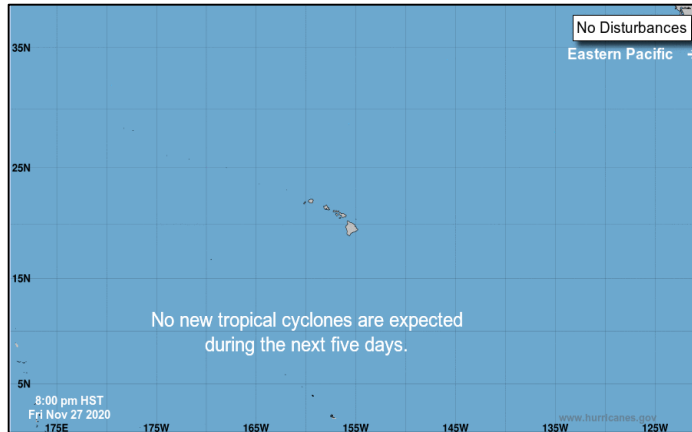

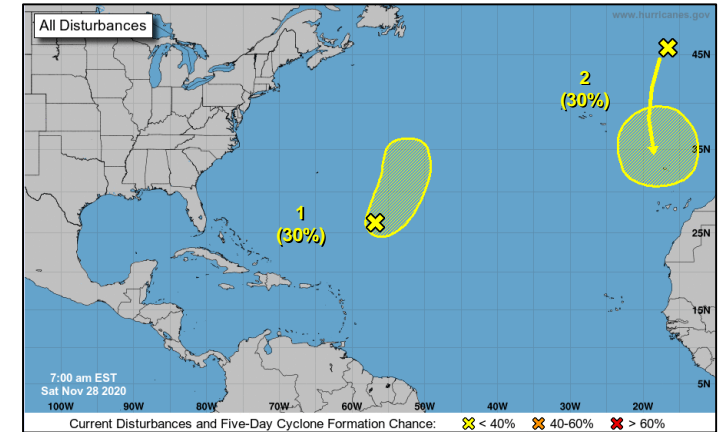

- Marginally conducive for development this weekend
- 48-hour formation chance: Low (30%)
- 5-day formation chance: Low (30%)

