- Atlantic –Disturbance 1 (Low 10%); Disturbance 2 (Low 10%)
- Eastern Pacific – Tropical Storm Ivette; Tropical Depression Eleven-E
- Central Pacific – No tropical cyclones are expected through early Tuesday morning
- Western Pacific – No activity threatening U.S. territories

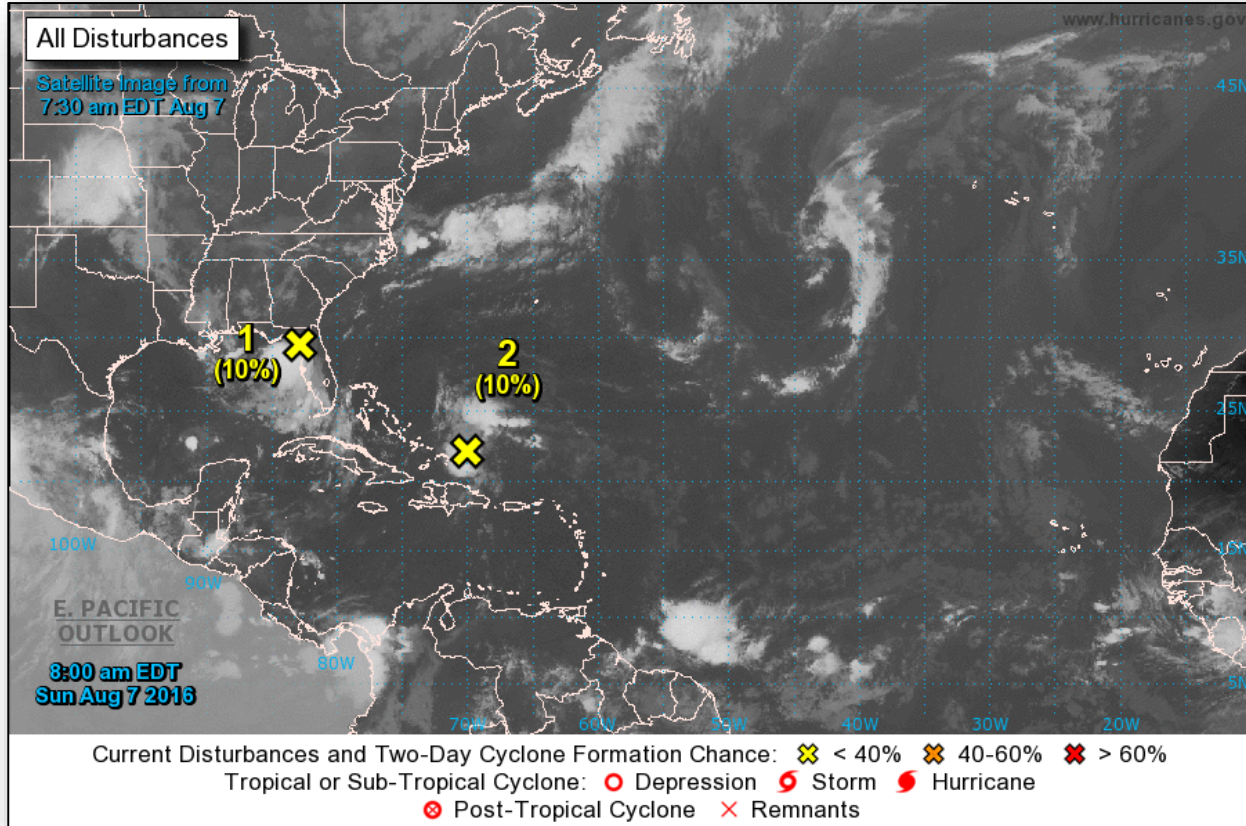
**Significant Weather:**

- Severe Weather – Northern Plains
- Flash Flooding – Central/Southern Plains; FL, Southern Appalachians & NC
- Rain and Thunderstorms – Northern Intermountain, Rockies, Great Plains, Middle & Lower Mississippi valleys to Mid-Atlantic
- Rain – Northwest and Northeast
- Critical/Elevated Fire Weather areas – OR, WA, ID, NV, UT, WY & MT
- Isolated Dry Thunderstorms – OR, WA, ID, NV, UT, WY & MT
- Red Flag Warnings – OR, WA, ID & UT
- Space Weather – Past 24 hours, no storms observed; next 24 hours, Minor geomagnetic storms at G1

