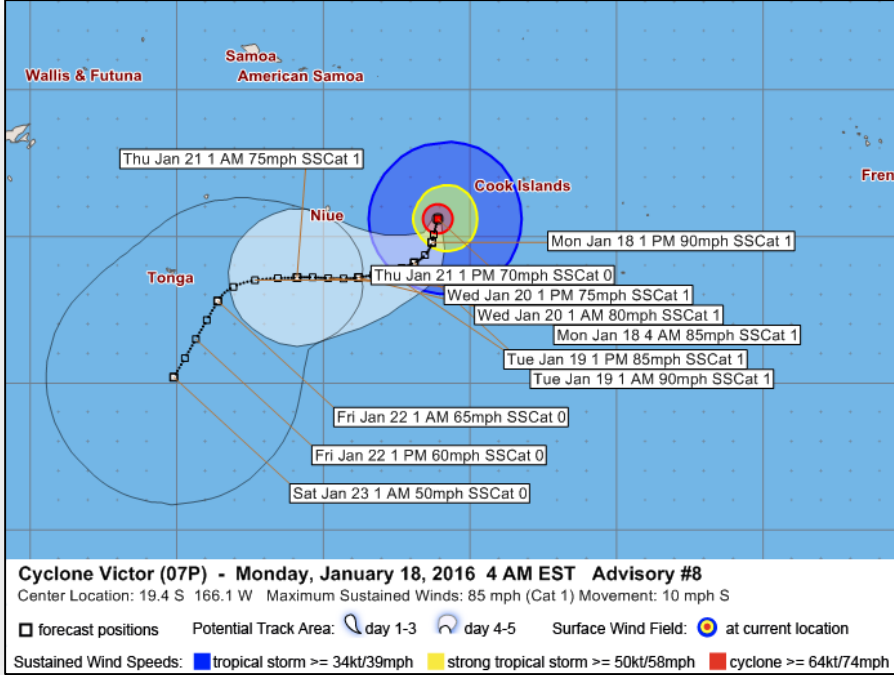

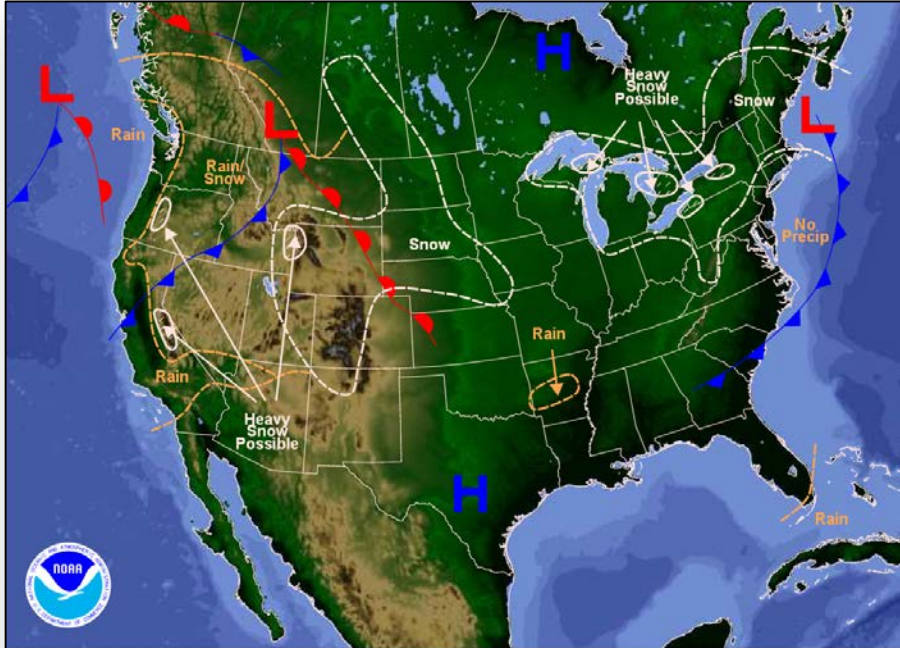
# 2 Day Tropical Outlook – South Pacific (Final)



