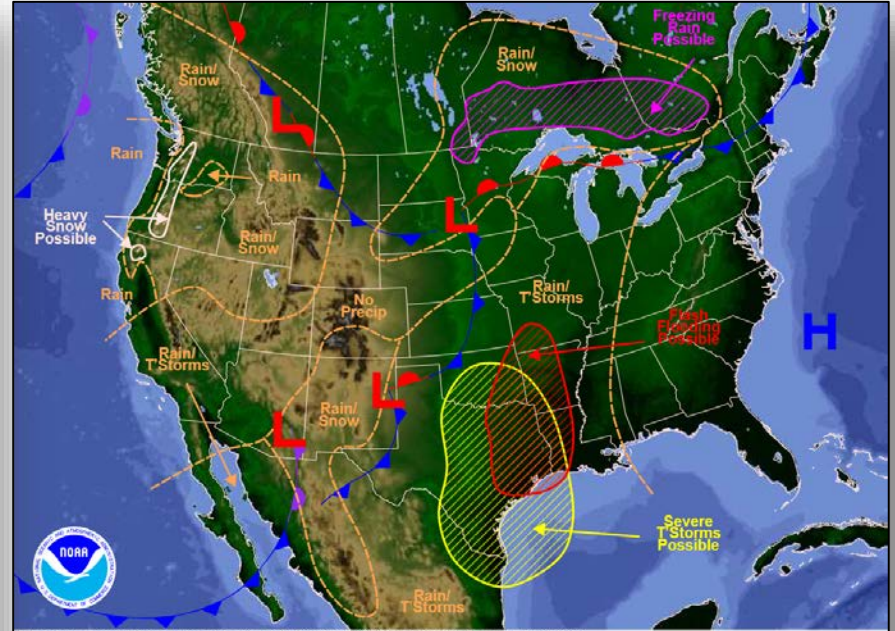

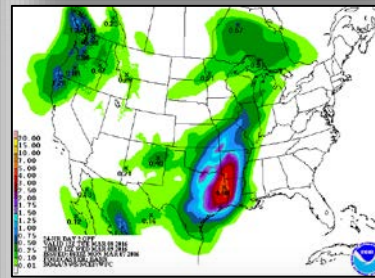
Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



