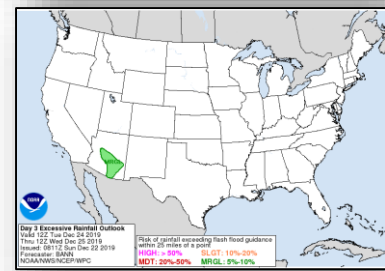
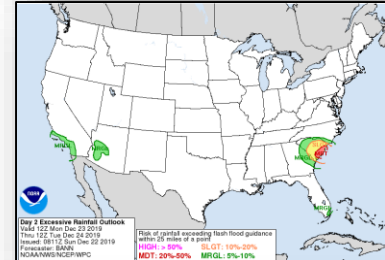
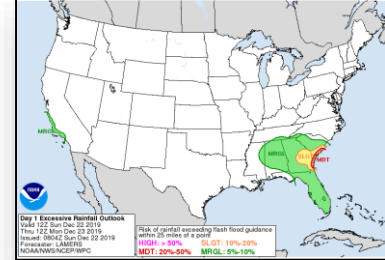
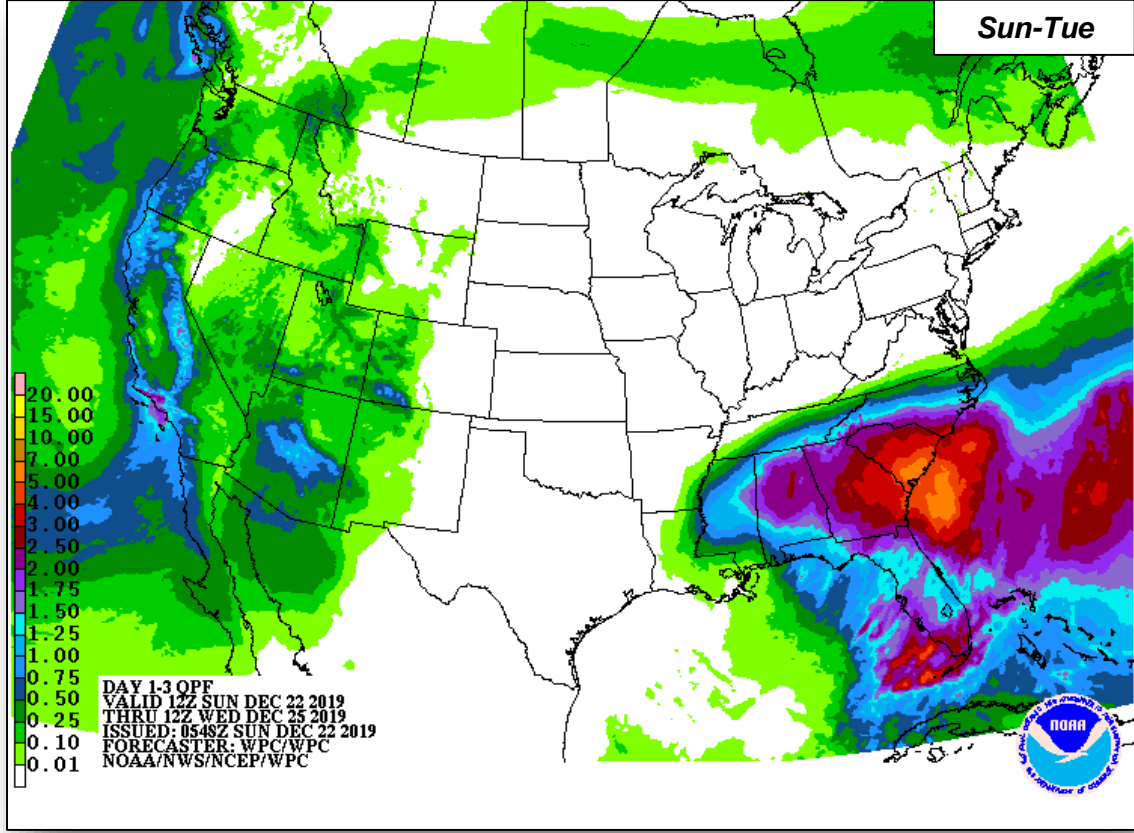
National Weather Forecast



