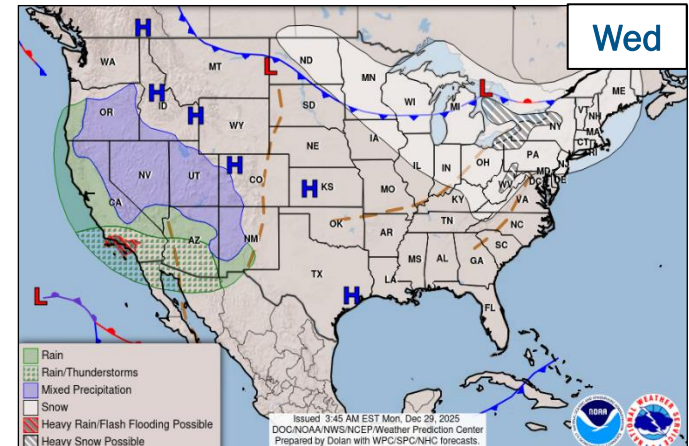

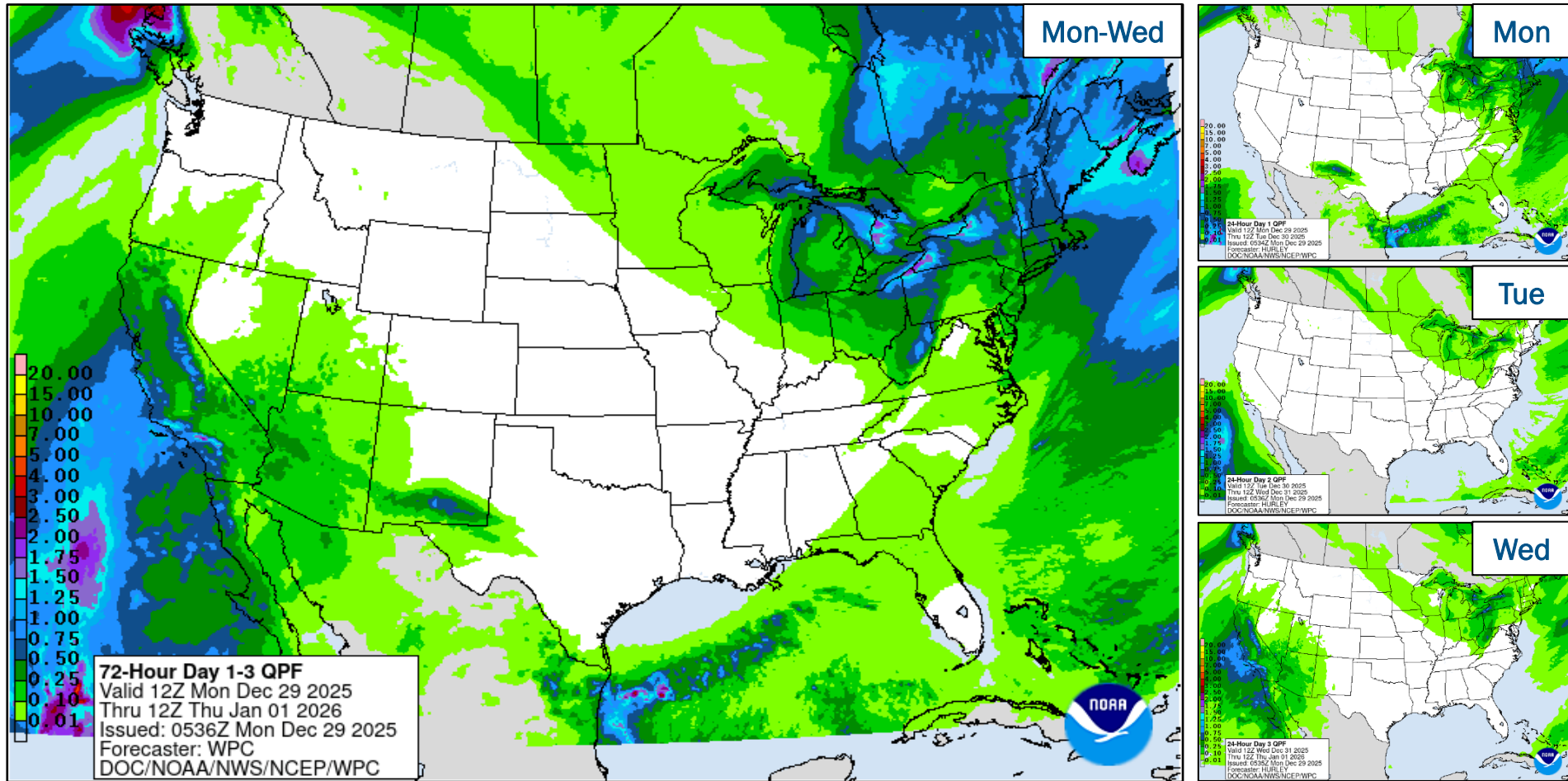