## Tropical Cyclone 07P (Victor) Warning #8 (As of 4:00 a.m. EST)

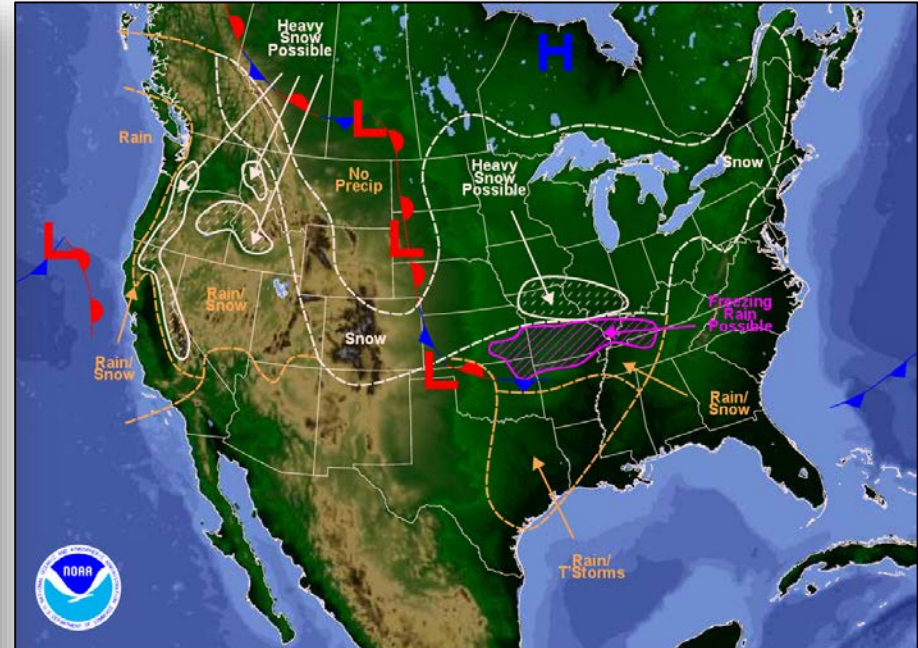
- Located 450 miles SE of Pago Pago, American Samoa

