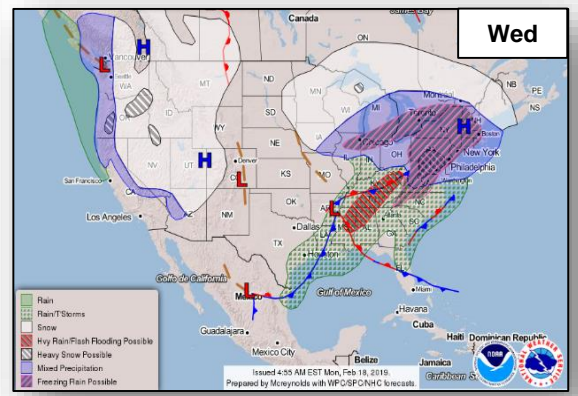
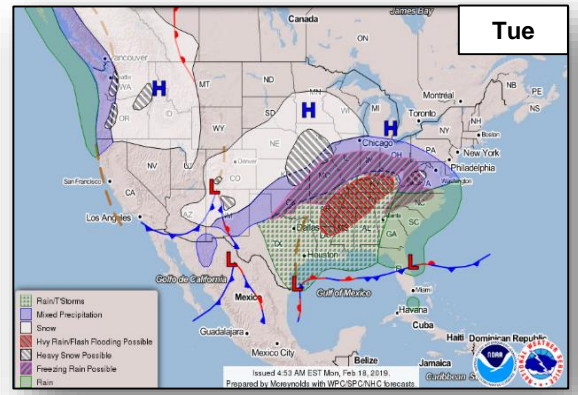
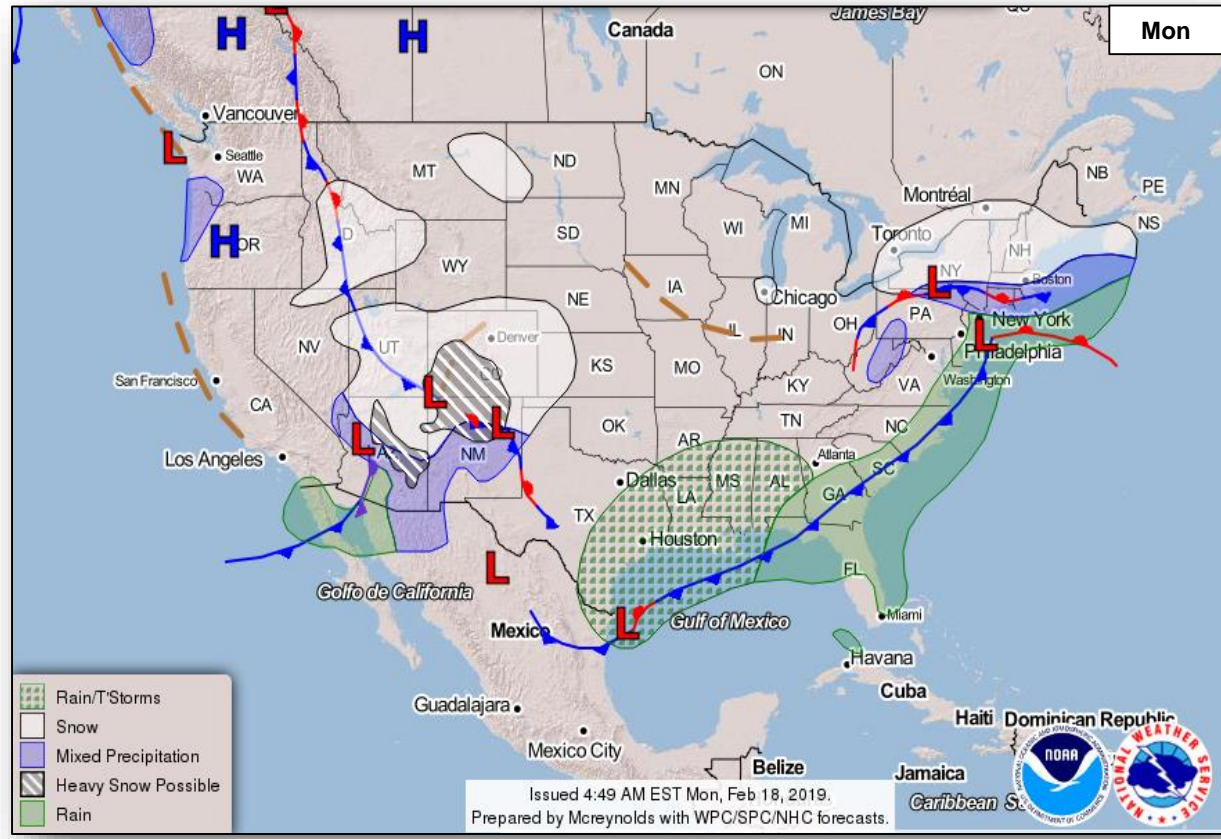
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Invest 92W (as of 10:00 p.m. EST)

