

Ice Accumulation Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





- Fairly benign solar disk. Only 15% chance of R1-R2 (M-class flares) and a 1% chance of >= R3 (X-class flares) radio blackout activity for the next few days.
- Minimal chance of a solar radiation storm through 03 Feb.
- Decreasing chances of G1 geomagnetic storming as the day progresses.






