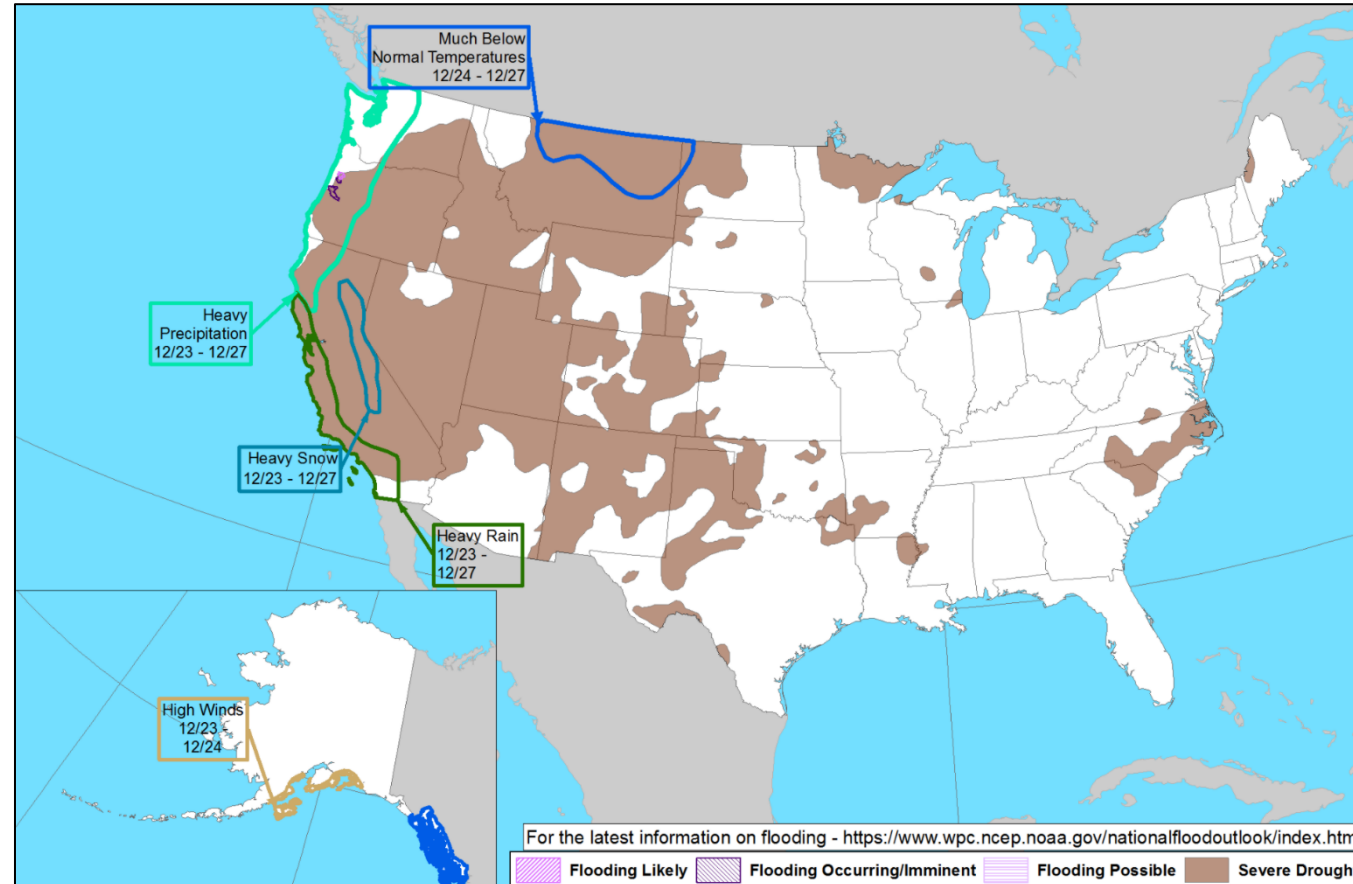
National Weather Forecast

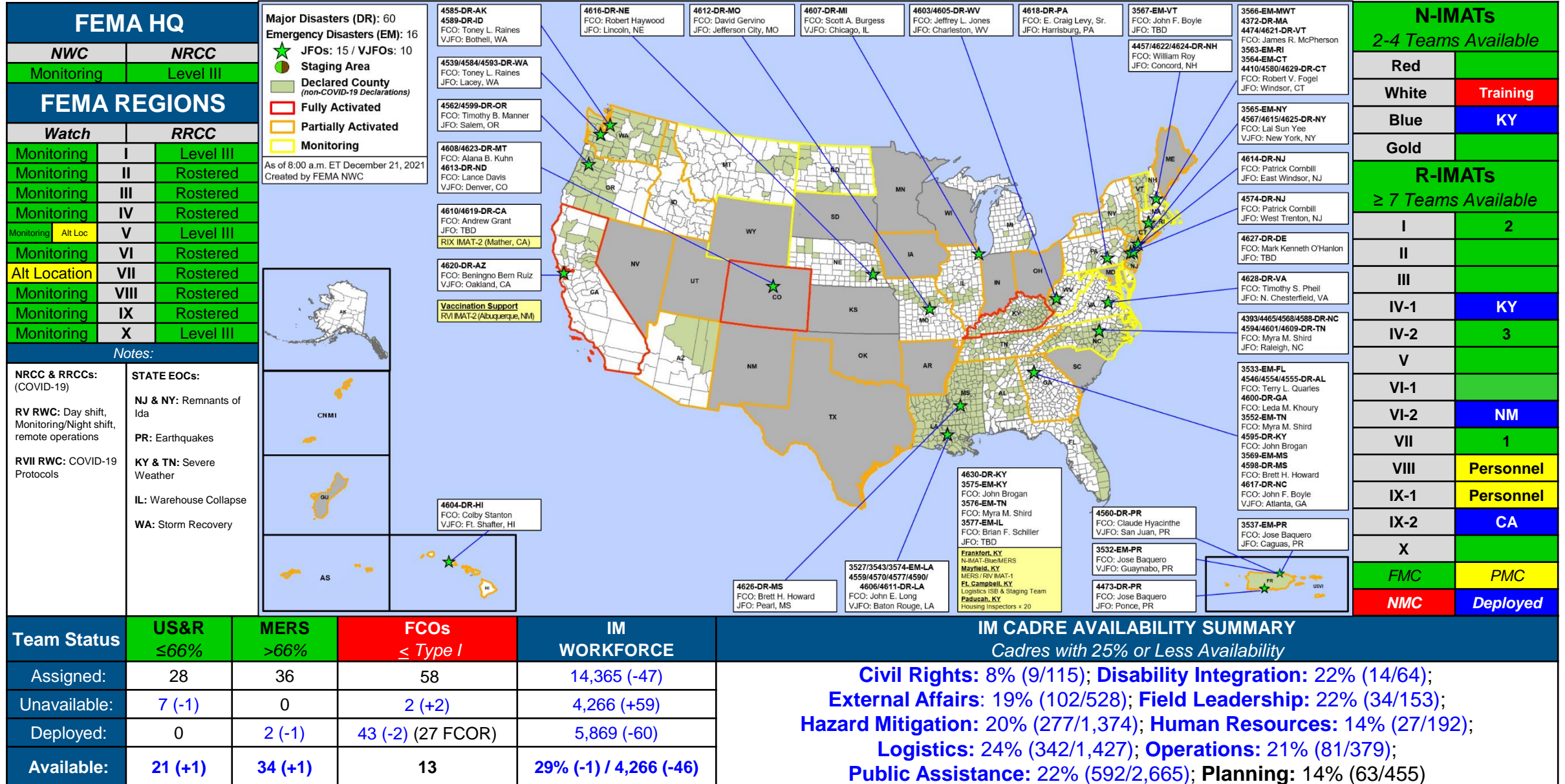