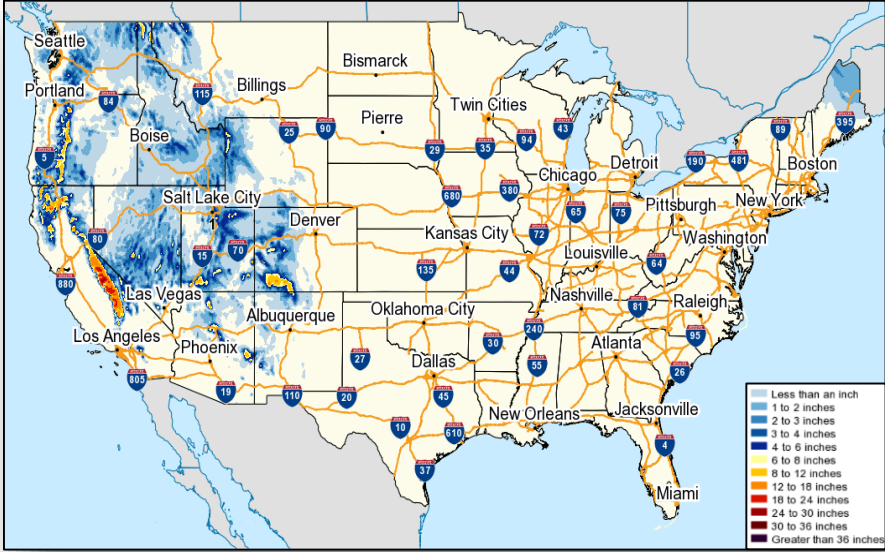
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

Forecast Snowfall

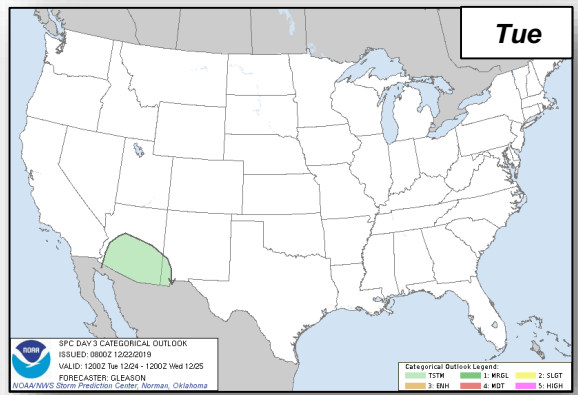
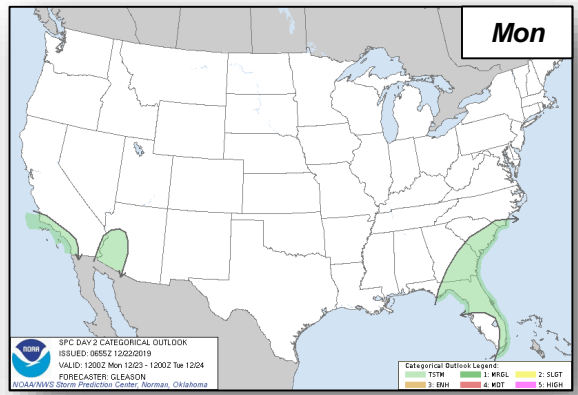
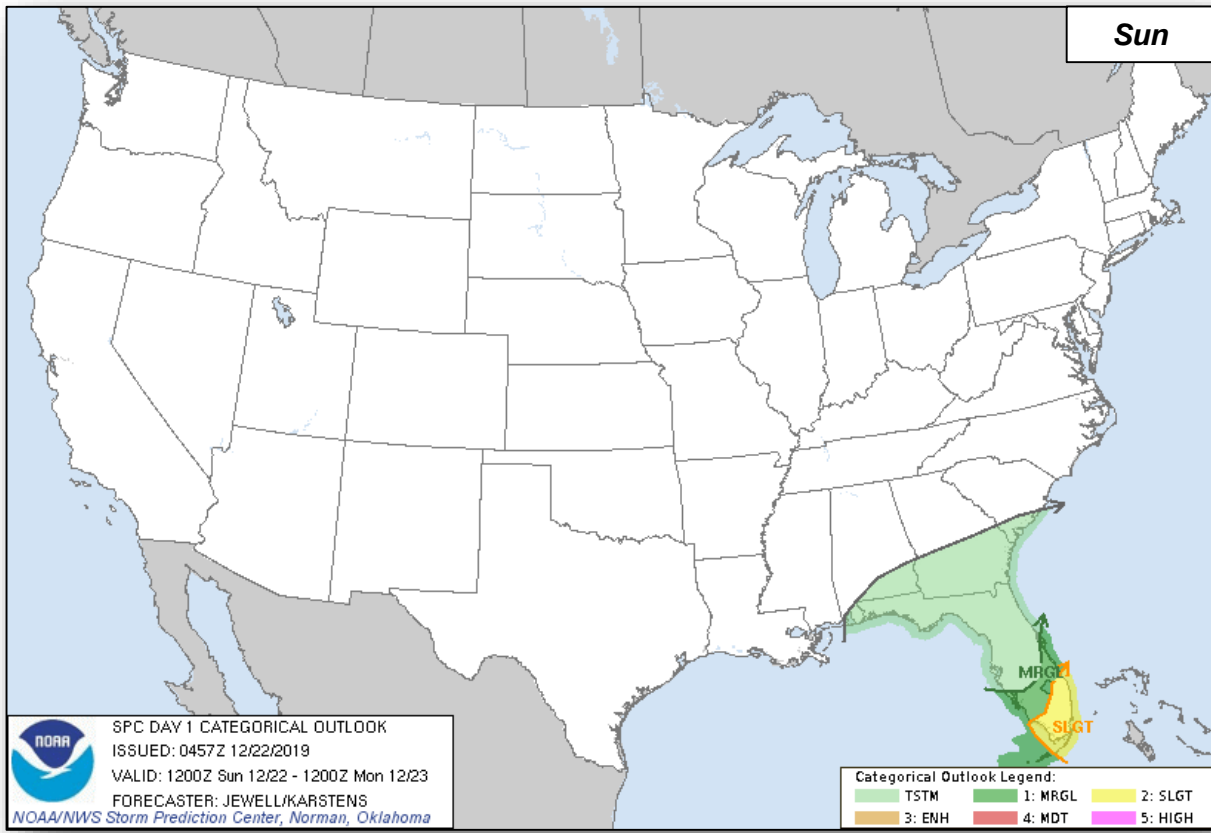


