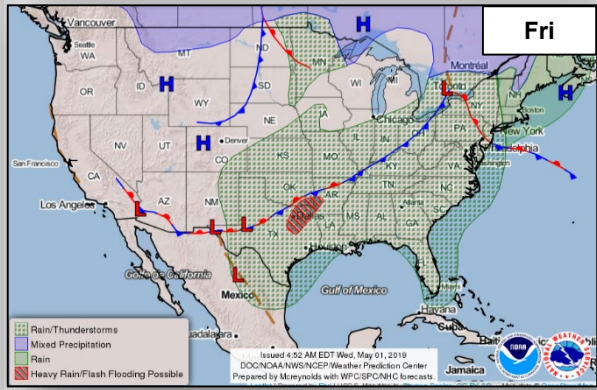
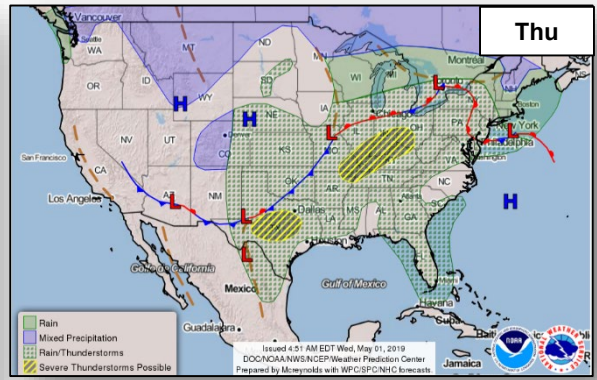
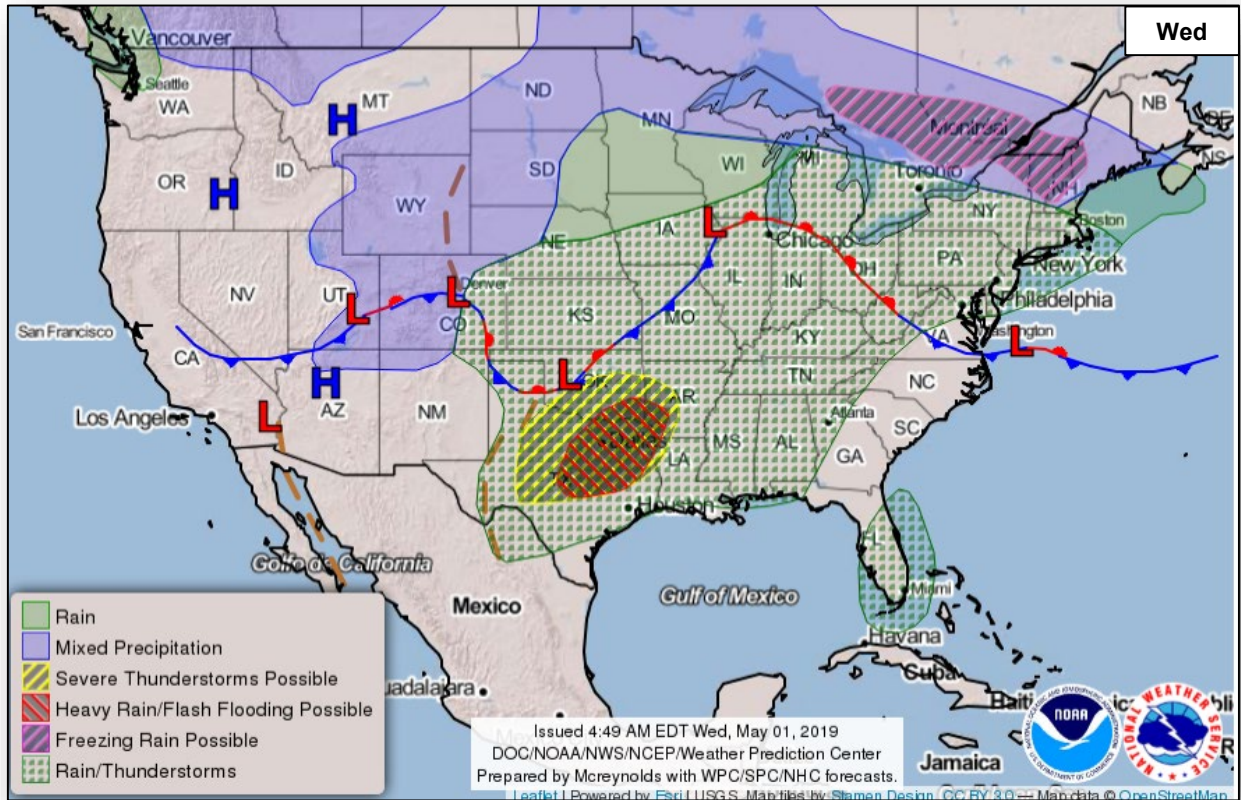
Significant Weather:

