Severe Weather – Southern Plains to Lower MS Valley - FINAL

<u>Current Situation</u>: Severe weather impacted the Southern Plains with high winds, large hail, and tornadoes through early Nov 5. There were approximately 180 homes damage. The region remains in contact and has Preliminary Damage Assessment (PDA) teams ready to support. Local assessments continue.

Impacts: (All Lifelines Green) (FEMA Region VI Enhanced Watch Overnight Summary, Nov 6)


- Oklahoma: The Governor declared a State of Emergency (Region VI SPOTREP as of 3:46 p.m. Nov 5)
- Minimal power outages across the region (Eagle-I as of 8:40 a.m. ET Nov 6)
- Shelters: 1 with 0 occupants (ARC report as of 6:50 a.m. ET Nov 6)
 - One (1) fatality and seven (7) injuries

State / Local Response:

- TX EOC at Partial Activation (Severe Weather) with ESF 1,3,4,6-10,12,13,15,17,19
- TX TF-1/TF-2 (Type 3 with boats) activated
- OK EOC at Monitoring (with increased staff and extended hours) (Severe Weather)

FEMA / Federal Response:

- Region VI RWC: Monitoring; RRCC: Rostered
- National Watch Center is monitoring in coordination with FEMA Region VI



Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)


- Located several hundred miles E of Bermuda
- A short-lived tropical depression or storm is likely to form in the next day or so
- Forecast to turn northward and northeastward and merge with a strong cold front
- Formation chance 48-hour: High (70%); 5-day: High (70%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 7:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 100 miles N of Puerto Rico
- Forecast to move northward over the southwestern Atlantic later today
- A subtropical or tropical depression is likely to form early this week
- Formation chance 48-hour: High (70%); 5-day: High (90%)




National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Forecast Snowfall






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Long Range Outlooks – Nov 11-15

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability











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FEMA Common Operating Picture