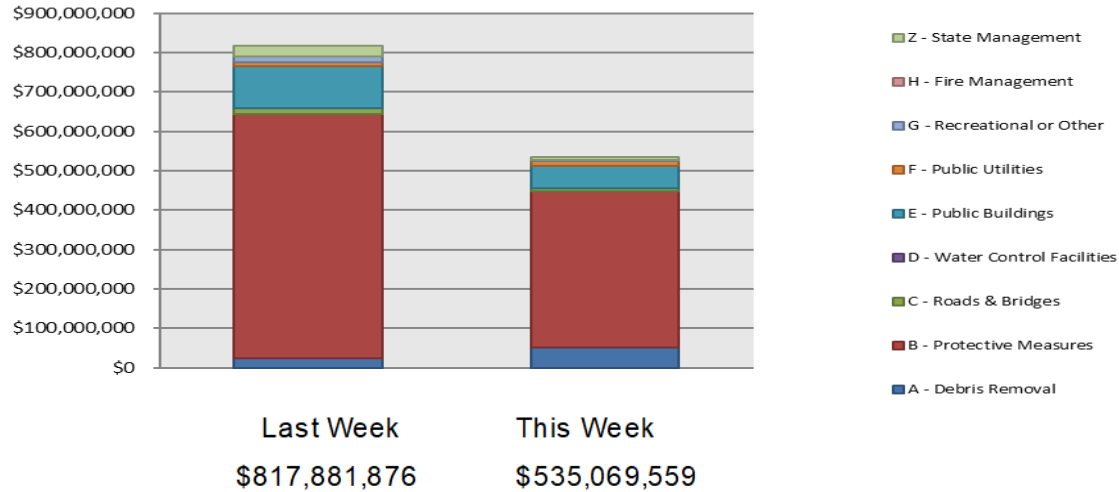

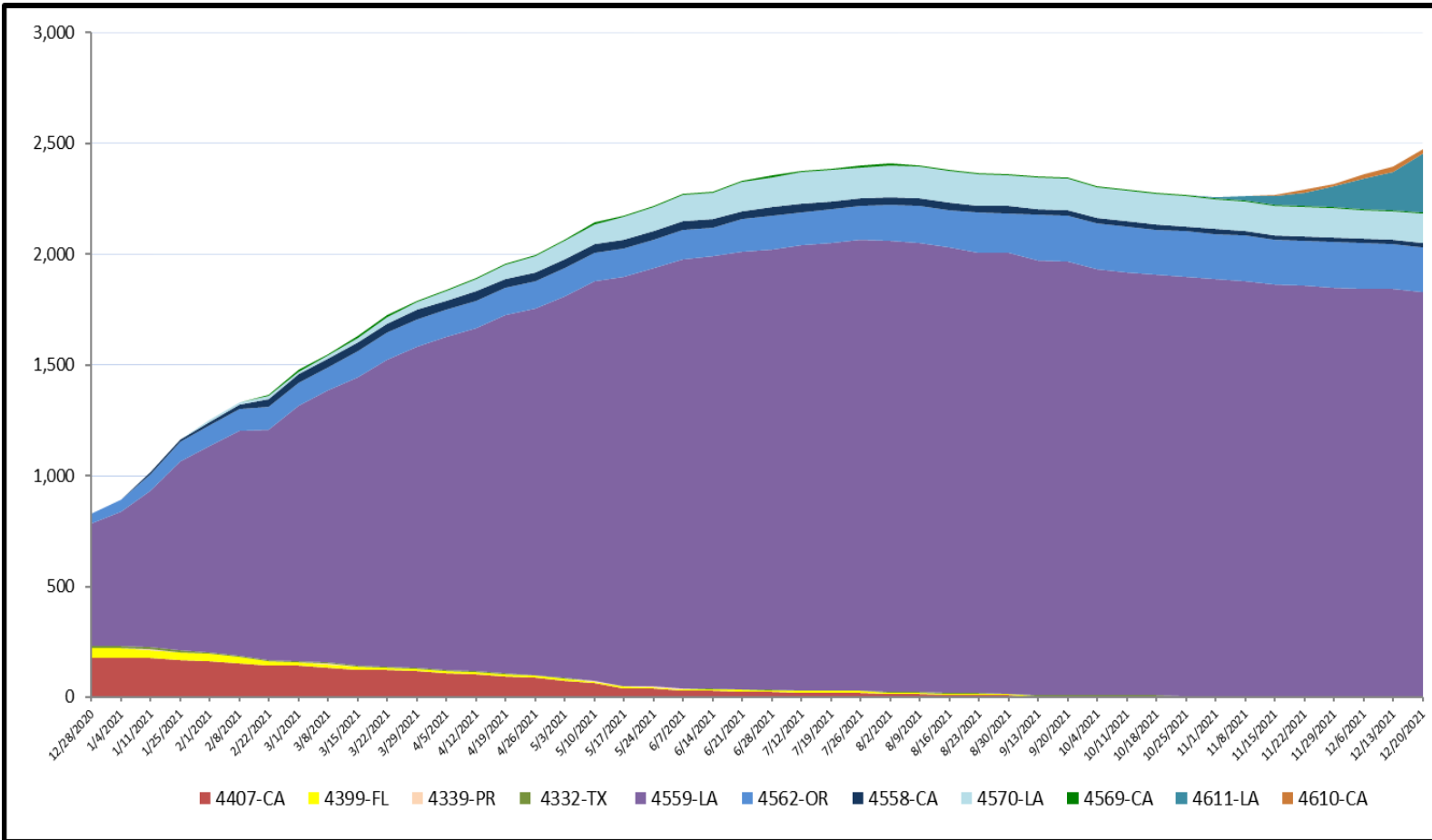

