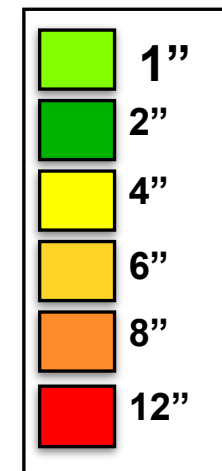

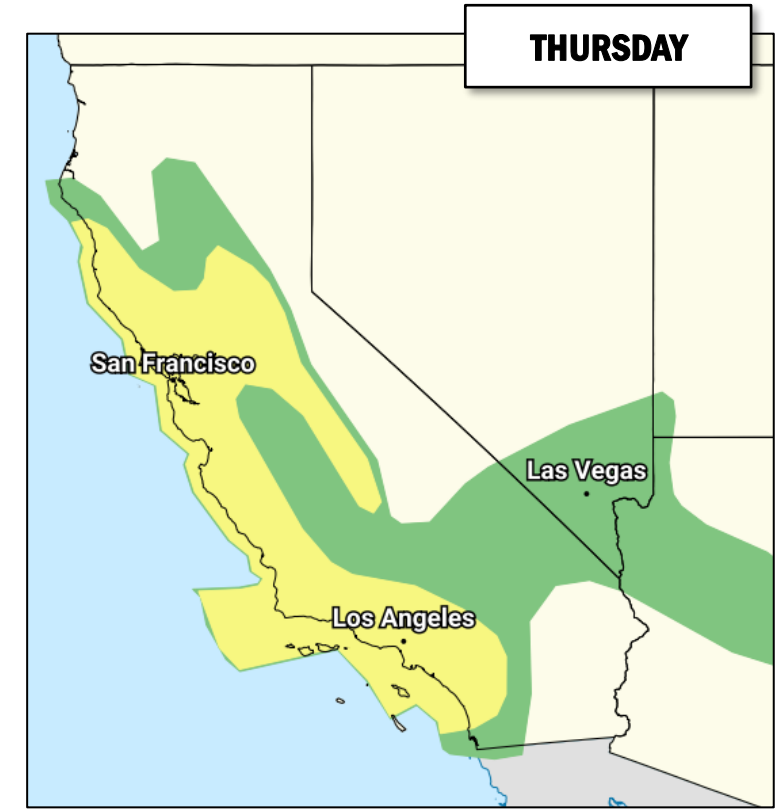
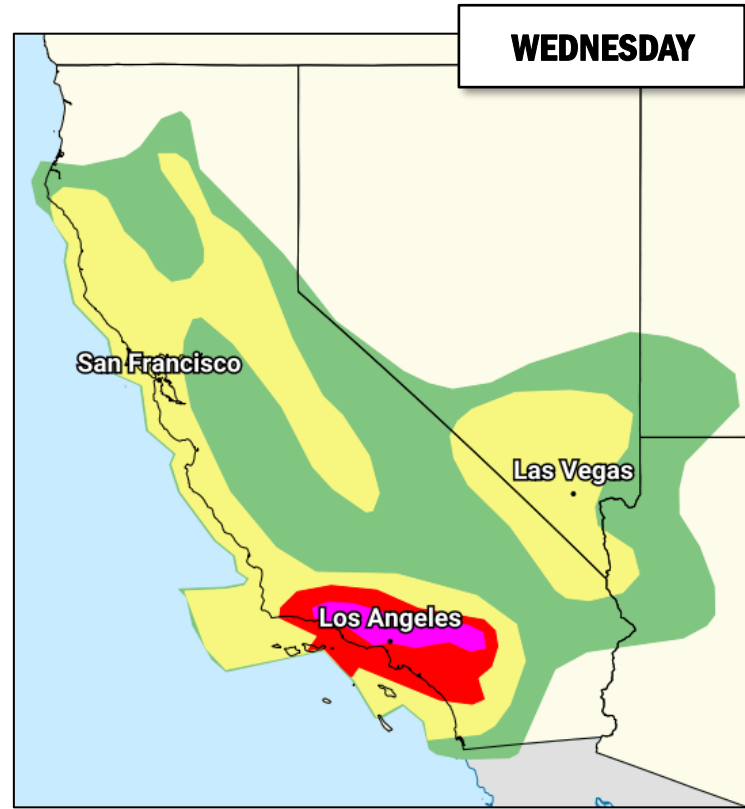