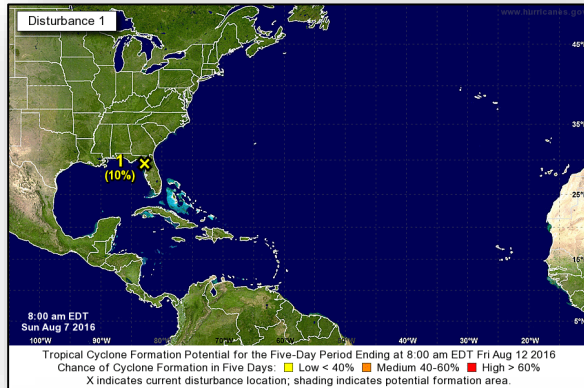

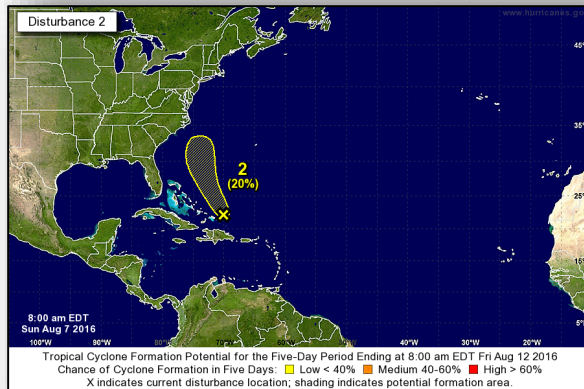

## Disturbance 1 (As of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

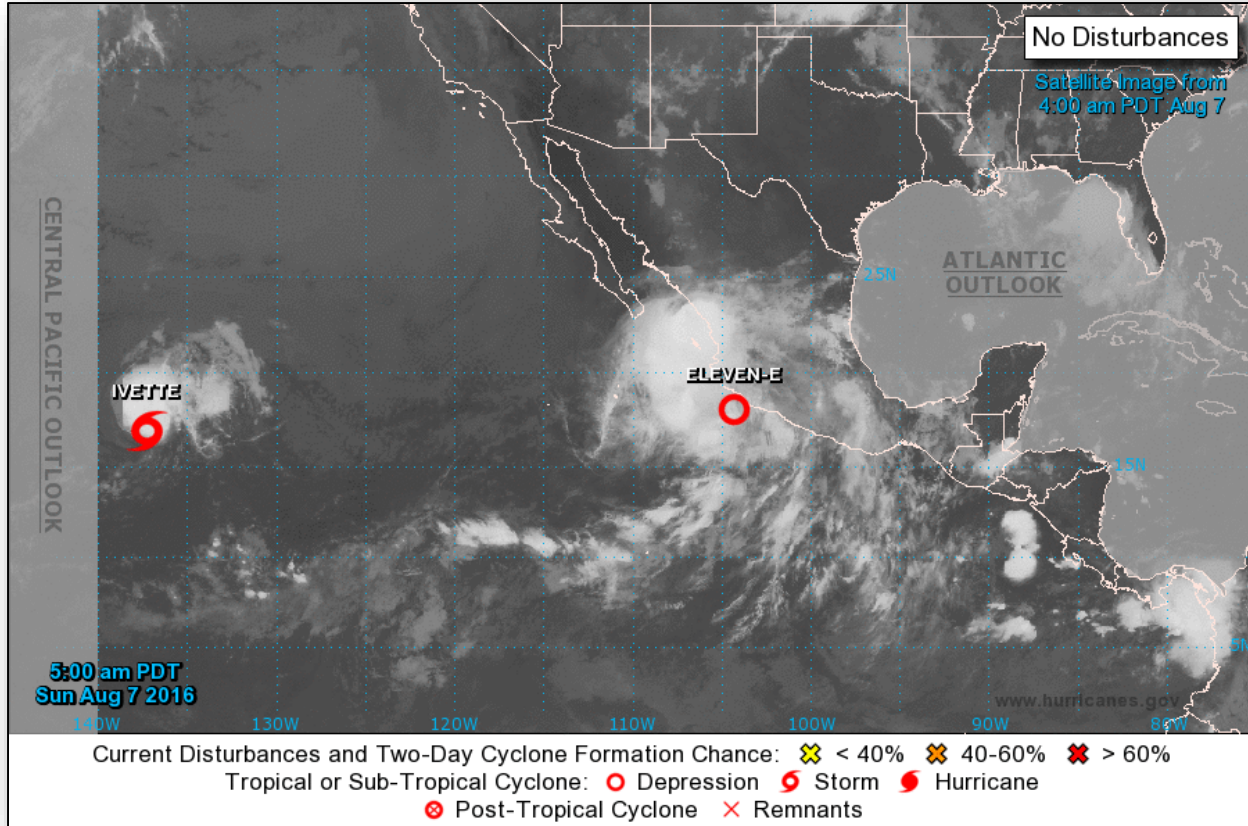
- Weak area of low pressure located near Cross City, FL
- Drifting NE to N, moving further inland today
- Heavy rainfall expected for portions of northern and central Florida peninsula and much of the Florida panhandle
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)



