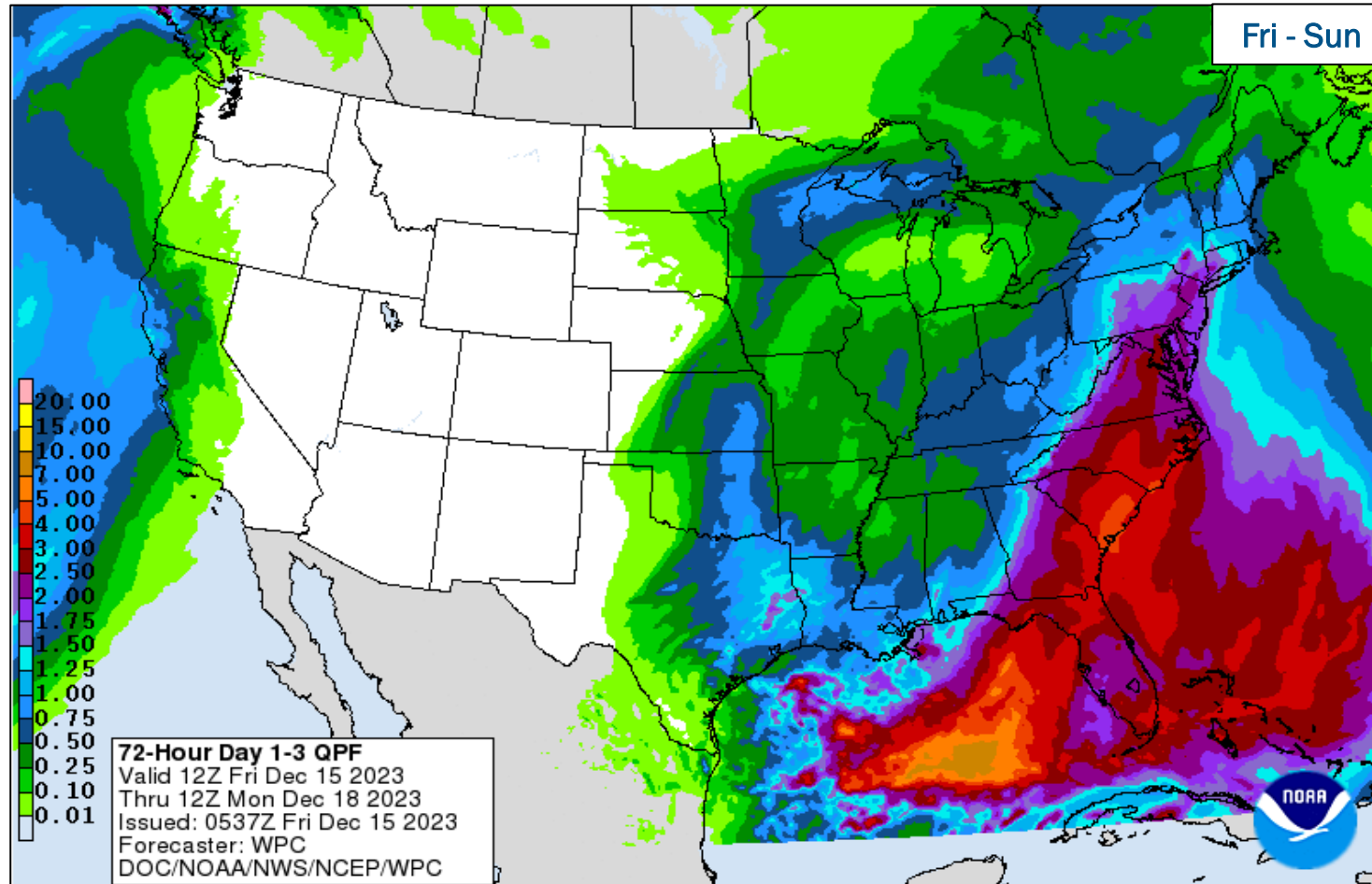
# National Weather Forecast



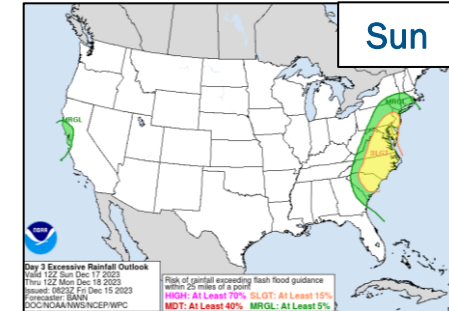
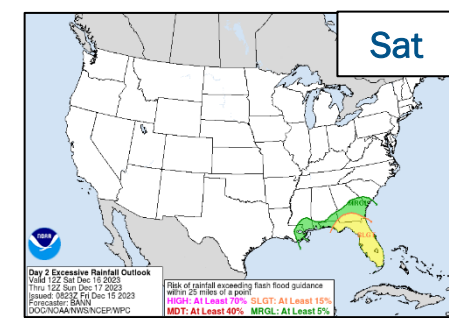
