 - Next 24 hours – minor; geomagnetic storms reaching G1 level likely

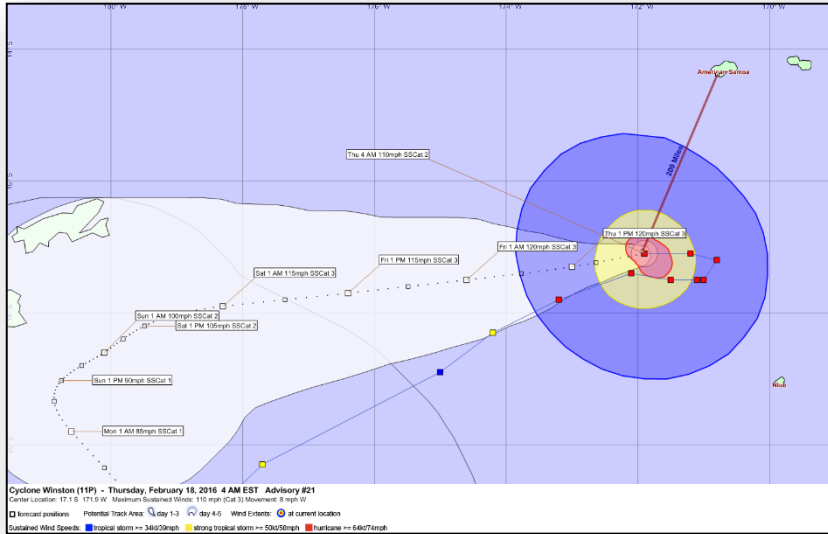

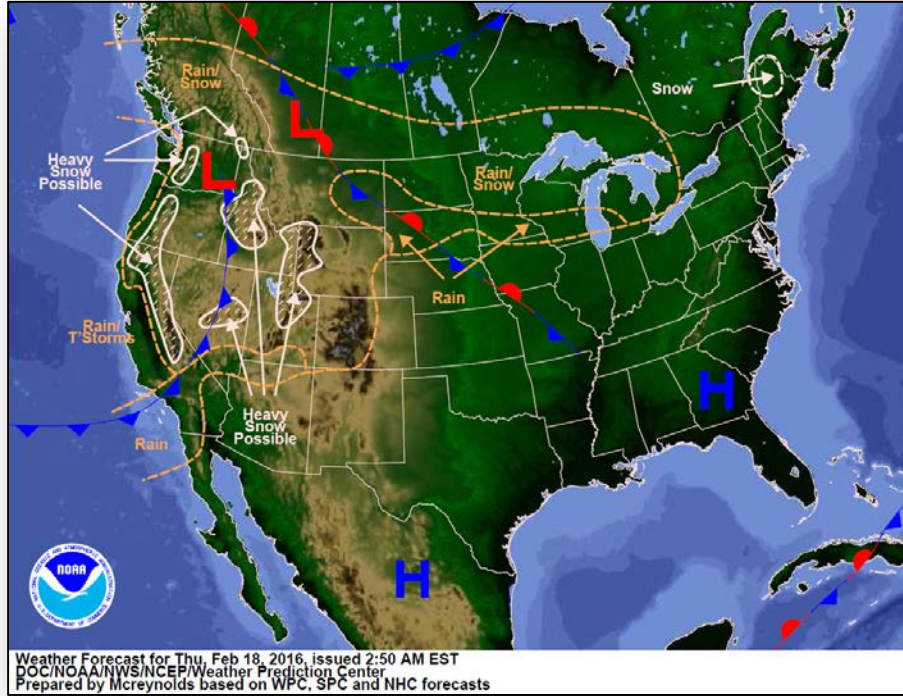
South Pacific – Tropical Cyclone 11P (FINAL)



