- Wintry mix of heavy rainfall, sleet, and freezing rain – Central Plains to the Tennessee/Ohio valleys and Mid-Atlantic

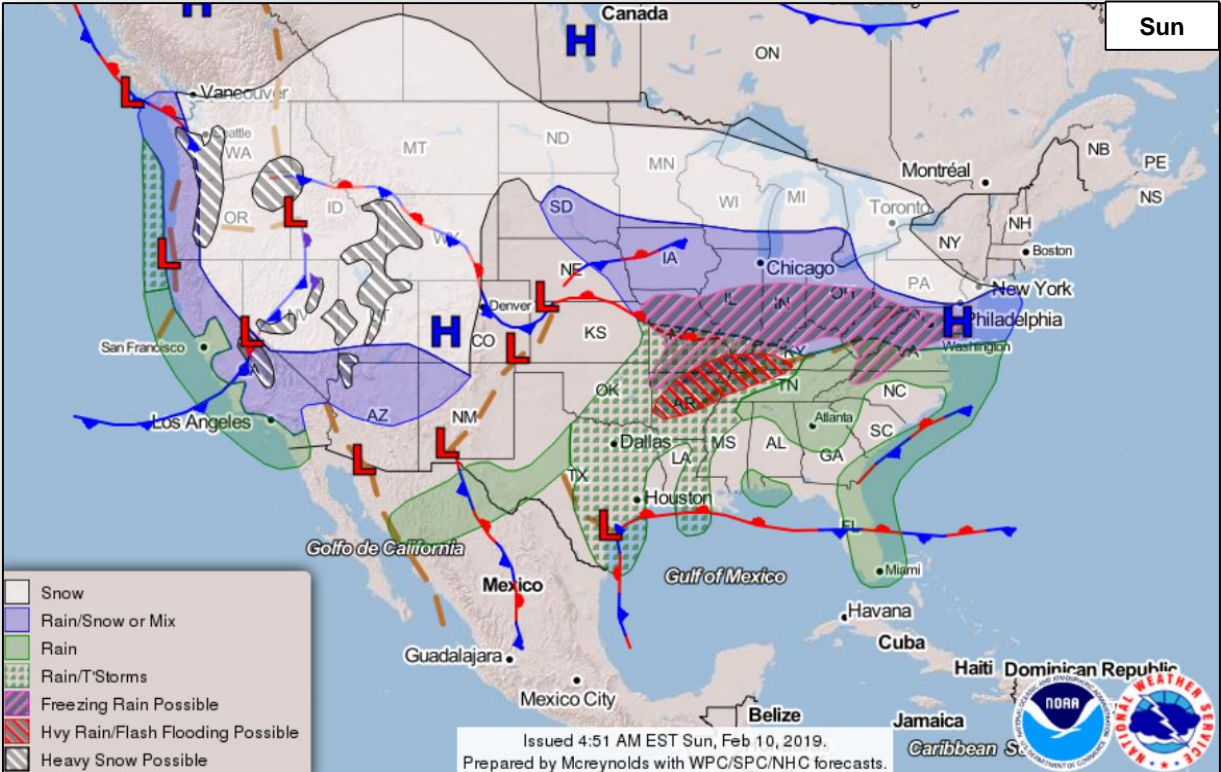

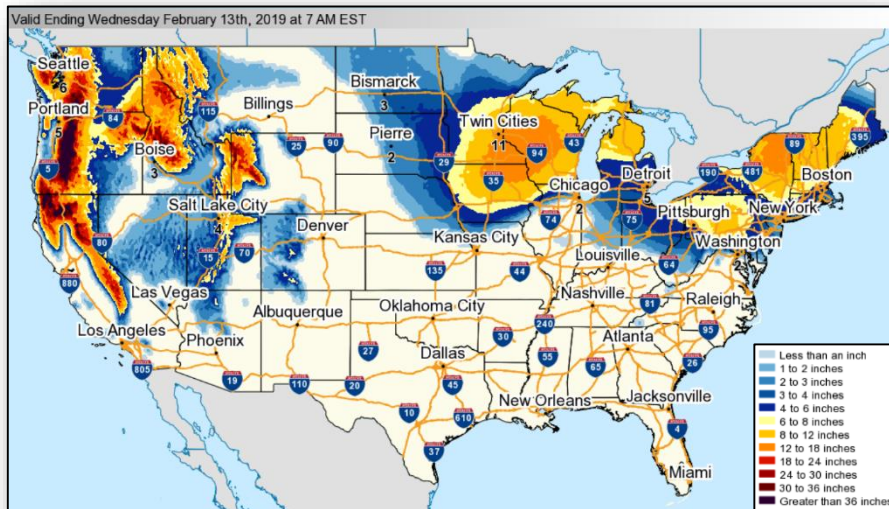


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