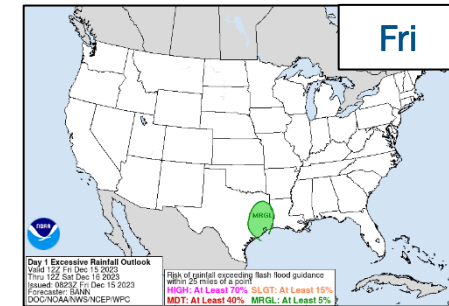

Fri - Sun



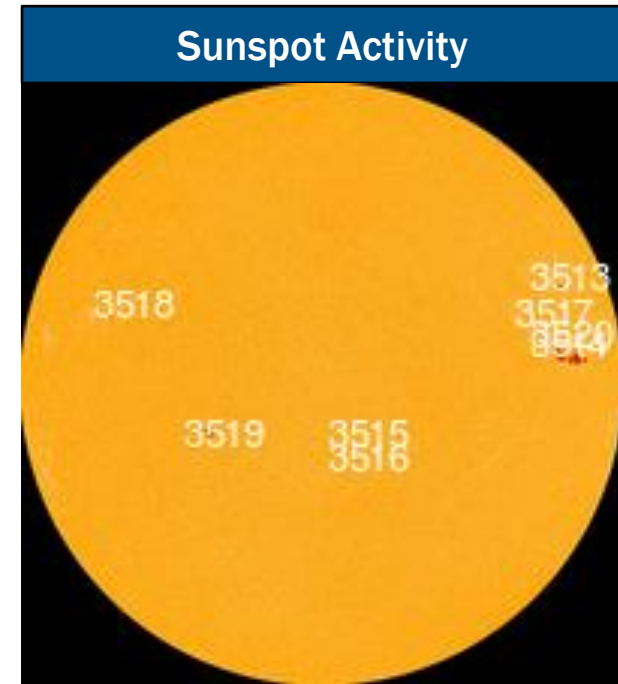
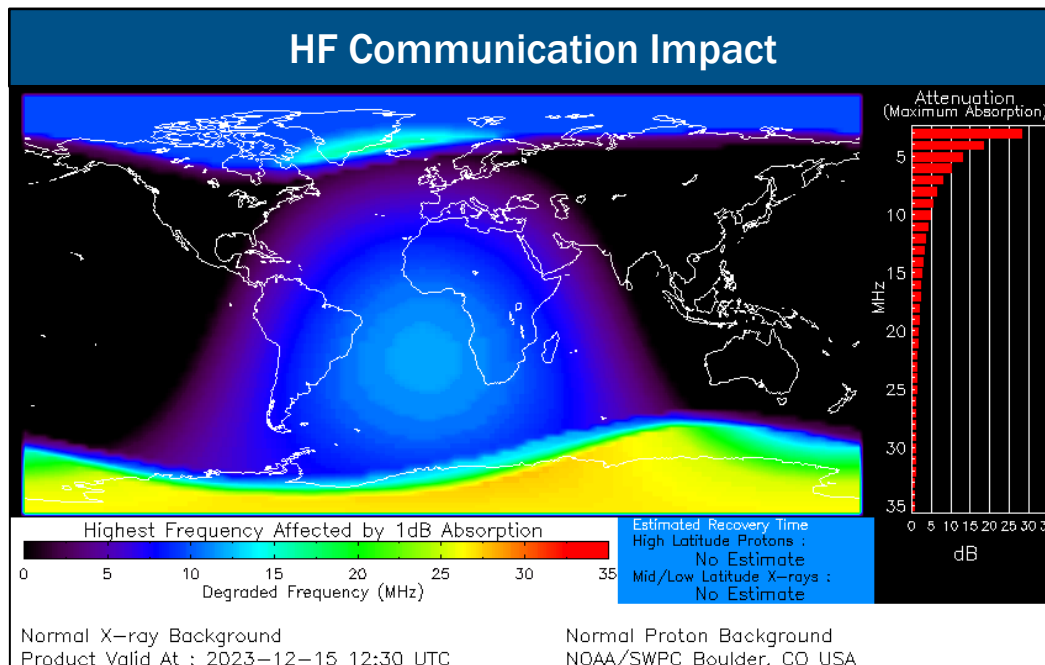