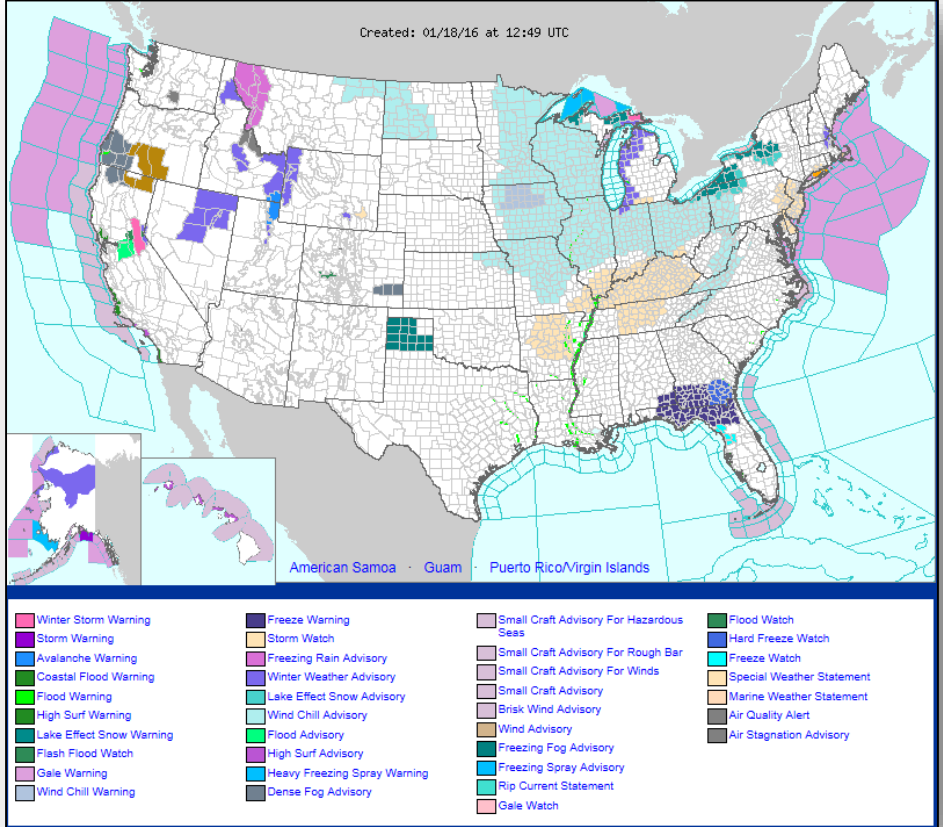

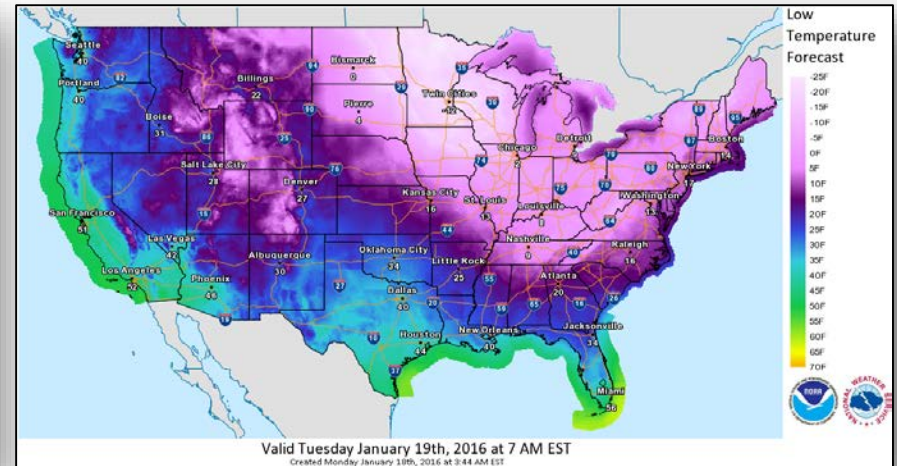

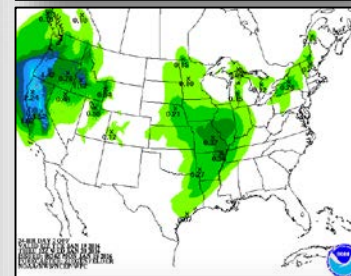
# Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



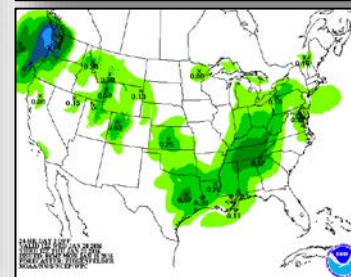

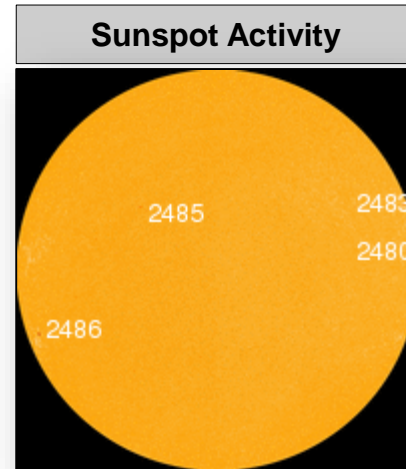
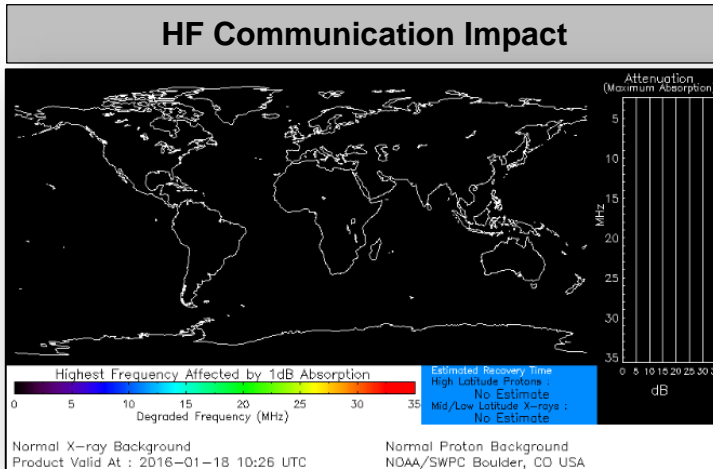
*Temperature Probability*