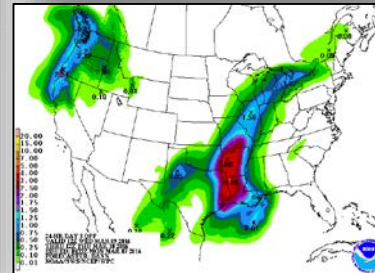

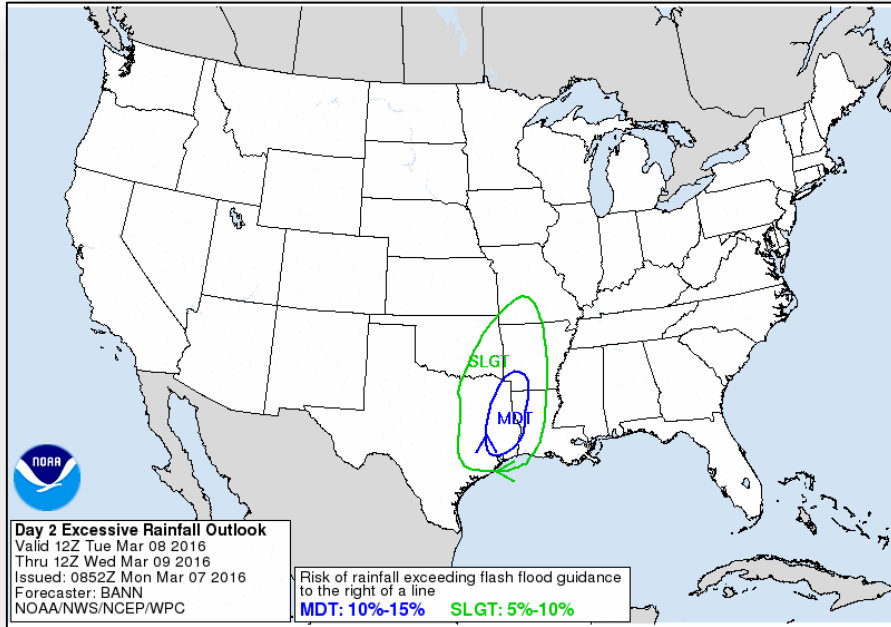

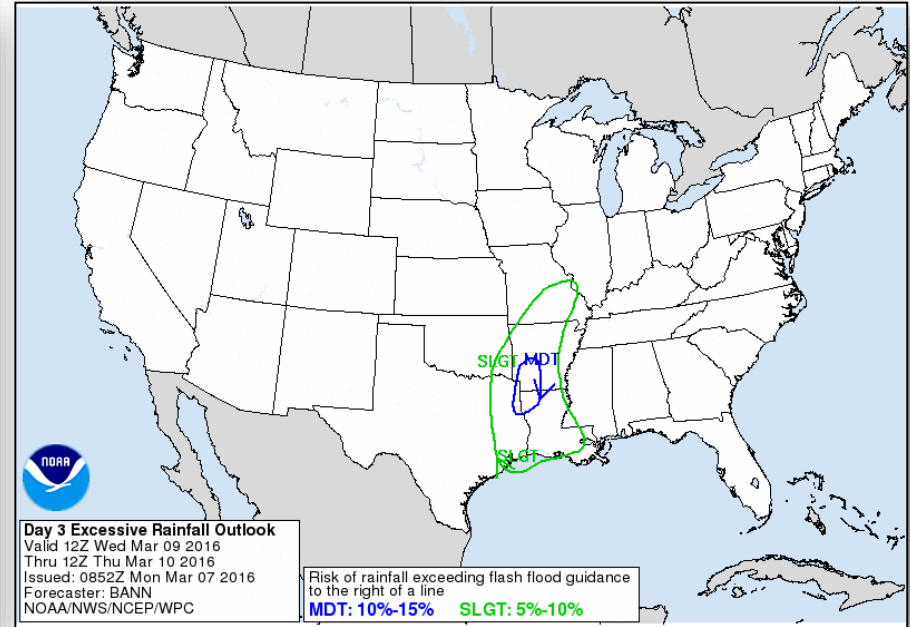

