- Central Pacific: No tropical cyclones expected through late Sunday night

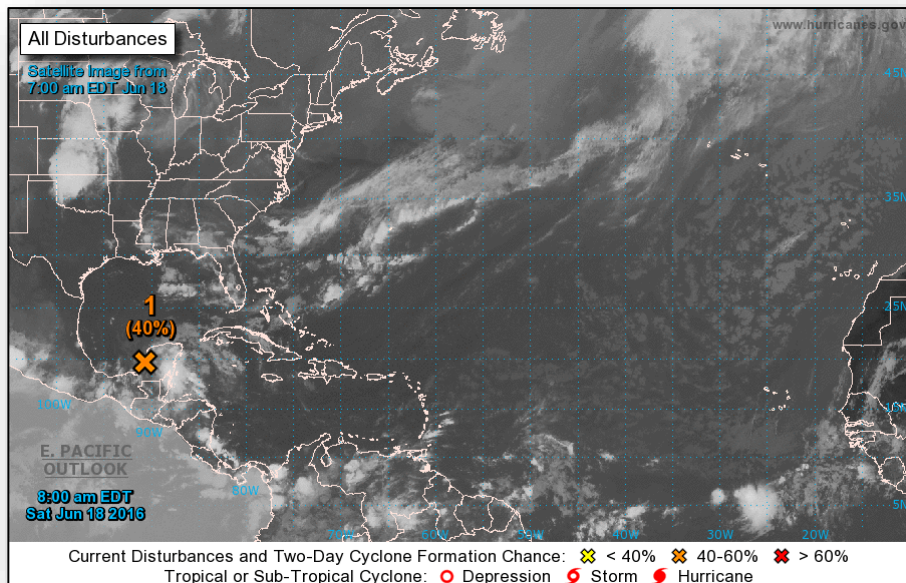
## **Significant Weather:**

- Severe thunderstorms and flash flooding – Northern Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley

- Excessive heat – southern CA to Southwest, UT, Southern Plains, Northern Plains to Upper Mississippi Valley
- Elevated Fire Weather Areas – NV & UT
- Red Flag Warnings – AK
- Space weather – No space weather storms observed past 24 hours; no space weather storms predicted next 24 hours

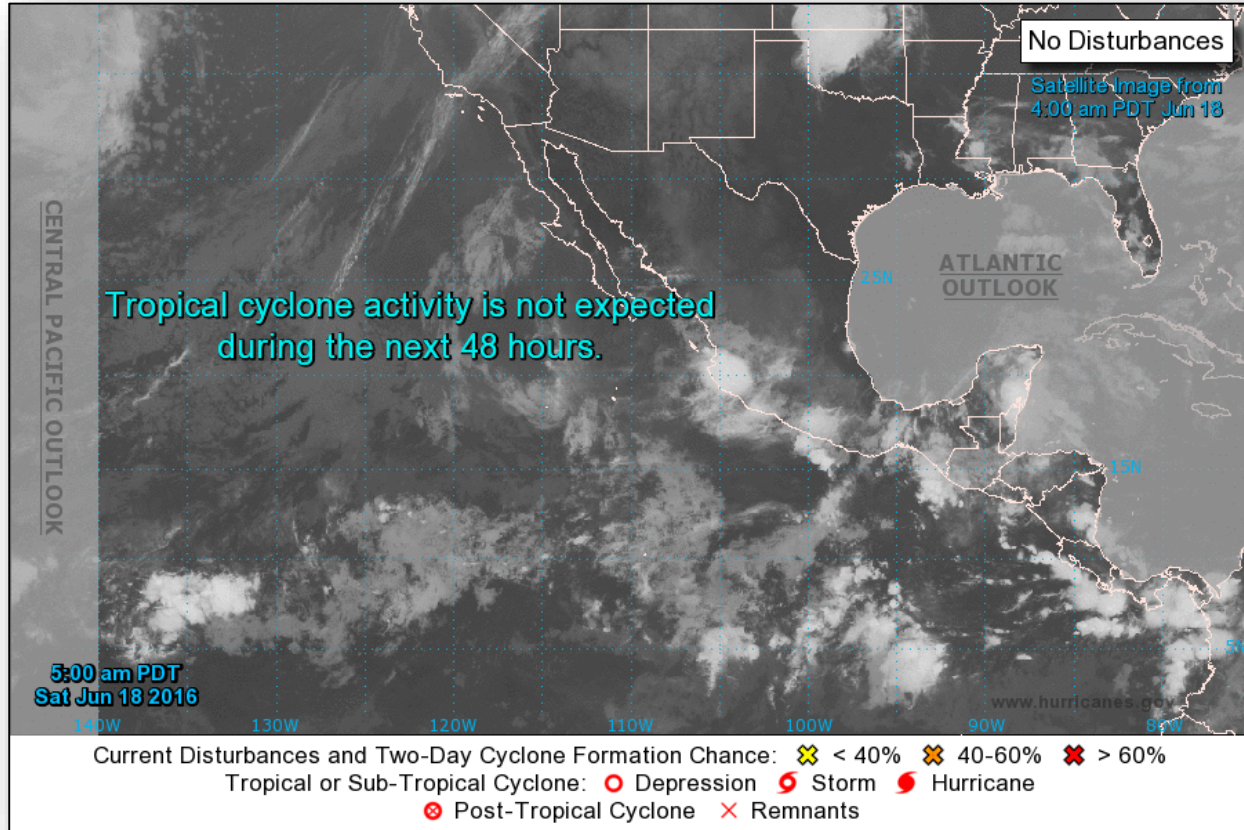
## Disturbance 1: (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Formation chance through 5 days: MEDIUM (40%)

