### **Situation**

Bitter cold temperatures with wind chills of 20° and below continued overnight across the Midwest and into the Northeast. Widespread impacts have been reported to roads, rail, air, government facilities, schools, and private businesses. Services are expected to be restored today throughout the impacted area with the exception of MN, where schools, business, and government offices remain closed.








## Winter Weather Outlook






Minimum Temperatures – Friday





Minimum Temperatures – Saturday

### National Weather Forecast










# Winter Precipitation Outlook






Forecast Snowfall