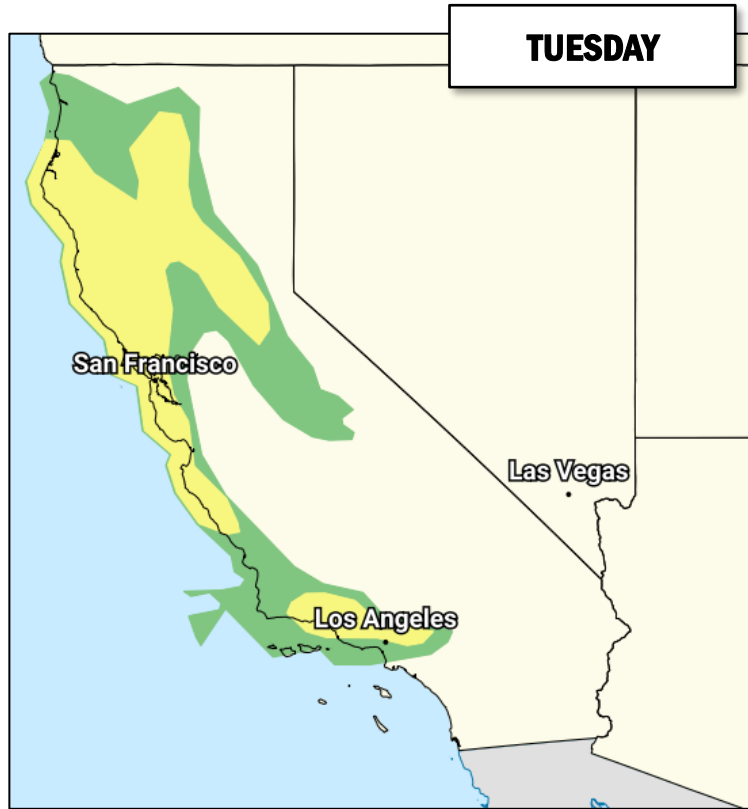
December 23-25 Precipitation Forecast

