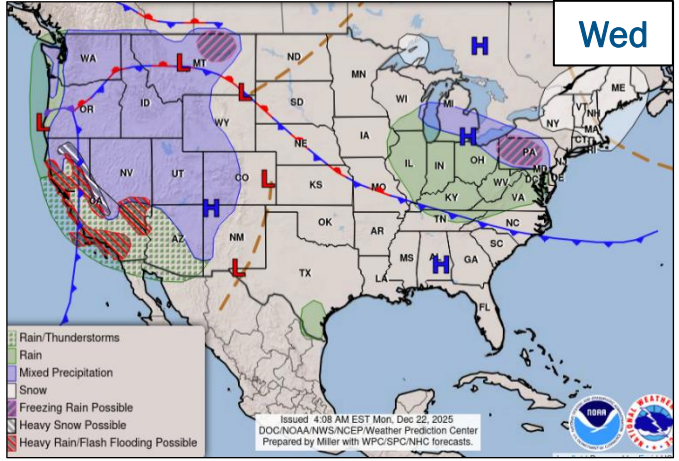

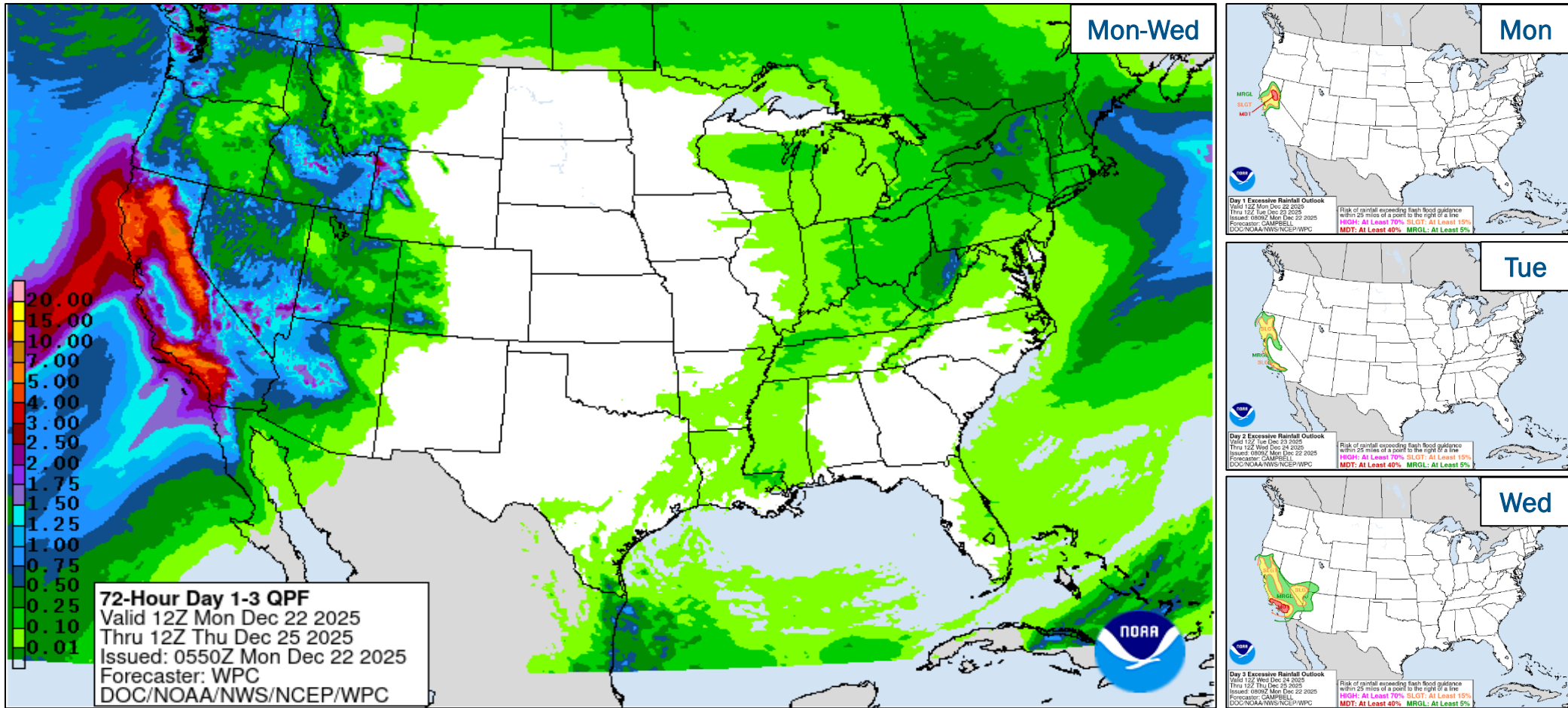
