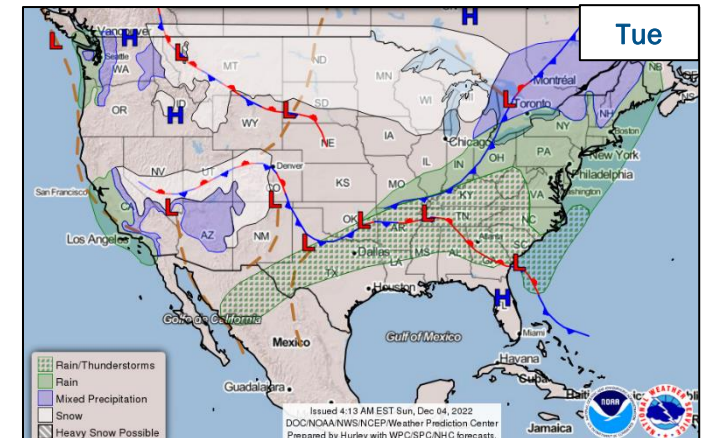

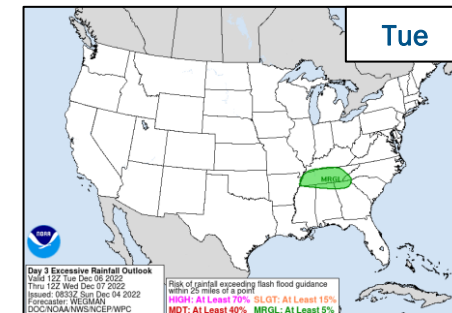

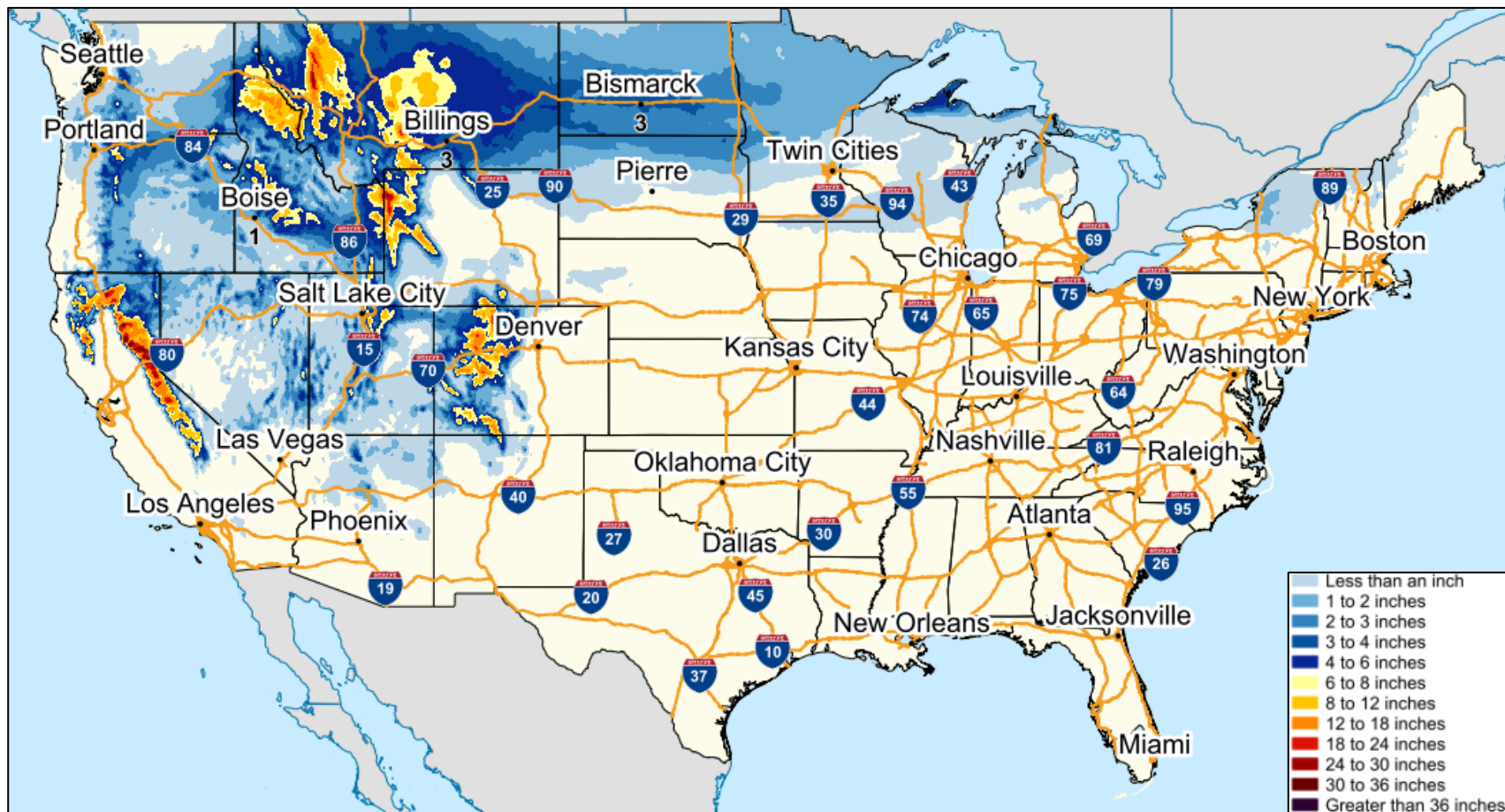
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