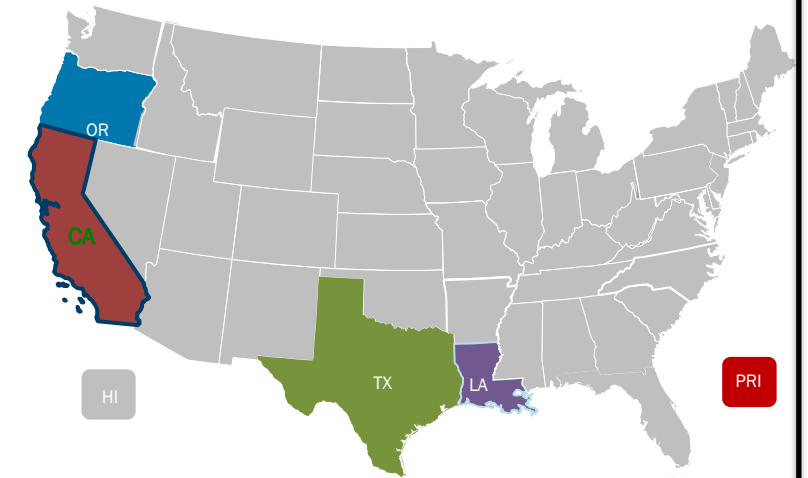

Past Year per Week, 12/13/2020 – 12/20/2021. There are currently **2,476** Households Occupying **2,529** Temporary Units.



