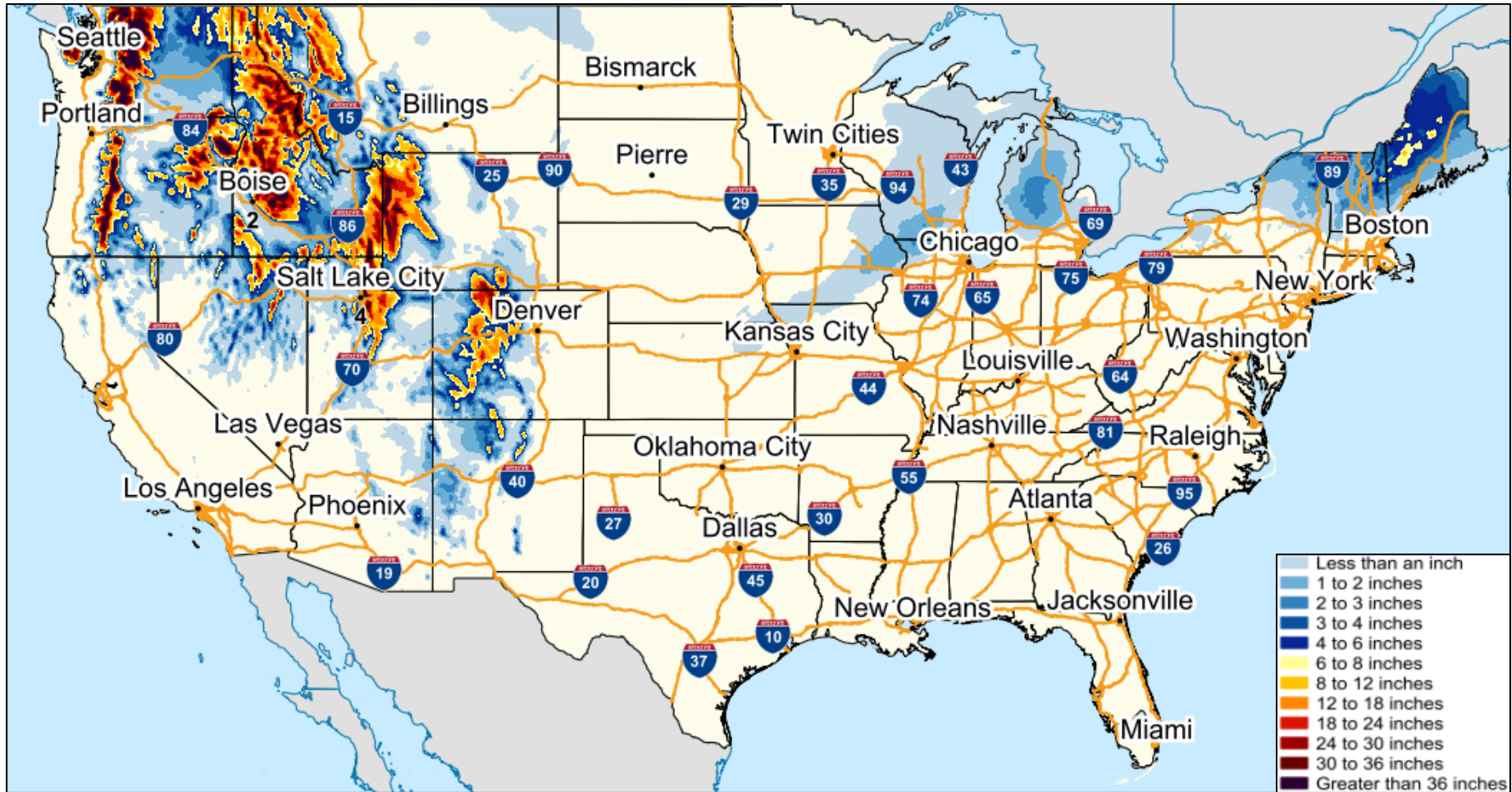
National Weather Forecast