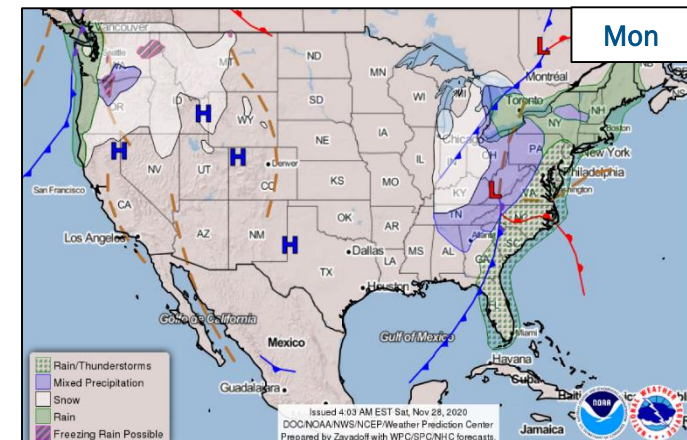
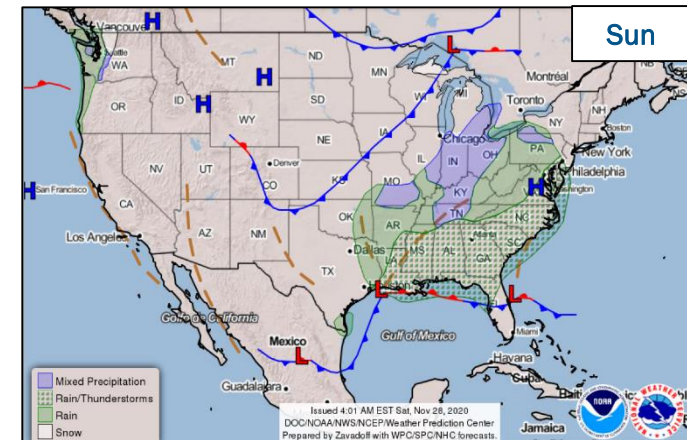
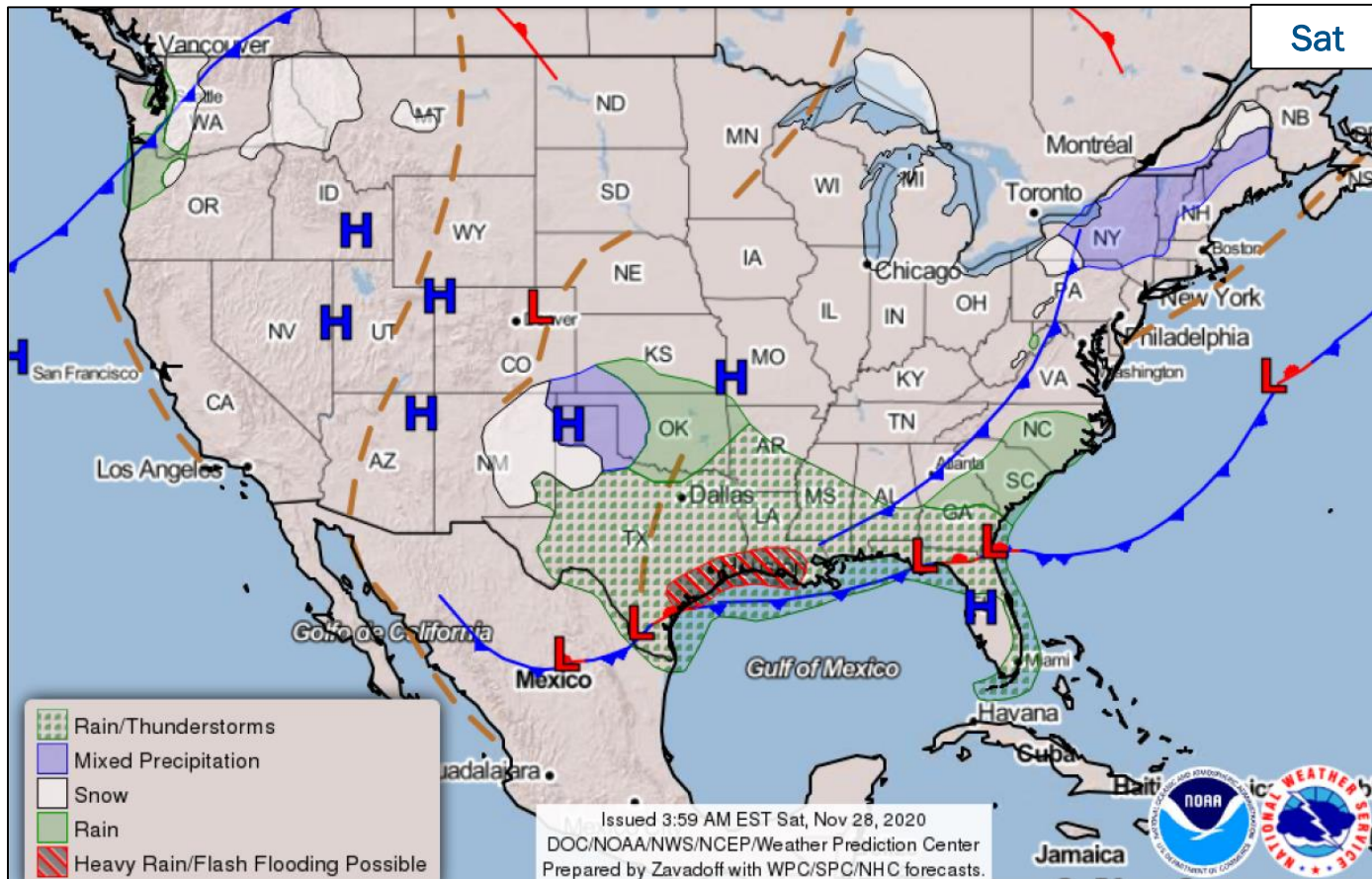
### Disturbance 2 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to move S midway between Portugal and Azores
- Marginally conducive to acquire subtropical characteristics early next week