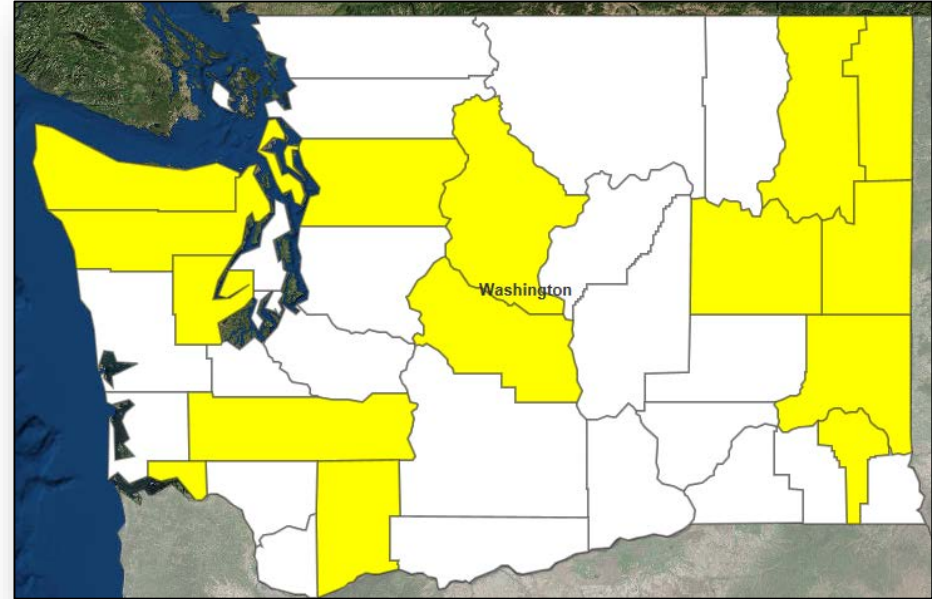

## January 15, 2016

- President approved Major Disaster Declaration, FEMA-4249-DR, for the State of Washington
- For Severe Winter Storms, Straight-line Winds, Landslides, Mudslides, and Flooding
- During the period of November 12-21, 2015
- Provides Public Assistance for 16 counties and Hazard Mitigation statewide
- FCO is Thomas J. Dargan

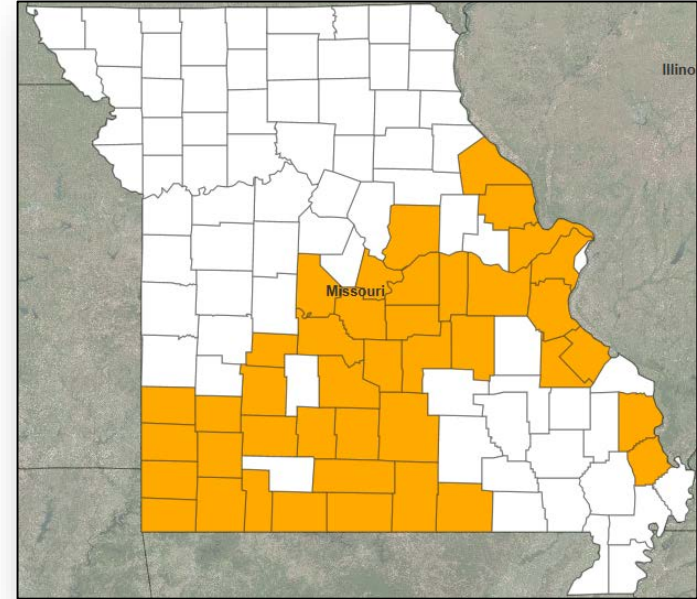


# Major Disaster Declaration Request – MO



## January 15, 2016

- Governor requested a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Missouri
- For Severe Storms, Tornadoes, Straight-line Winds and Flooding
- During the period of December 23, 2015 to January 9, 2016
- Requesting:
  - Individual Assistance for 41 counties and Hazard Mitigation statewide
  - Direct Federal Assistance for emergency protective measures and debris removal, which were authorized under Emergency Declaration FEMA-3374-EM-MO



