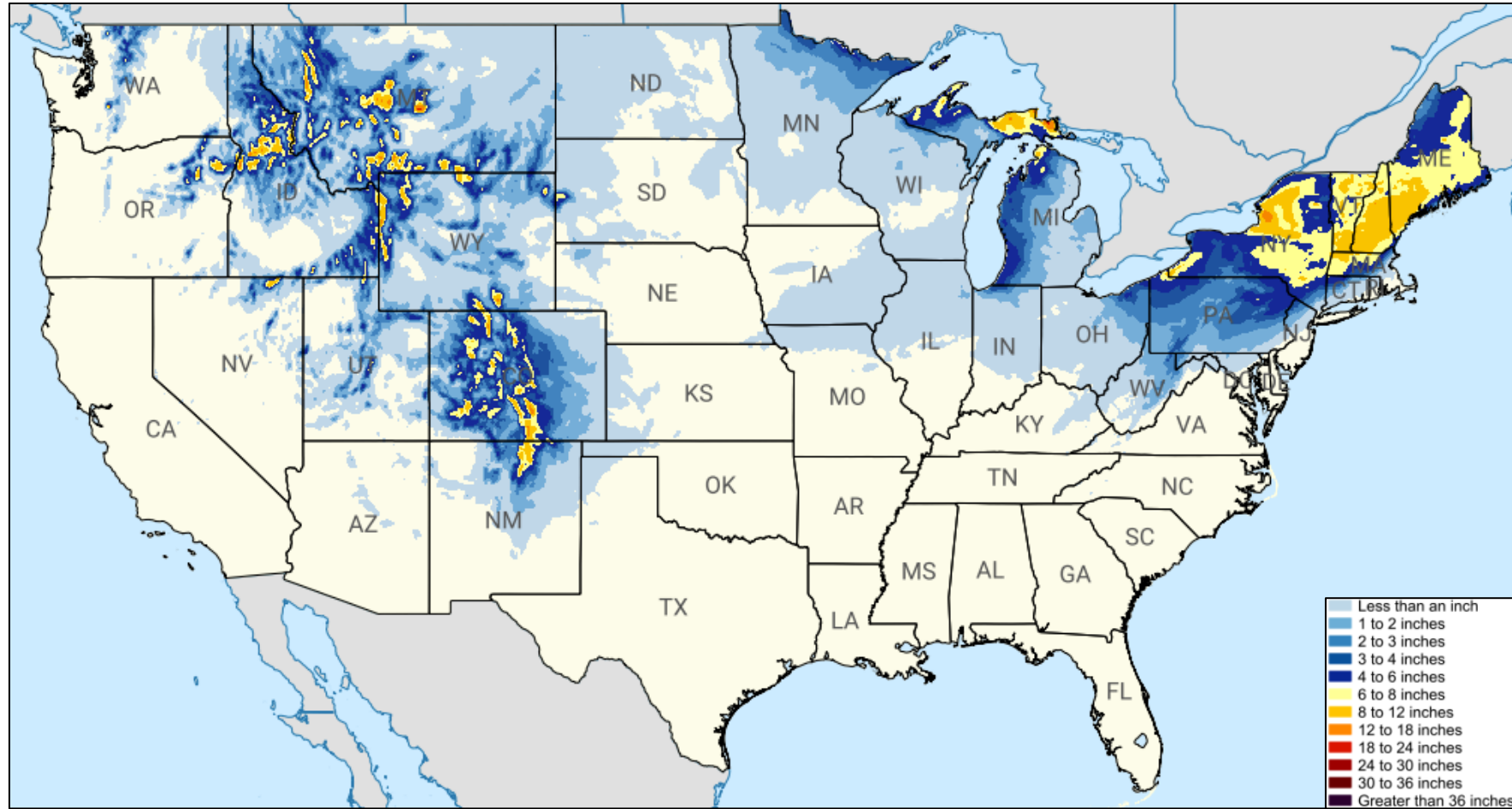
# National Weather