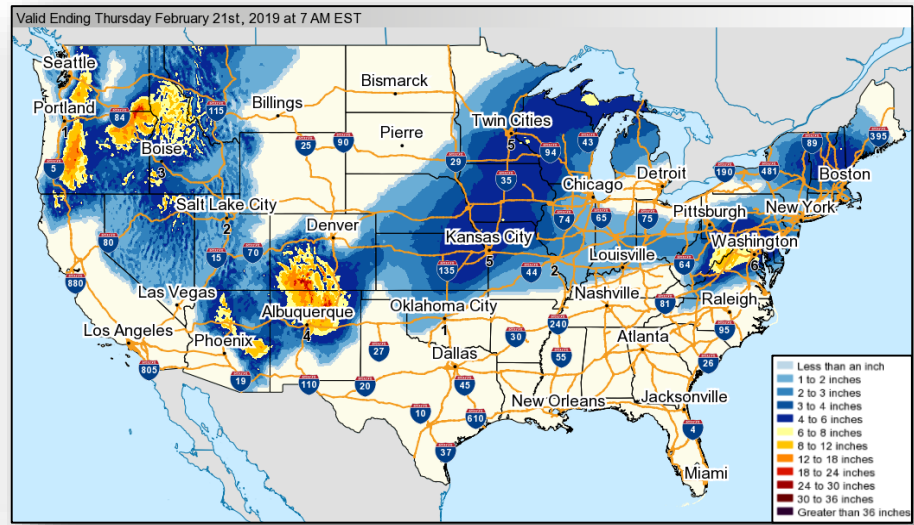
- Located 860 miles ESE of Chuuk, Federated States of Micronesia
- Moving W at 10 mph; this motion expected to continue through midweek, then turn WNW
- May be near the Marianas by sometime this weekend CHST
- Maximum sustained winds 25 mph
- The intensity of the circulation as it passes near the Marianas is uncertain
- Formation chance through next 24 hours: High
- No Watches or Warnings in effect; no current threat to U.S. interests
- FEMA Region IX and NWC remain at Steady State and continue to monitor