National Weather Forecast

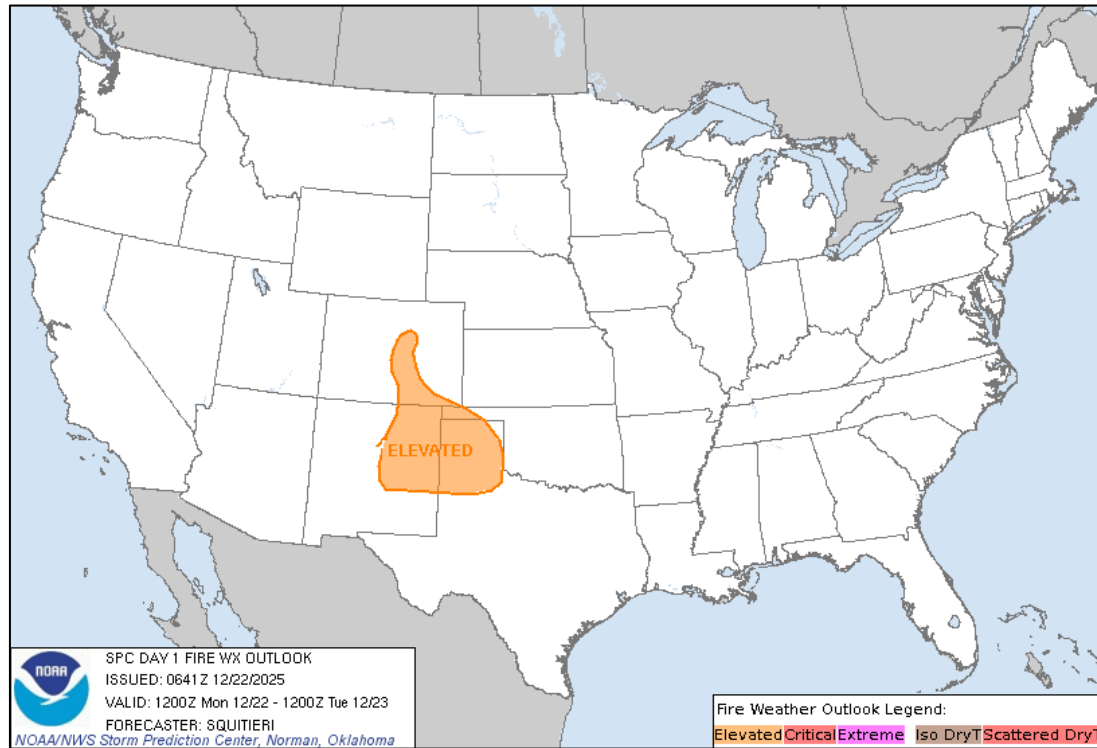

