- Central Pacific: No tropical cyclones expected through Sunday night

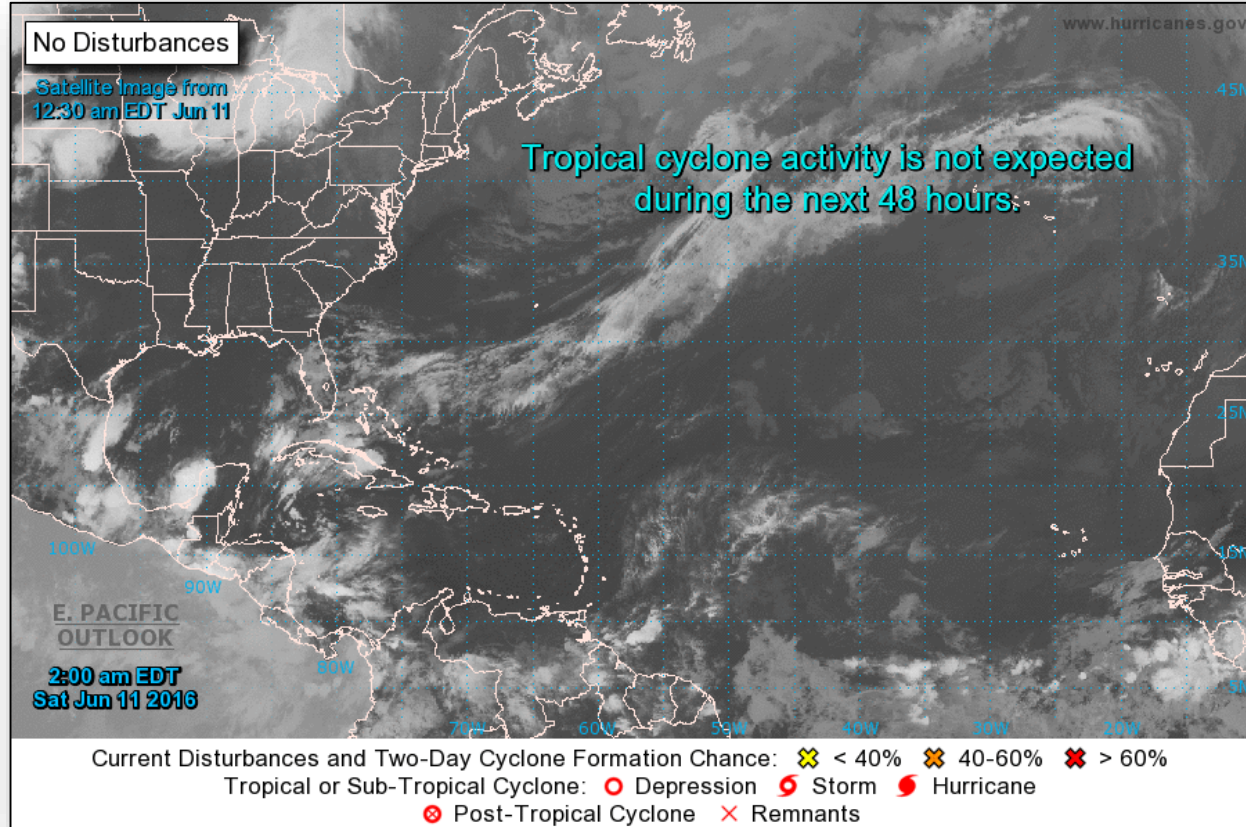

- Space weather – no space weather storms observed in the past 24 hours; space weather next 24 hours predicted to be minor with G1 level geomagnetic storm likely