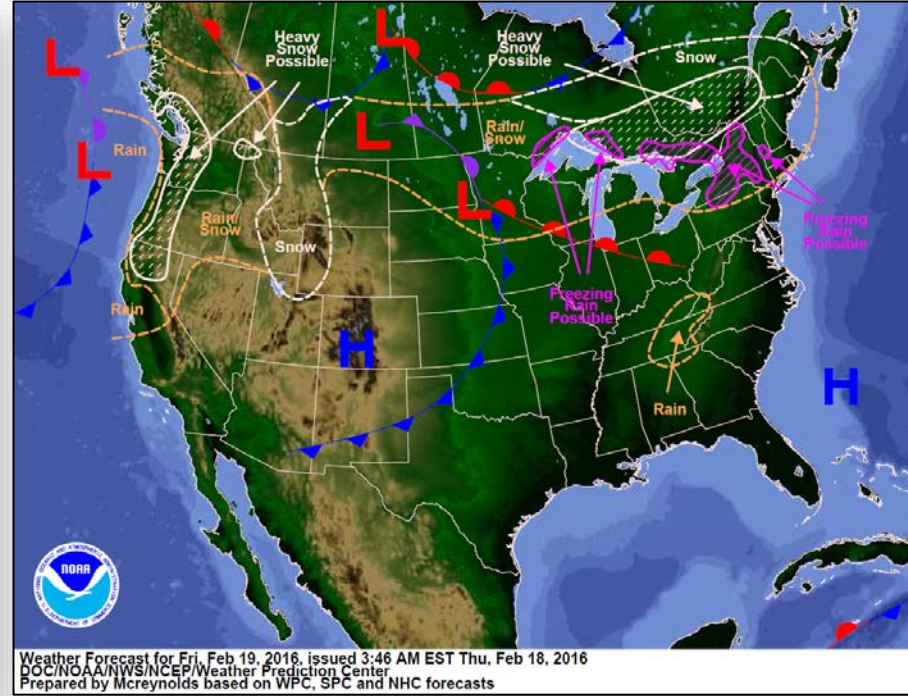
Tropical Cyclone 11P – Winston (Advisory #21 as of 4:00 am EST)

- Located 200 miles S of Pago Pago, American Samoa
- Moving W at 6 mph; past the closest point of approach to Pago Pago
- Maximum sustained winds 109 mph (CAT 2)
- Forecast to strengthen slightly
- High Wind, High Surf, and Gale Warnings in effect for American Samoa
- American Samoa EOC is at Partial Activation
- FEMA Region IX is Monitoring

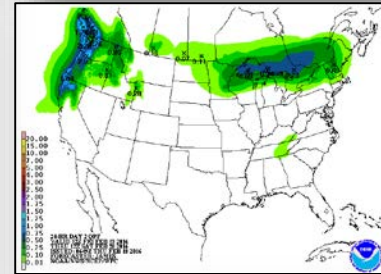
Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