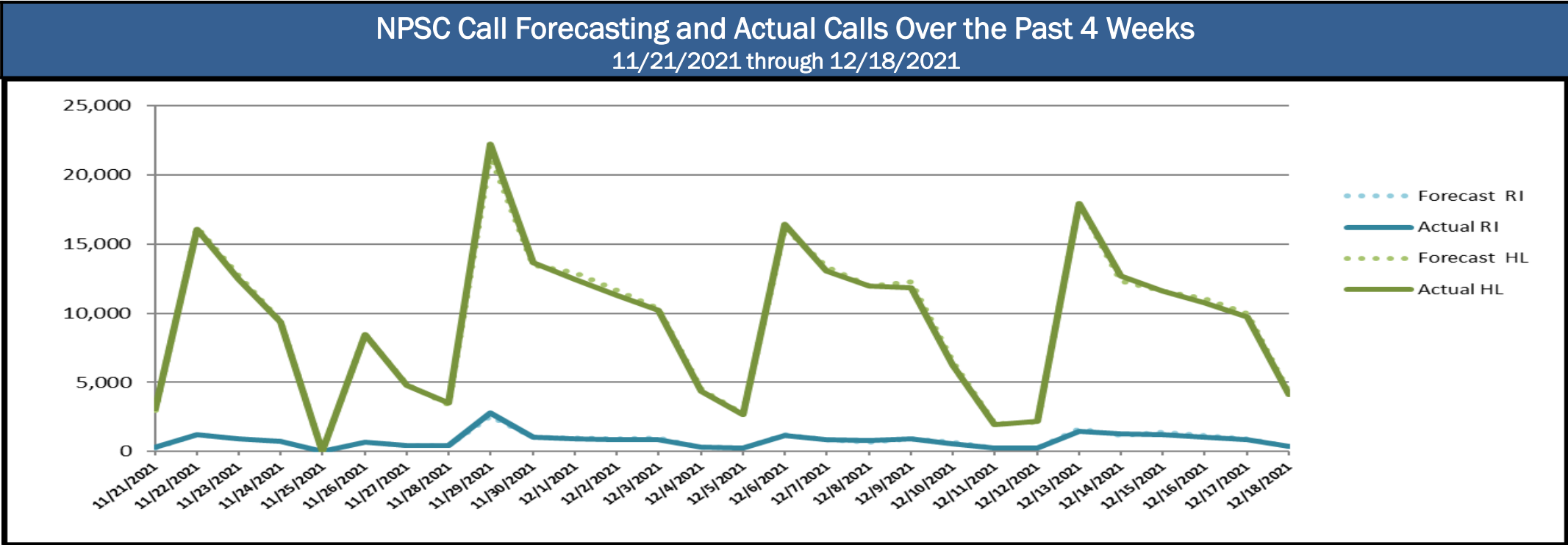

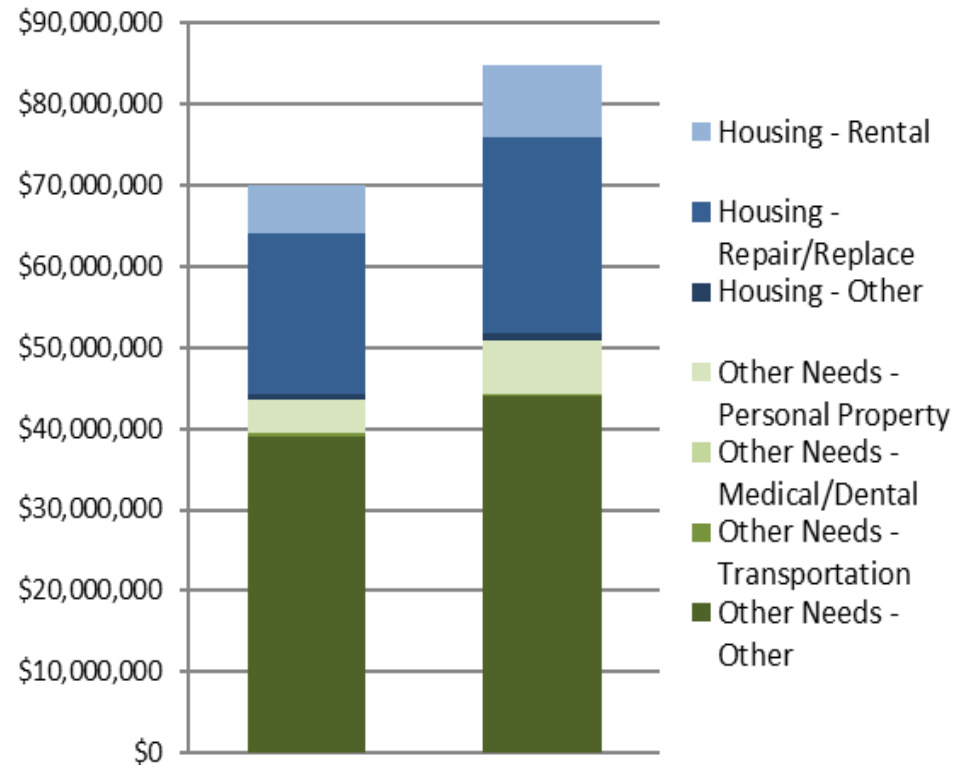
