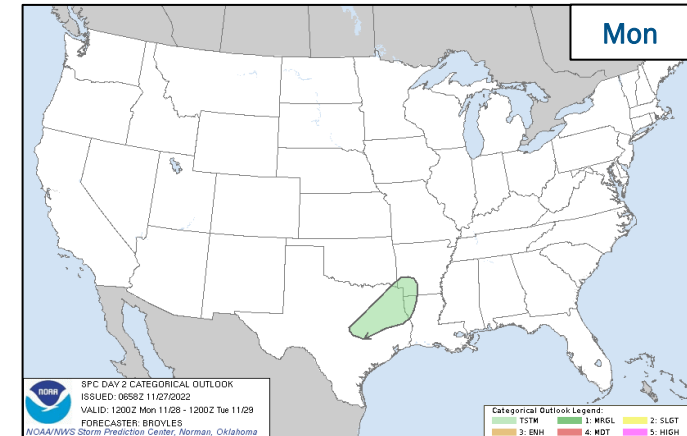

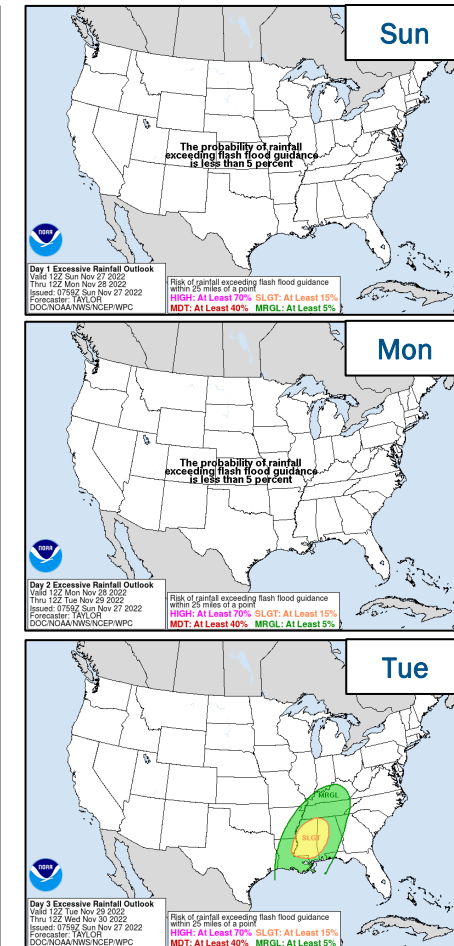
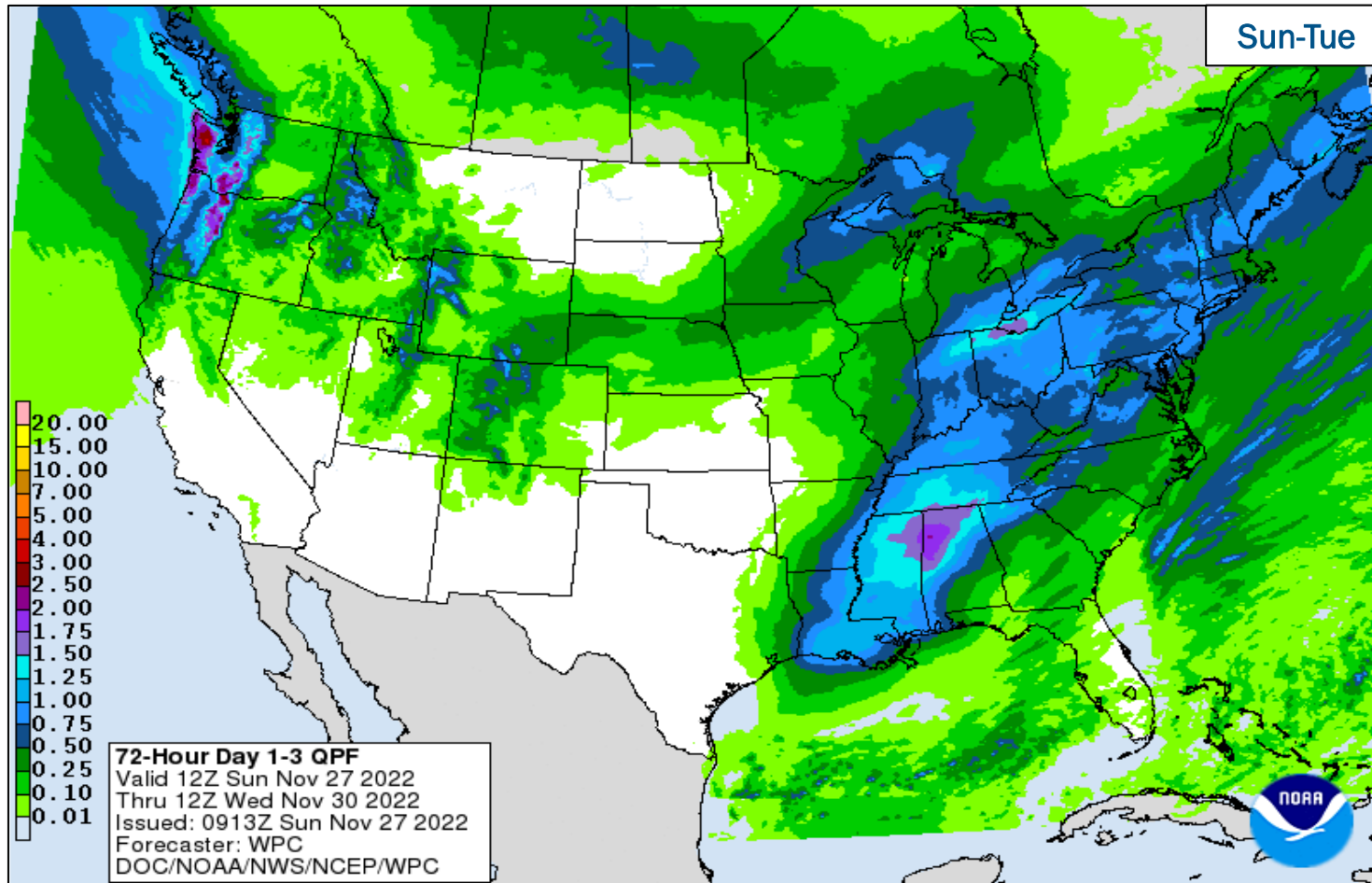
Severe Weather Outlook

