


#### **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**








- Currently have several numbered spot groups on solar disk, giving us a 40% chance of R1-R2 (M-class flares) and a 10% chance of >= R3 (Xclass flares) radio blackout activity for the next few days.
- With the increase in X-ray flare activity, there is also a slight chance of solar radiation storms through 09 Dec.
- G1 geomagnetic storming is likely on 08 Dec associated with enhanced solar wind speeds.