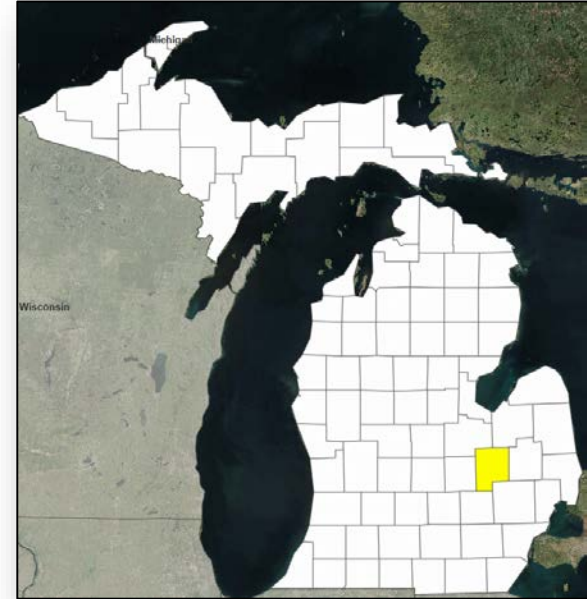

# Emergency Declaration – MI



**January 16, 2016**

- President approved Emergency Declaration FEMA-3375-EM for the State of Michigan
- For contaminated water from April 25, 2014 and continuing
- Specifically Provides:
  - Provides emergency protective measures (Category B) limited to direct federal assistance under the Public Assistance program at 75% federal funding
  - Water, water filters, water filter cartridges, water test kits and other necessary related items for a period of no more than 90 days for Genesee County
- FCO is David G. Samaniego



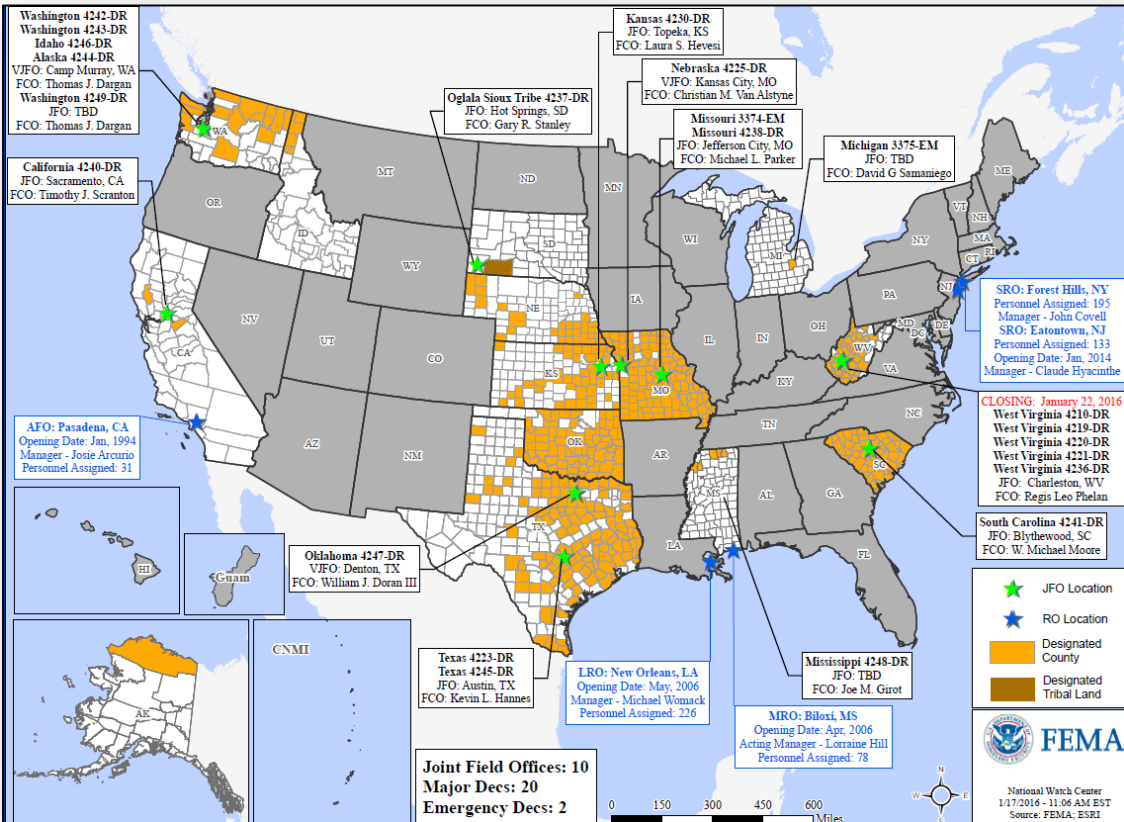
