Current Situation

While historic flooding continues along the Missouri River basin, and significant impacts are ongoing, conditions are stabilizing within the region. Nebraska and lowa are assessing damages as floodwaters begin to recede in some areas.

Lifeline Impacts

Safety and Security:

- Santee Sioux of Nebraska:
 - o Impassable roads impacting many tribal residents
 - Flooding/damage to homes, roads, & health clinic

Food, Water, and Sheltering:

- Mandatory evacuations ongoing in numerous counties impacted by flood
- Shelter populations trending down:
 - o NE: 8 (+1) open with 268 (-79) occupants
 - o IA: 4 open with 44 (+8) occupants (ESF-6, as of 5:47 a.m. EDT)


Health and Medical:

 NE HHS working with EPA for mobile water testing for presence of tetanus

Transportation:

 NE & MO: Interstate 29 is closed from Omaha, NE to St. Joseph, MO; approximately 150 miles (FEMA Region VII, as of 6:35 a.m. EDT)




National Weather Forecast












Severe Weather Outlook










Precipitation Forecast