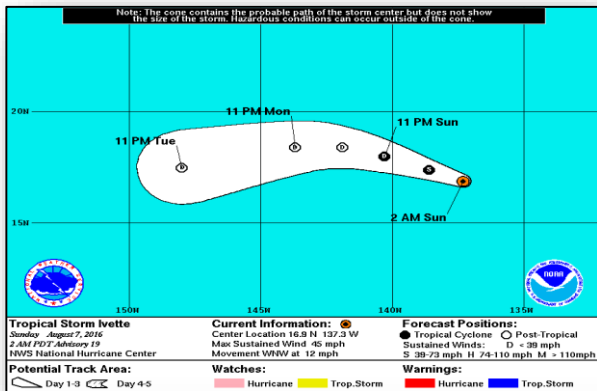
## Disturbance 2 (As of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Disorganized cloudiness and showers near southeastern Bahamas
- Slow development expected as it moves NWN; positioned between Florida and Bermuda by Tuesday
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

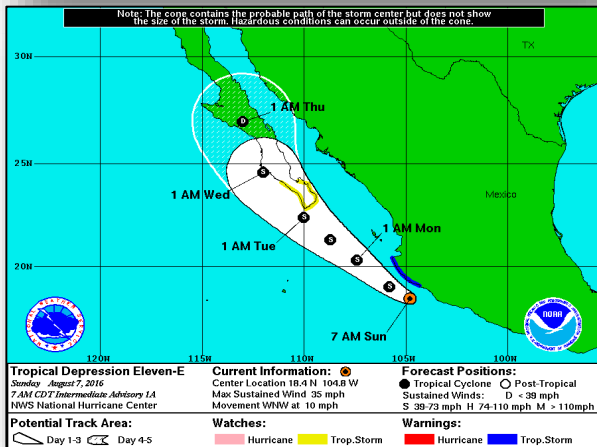


# Tropical Outlook - Eastern Pacific



## Tropical Storm Ivette (Advisory #19 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)

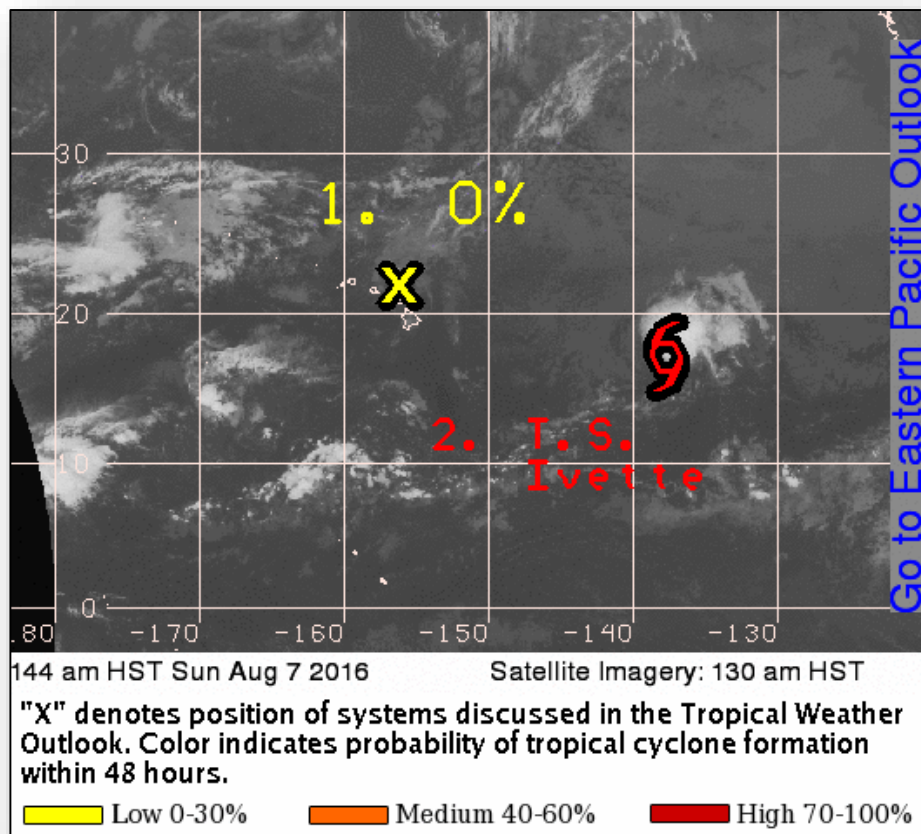
- Located 1,180 miles E of Hilo Hawaii
- Moving WNW at 12 mph; maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- General motion expected to continue through tonight
- Slow weakening forecast during the next 48 hours
- Expected to be a tropical depression tonight or Monday
- Tropical storm force winds extend 90 miles



## Tropical Depression Eleven-E (Advisory #1a as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located about 55 miles SSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 10 mph; maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- A turn NW expected later today through Monday
- Gradual strengthening expected next 48 hours; forecast to become a tropical storm later today or tonight

