
- A line of severe thunderstorms moved across northern TX overnight, causing locally significant damage
- Large hail, strong winds & heavy rain reported in TX, LA, AR & OK
- Damaging winds & a few tornadoes possible today/tonight from east TX into far southwest MS

State/Local Impacts

- Preliminary reports of three EF-1 tornadoes in north Texas
- Several homes and businesses damaged near Dallas, TX
- One unconfirmed fatality and three injuries reported in TX
- Water rescues near Denton, TX including 6 children trapped in school bus
- 30 homes (approx. 50 people) evacuated in Haughton, LA due to flooding (Bossier Sherriff and Haughton PD assisting)
- Power outages: Region VI-29k; TX-20k, down from peak of 52k (Eagle I)
- Shelters open in TX (1) and LA (1) with no occupants (ESF-6, March 8)




Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day






Flash Flood Potential








Precipitation Forecast, 4-7 Day