Snowfall Forecast

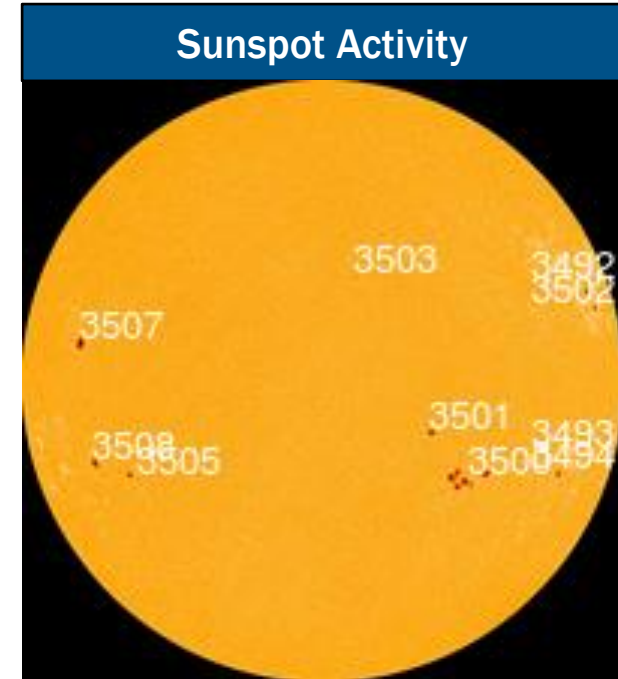
