 - Tropical Depression Chantal
 - Disturbance 1: High (70%)
 - Disturbance 2: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Ivo
 - Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Central Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

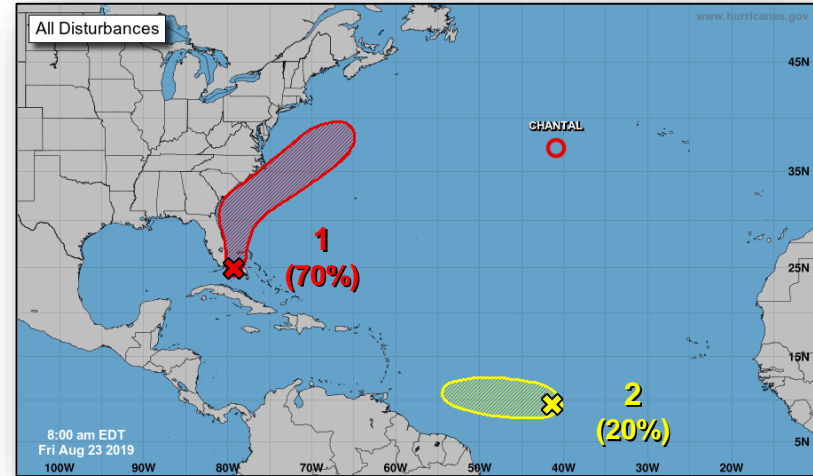
- East of Florida Keys
- Regardless of development, locally heavy rains are possible over portions of the Florida peninsula during the next day or two
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (40%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,400 miles ESE of the Windward Islands
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Tropical Depression Chantal (Advisory #10 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

- 765 miles W of The Azores
- Moving SE at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 30 mph
- Forecast to degenerate into a remnant low by tonight

Tropics – Eastern & Central Pacific

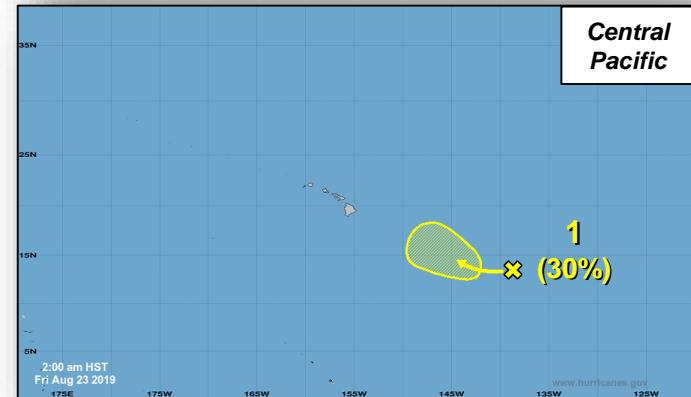


Tropical Storm Ivo (Advisory #8 as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 4,555 miles SW of southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving NNW at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Little change in strength is forecast today; weakening likely to begin tomorrow

