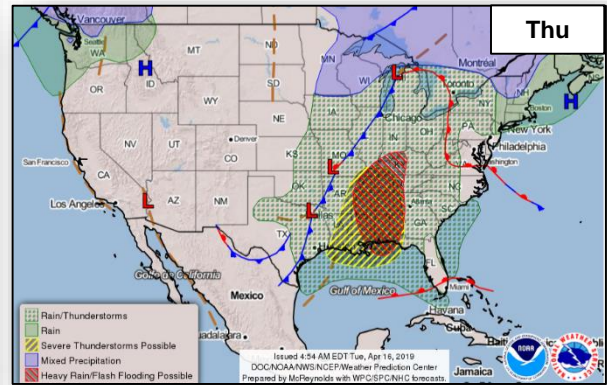
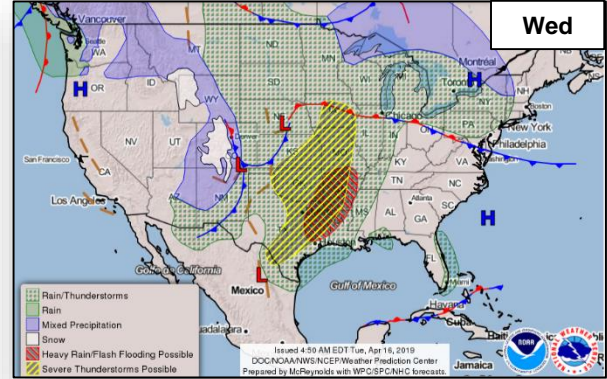
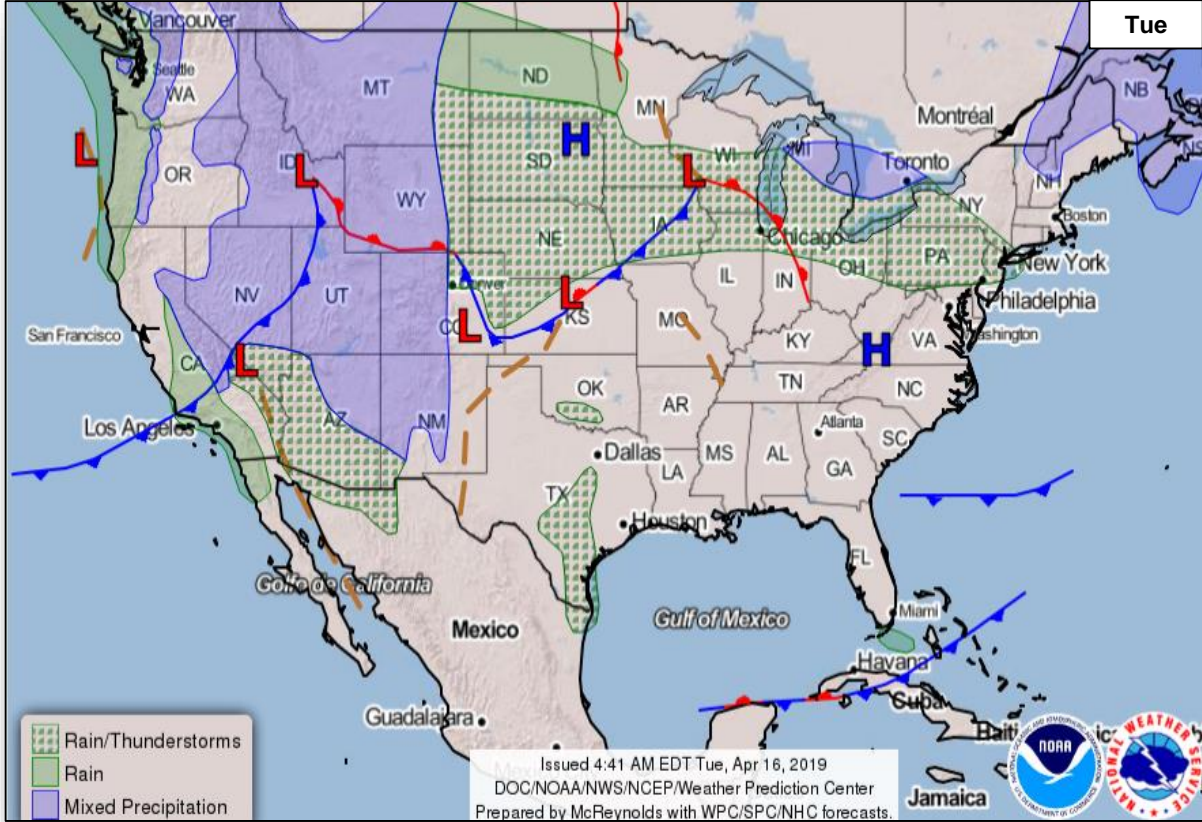
FEMA continues to support DHS and the Interagency Border Emergency Cell (IBEC) with operations on the southwest border.