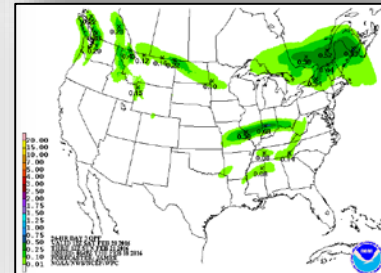

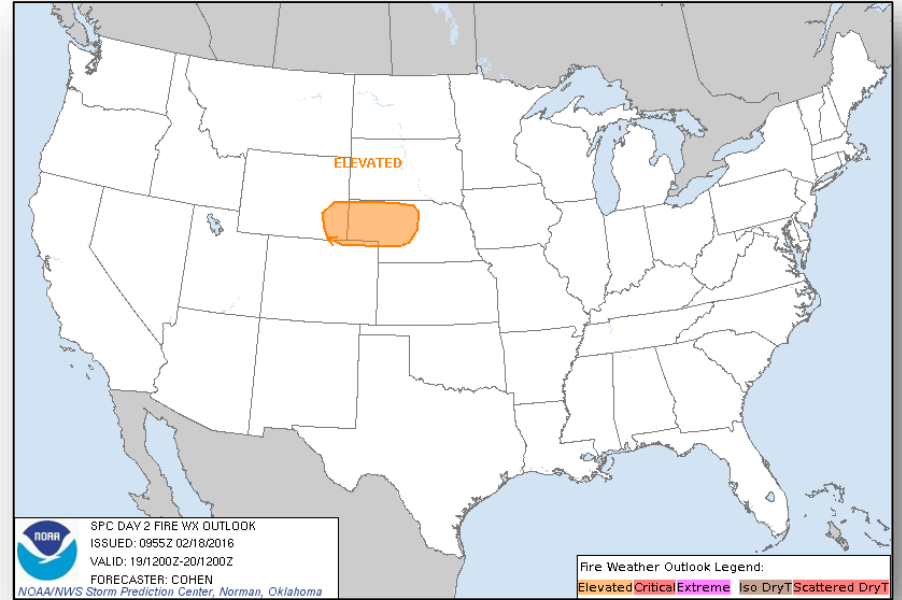
Max Wind Gust/Min Relative Humidity



Fire Weather Outlook

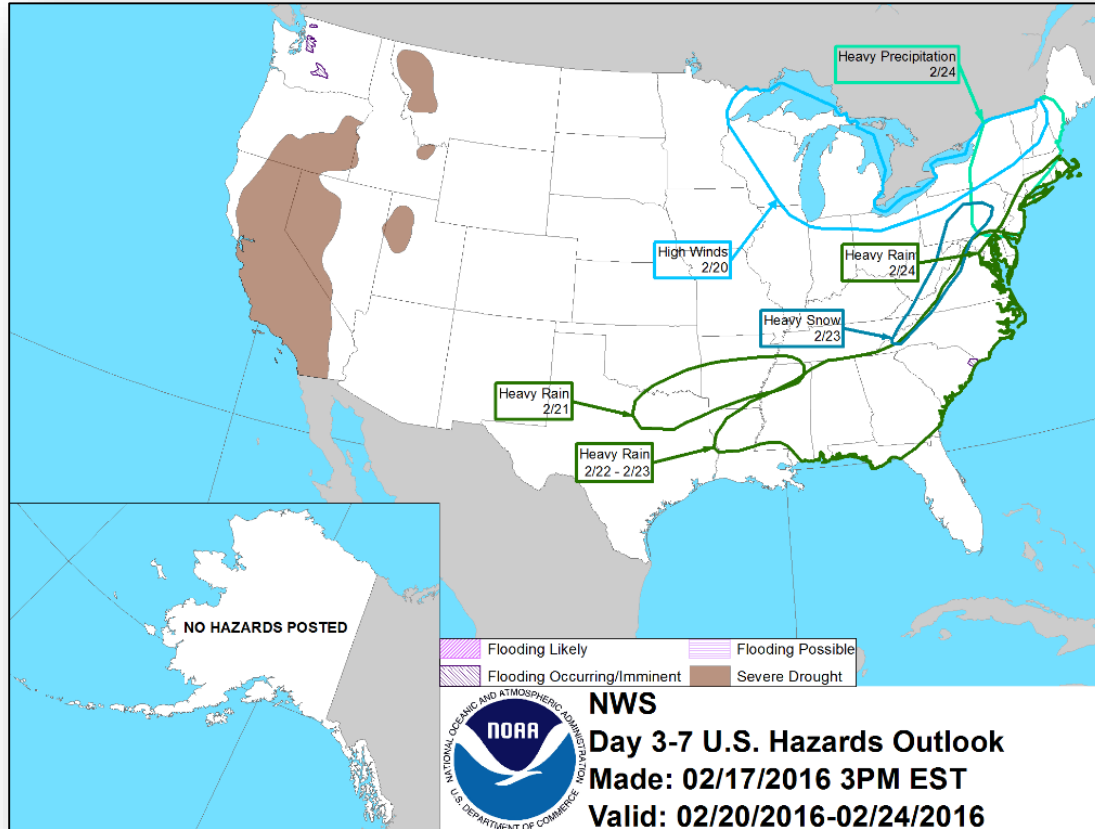

- FCO is Sharon Loper