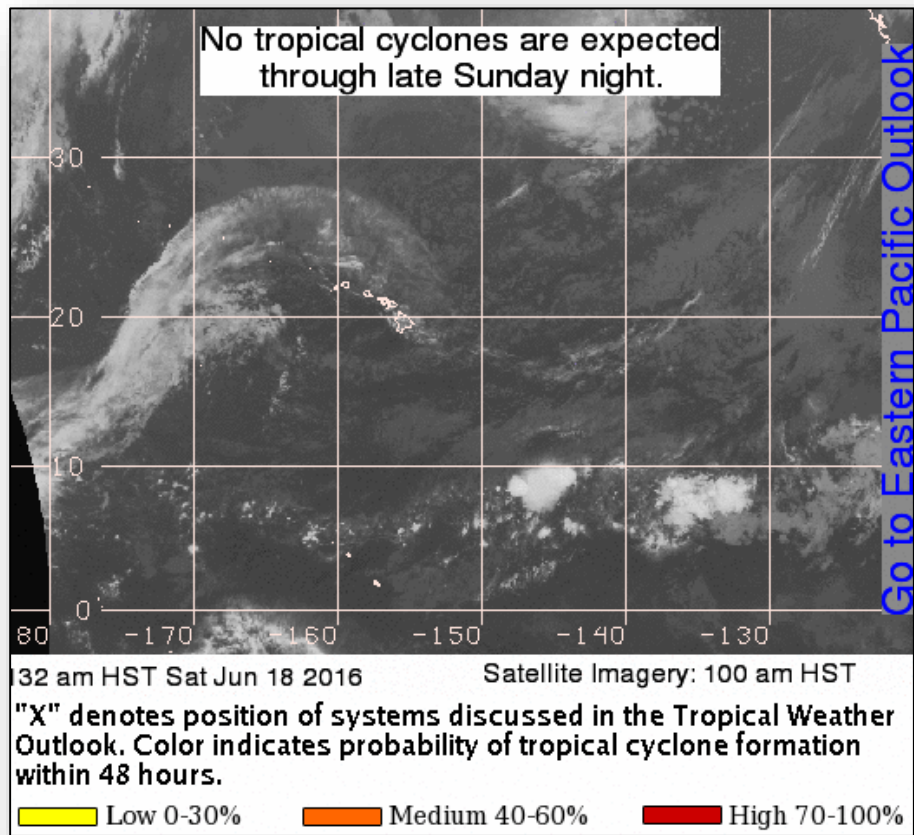

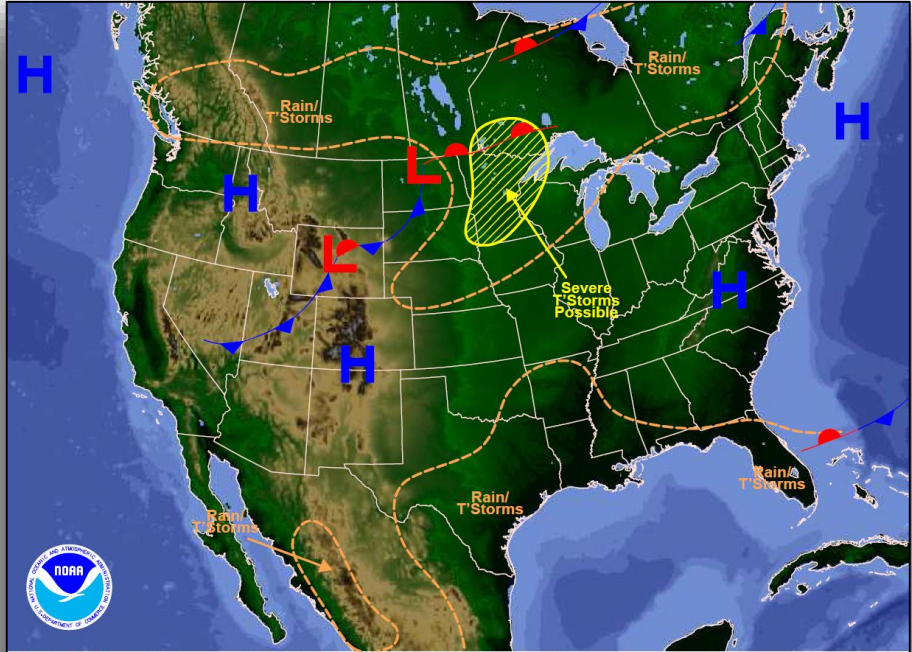

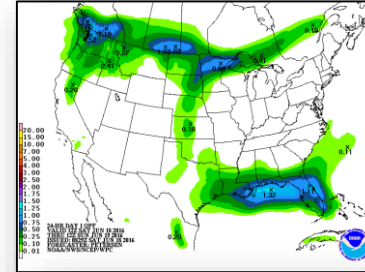
