Precipitation Forecast



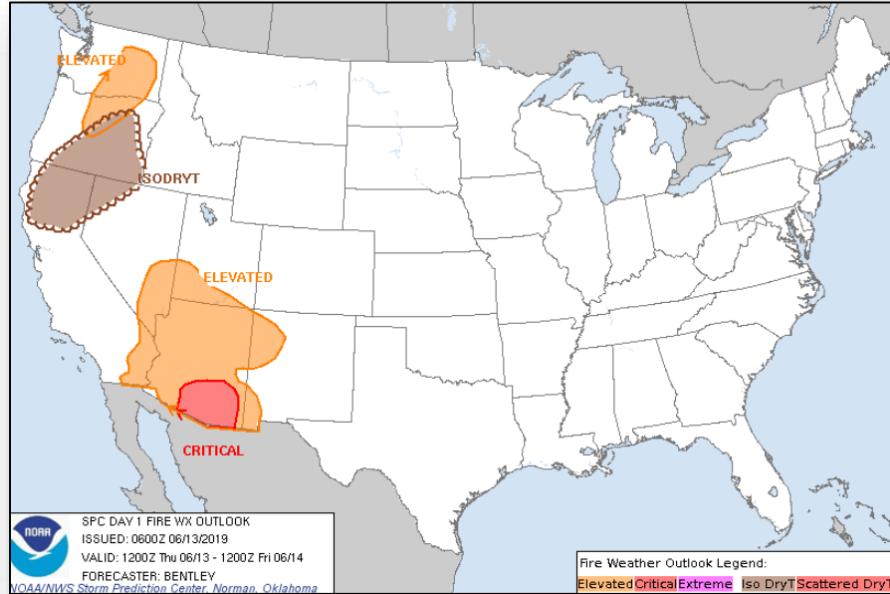

- Provides:
 - Public Assistance for 51 counties and the Prairie Island Indian Community, Red Lake Band of Chippewa, Upper Sioux Community, and the White Earth Nation
 - Hazard Mitigation for all areas in the State of Minnesota
- FCO is Steven W. Johnson



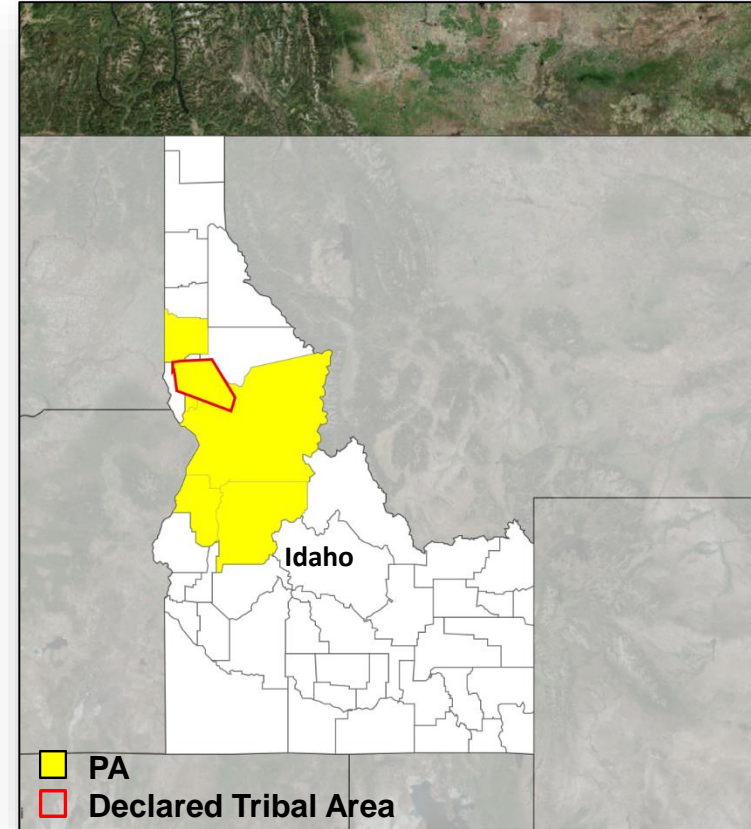

 - Hazard Mitigation for all areas in the State of Idaho
- FCO is Dolph A. Diemont