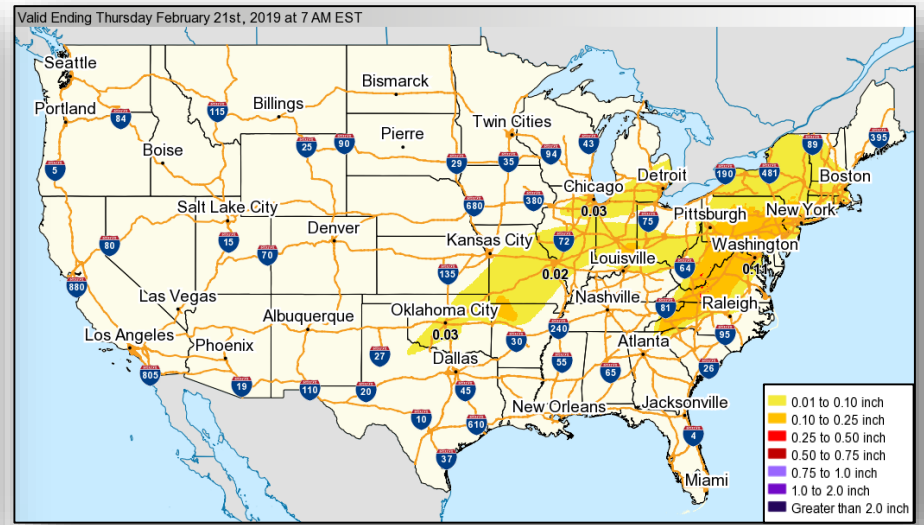
National Weather Forecast

Forecast Snowfall

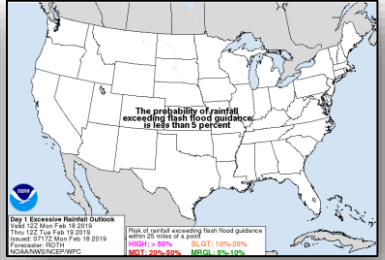
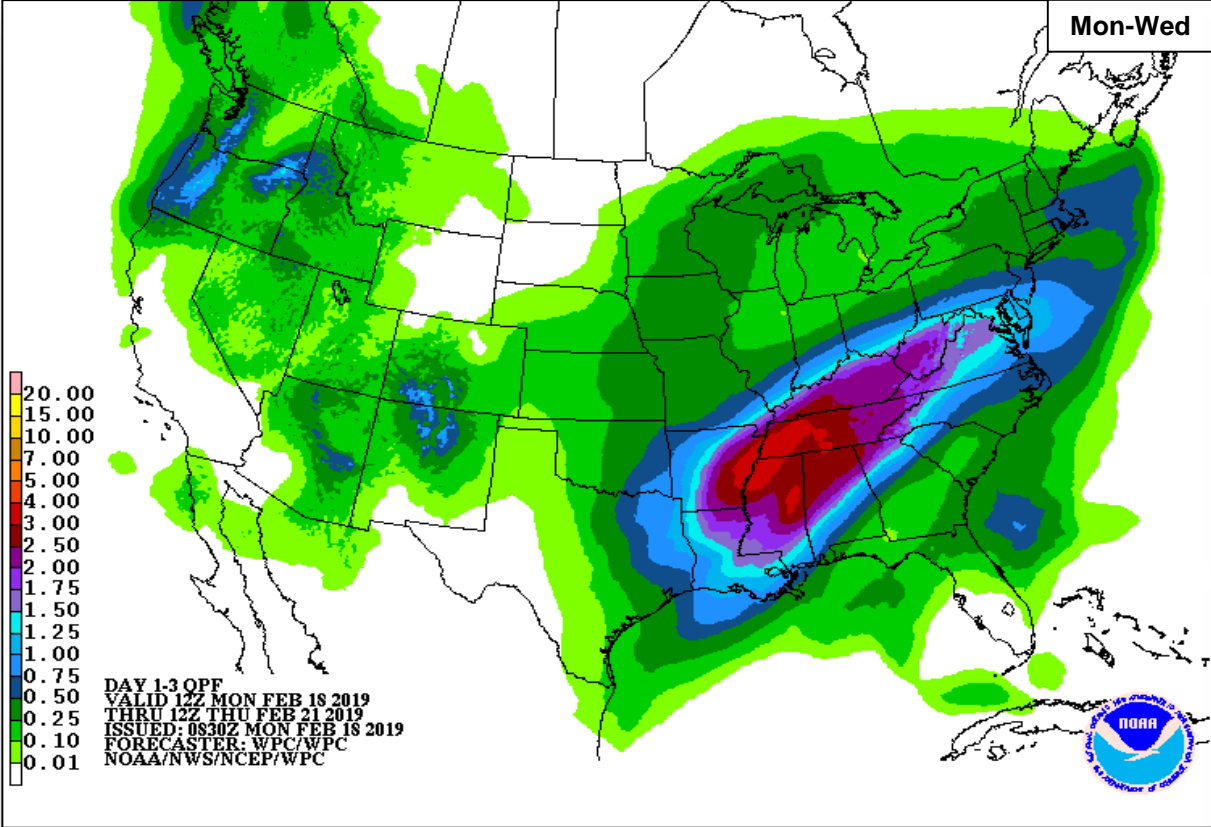