National Weather Forecast

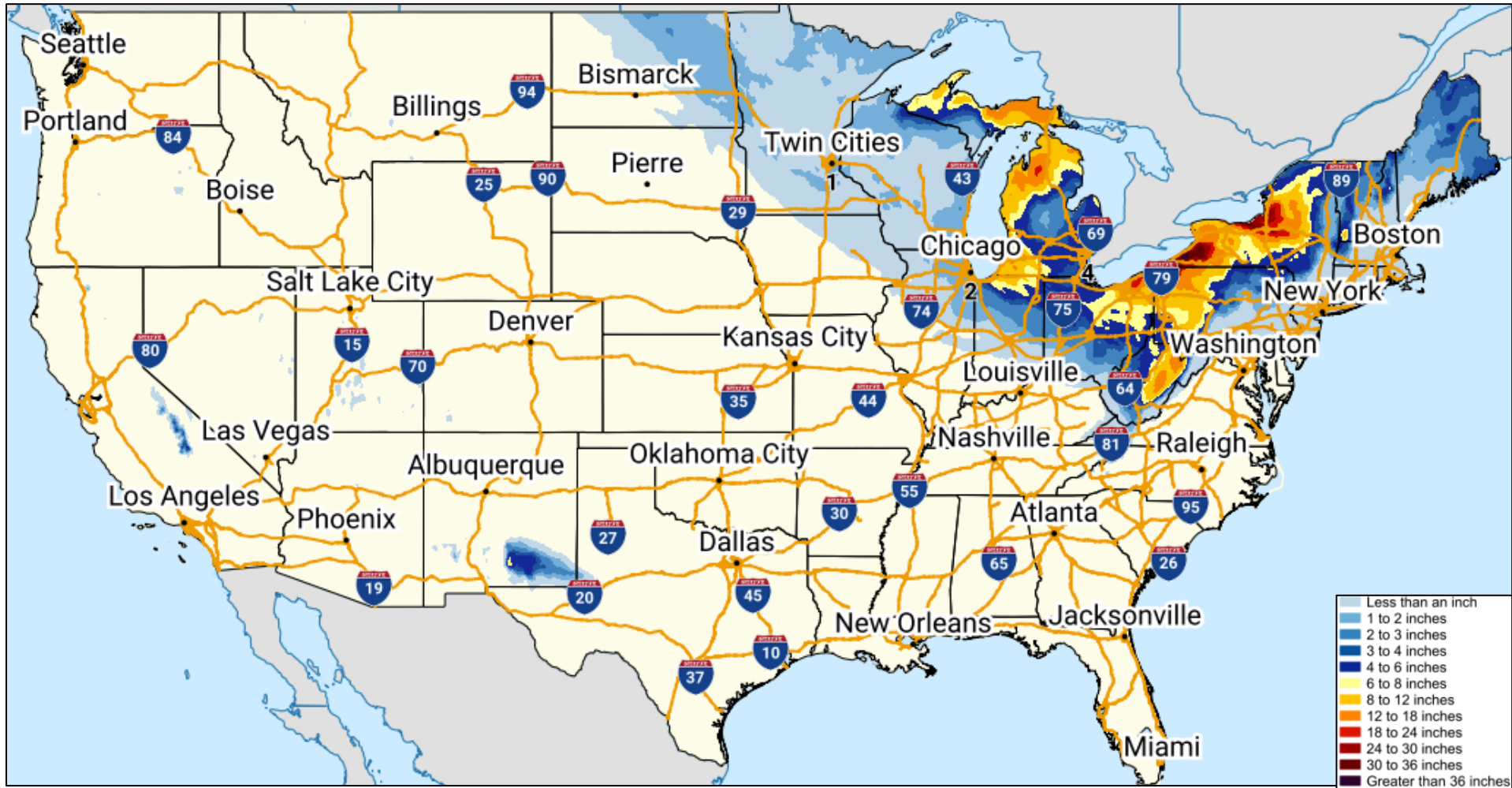