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

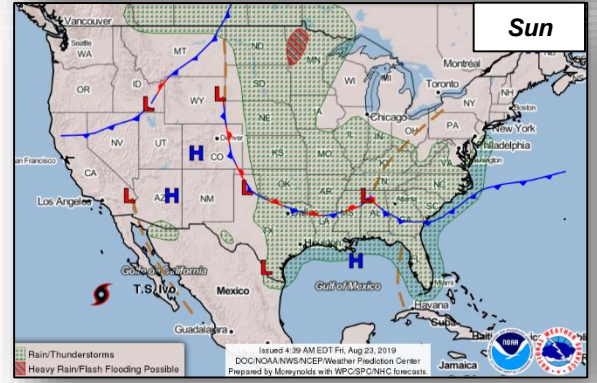
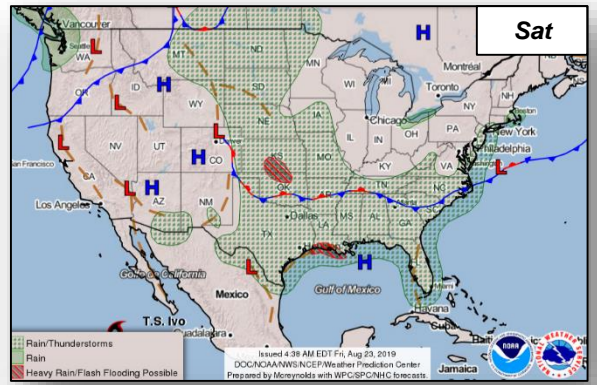
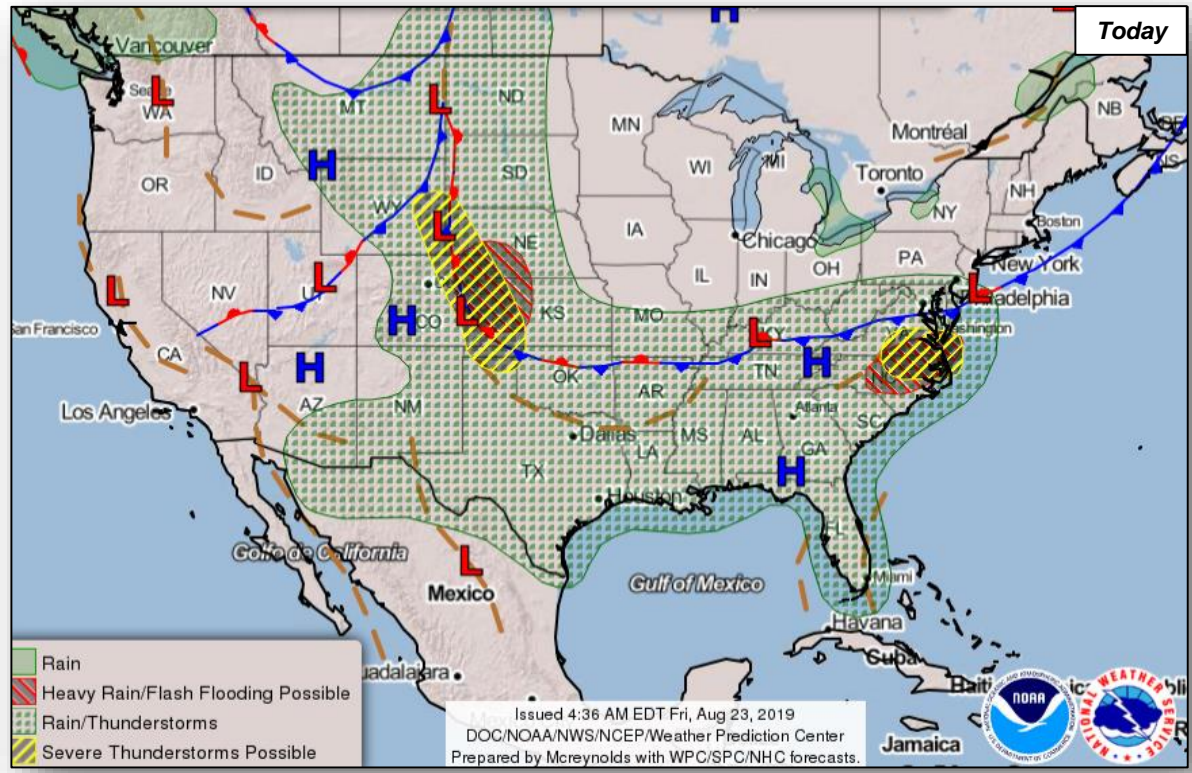
- Currently in the Eastern Pacific basin

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)