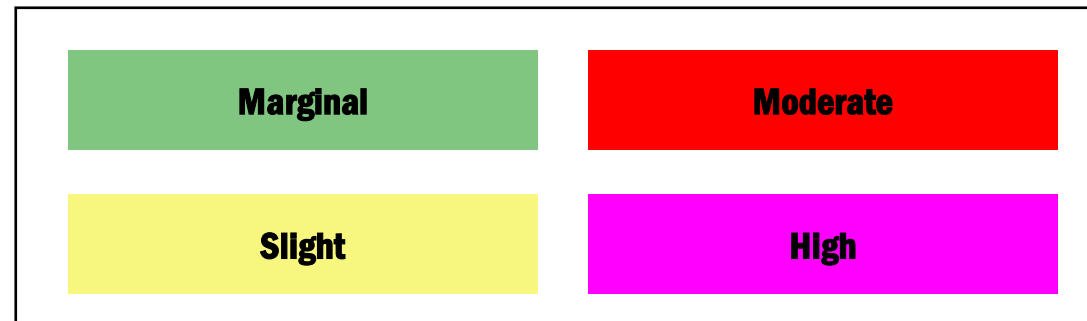


December 23-25 Flash Flooding Risk

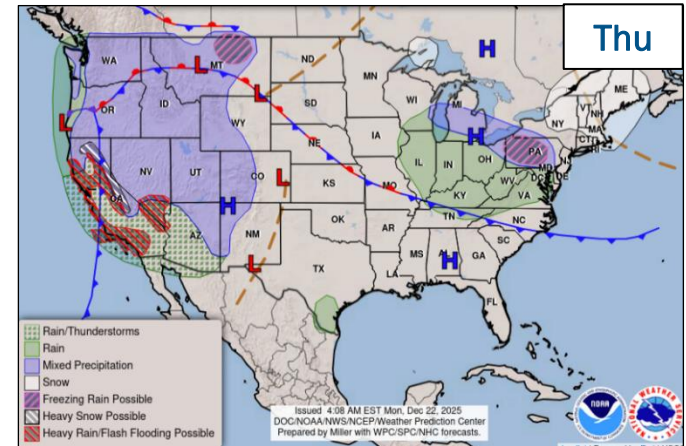
