Updated 7 AM EST, December 9, 2025



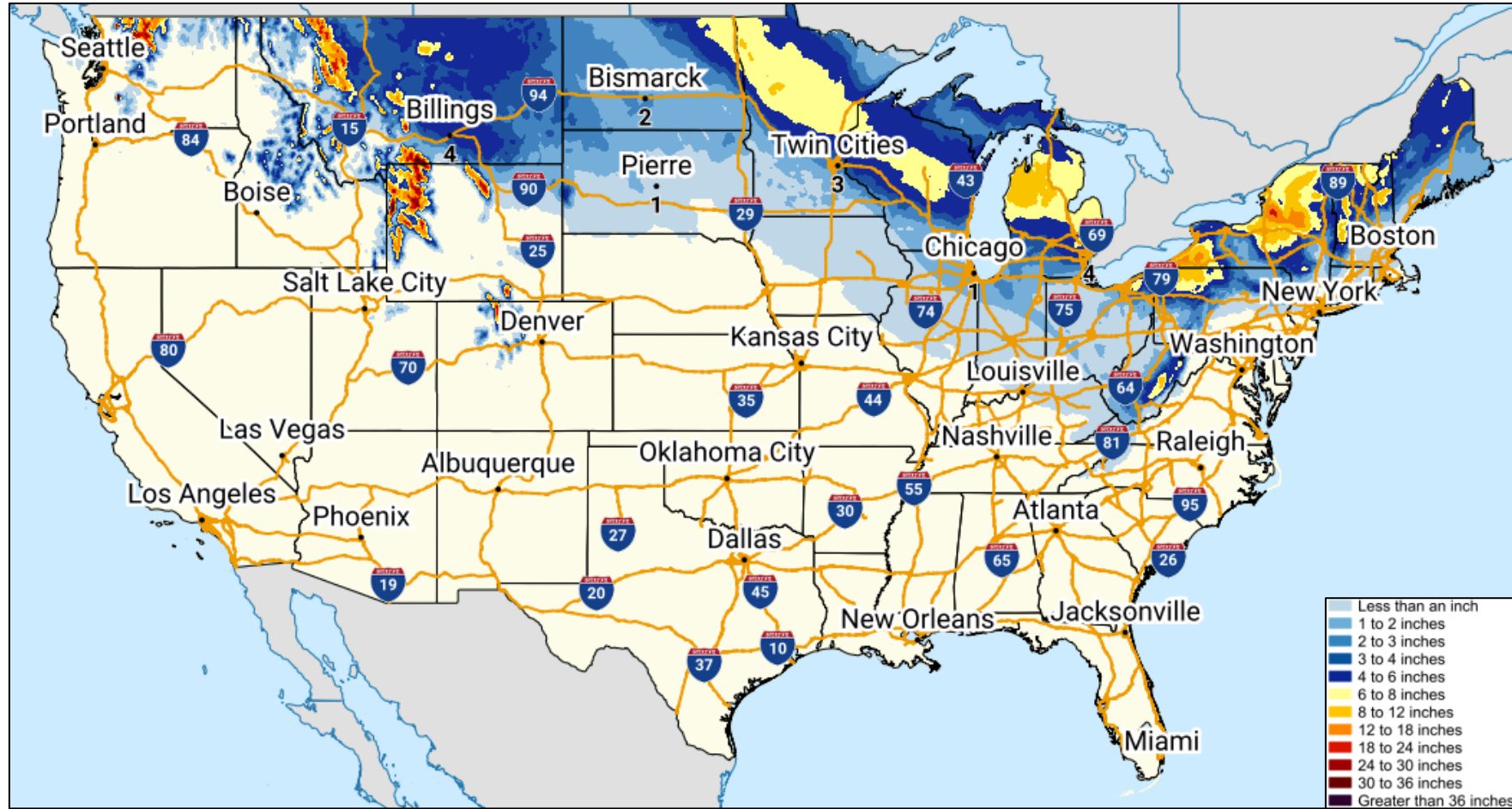