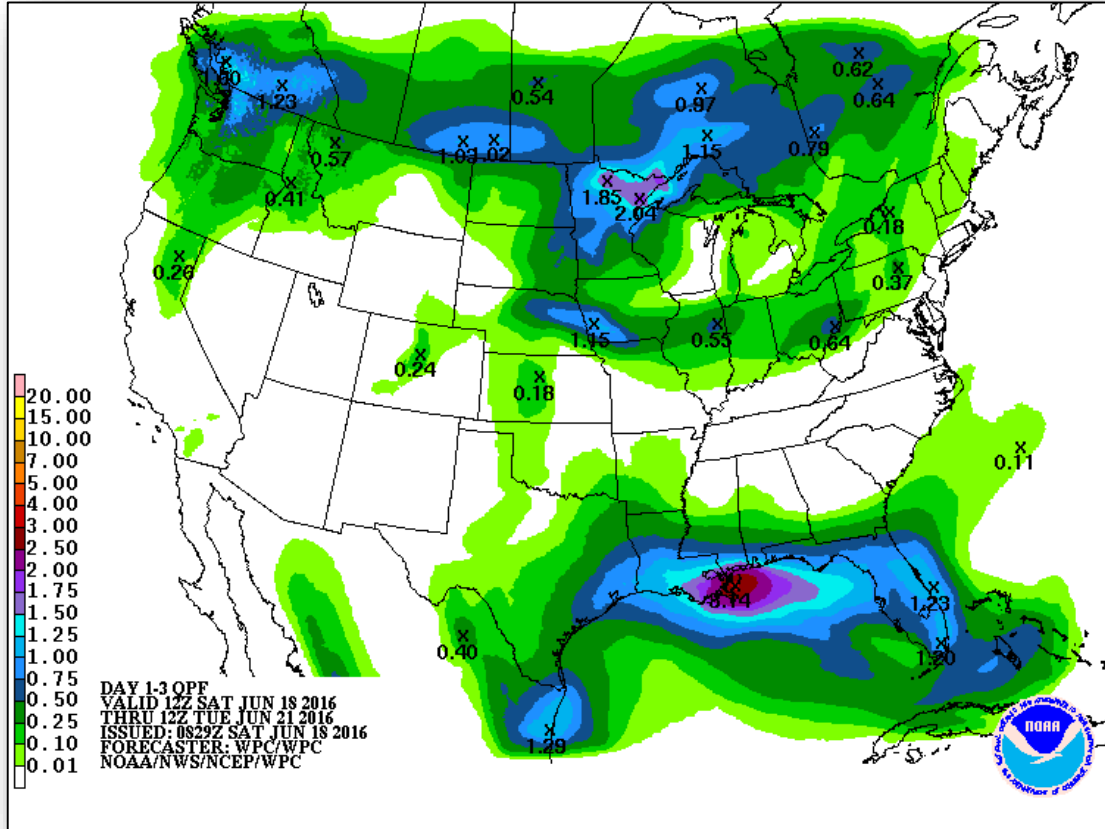




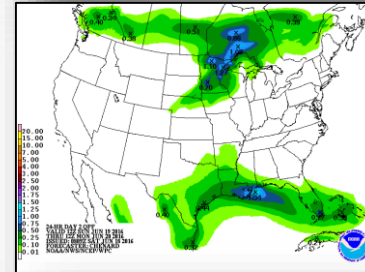
# Precipitation Forecast, 1-3 Day



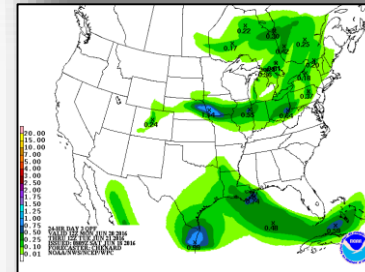
