




### **National Weather Forecast**






# **Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall**






### **Snowfall Forecast**

- Low to moderate level solar activity taking place with a recent notable, but minor flare event – chance of minor HF radio impacts, but not likely at this time.
- Very low risk of any solar radiation storms satellite operations, aviation, and launch activity impacts unlikely.
- There is only a slight chance for a minor geomagnetic storm unlikely impacts to power grid, GPS, and other technologies (if any should occur, they would most likely be mitigatable)
