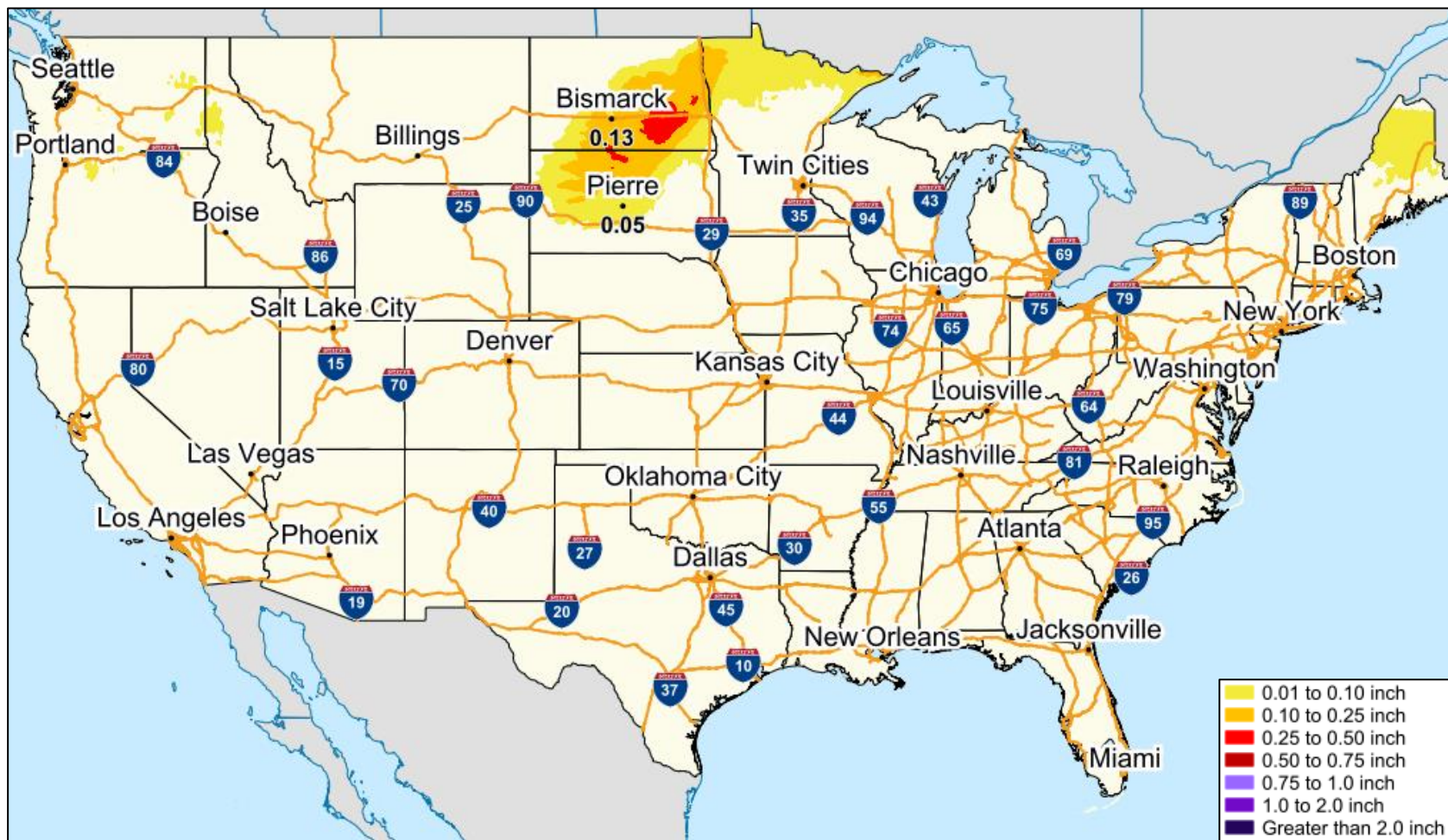
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