Forecast

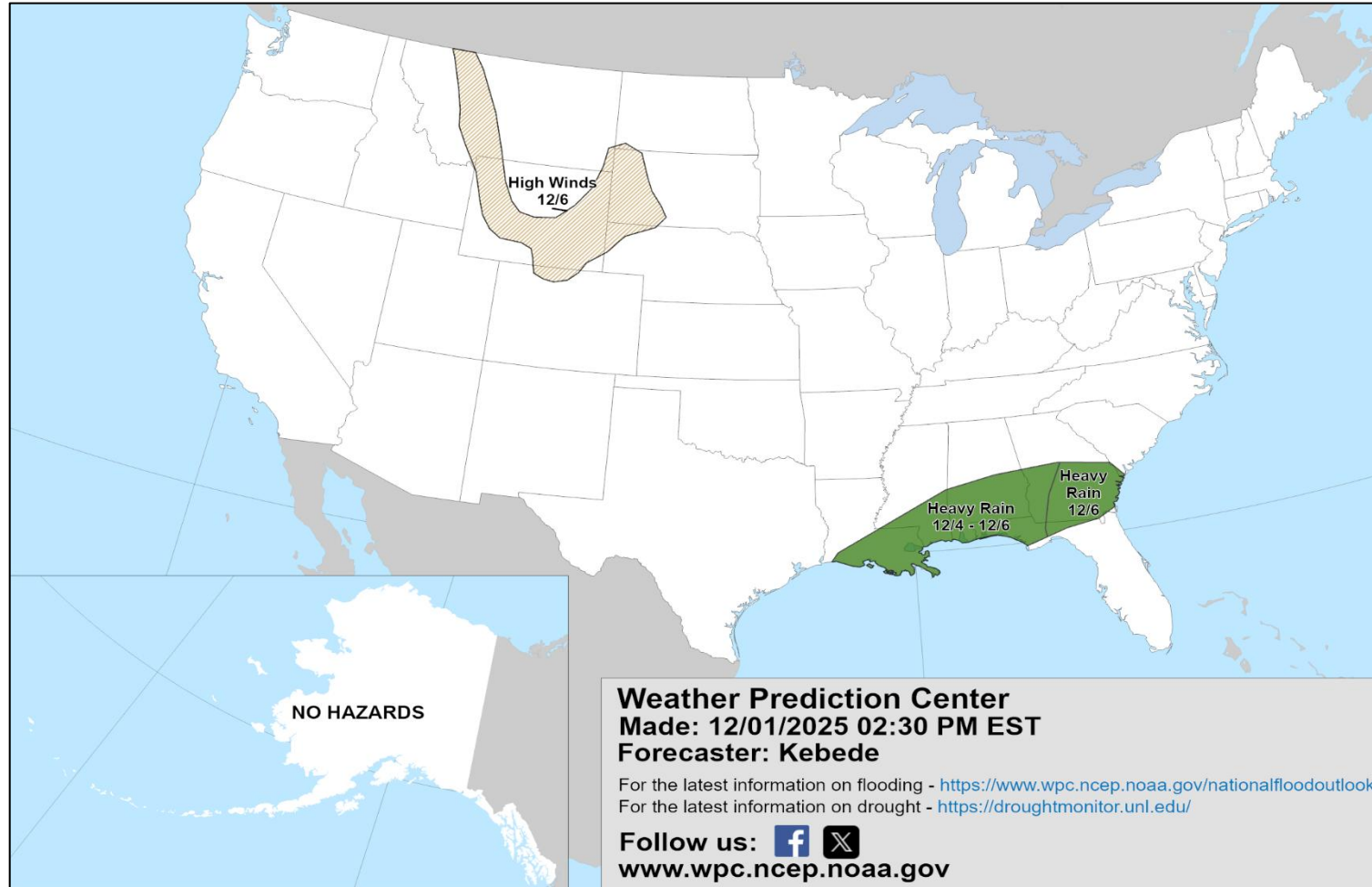

