

# Earthquake Activity – Kyushu, Japan (Final) FEMA



#### M7.0 - Kyushu, Japan

- Occurred at 12:25 pm EDT (1:25 am local time in Japan) on April 15, 2016
- Less than 1 mile west-southwest of Kumamoto-shi at a depth of 6 miles
  - M6.2 struck same area on April 14, 2016 resulting in 9 deaths
- No Tsunami threat
- USGS issued a PAGER alert:
  - Red Alert for economic losses, indicating extensive damage is probable
  - Yellow Alert for shaking-related fatalities, indicating some casualties possible
  - Level VIII on Modified Mercalli Scale (890k exposed to severe shaking)


# Convective Outlook Days 1-3








# Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day