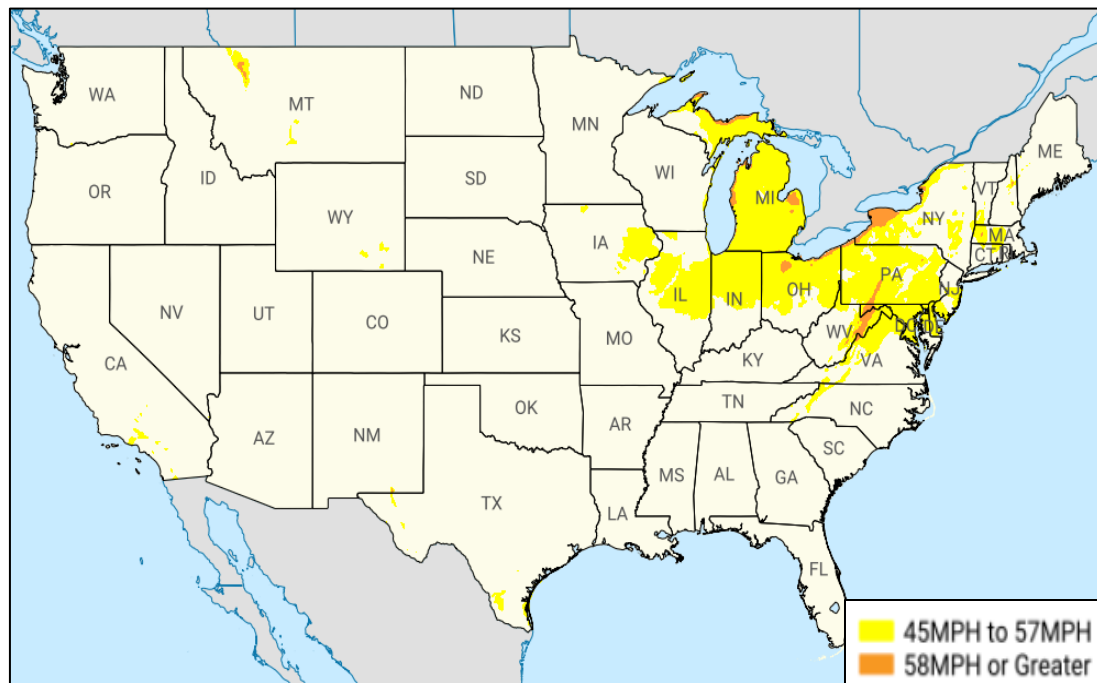
Ice Accumulation Forecast