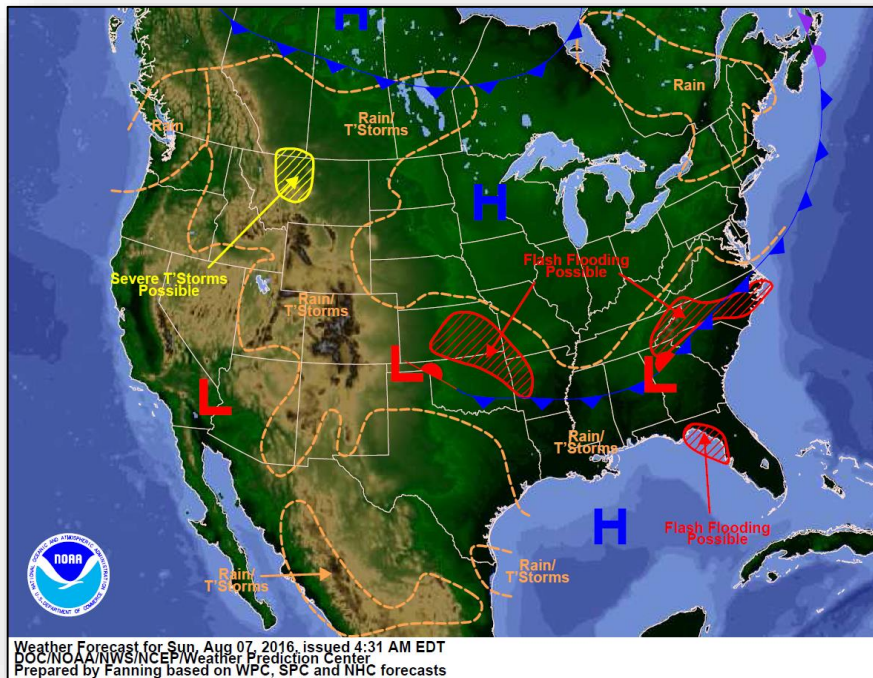

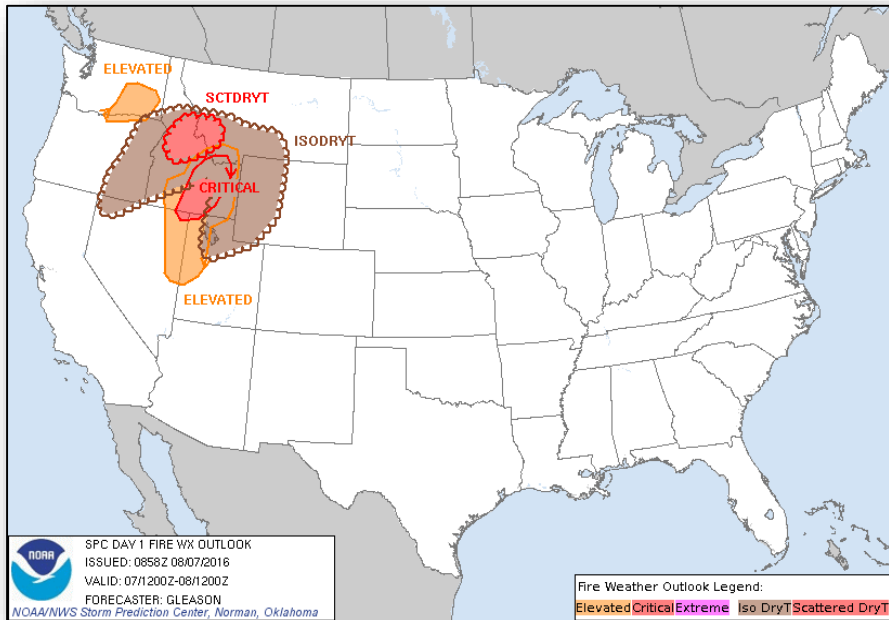
# Precipitation