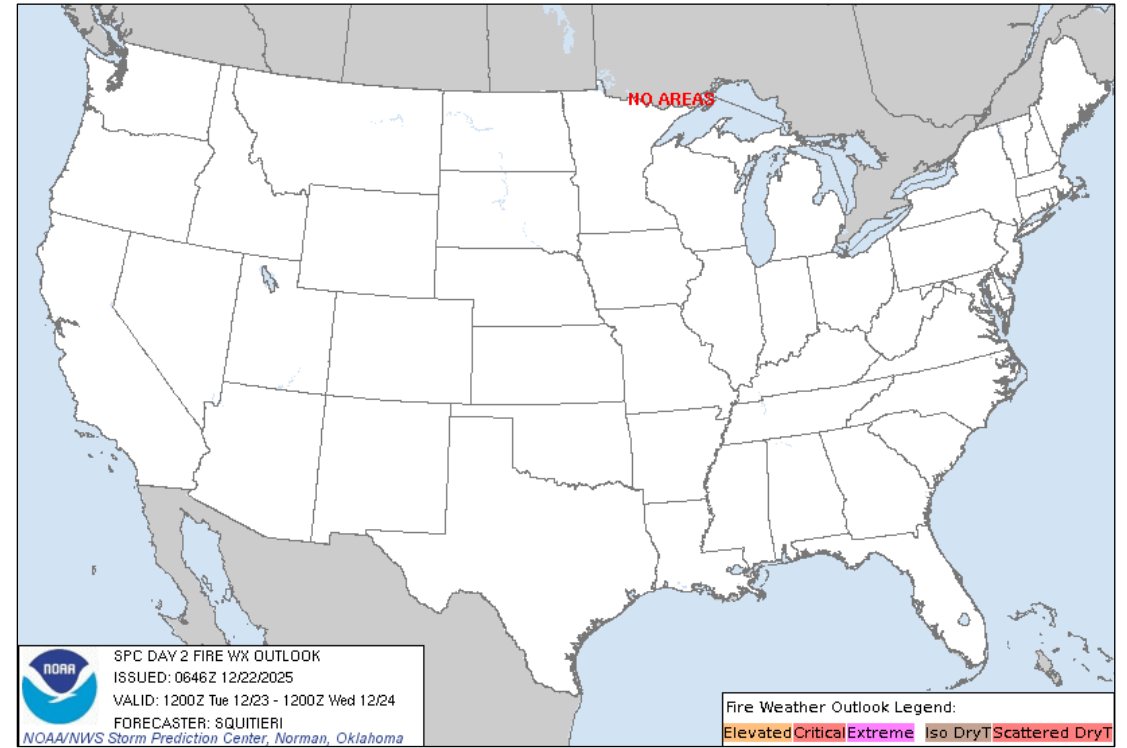