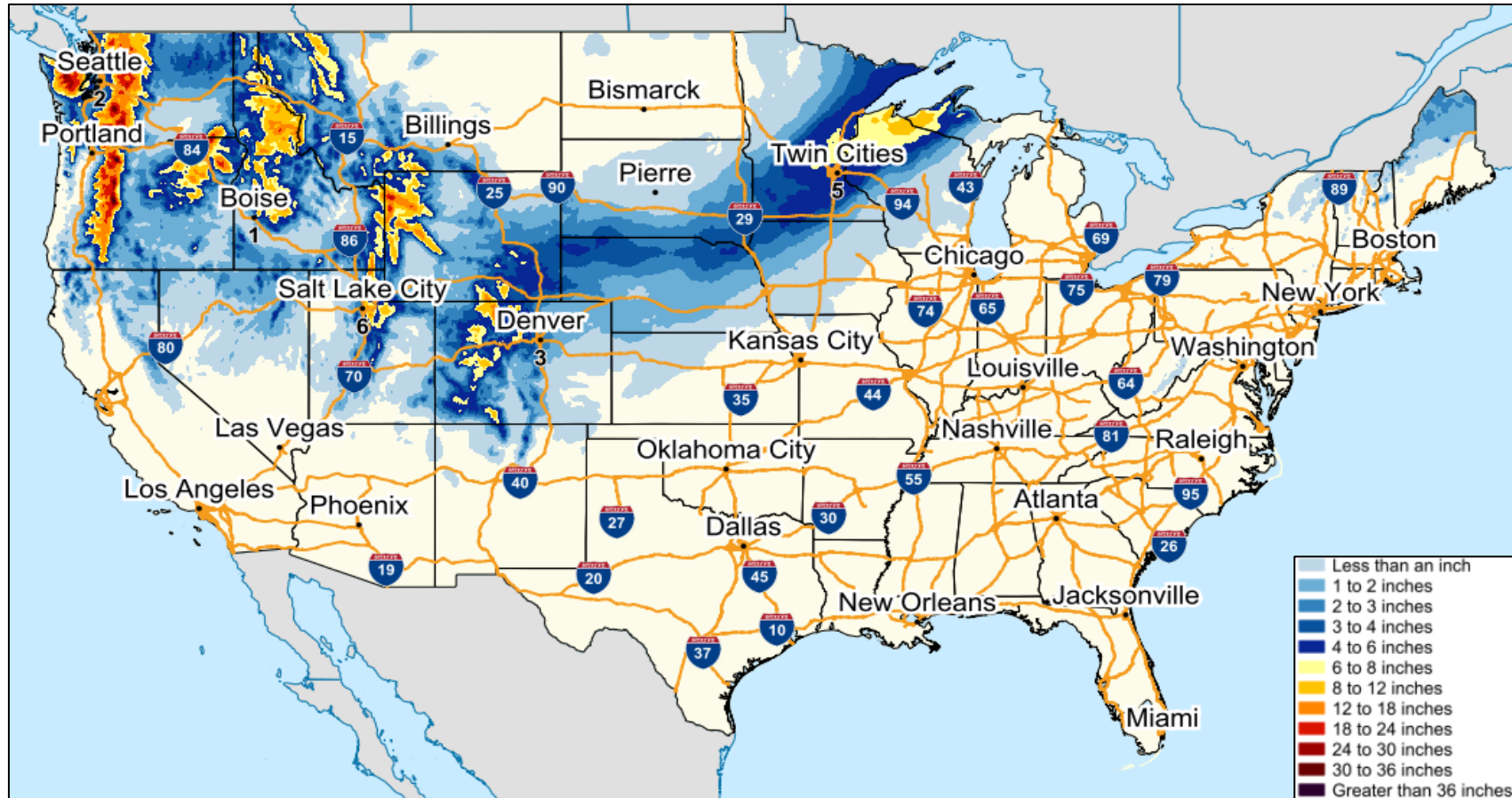

Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