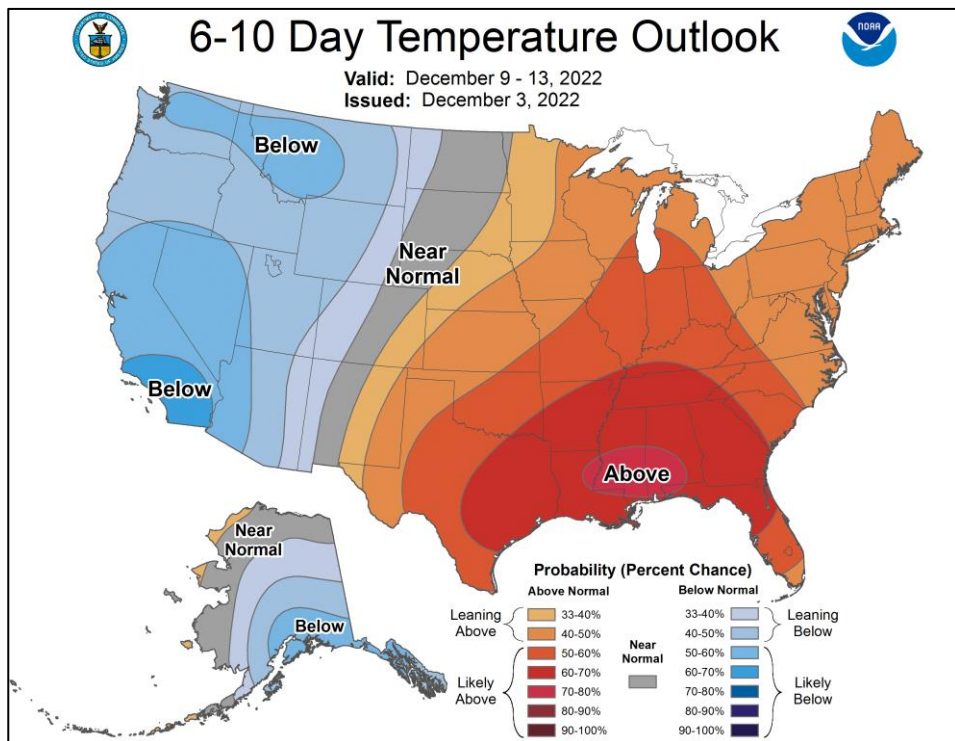

Forecast Snowfall

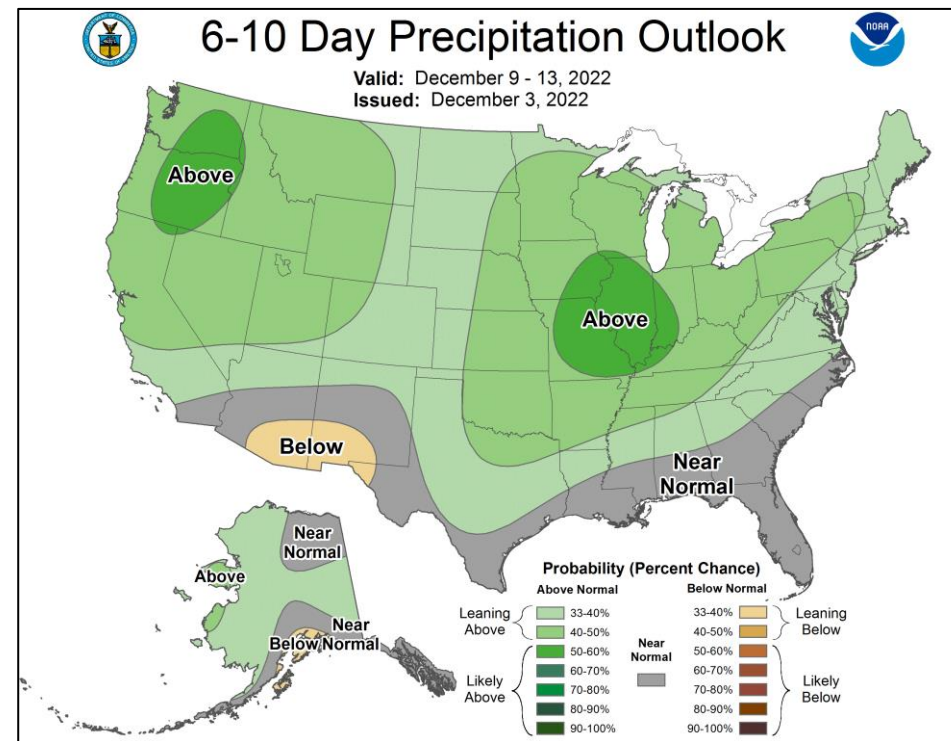