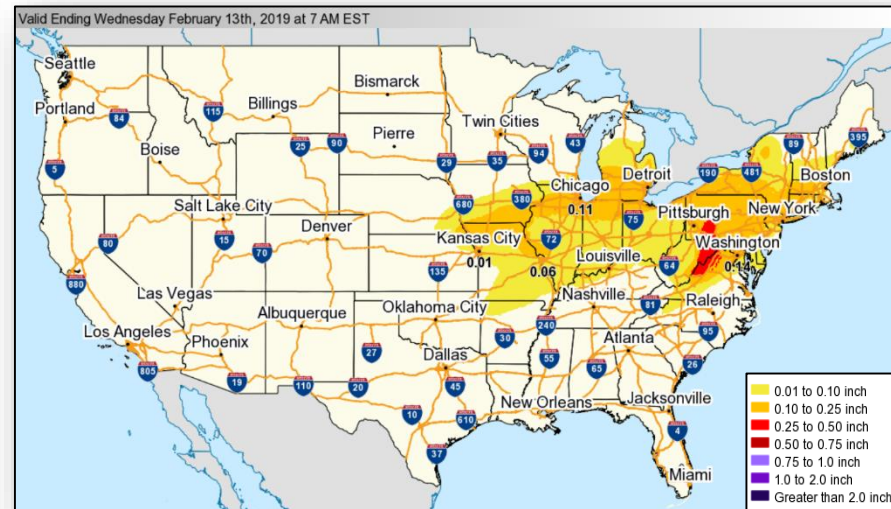
Winter Precipitation Outlook



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Forecast Snowfall

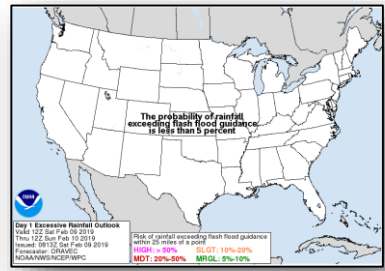
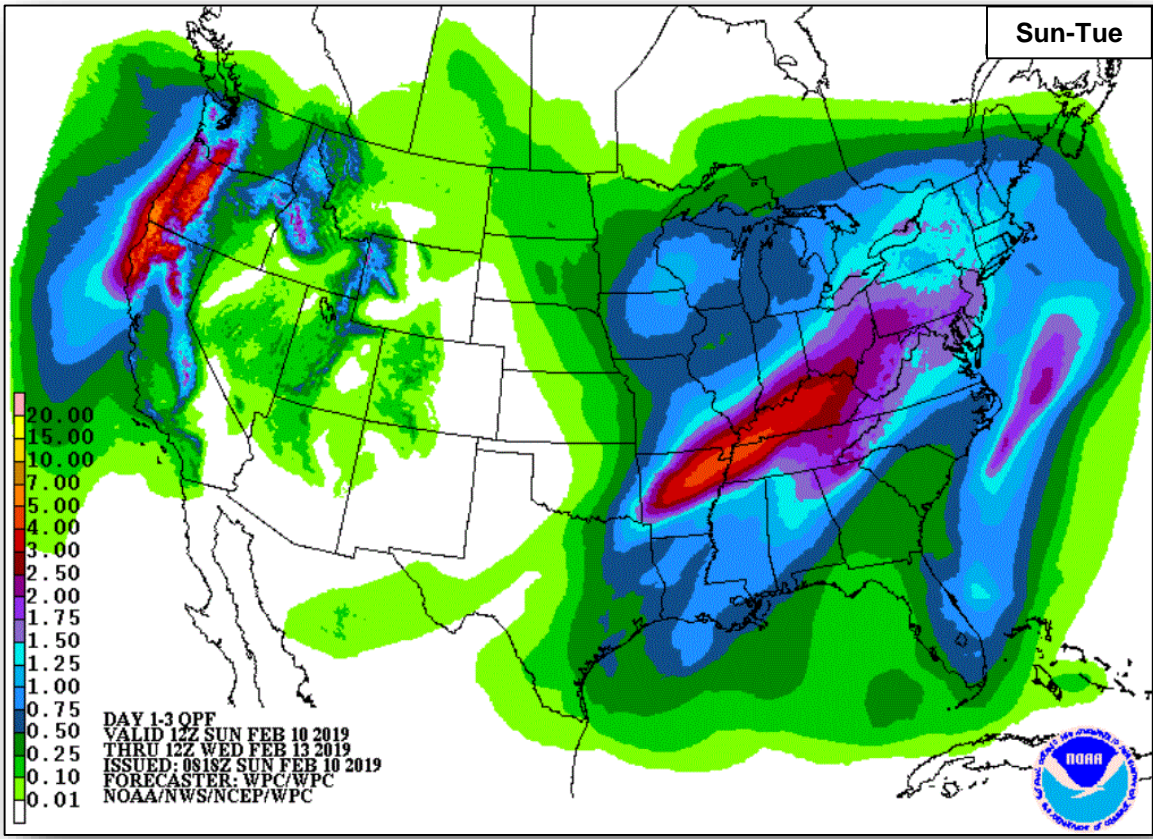