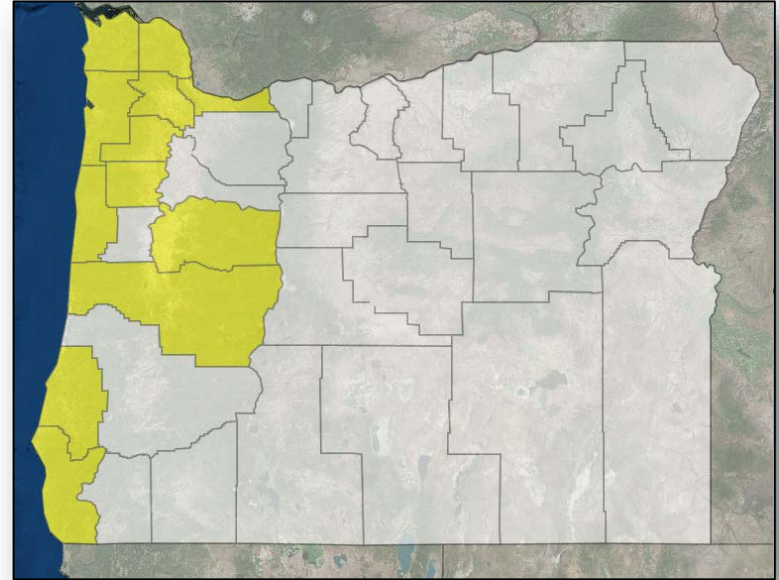


Major Disaster Declaration Approved – Oregon

- FCO is Dolph A. Diemont



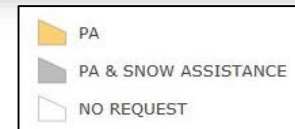
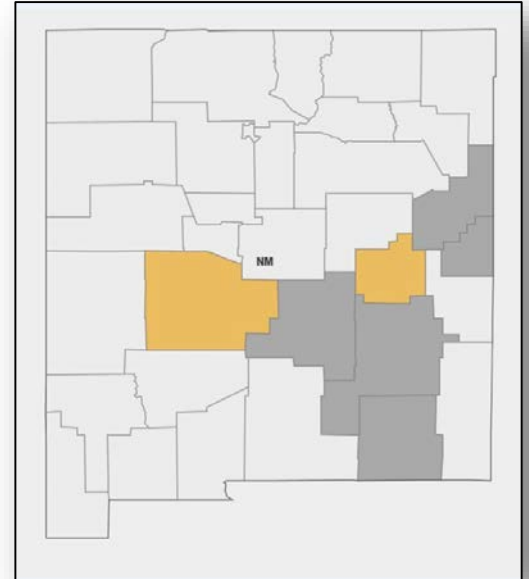