Flash Flood Potential

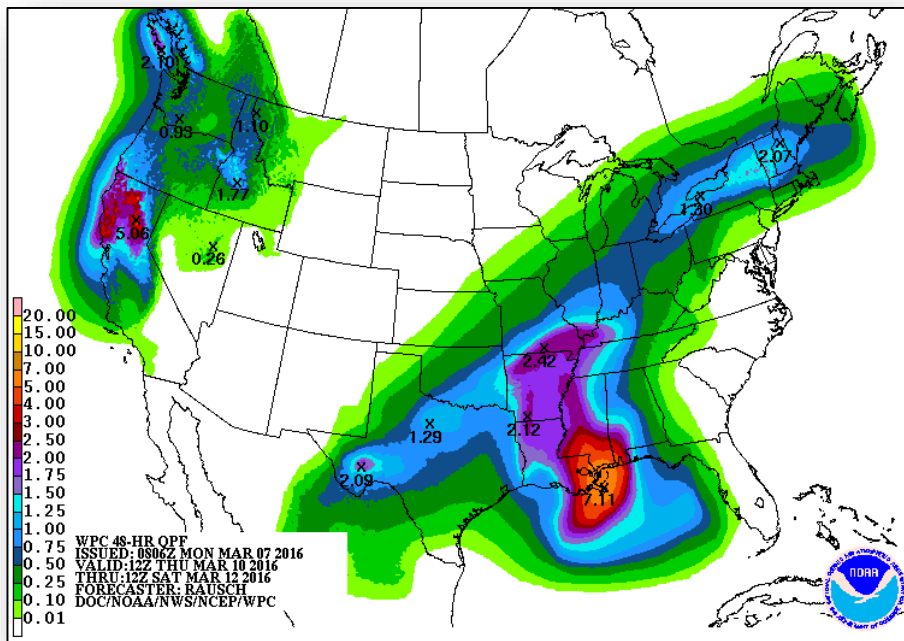

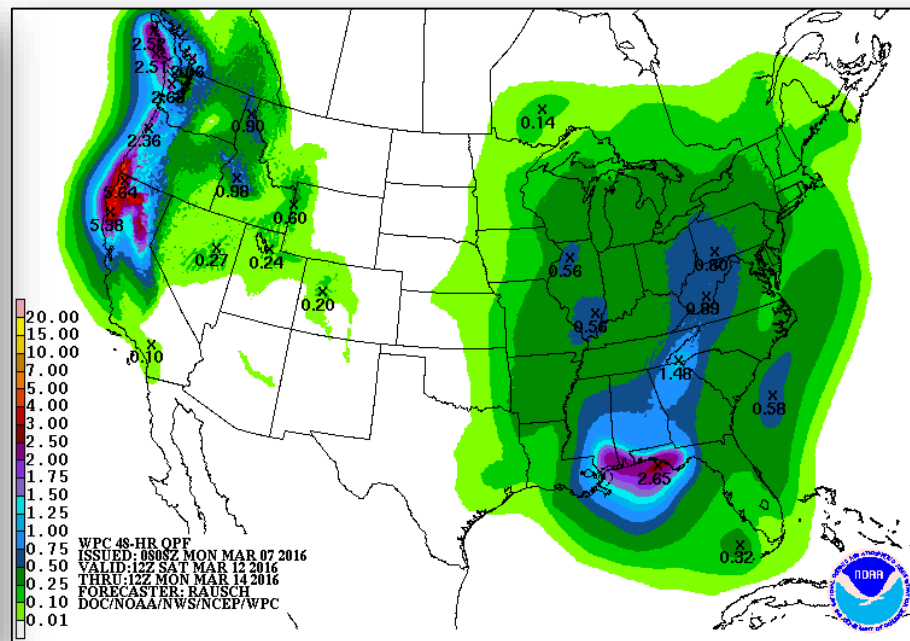


Day 3 (Wednesday)