Forecast Ice Accumulation

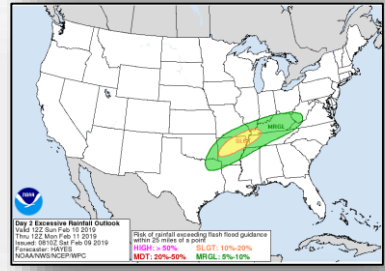
Precipitation Forecast



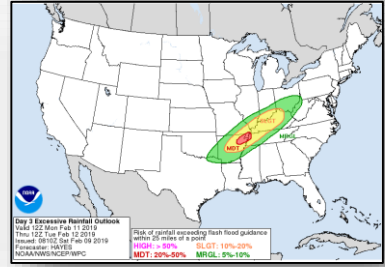

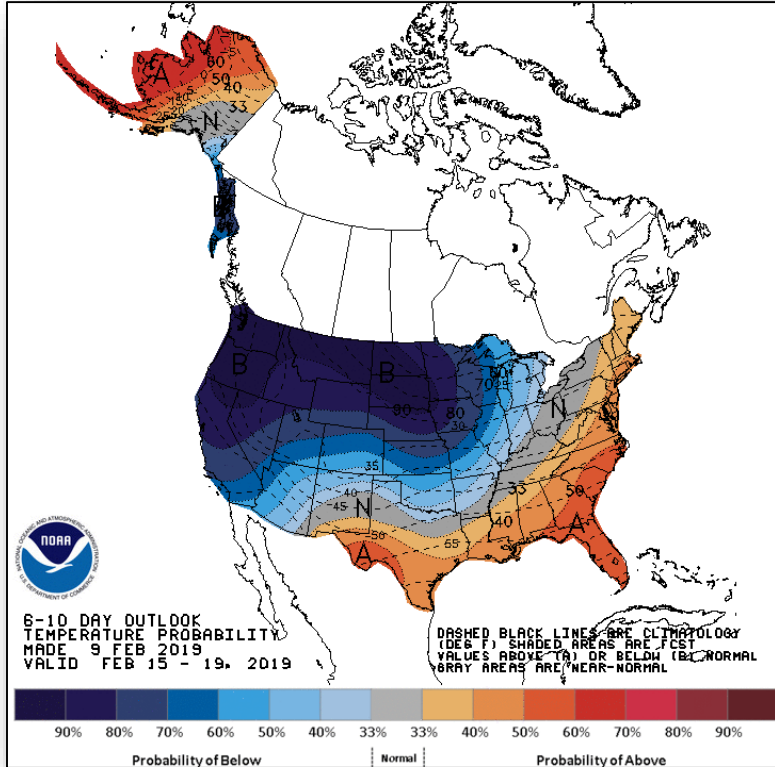