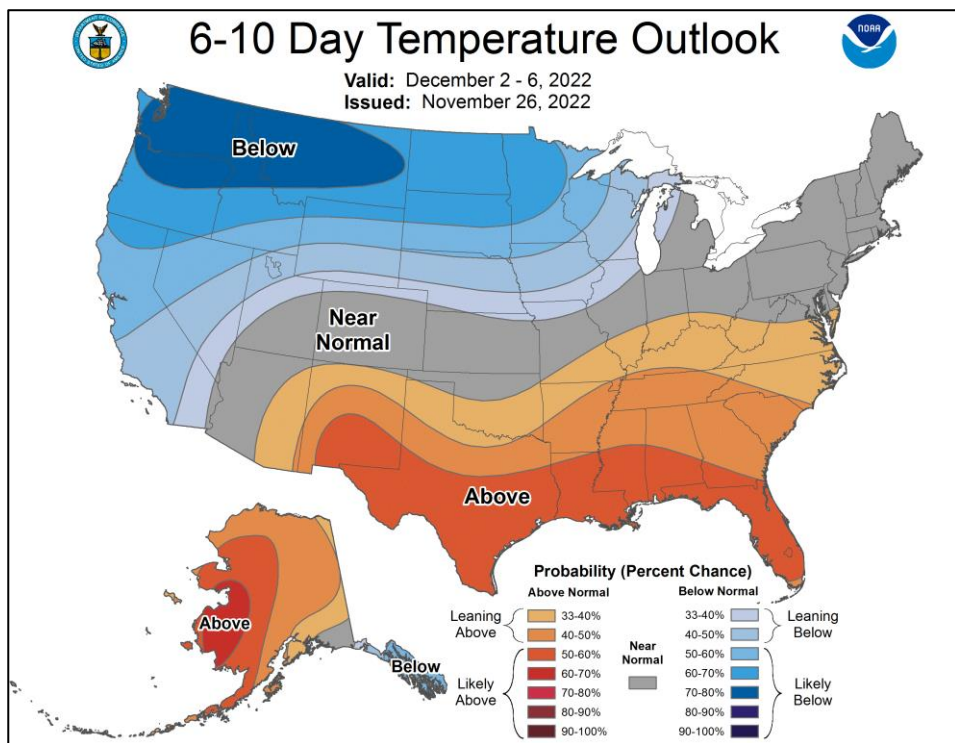

Forecast Snowfall