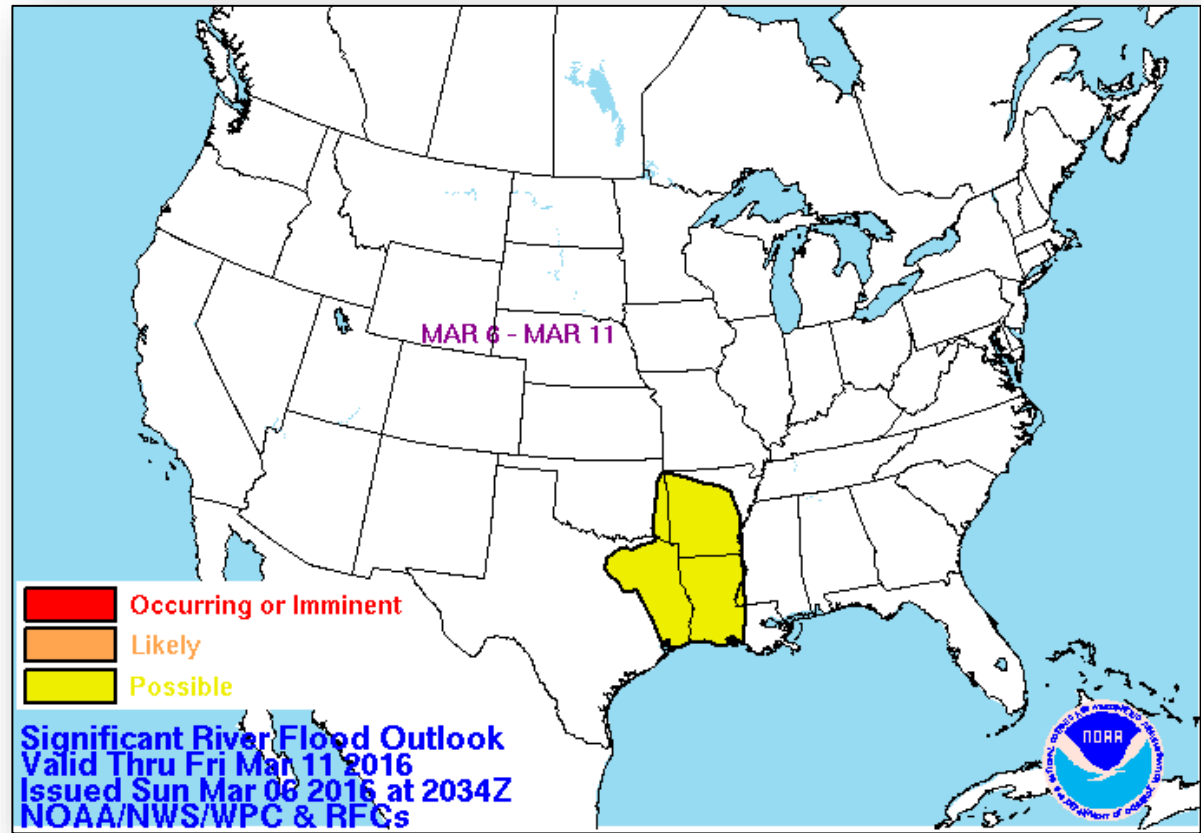

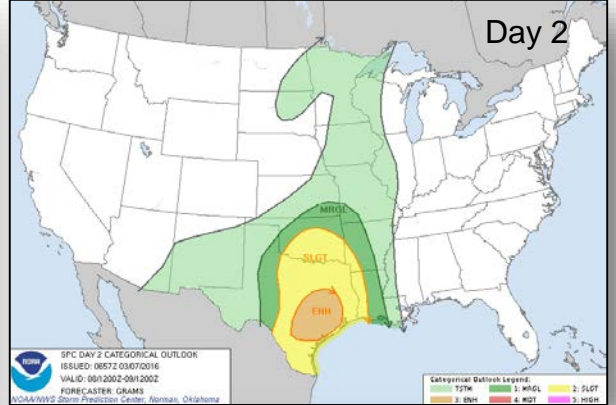
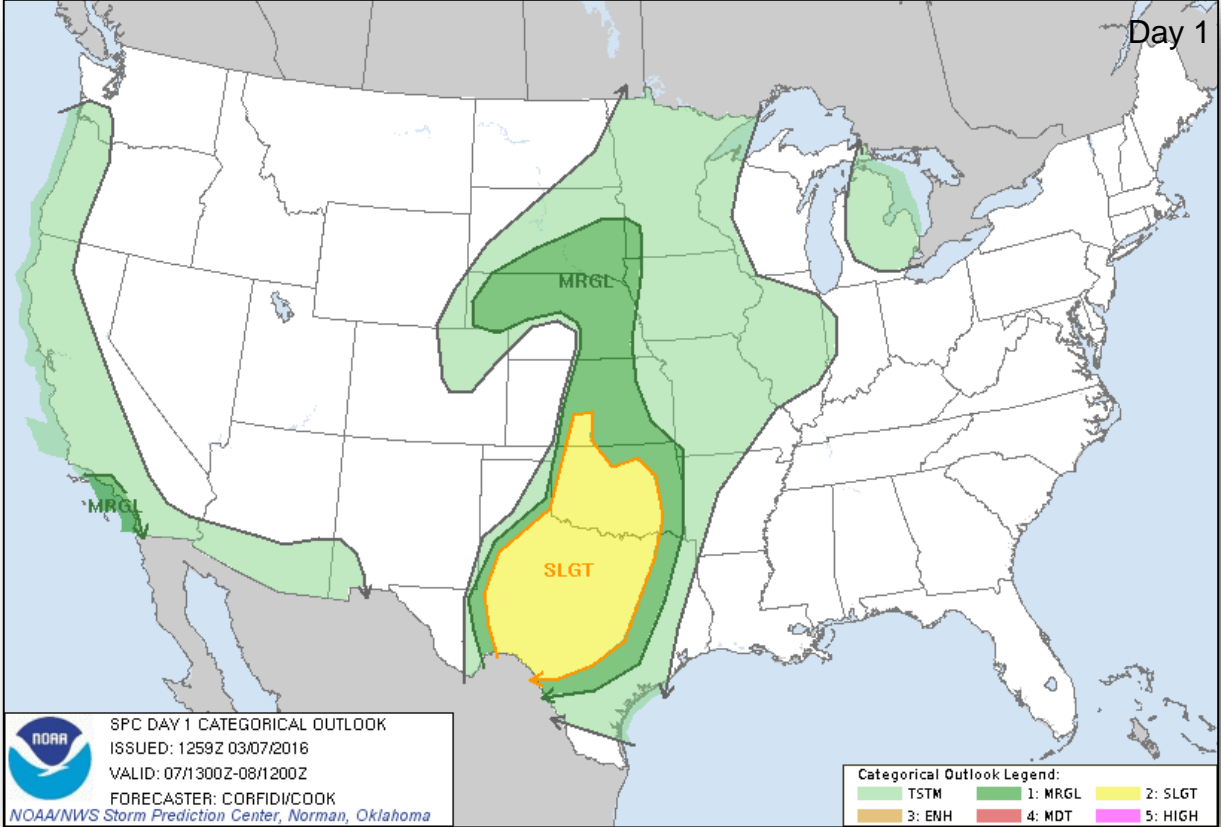
Significant River Flood Outlook