Forecast - Days 1-3



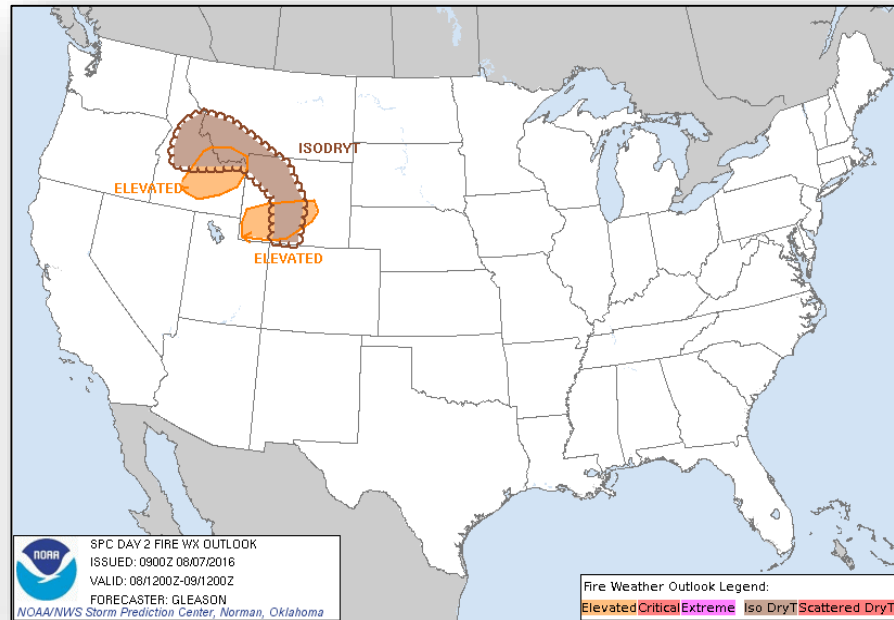

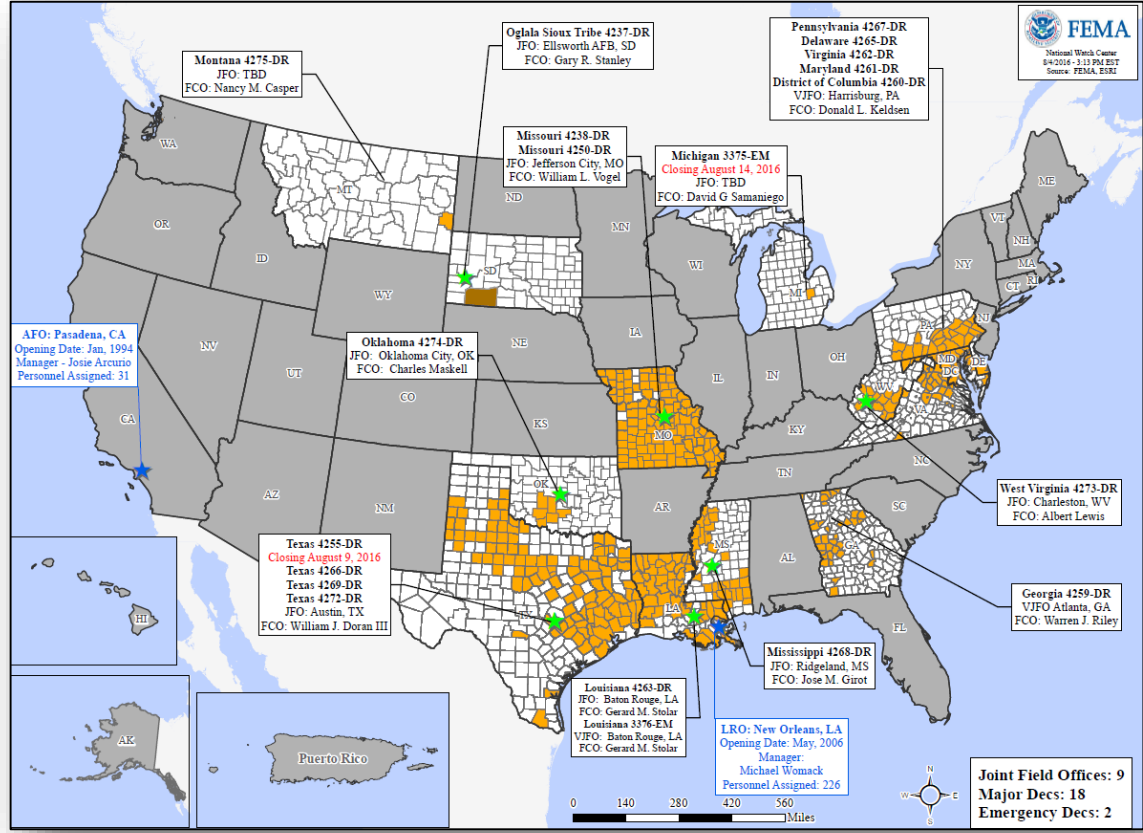