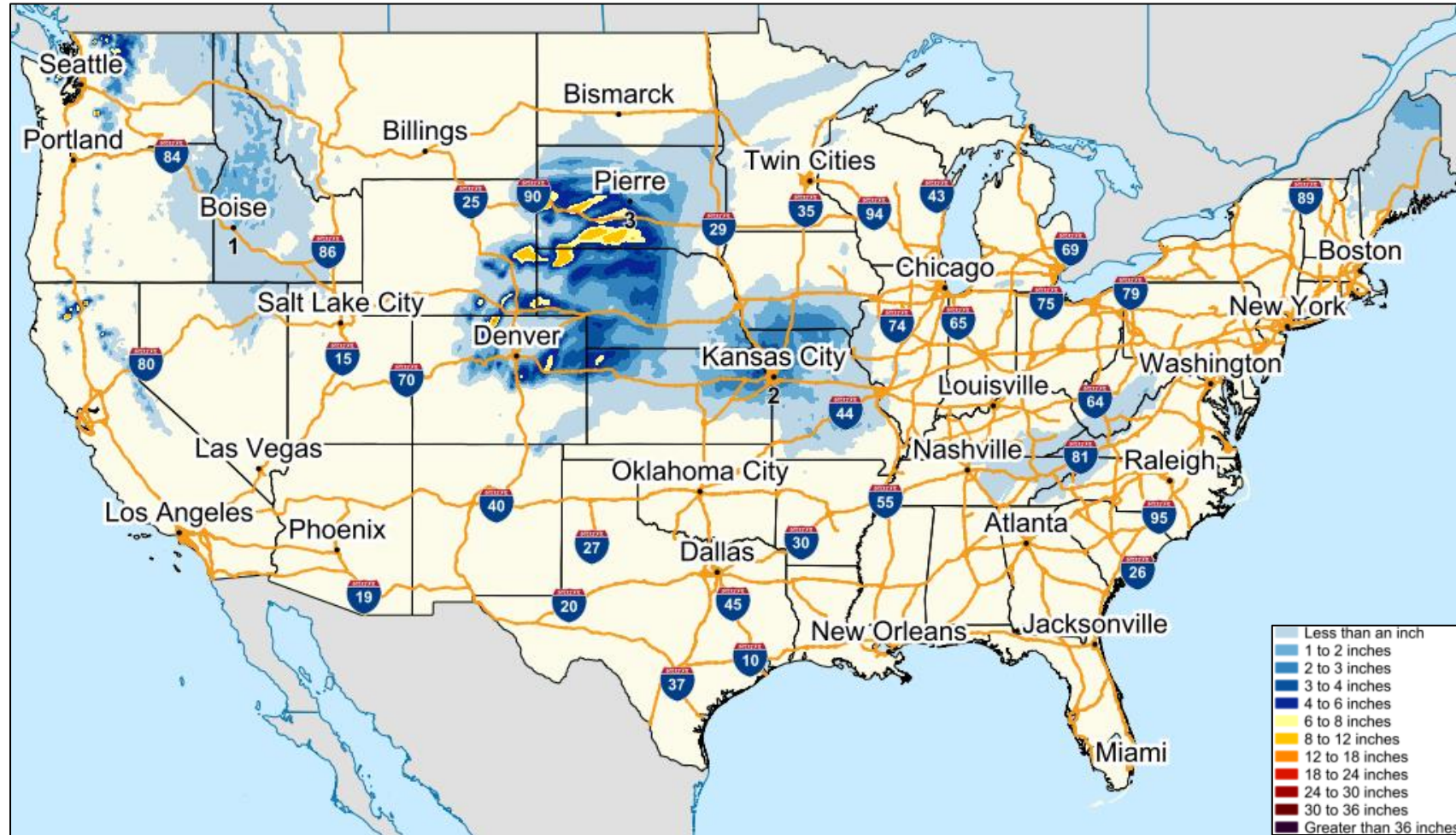

Ice Accumulation Forecast



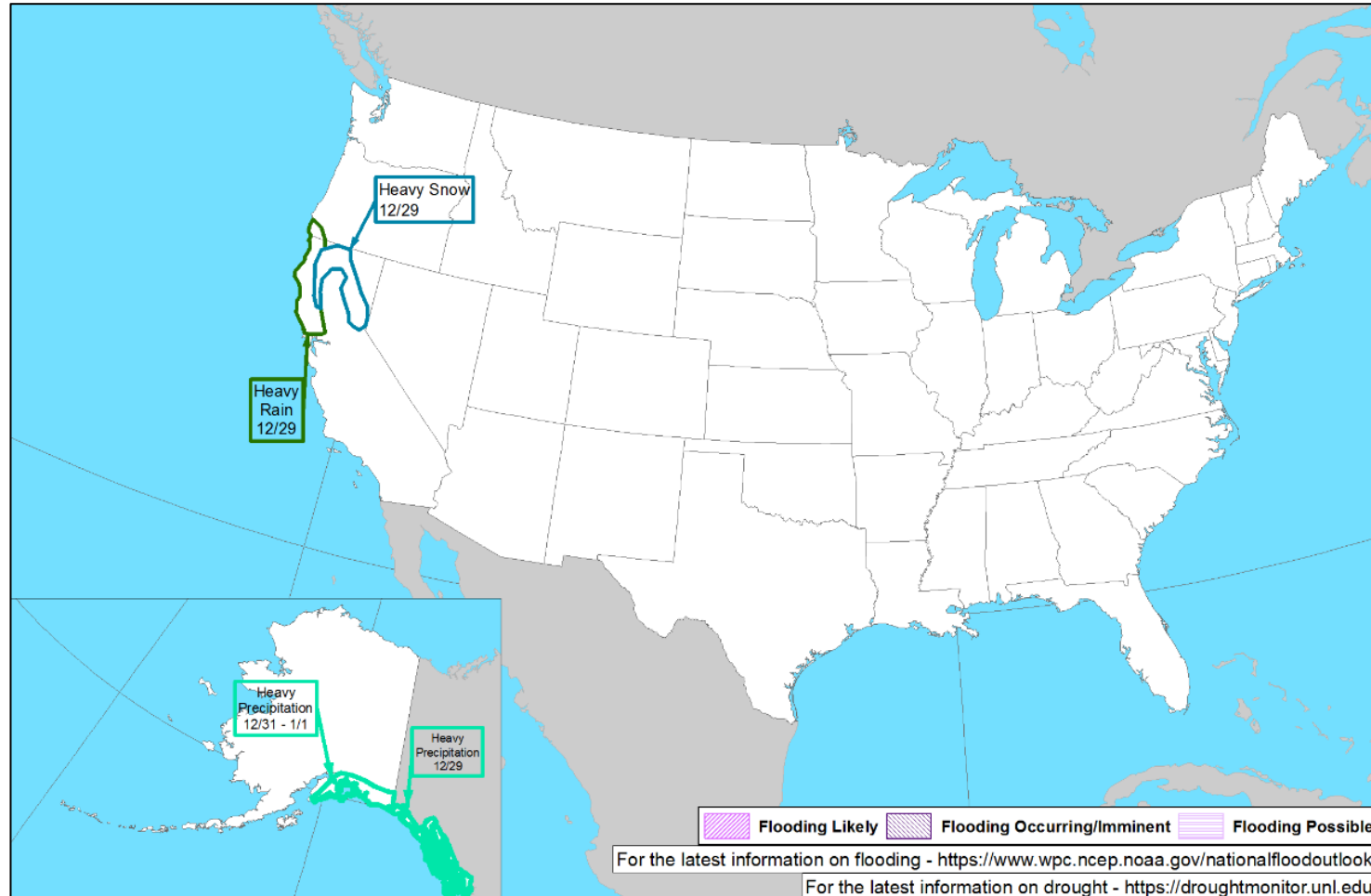

