Current Situation

Historic river flooding continues across eastern Nebraska and western Iowa; many locations expected to crest and begin to recede by Sunday. Ice jams and levee overtopping will remain a concern.

Lifeline Impacts

Food, Water, and Sheltering

- Evacuations ongoing in Sarpy County, NE and in Mills County, IA
- Shelters: NE 13 with 879 occupants; IA Five with 13 occupants
- Boil Water Order for Forest City, IA (pop. 4.5k) due to a water main break


- One confirmed fatality; two total (unconfirmed) missing persons
- Pender Community Hospital (Pender, NE; pop. 1k) evacuated

Transportation

• I-29 from Plattsmouth, IA to the Missouri border closed due to flooding

Hazardous Material

- River level gauges at Brownville, NE near the Cooper Nuclear Station are no longer reporting; site managers are checking levels every half hour
 - o Cooper Nuclear Station remains stable and at 100% power
 - If the river level increases to 45 feet, operators will take the plant offline as a protective safety measure
 - o No threat to plant employees or to the public

National Weather Forecast











Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation Forecast

Winter Precipitation Outlook






Forecast Snowfall




Forecast Ice Accumulation