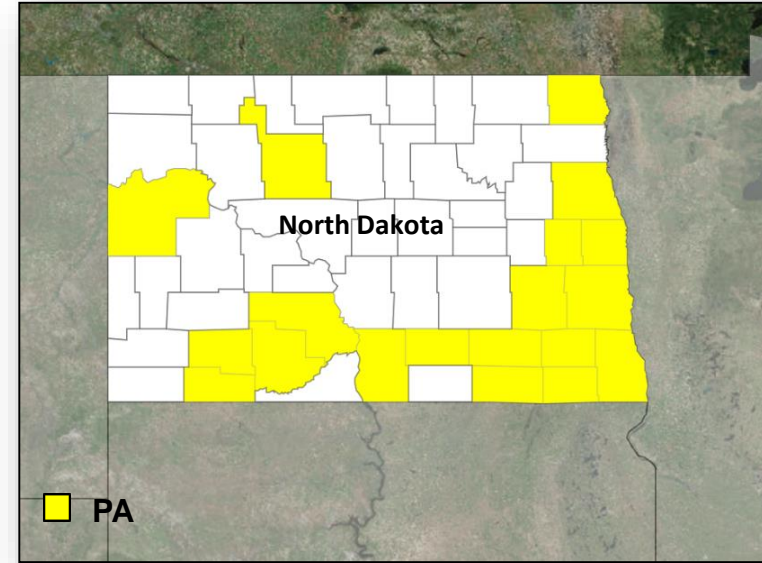

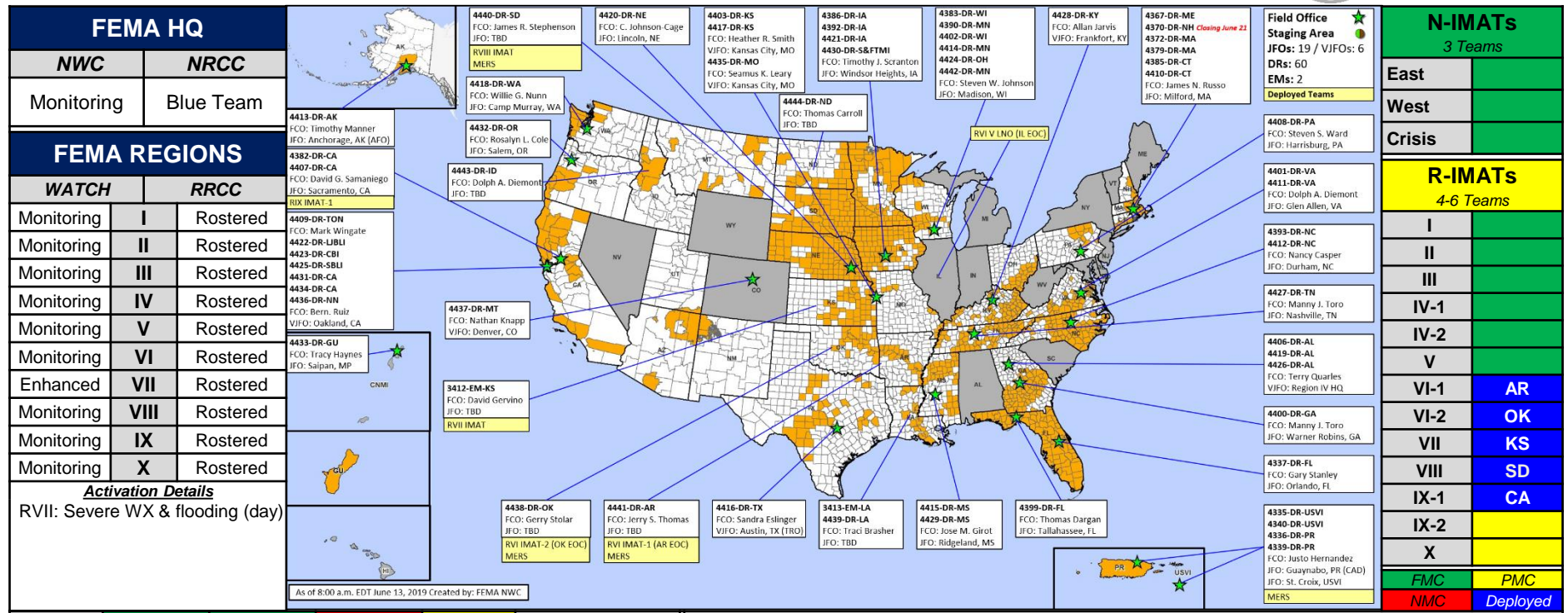