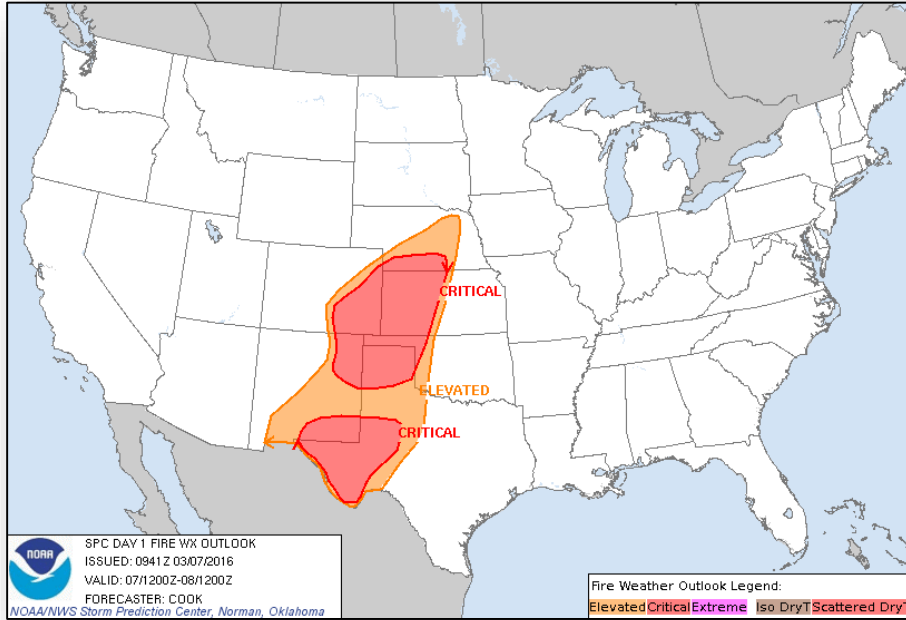

Temperature Probability

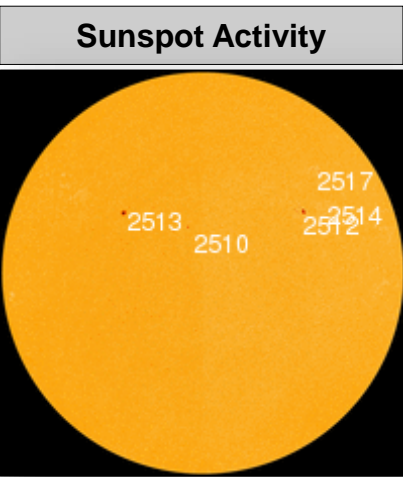
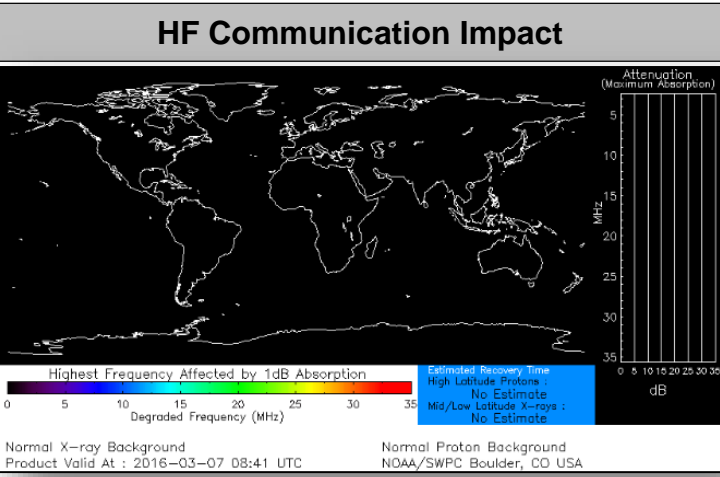

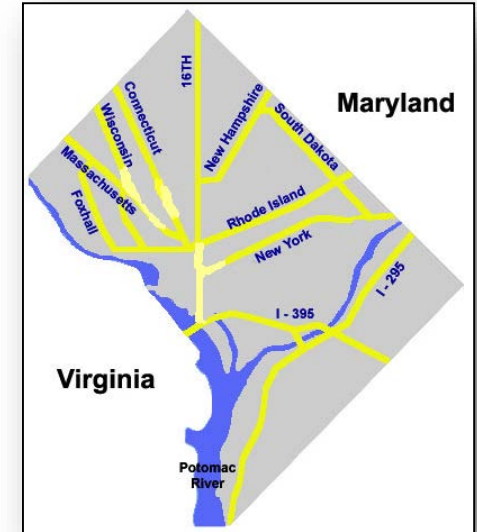

 - Emergency Protective measures (Category B), including snow assistance, under the Public Assistance program
 - Hazard Mitigation for the District of Columbia

