## 3-Day Rainfall Today - Thursday

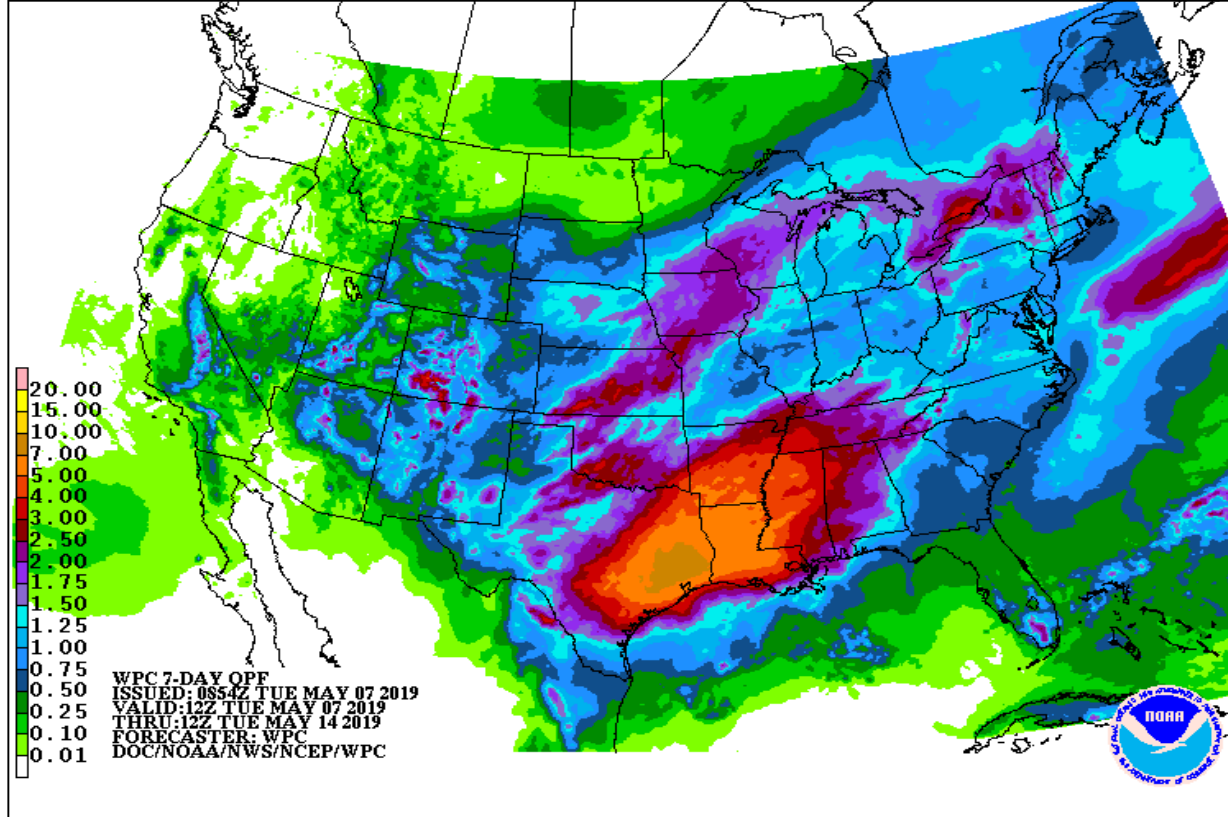


## Daily Flash Flood Risk





## 7-Day Rainfall Today – Tuesday (May 14)

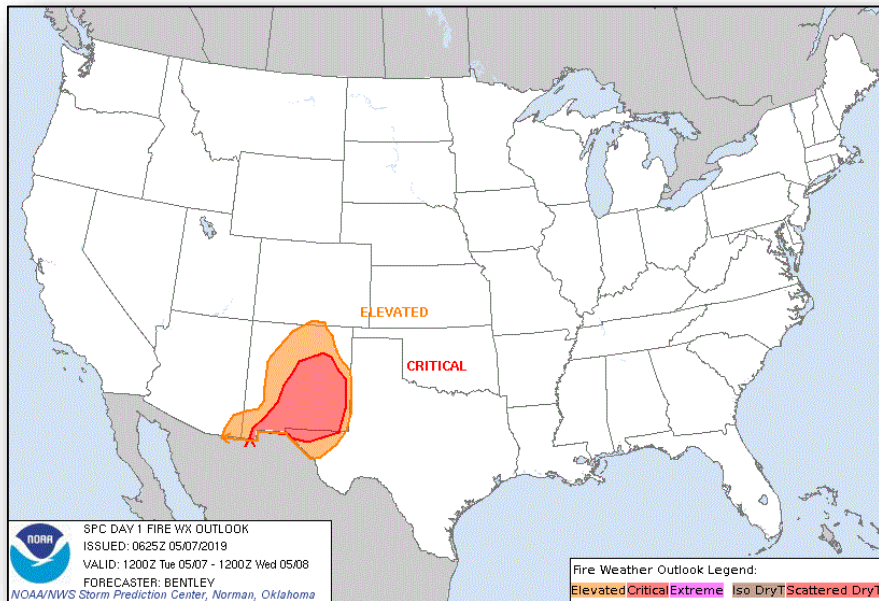




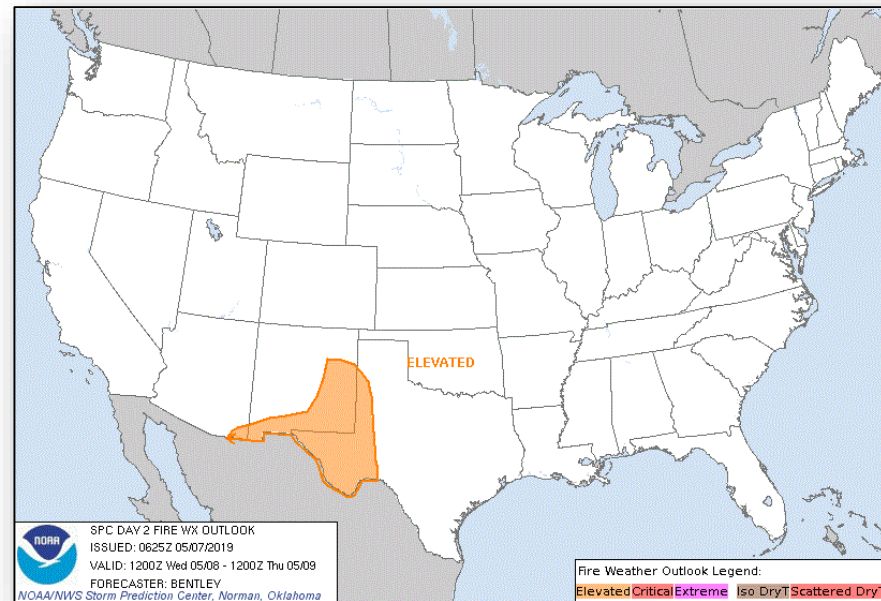

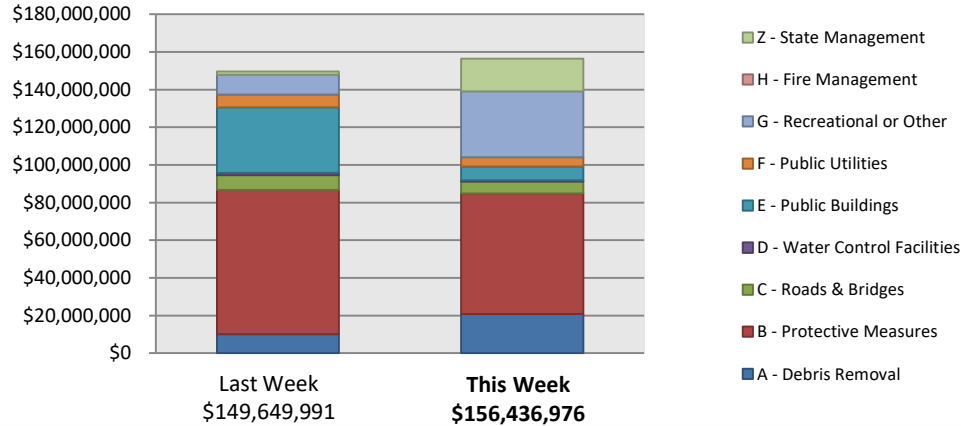

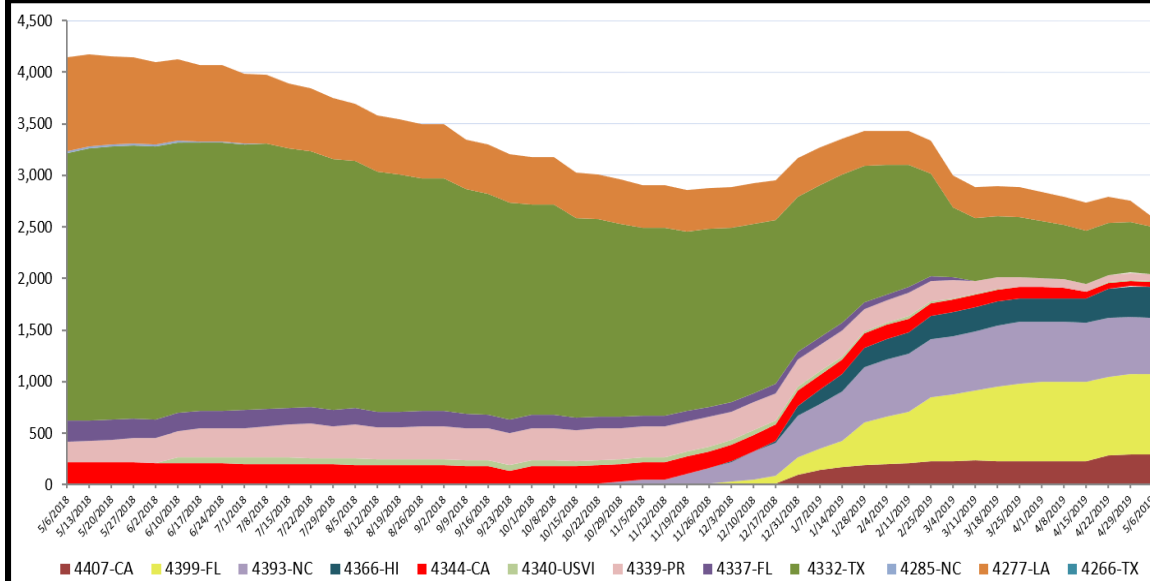

States with Currently Occupied Units

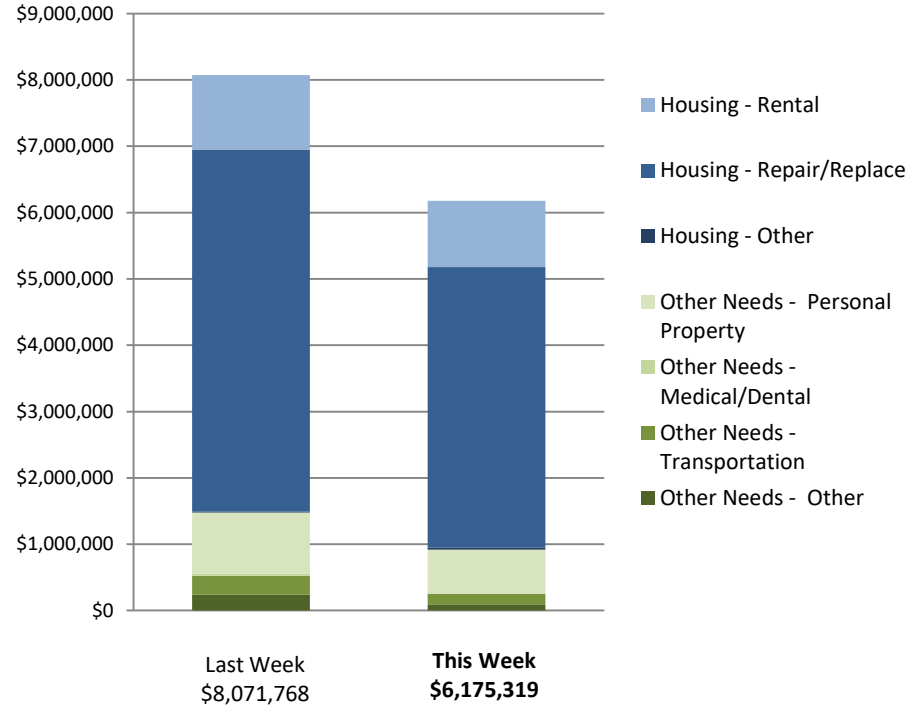

## Tuesday, May 7 – Assemble Disaster Supplies

Hurricane Preparedness Week is your time to prepare for a potential land-falling tropical storm or hurricane:

- You're going to need supplies not just to get through the storm but for the potentially lengthy and unpleasant aftermath
- Have enough non-perishable food, water and medicine to last each person in your family a minimum of three days - electricity and water could be out for at least that long
- You'll need extra cash, a battery-powered radio and flashlights
- Many of us have cell phones, and they all run on batteries – You're going to need a portable crank or solar powered USB charger

**ASSEMBLE DISASTER SUPPLIES.**

**MAY 7 - Assemble Disaster Supplies**  
Get your supplies before hurricane season begins. Have enough food and water for each person for at least three days. Be sure to fill your prescriptions and have medicine on hand. Radios, batteries and phonechargers on are also must haves. Gas up your vehicle and extra cash on hand.