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability



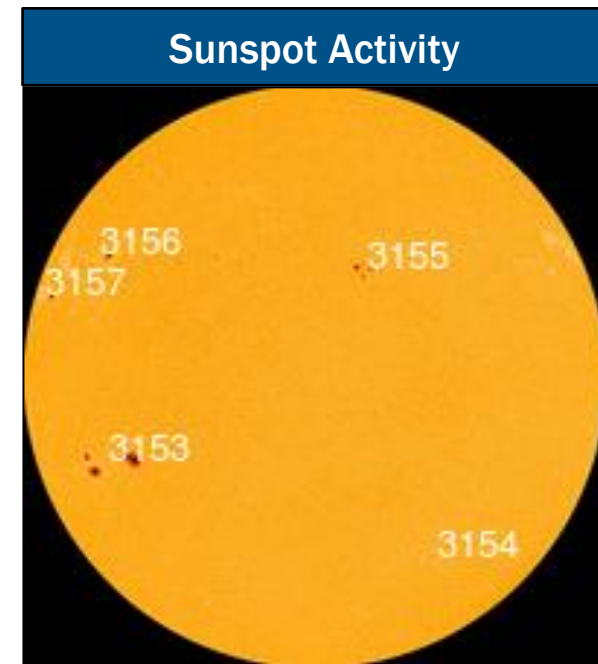
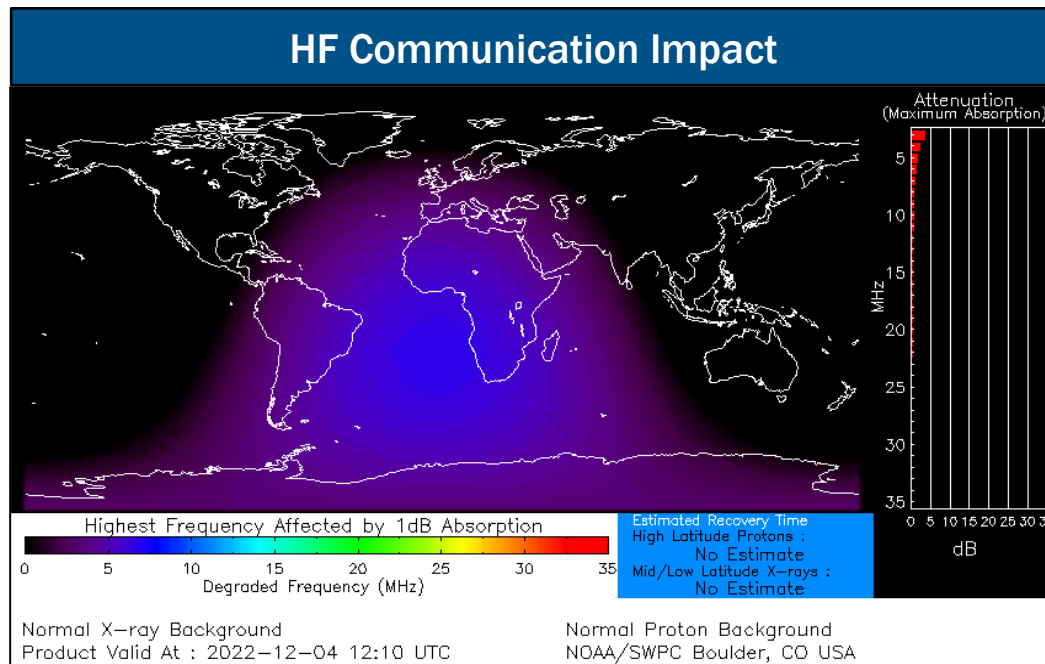