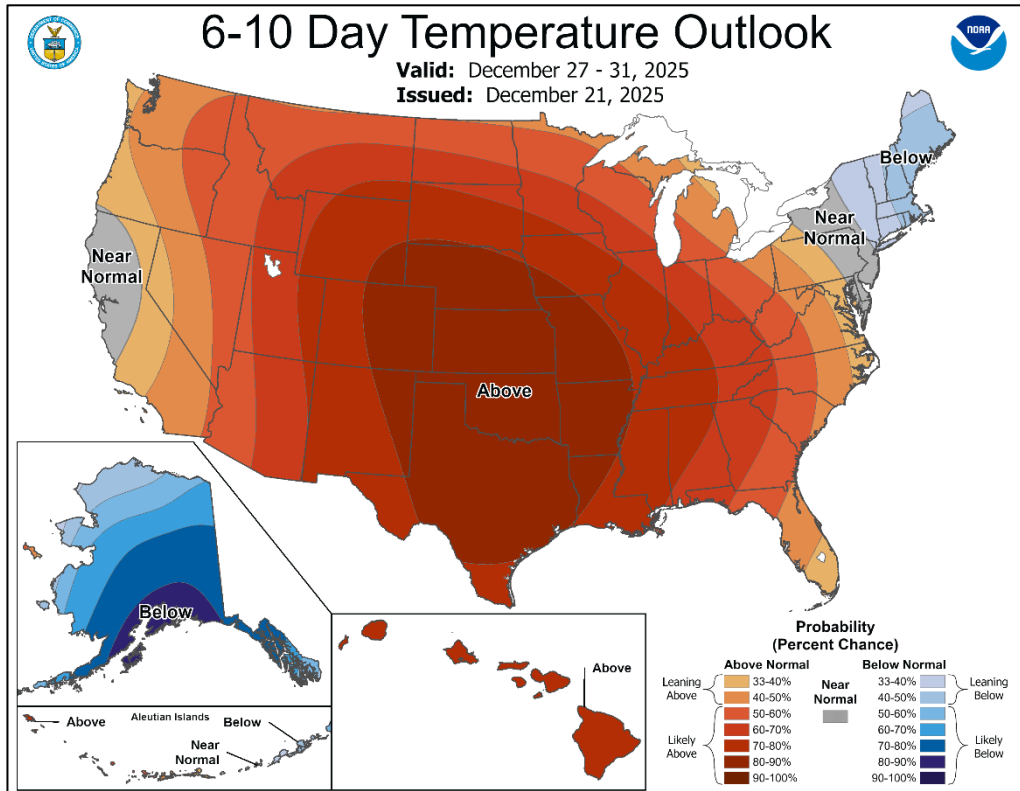

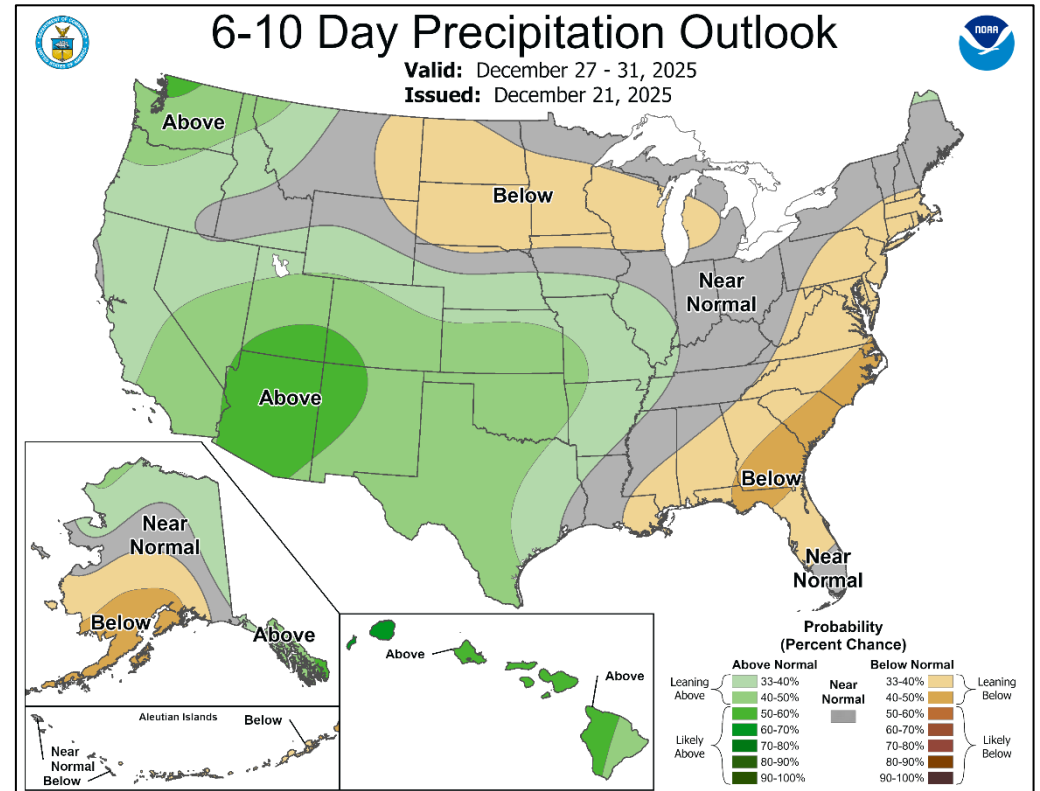