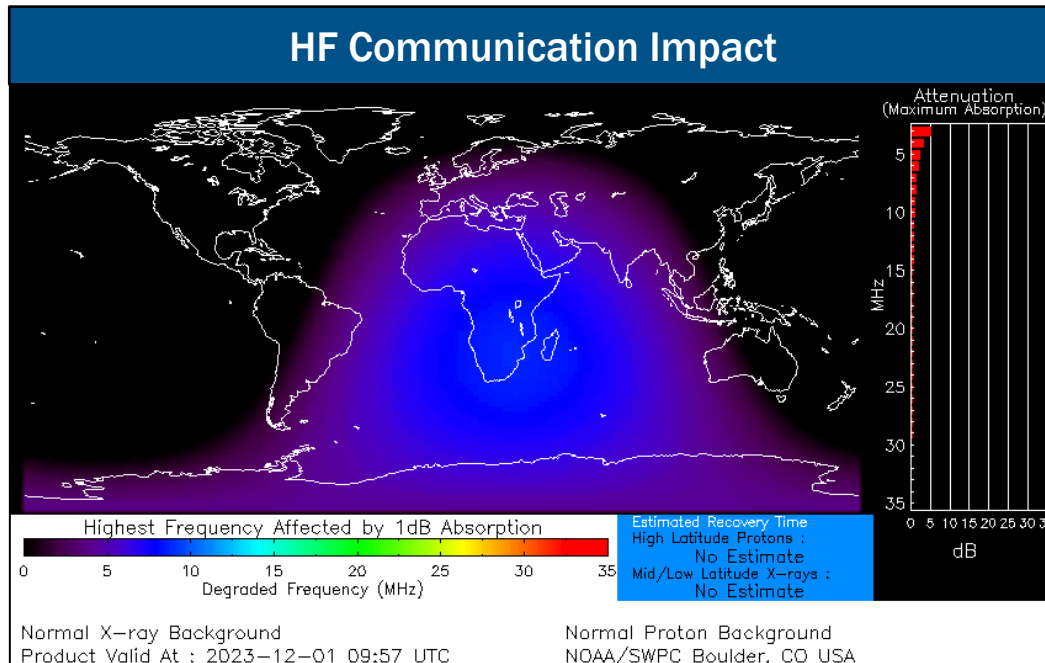

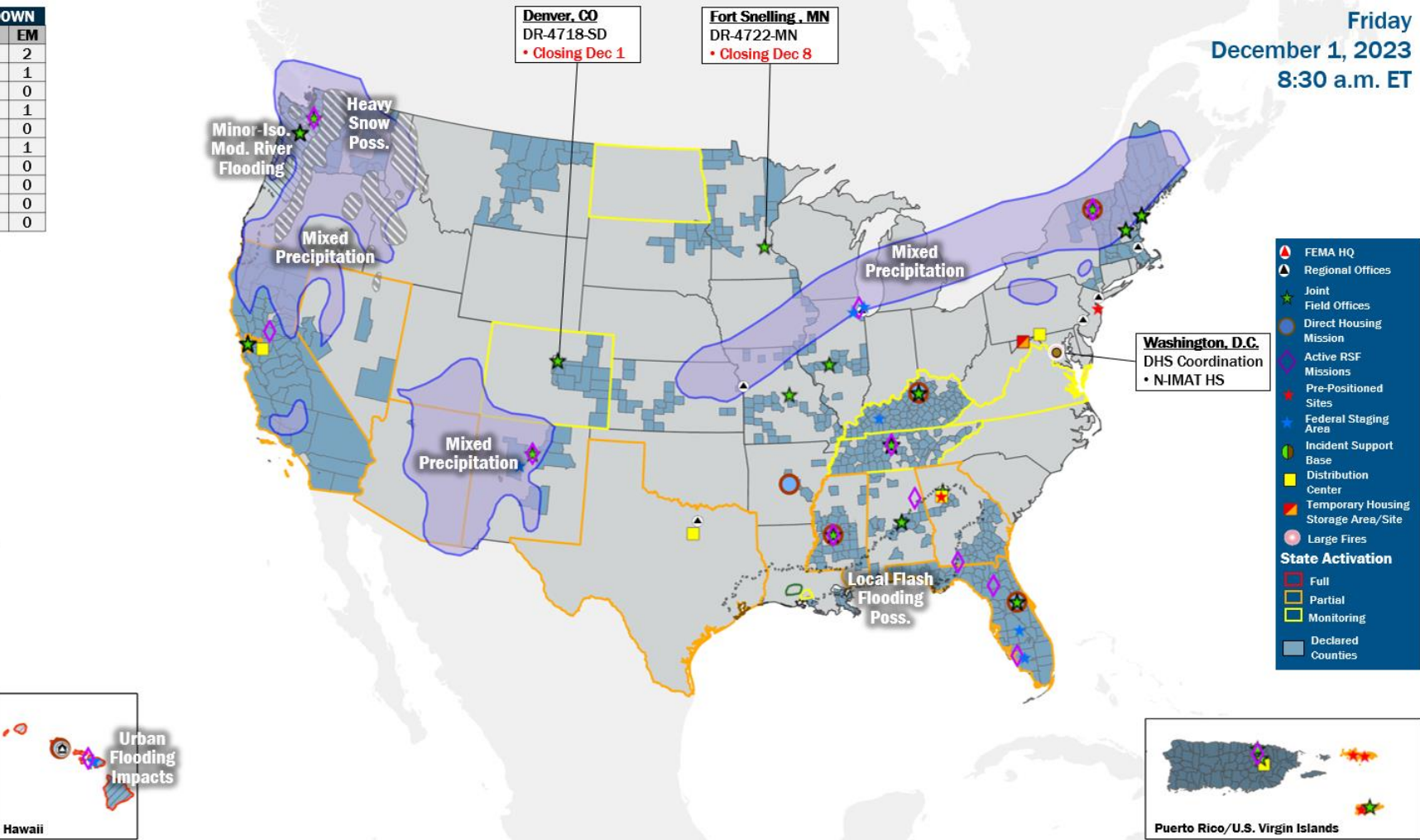