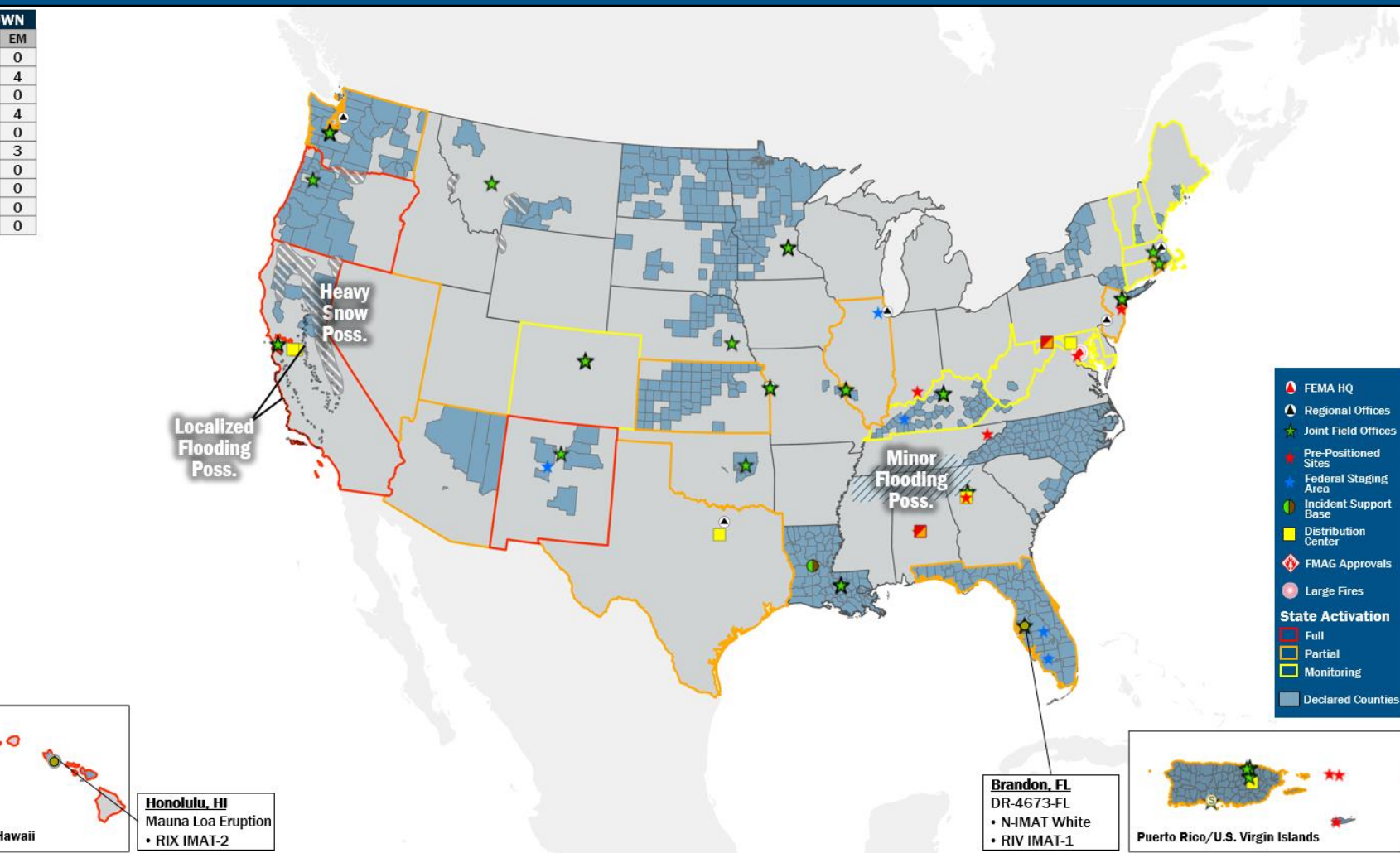