National Weather Forecast

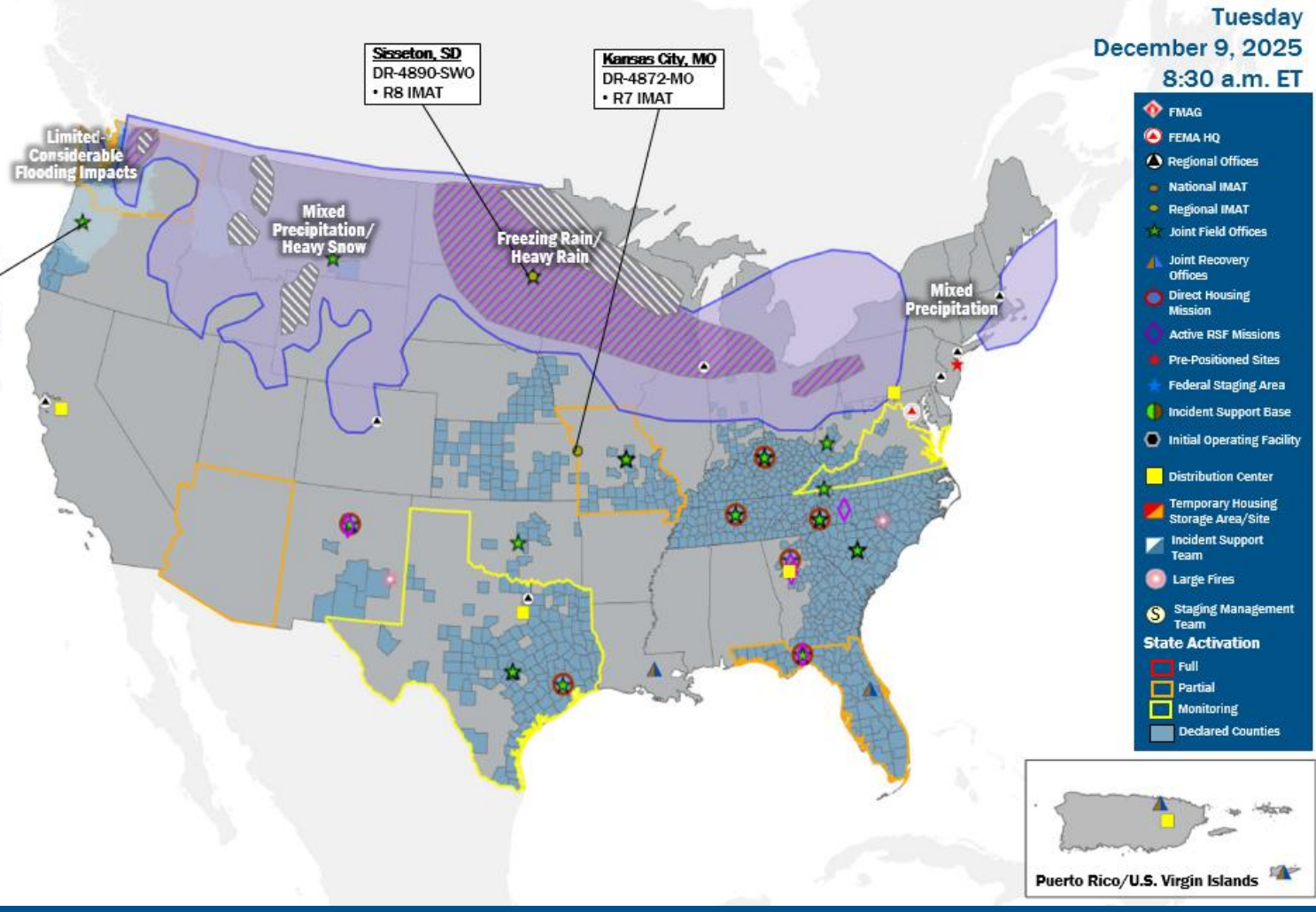