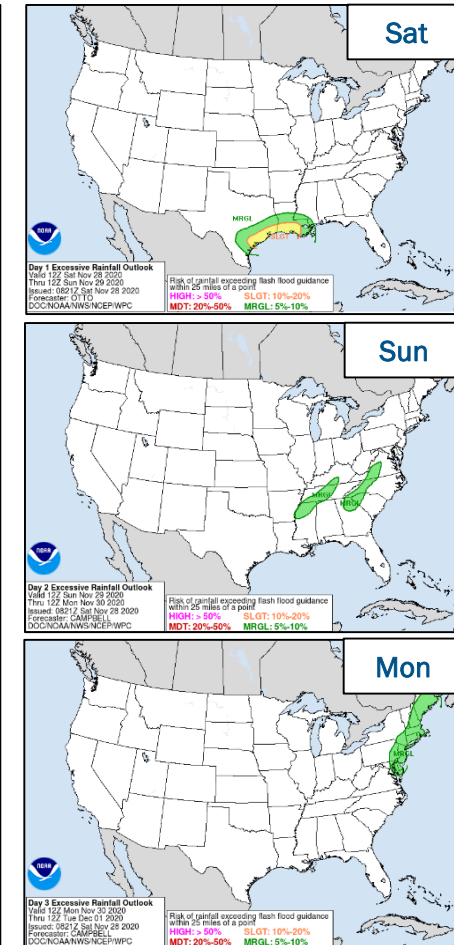
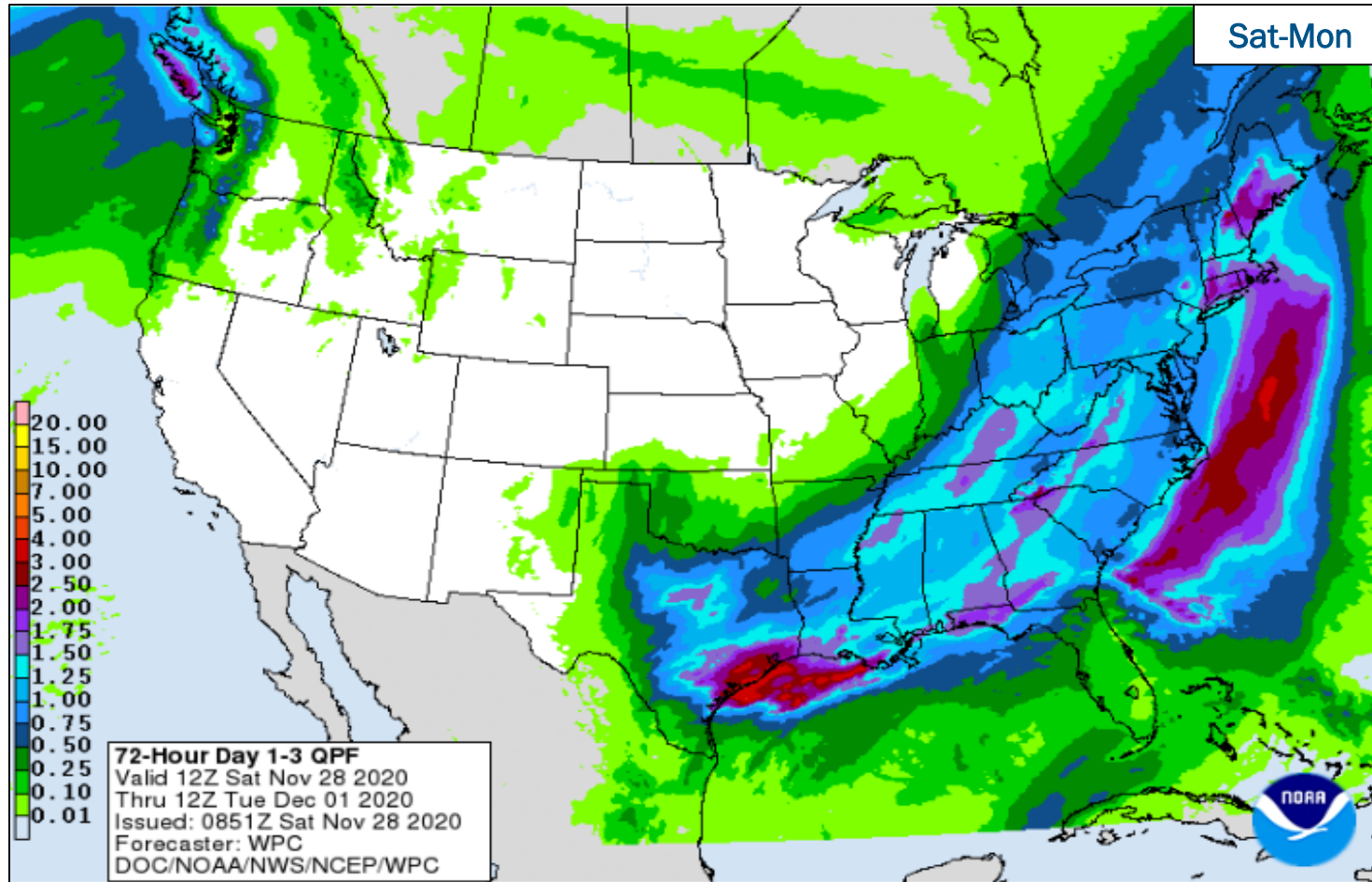
# Severe Weather Outlook