 - Hazard Mitigation statewide

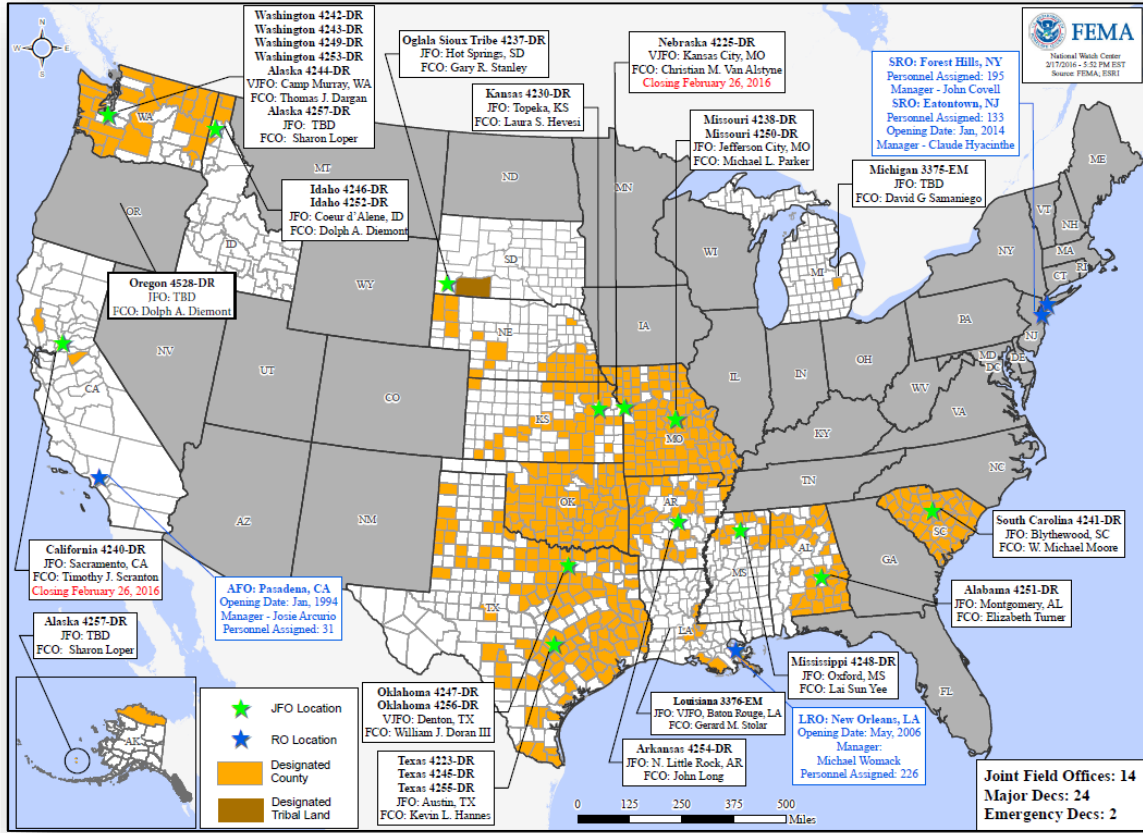

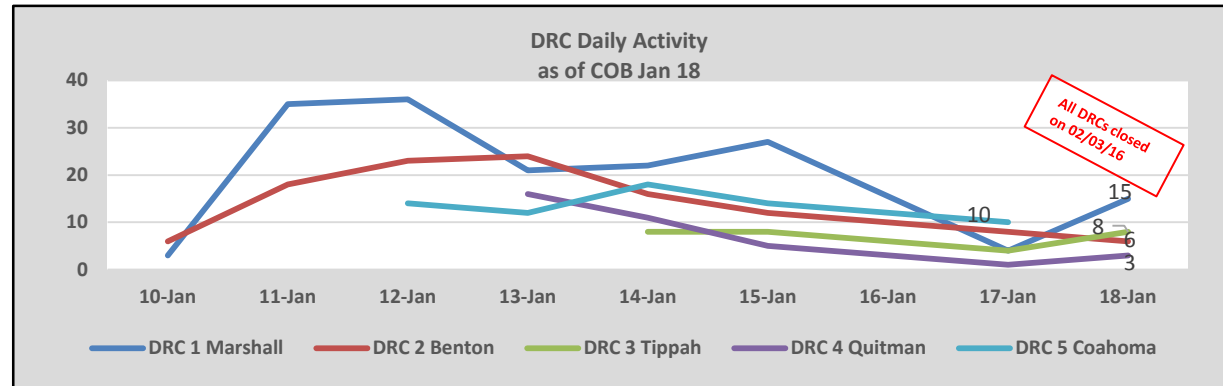

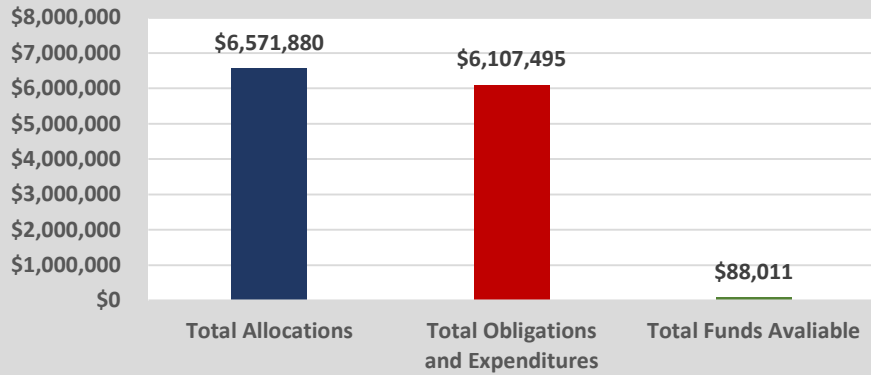

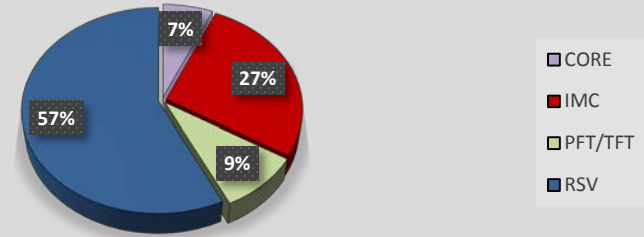