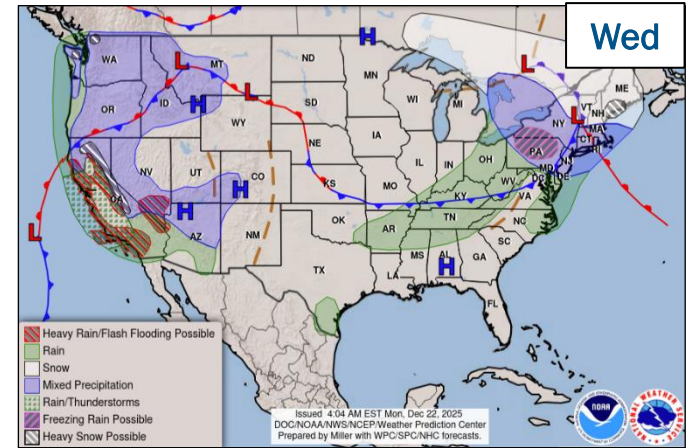
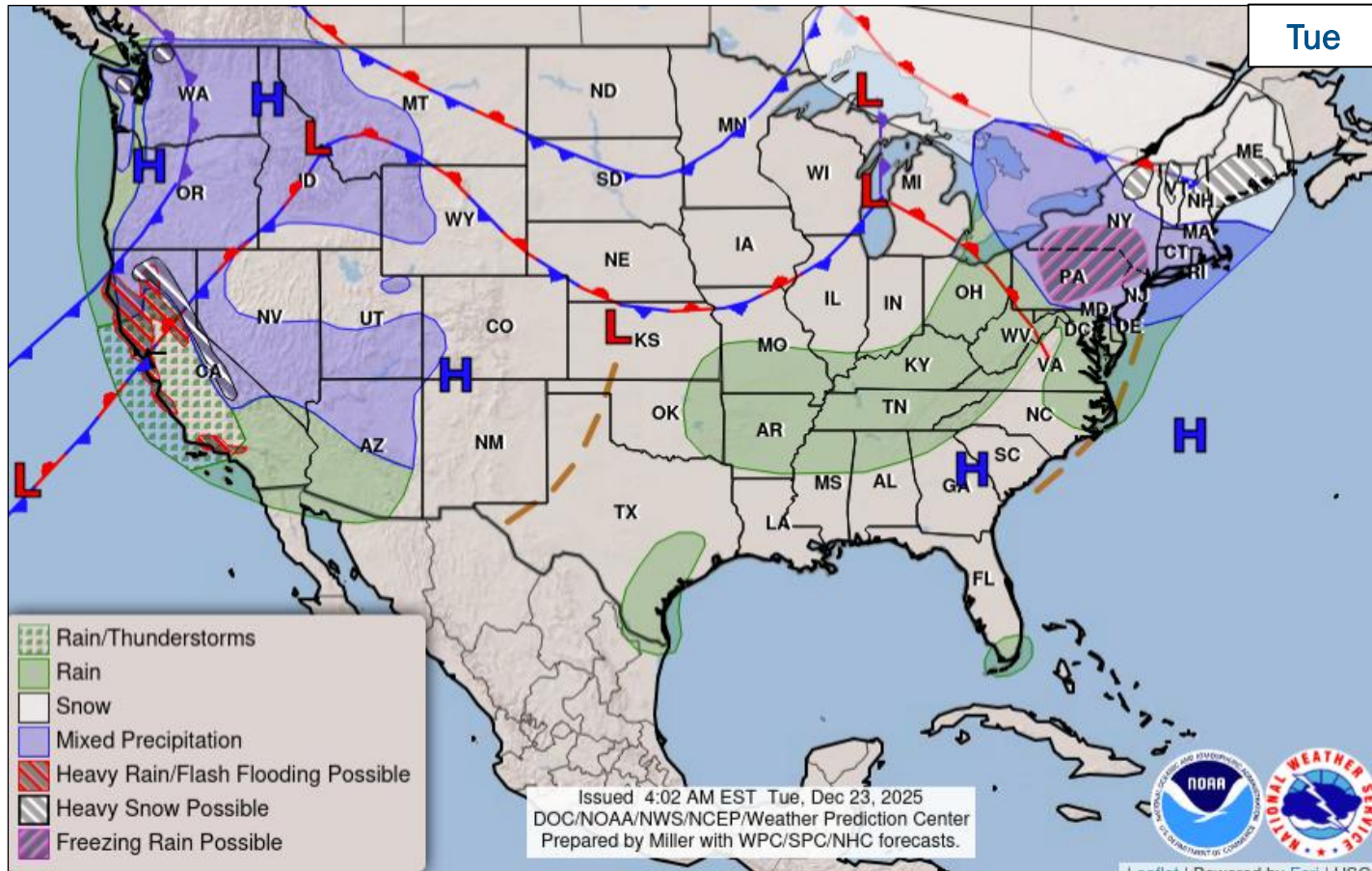

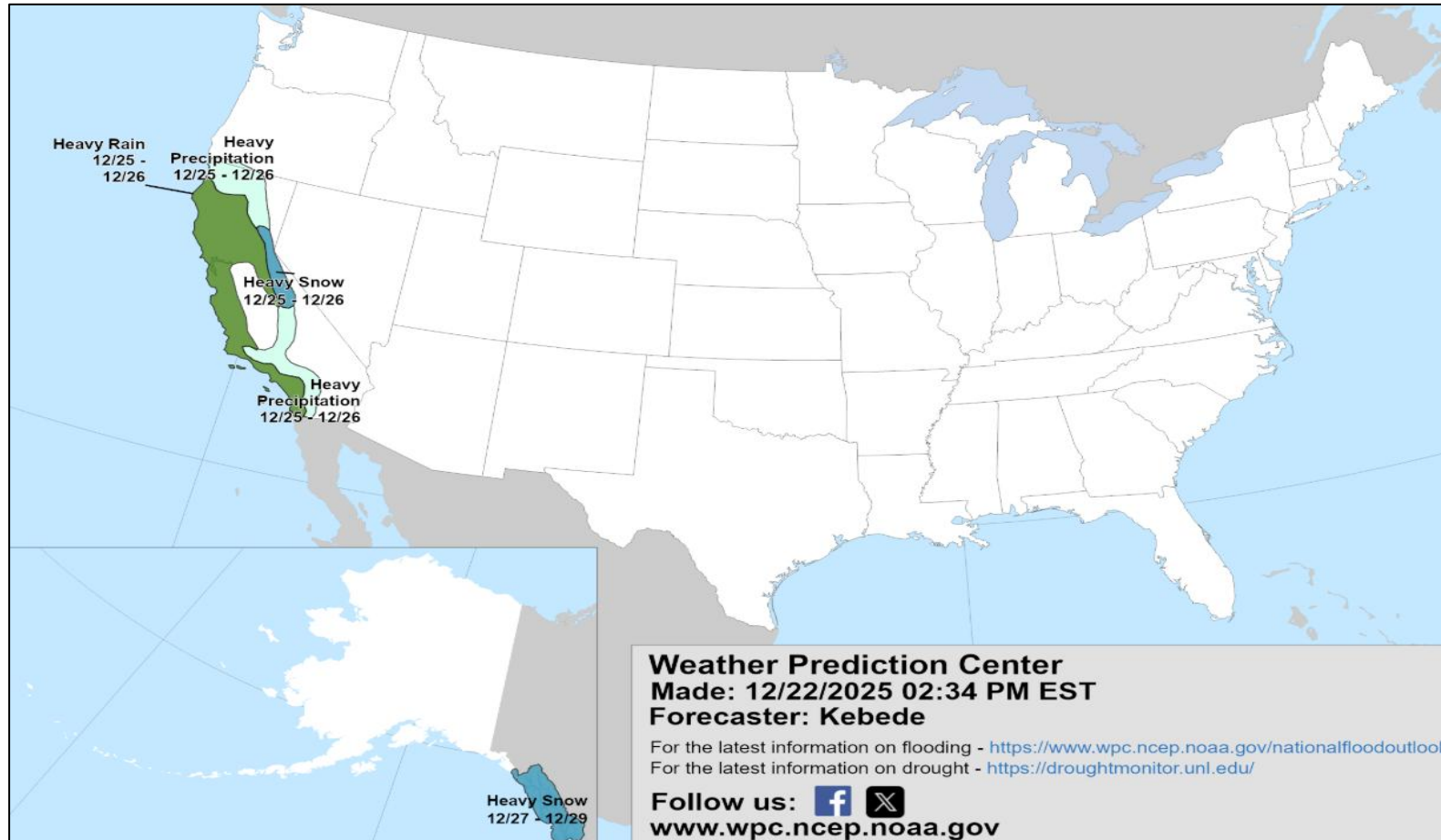