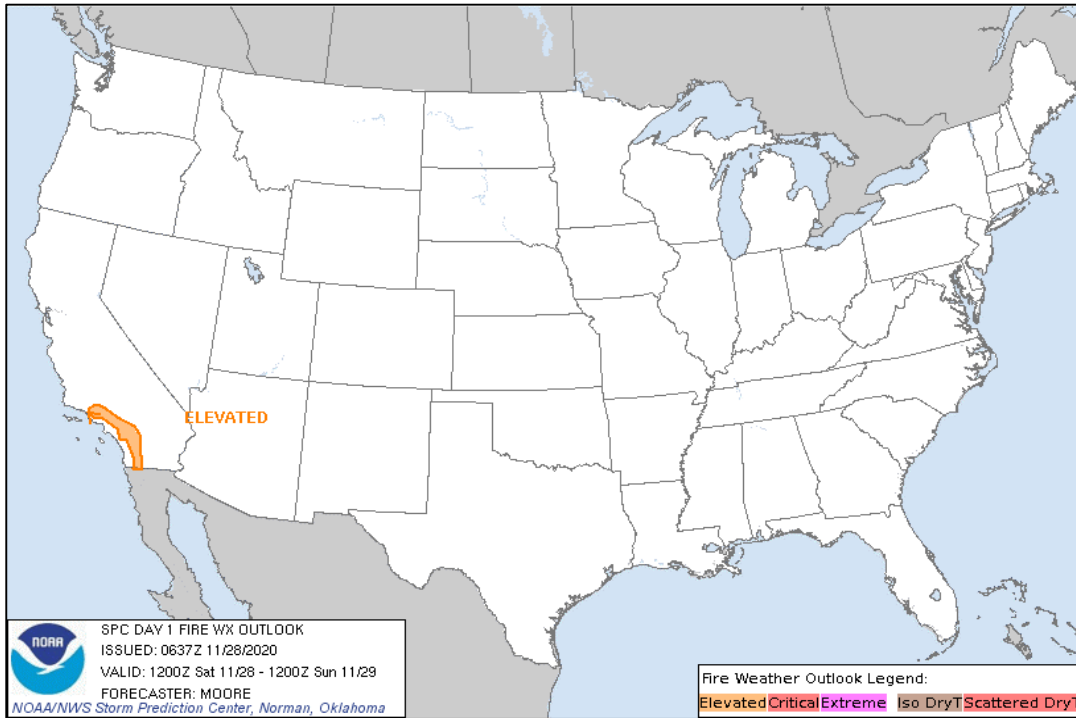

# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

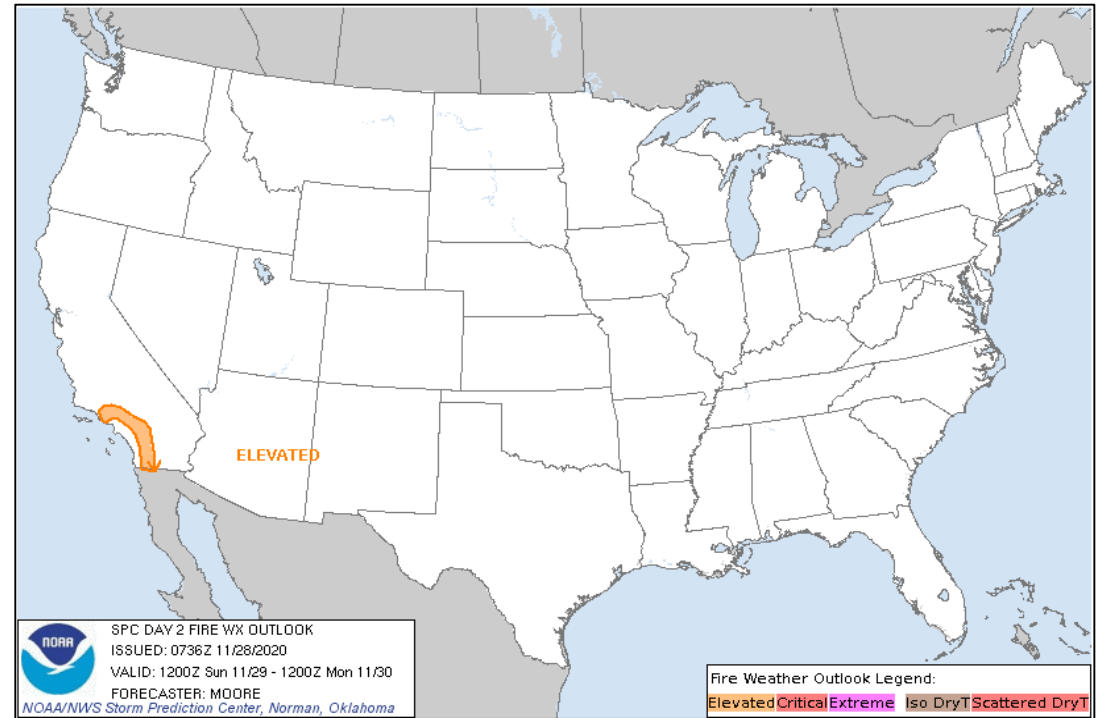