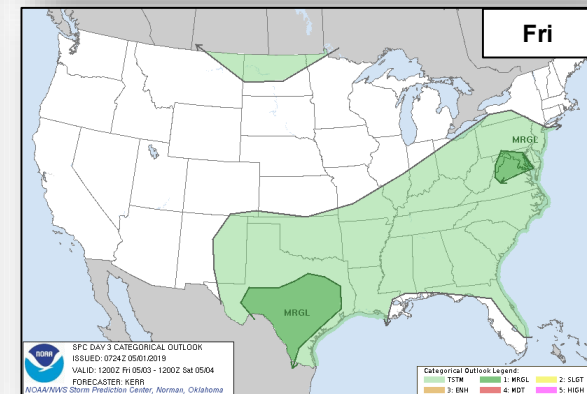
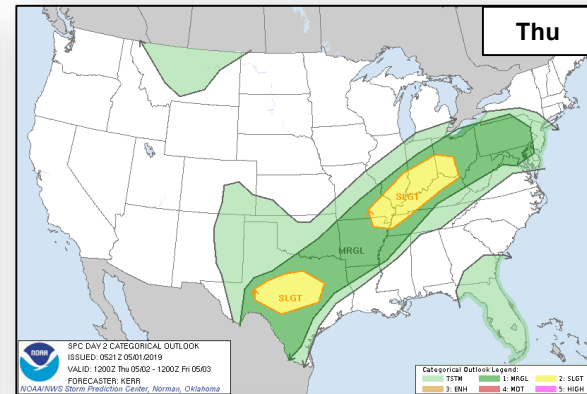
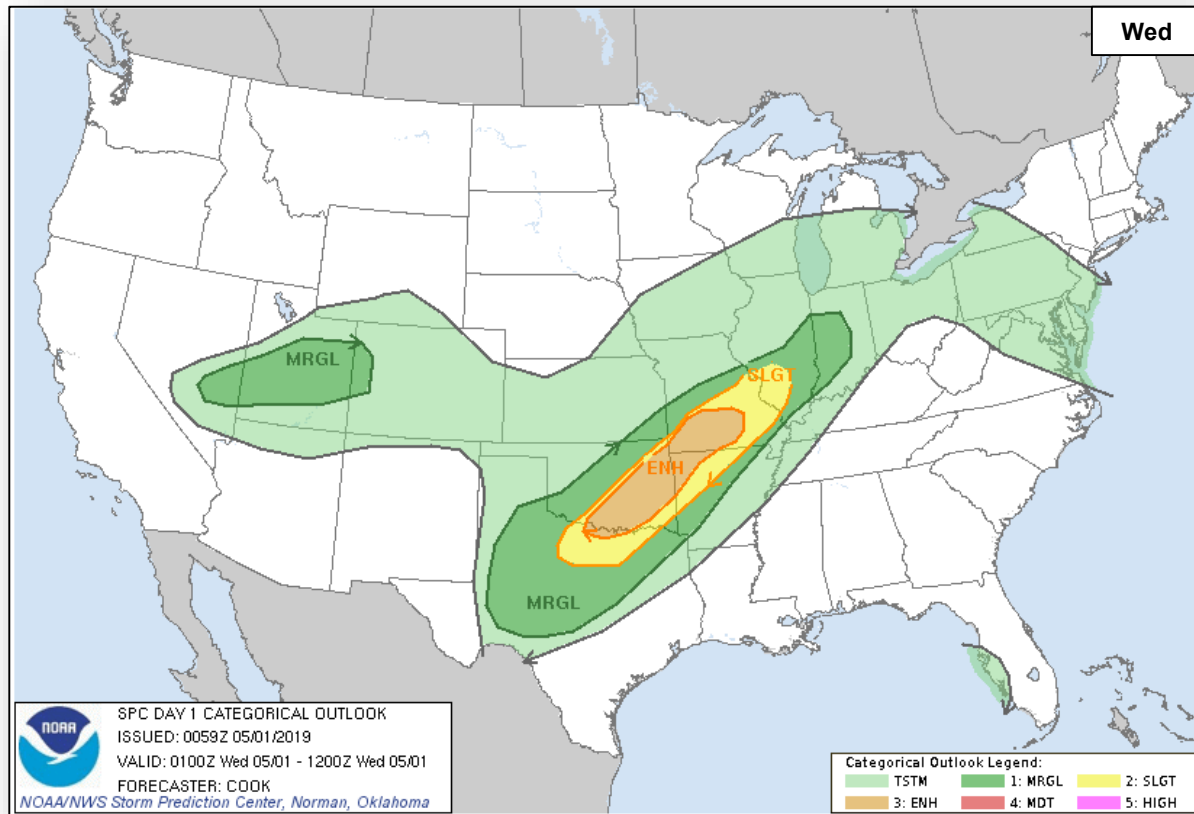
National Weather Forecast