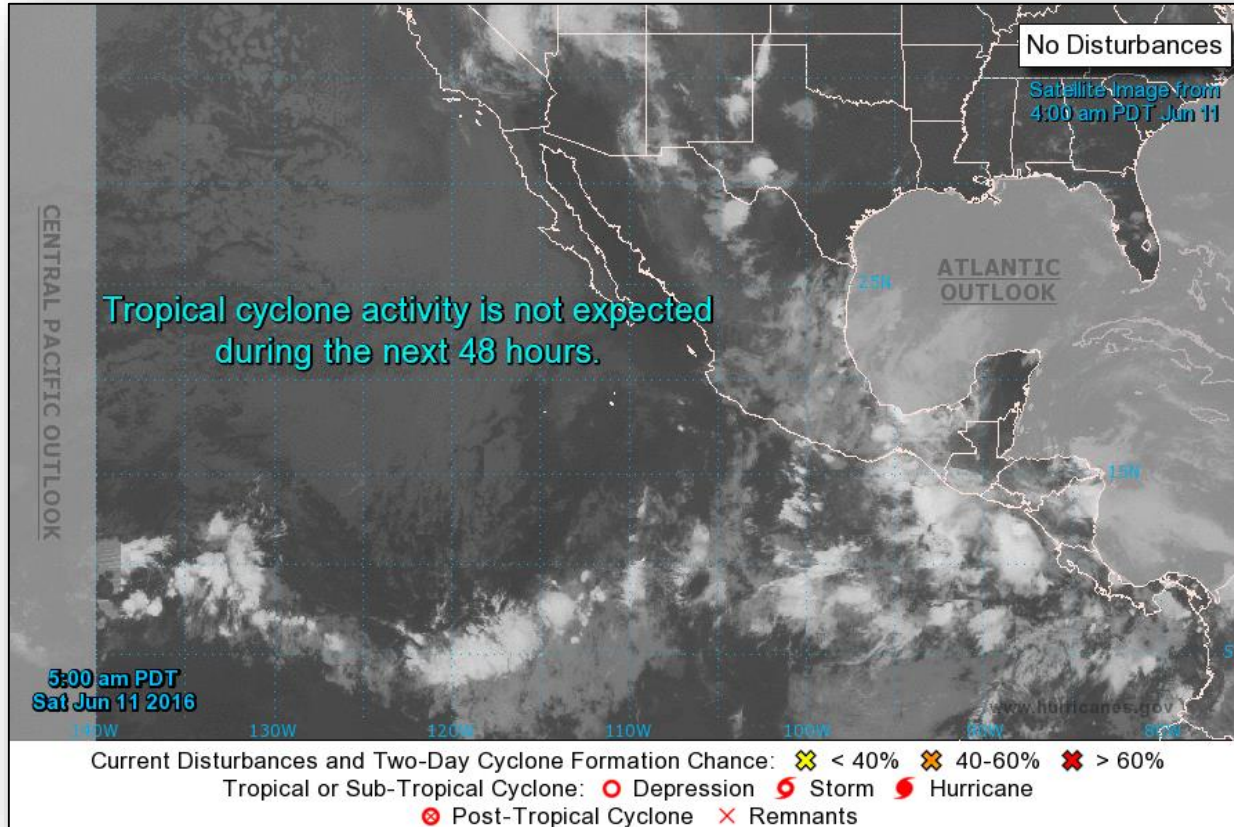

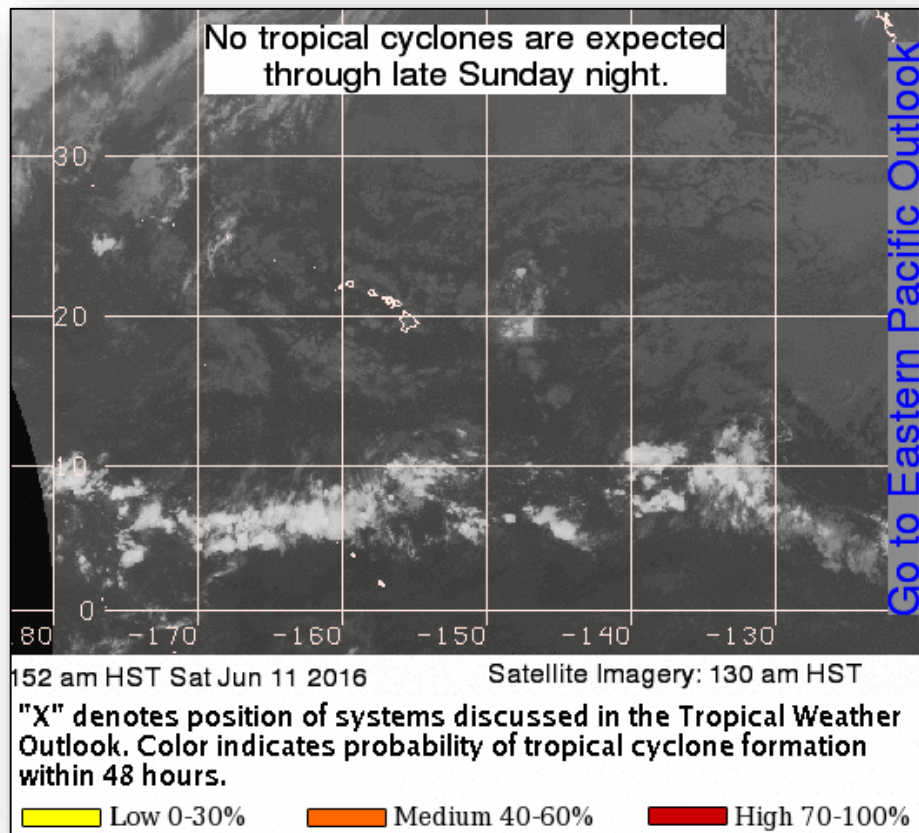
Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