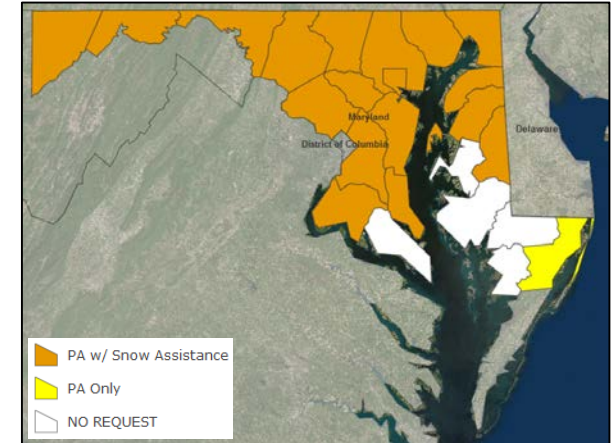

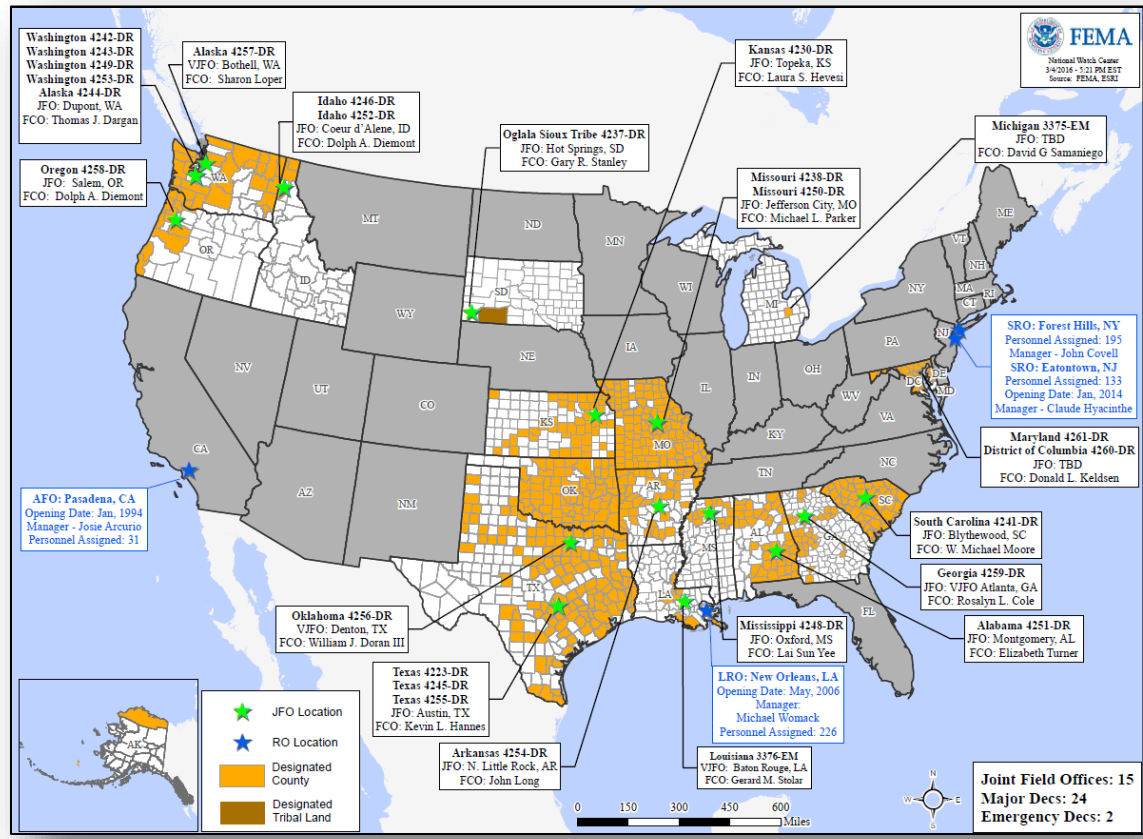


FEMA-4261-DR-MD

 - Public Assistance only for 1 county
 - Hazard Mitigation statewide
