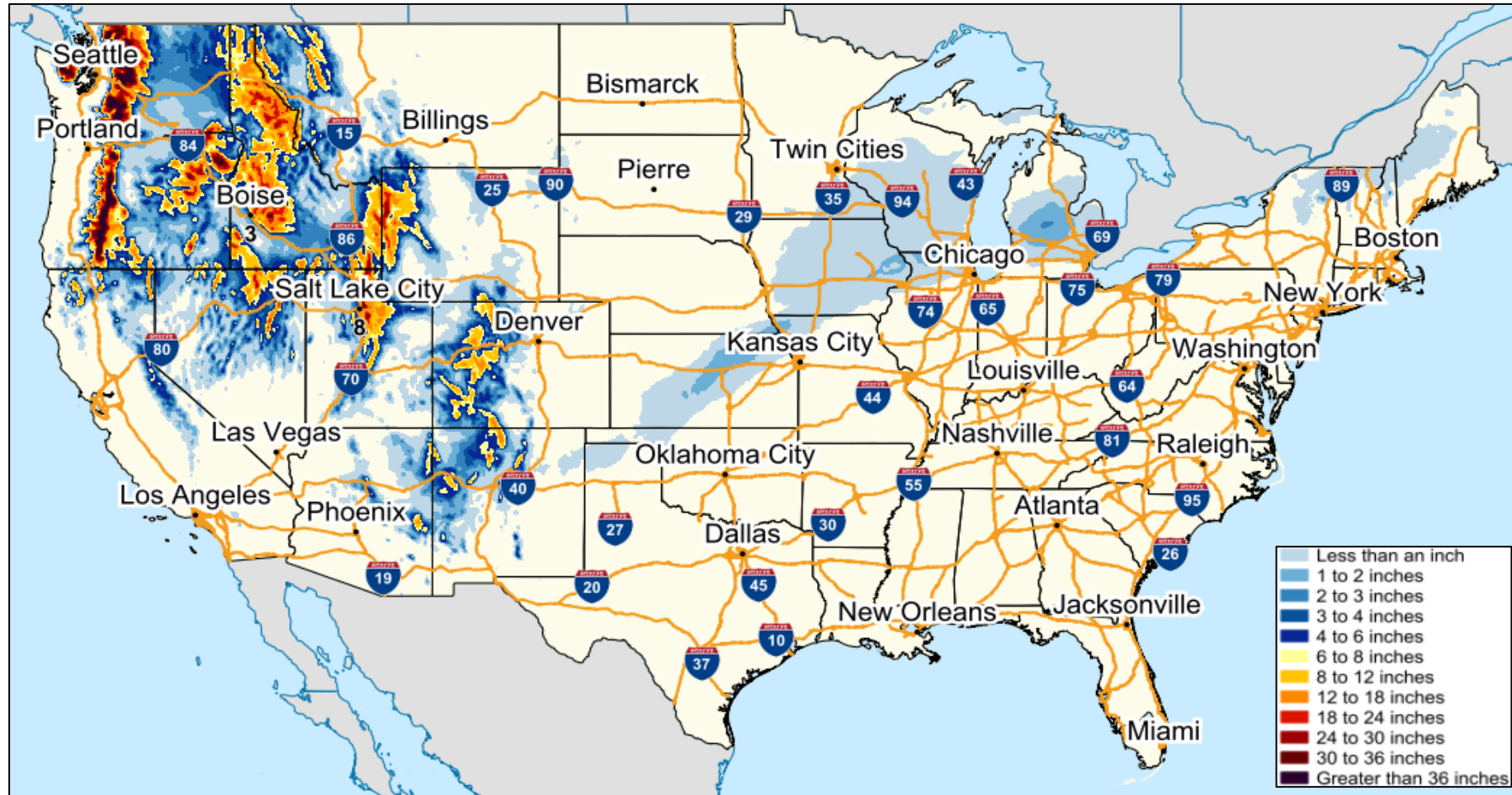
# National Weather Forecast