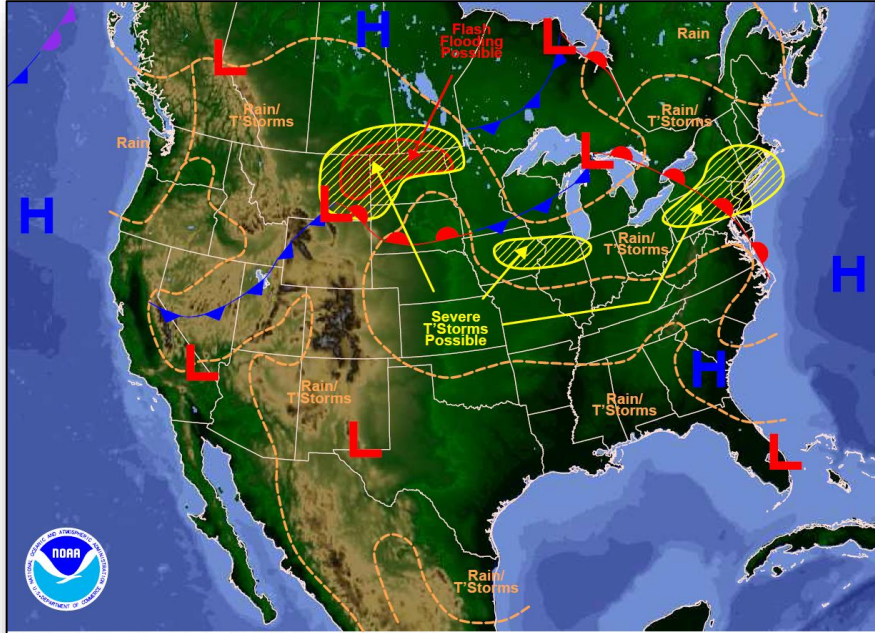
Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific