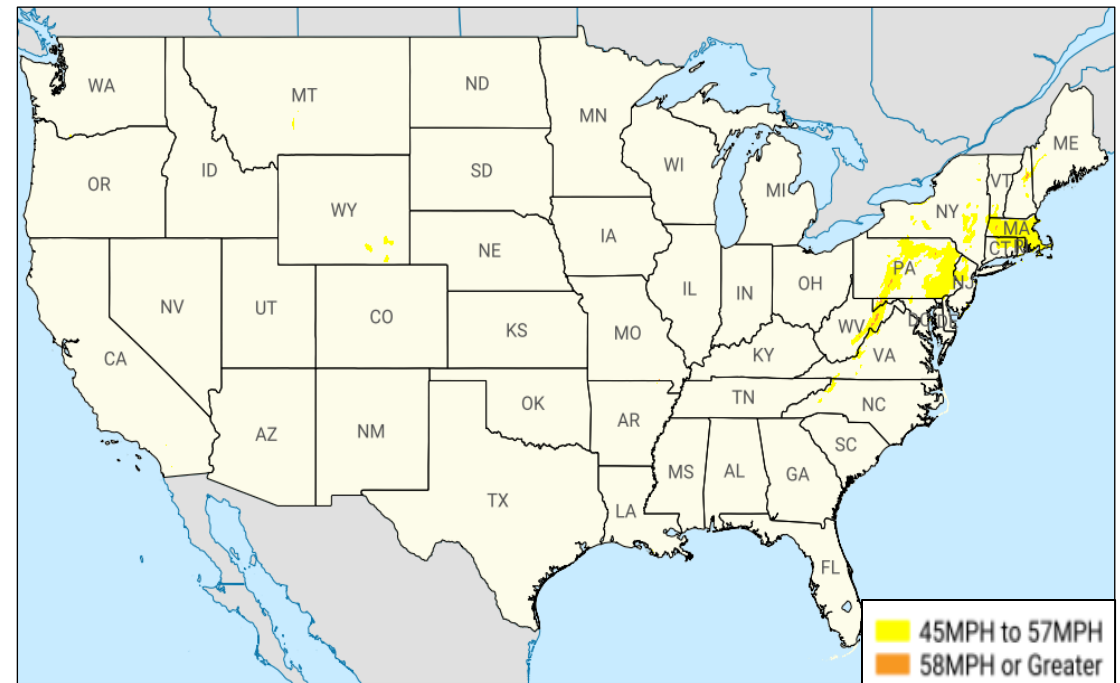

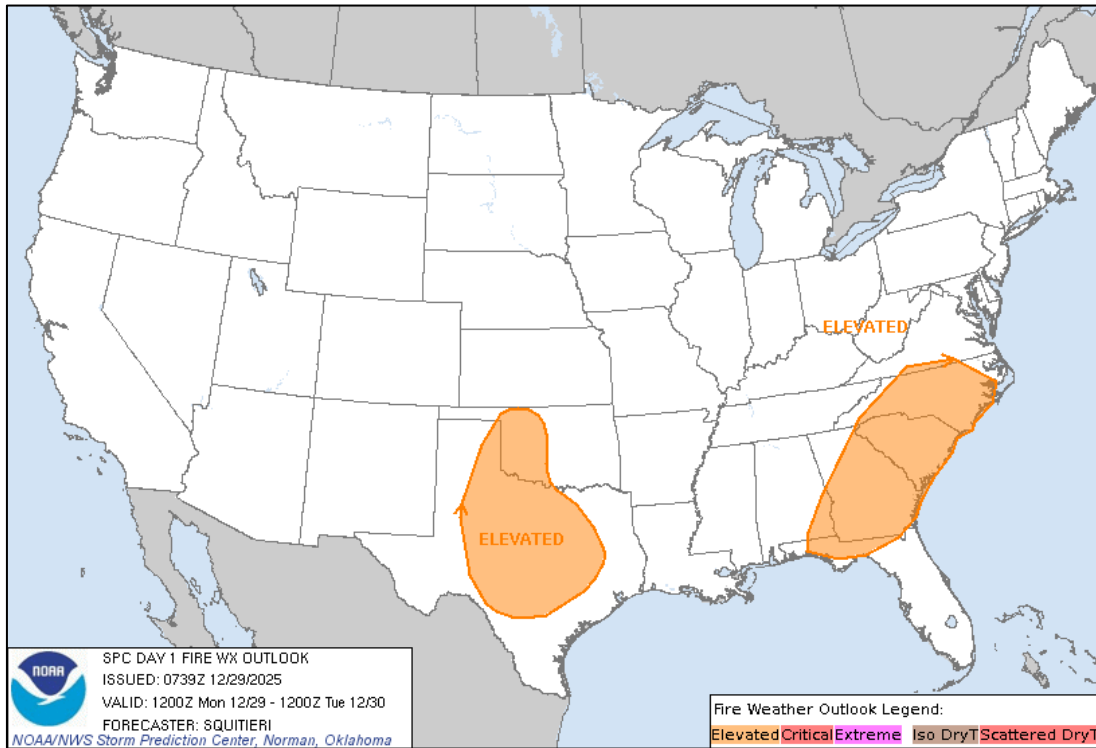