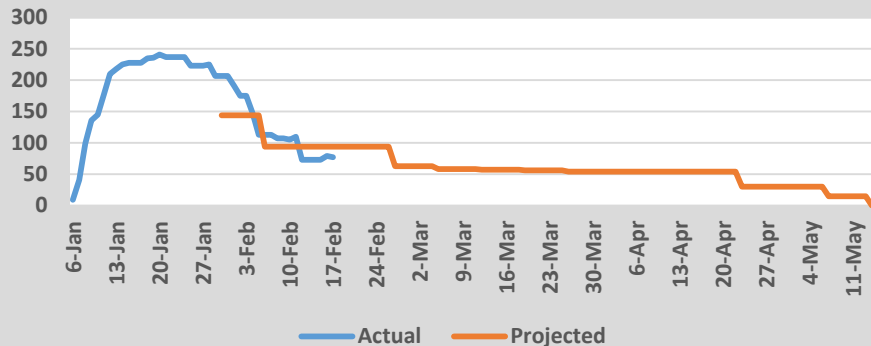
FINANCE & STAFFING (as of 02/17/2016)



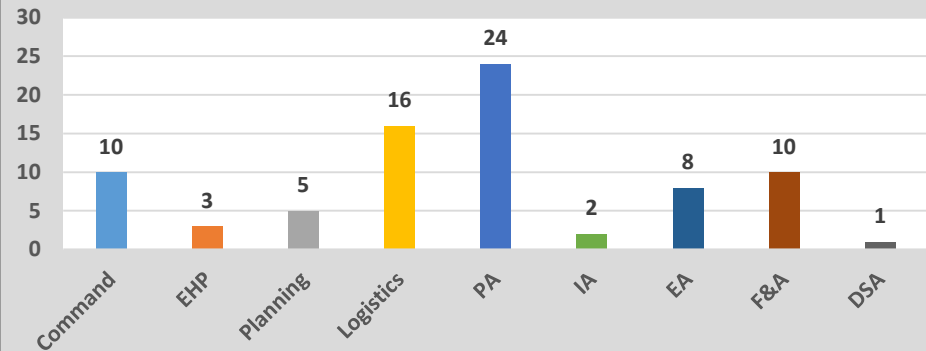
Staffing By Type as of Feb 17

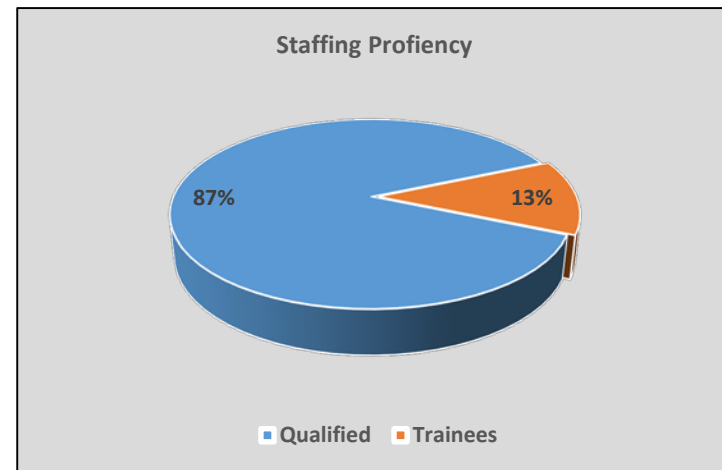