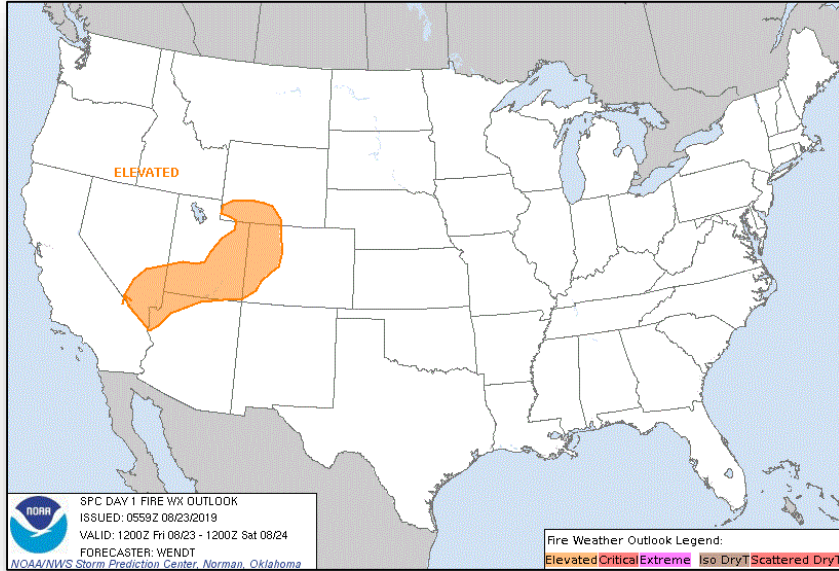

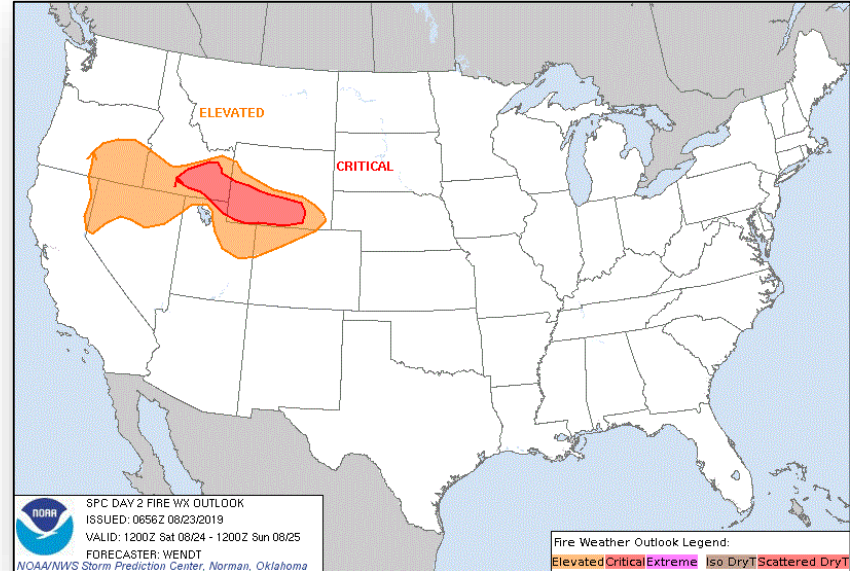
National Weather Forecast