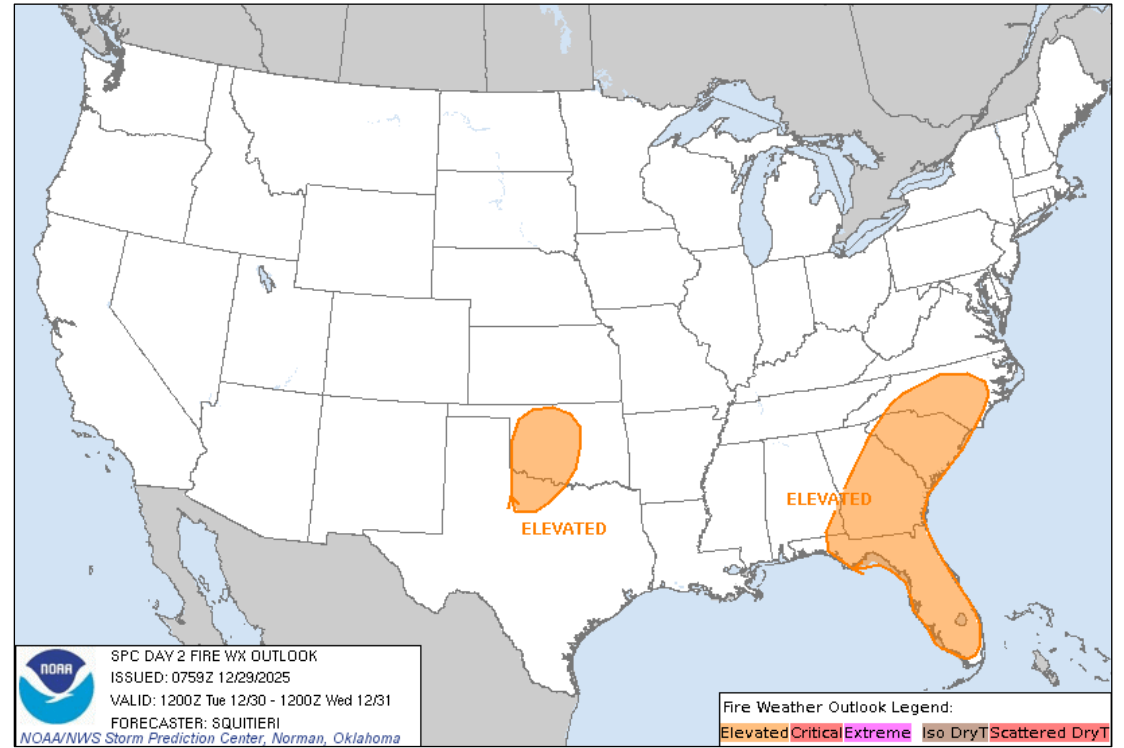