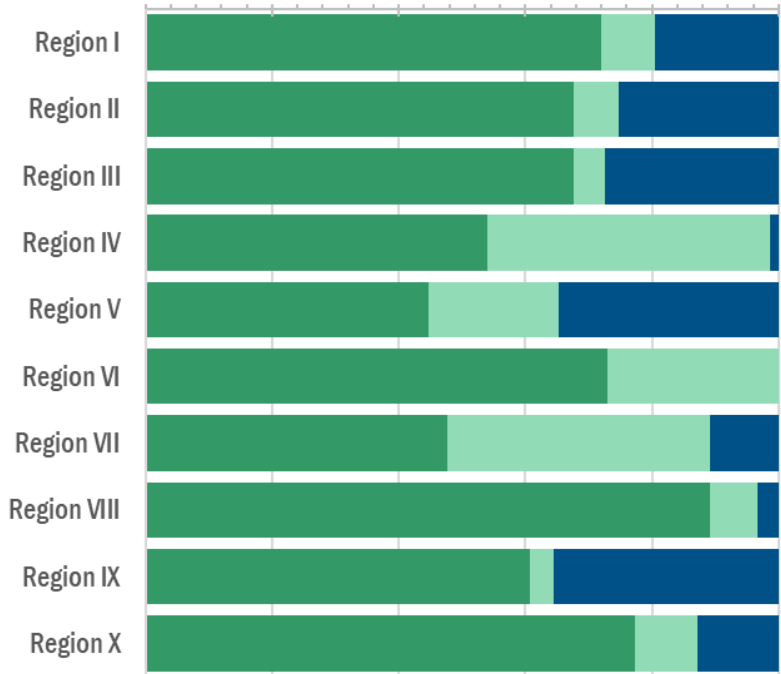

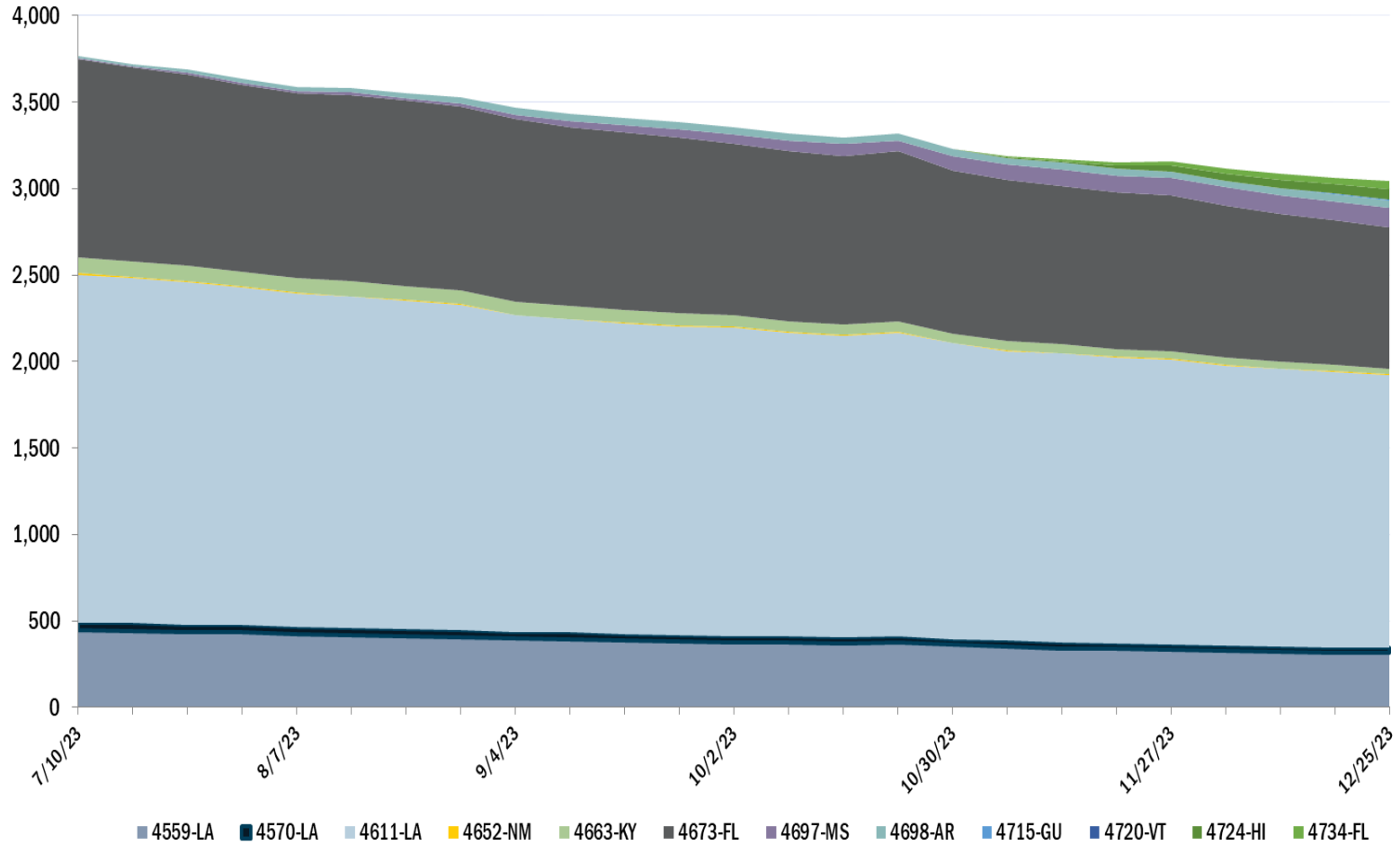

Direct Housing

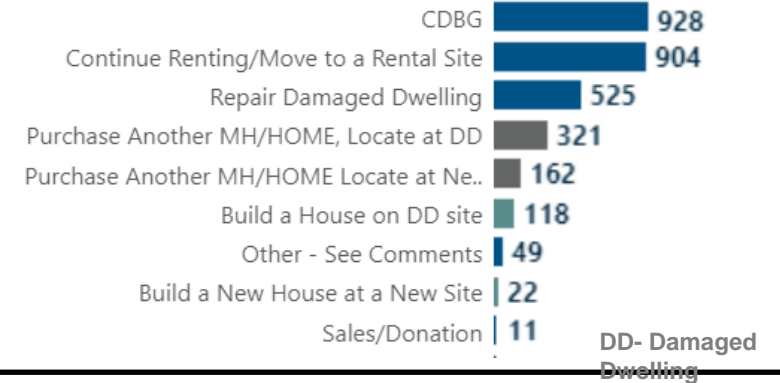
Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State