Forecast Ice Accumulation

Severe Weather Outlook



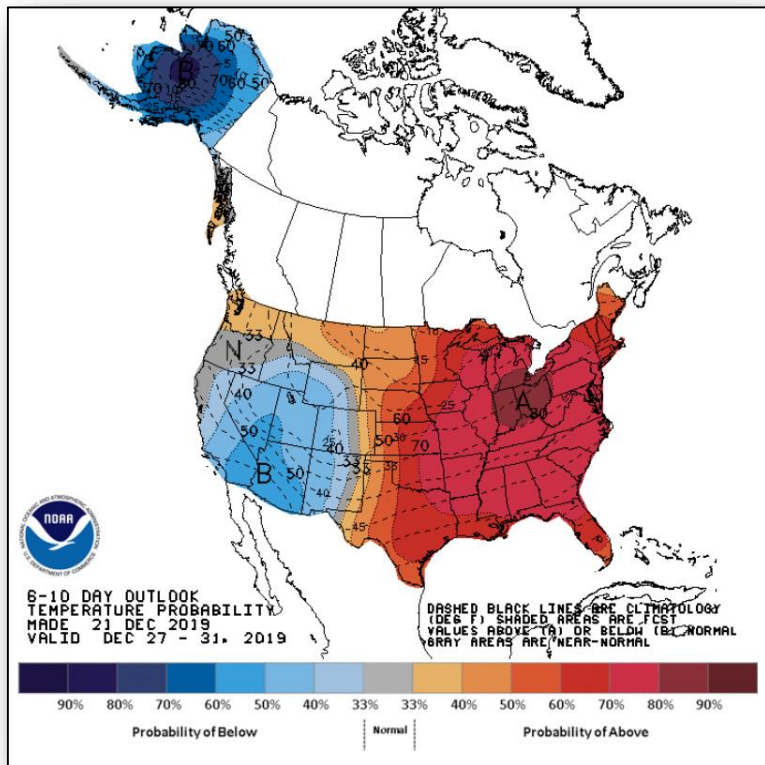

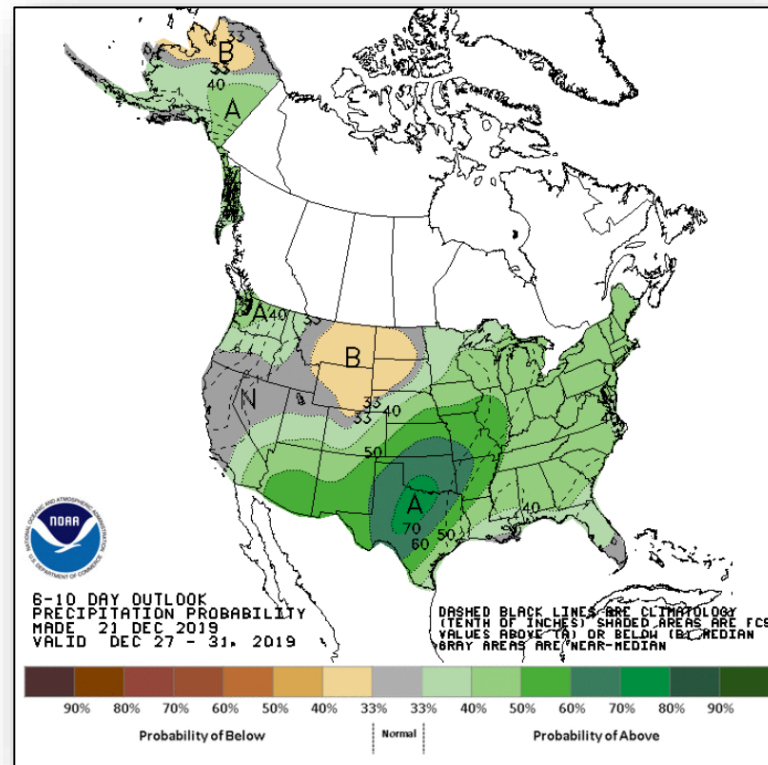
Long Range Outlooks – Dec 27-31

