Mauna Loa Volcanic Eruption - Hawaii

Situation: On Nov 28, a magnitude 3.2 earthquake occurred at the summit of Mauna Loa on the Big Island of Hawaii. At this time, lava flows are contained within the summit area and are not threatening downslope communities. At its current location, the lava flows are estimated to take 1-2 weeks to reach the outskirts of Hilo. Historically lava flows in this area last about 2 weeks. Volcanic gas, fine ash, and Pele's Hair (fine threads of volcanic glass) may be carried downwind. The situation is dynamic and the location and advance of lava flows can change rapidly. Earthquakes (at least 66 so far) ranging from M2.5 to M4.2 continue near the Mauna Loa summit.

- Volcano Alert Level: WARNING (hazardous eruption is imminent, underway or suspected)
- Aviation Color Code: RED (eruption is underway or suspected with significant emission of volcanic ash into the atmosphere)
- Volcanic Ash Advisories: None; no flight restrictions

Impacts:

- Precautionary evacuations are in effect; 2 shelters open with 56 occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count as of 6:49 a.m. ET)
- Mauna Loa Road closed from Kīpukapuaulu to the summit caldera








National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook








Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall












Tropical Outlook - Five-Day