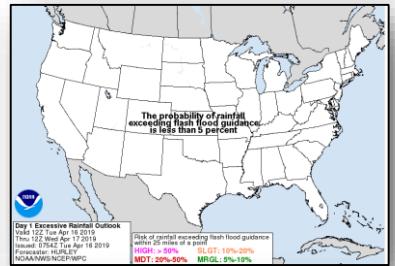
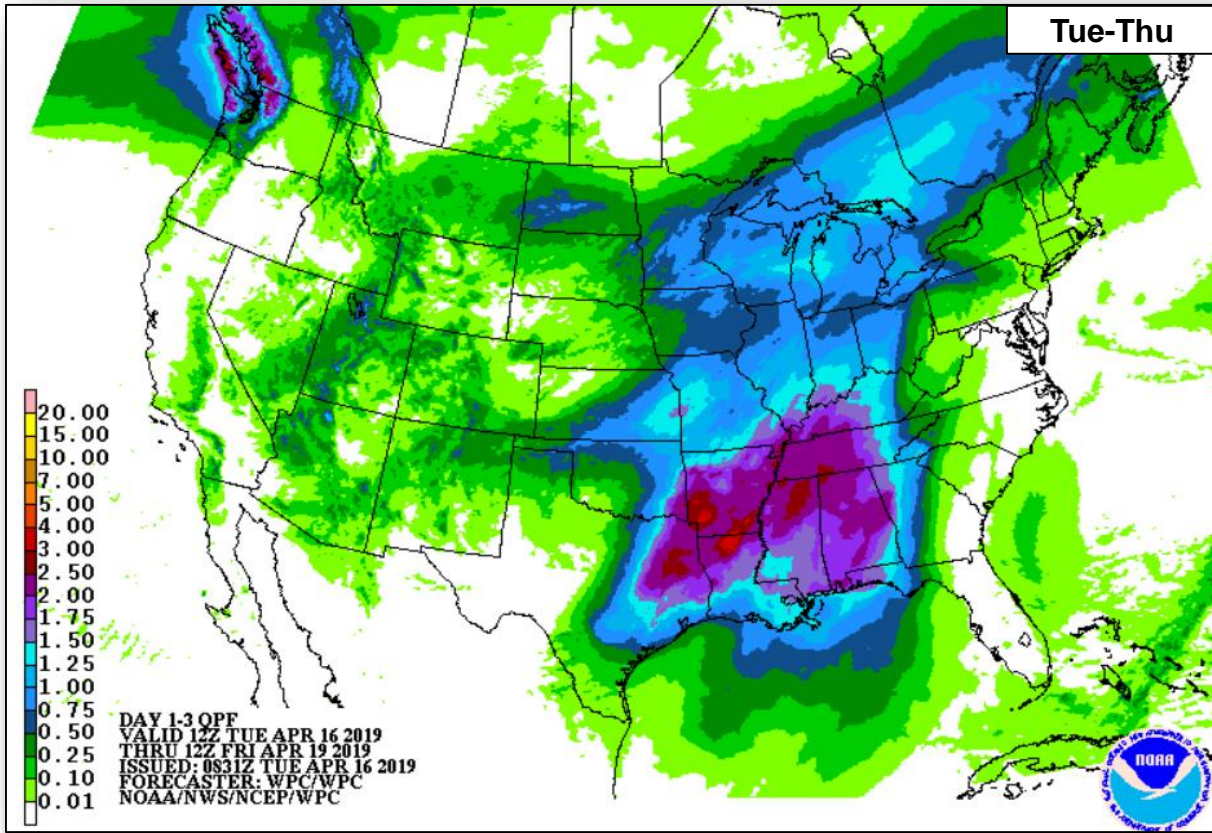
# Severe Weather Outlook



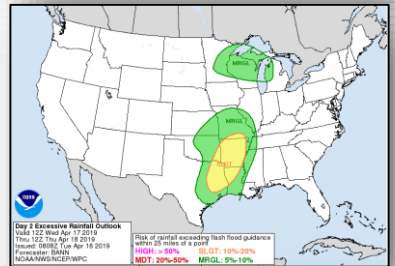

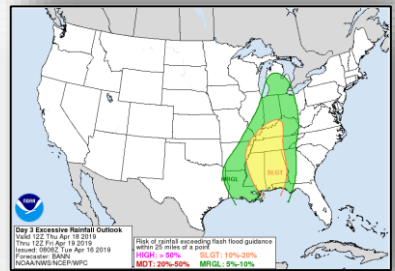
# Precipitation Forecast

  - Hazard Mitigation statewide



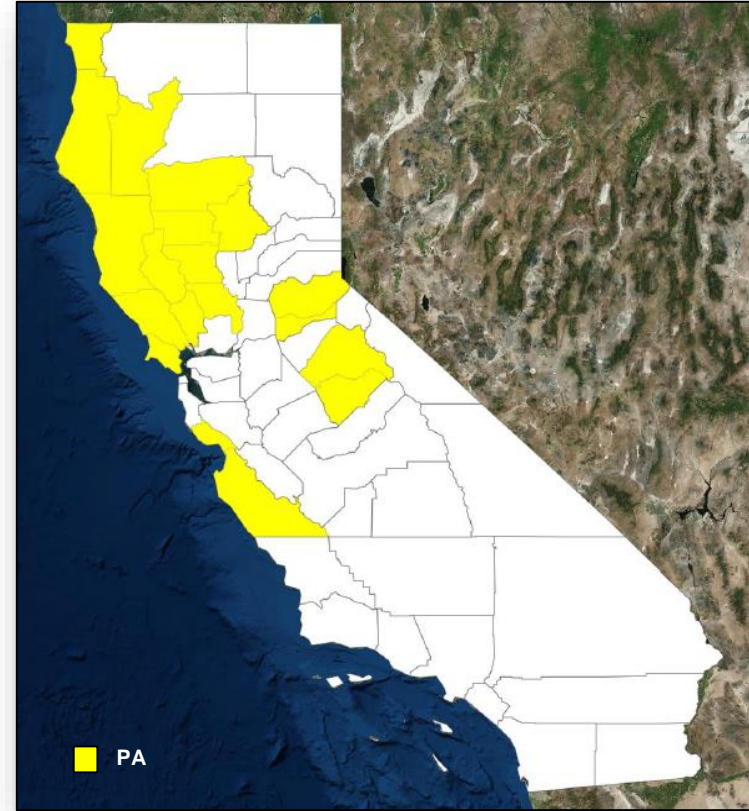