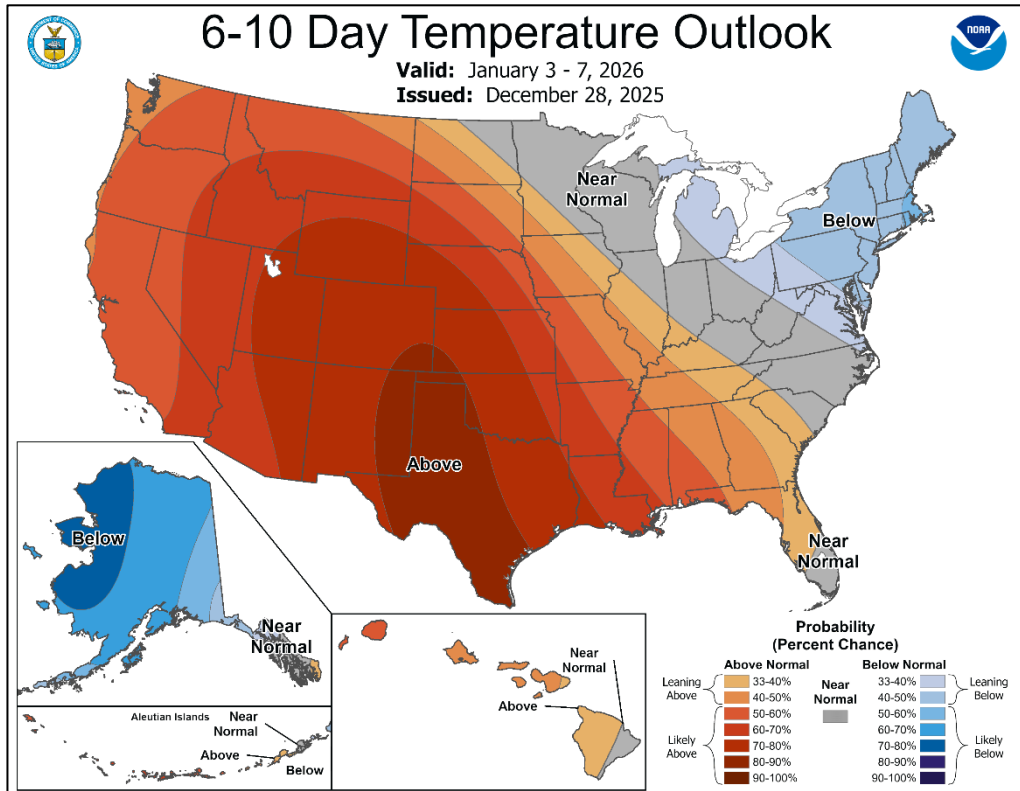

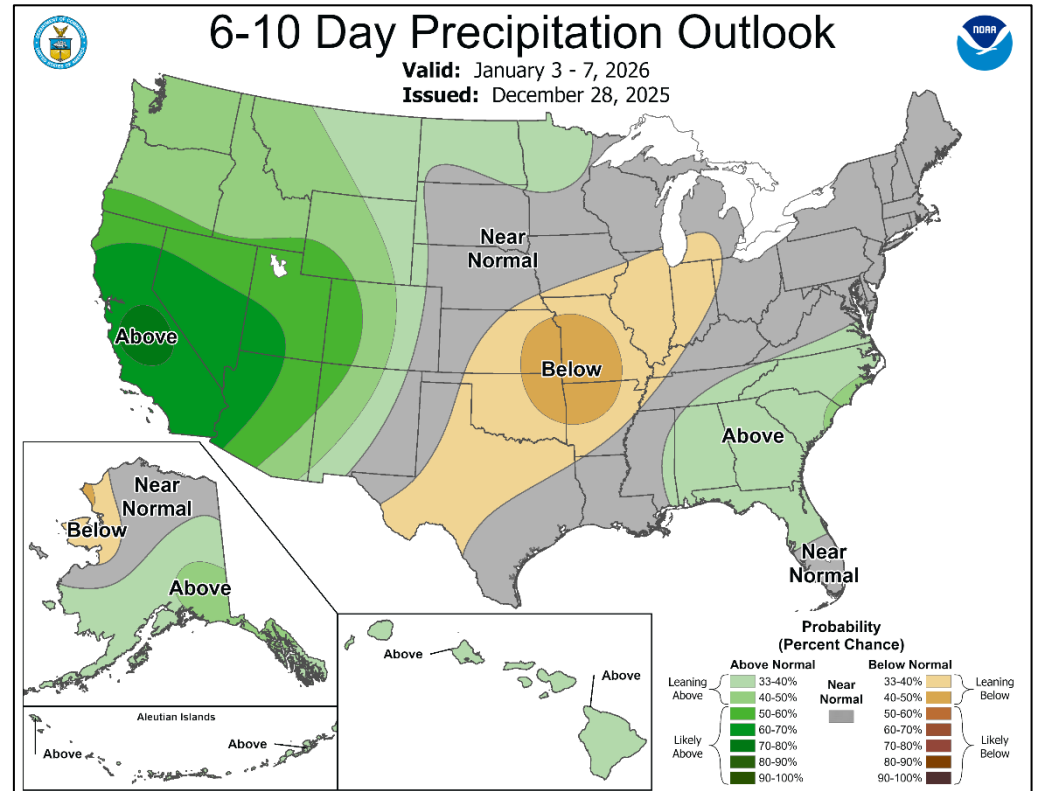