Severe Weather Outlook



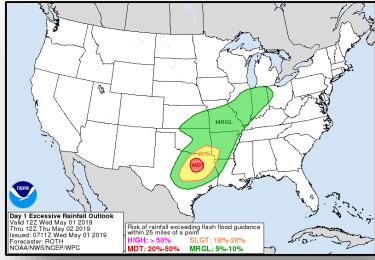
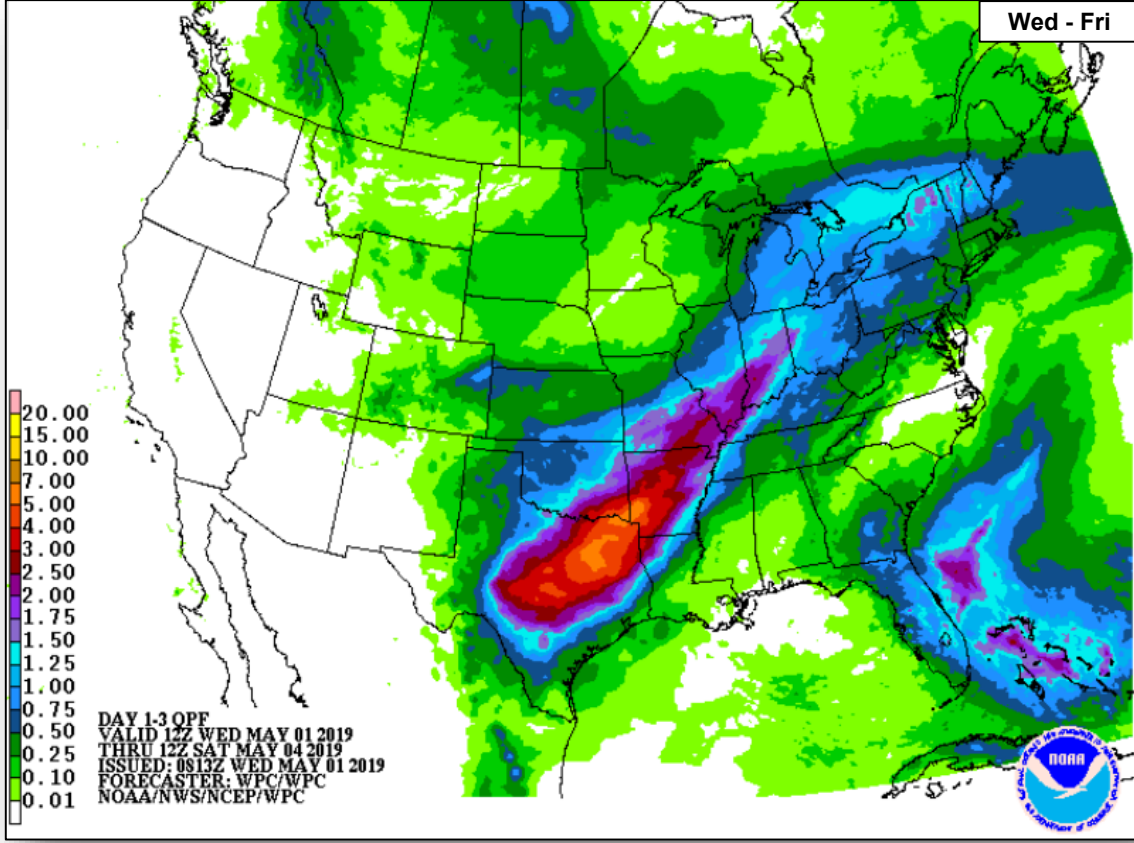

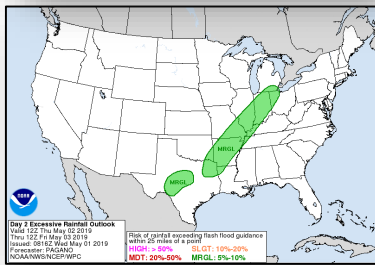
Precipitation Forecast



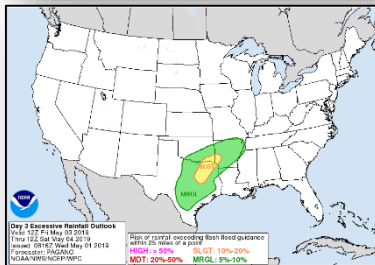