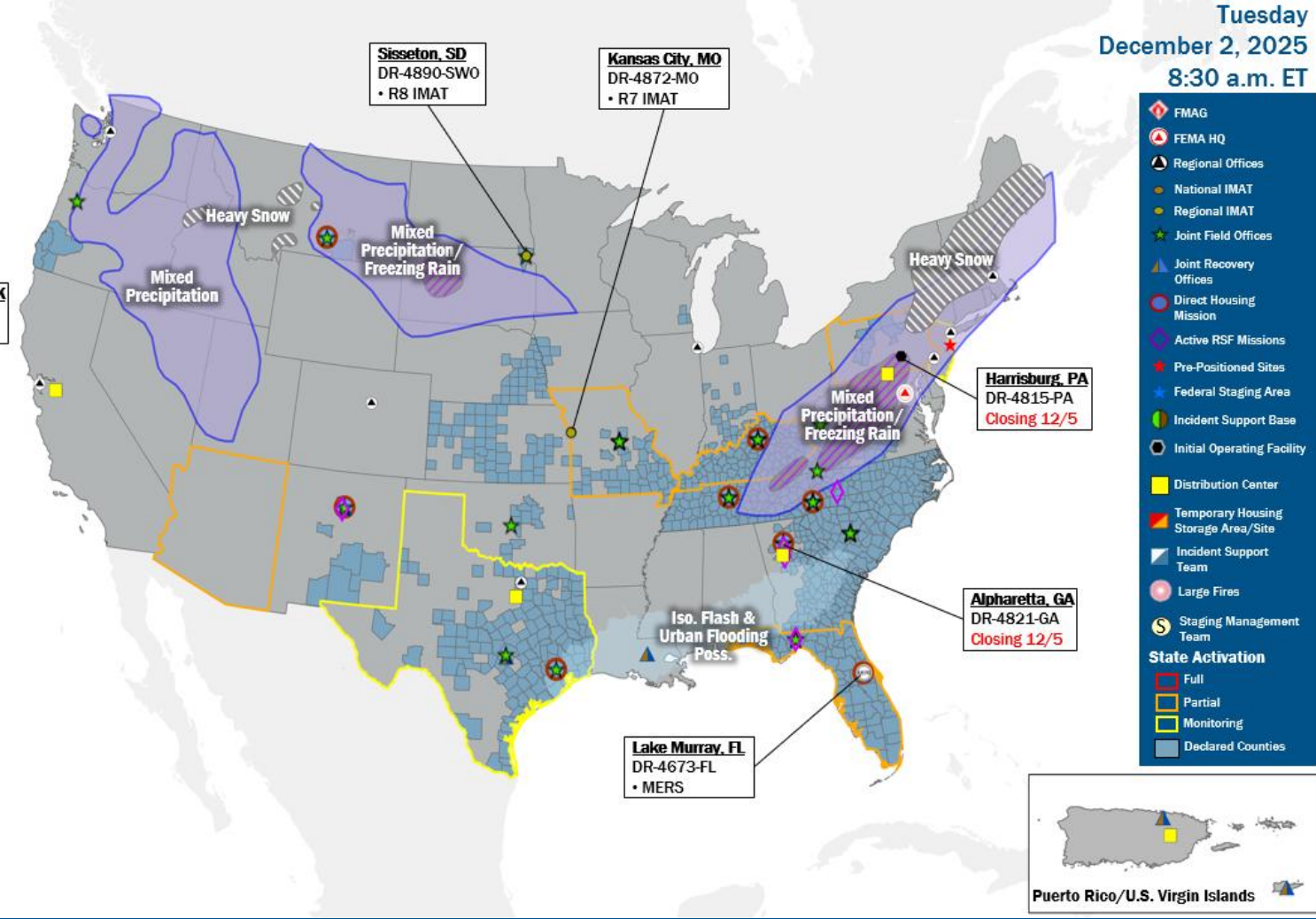

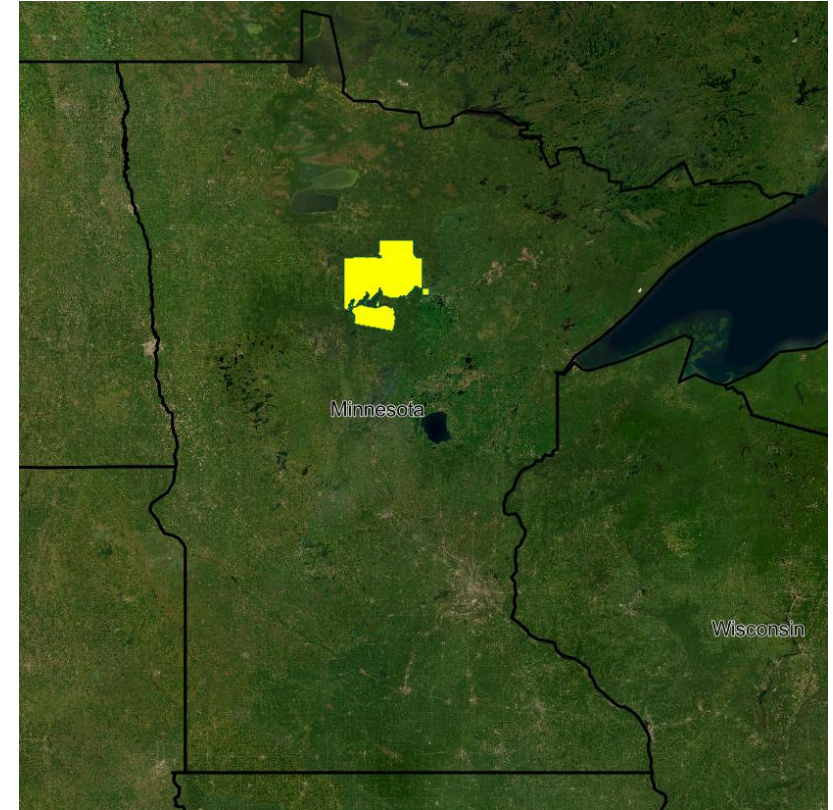