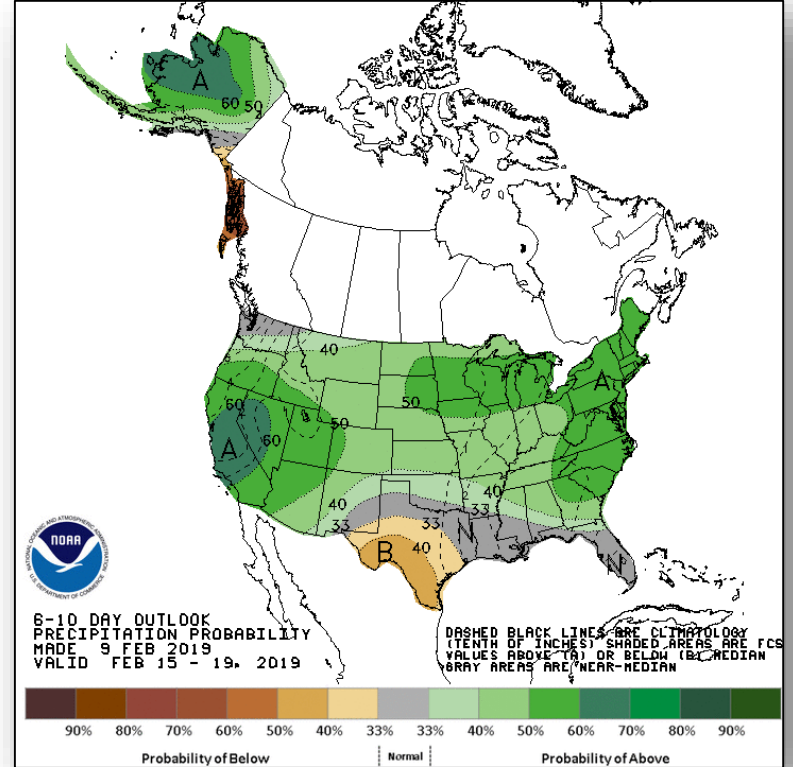
Long Range Outlooks – Feb 15-19

6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

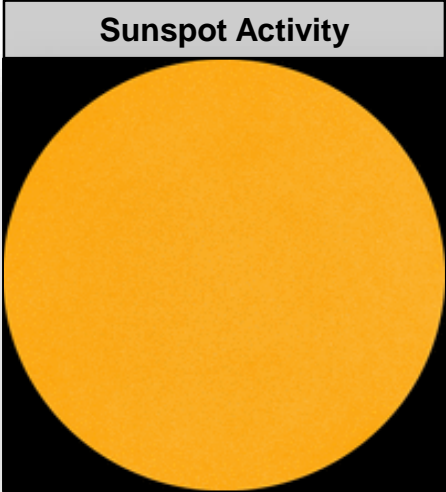
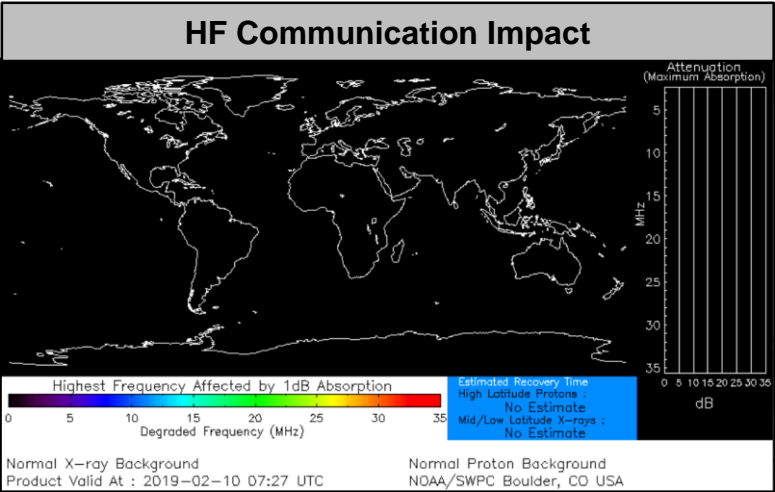