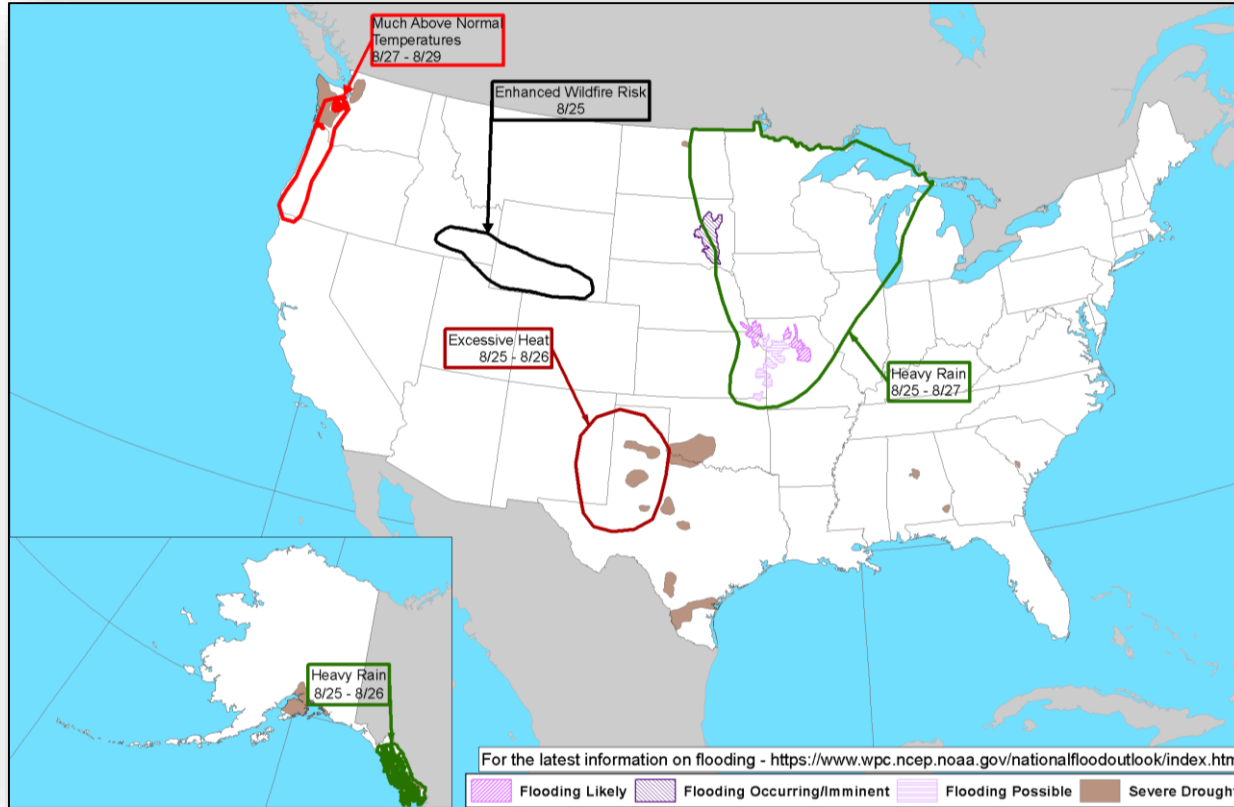

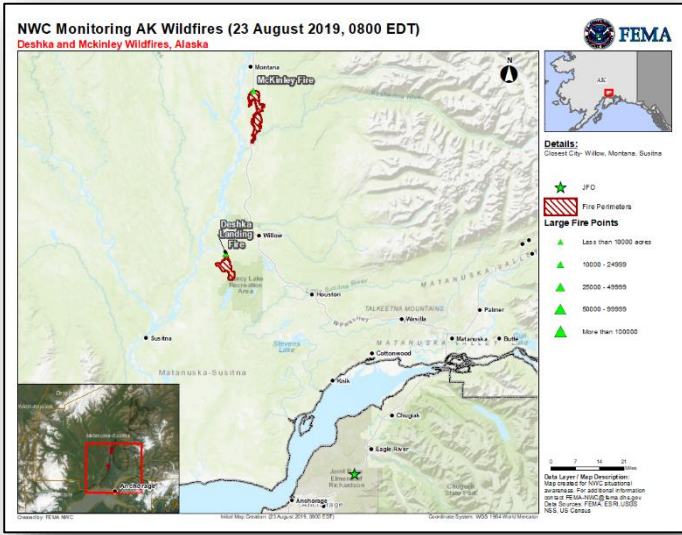

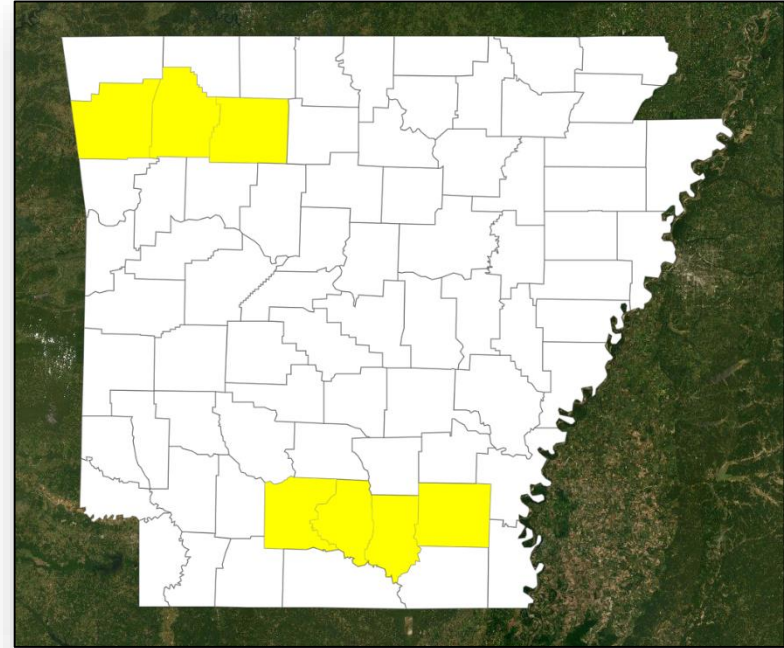