Forecast Ice Accumulation

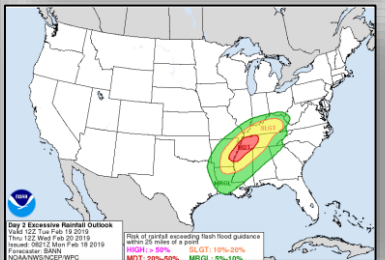

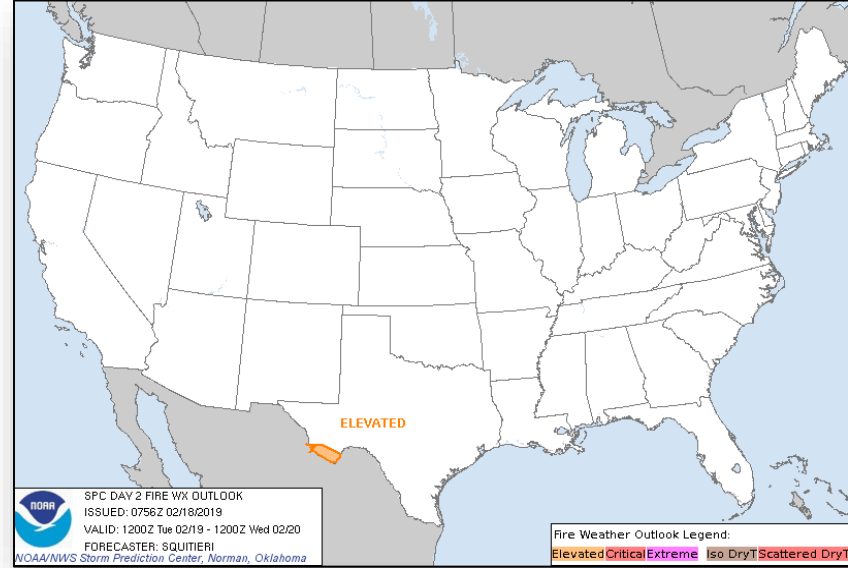

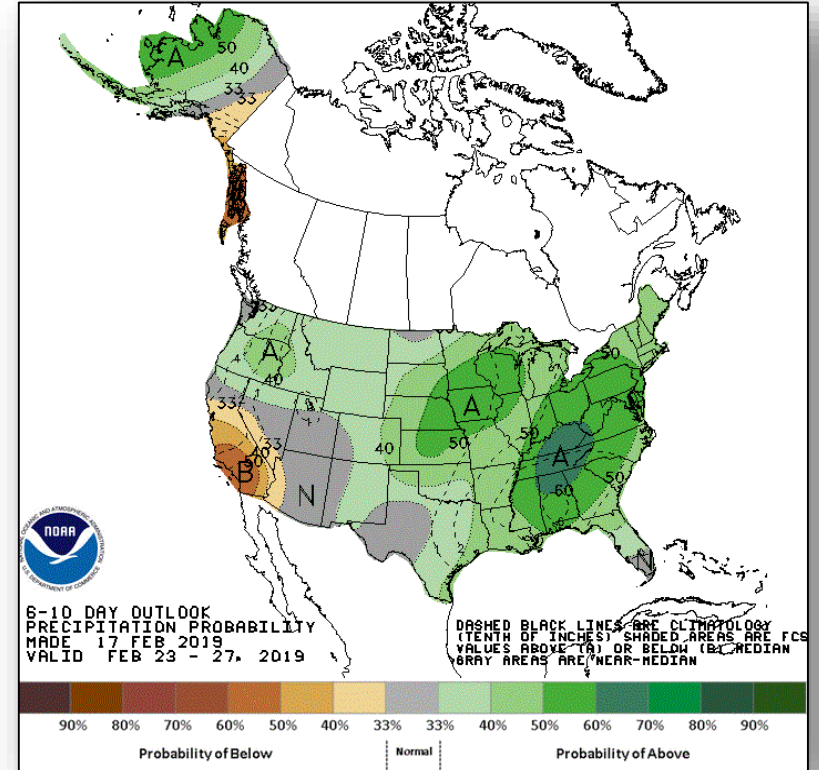
Long Range Outlooks – Feb 23-27

6 - 10 Day Precipitation Probability

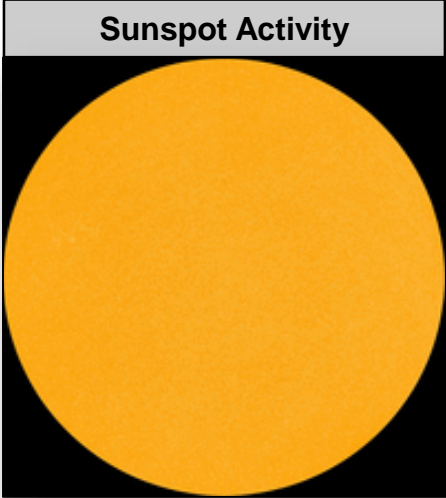
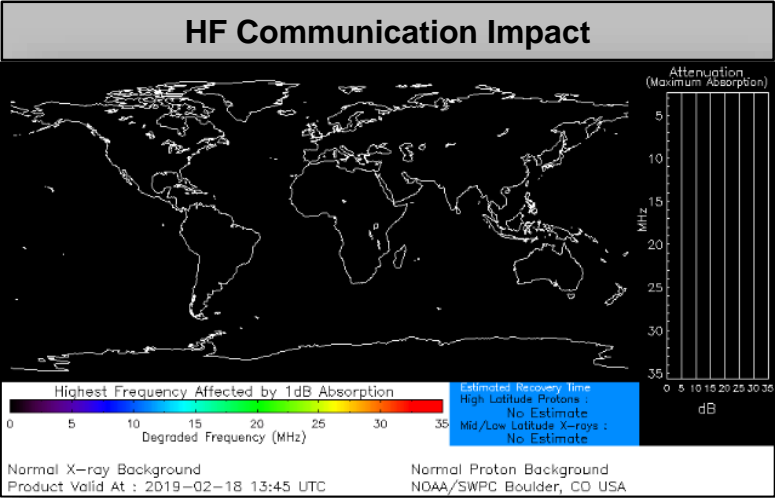