6-10 Day Precipitation Probability

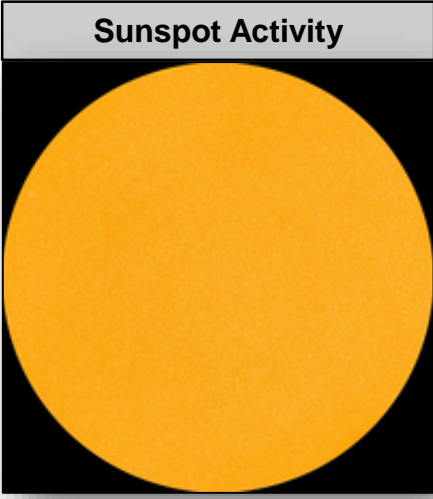
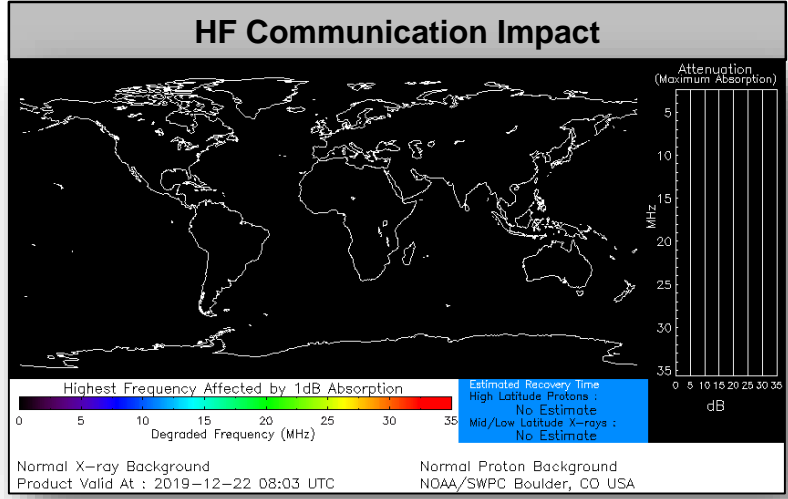

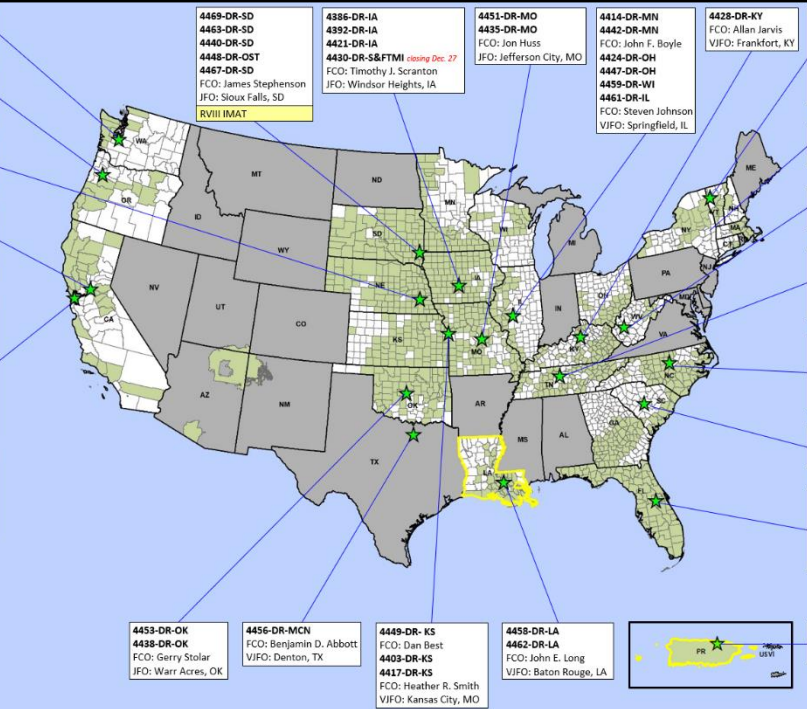