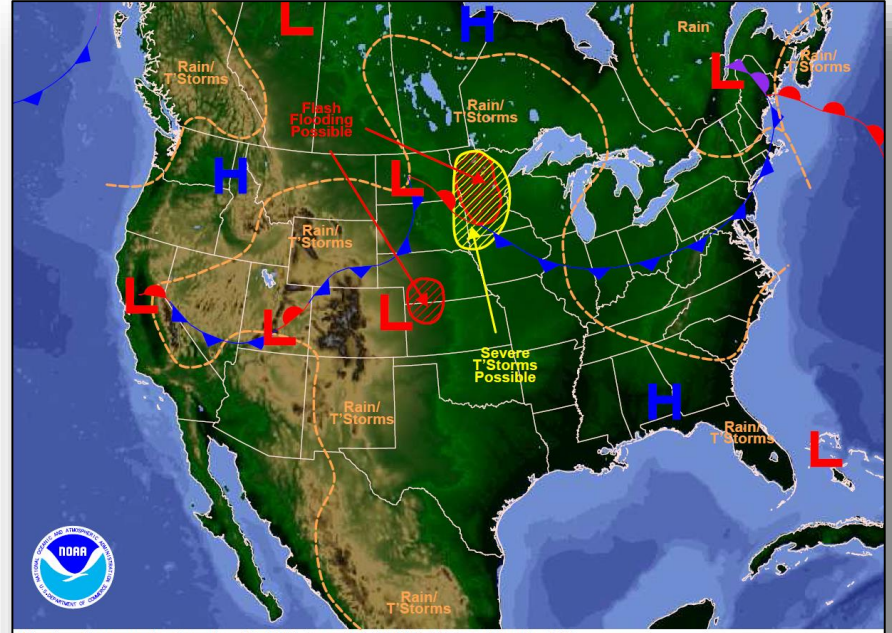

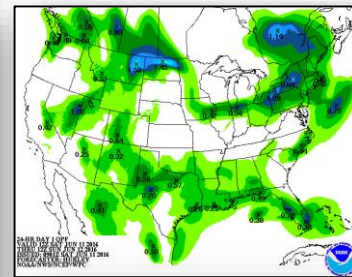
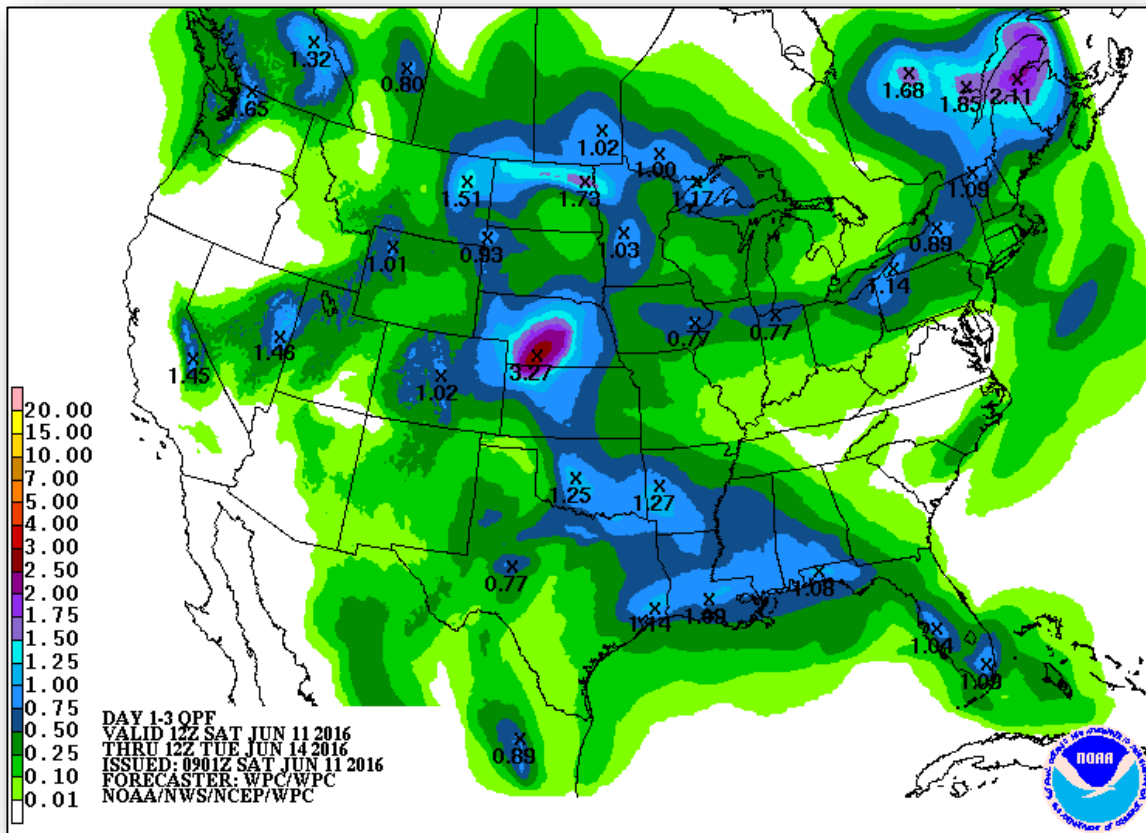
Severe Weather Outlook: Days 1-3



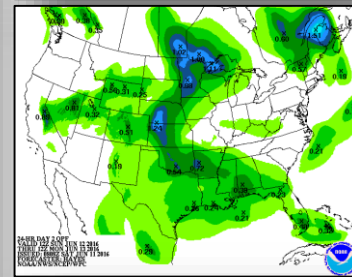
Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



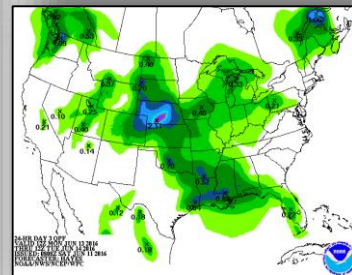