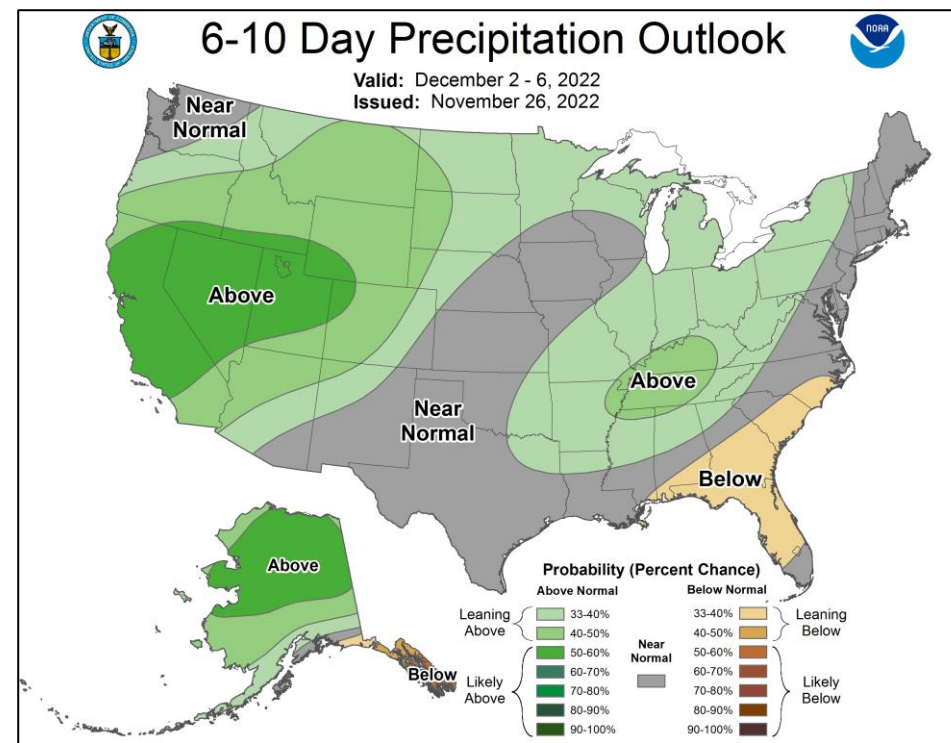

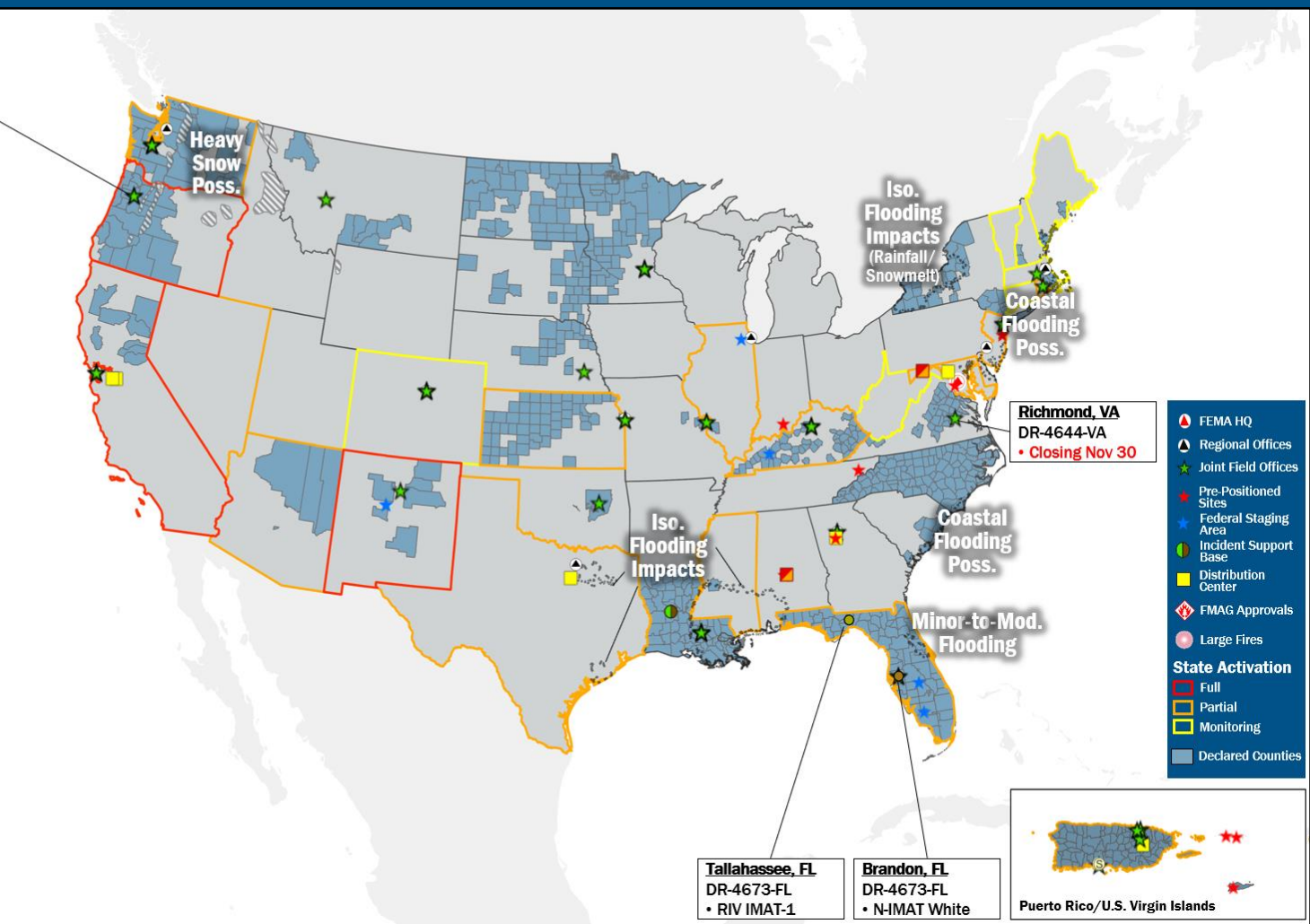
