- Western Pacific – No activity threatening U.S. territories

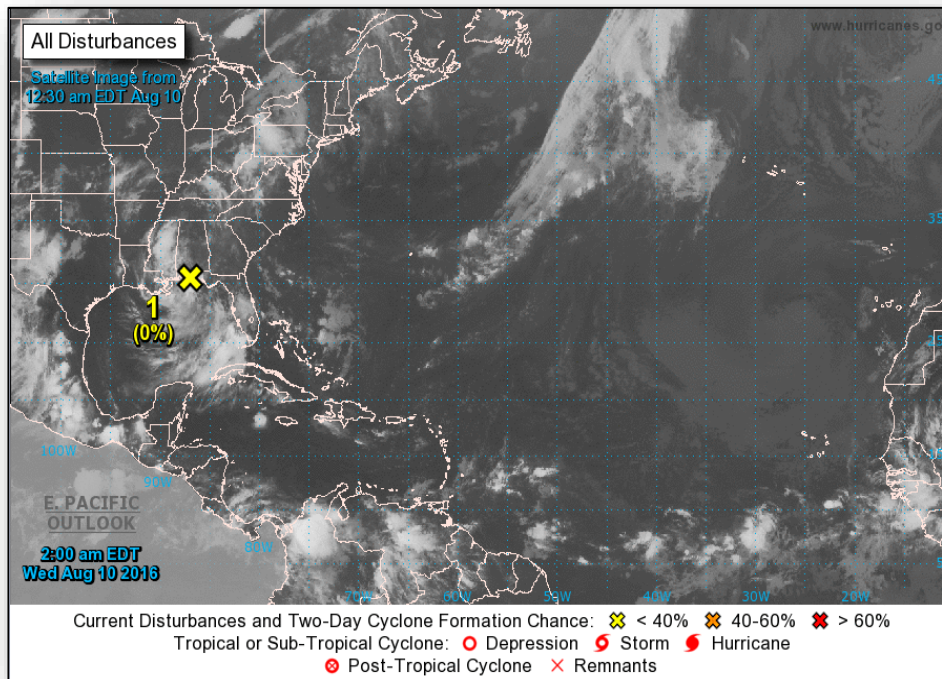
Significant Weather:

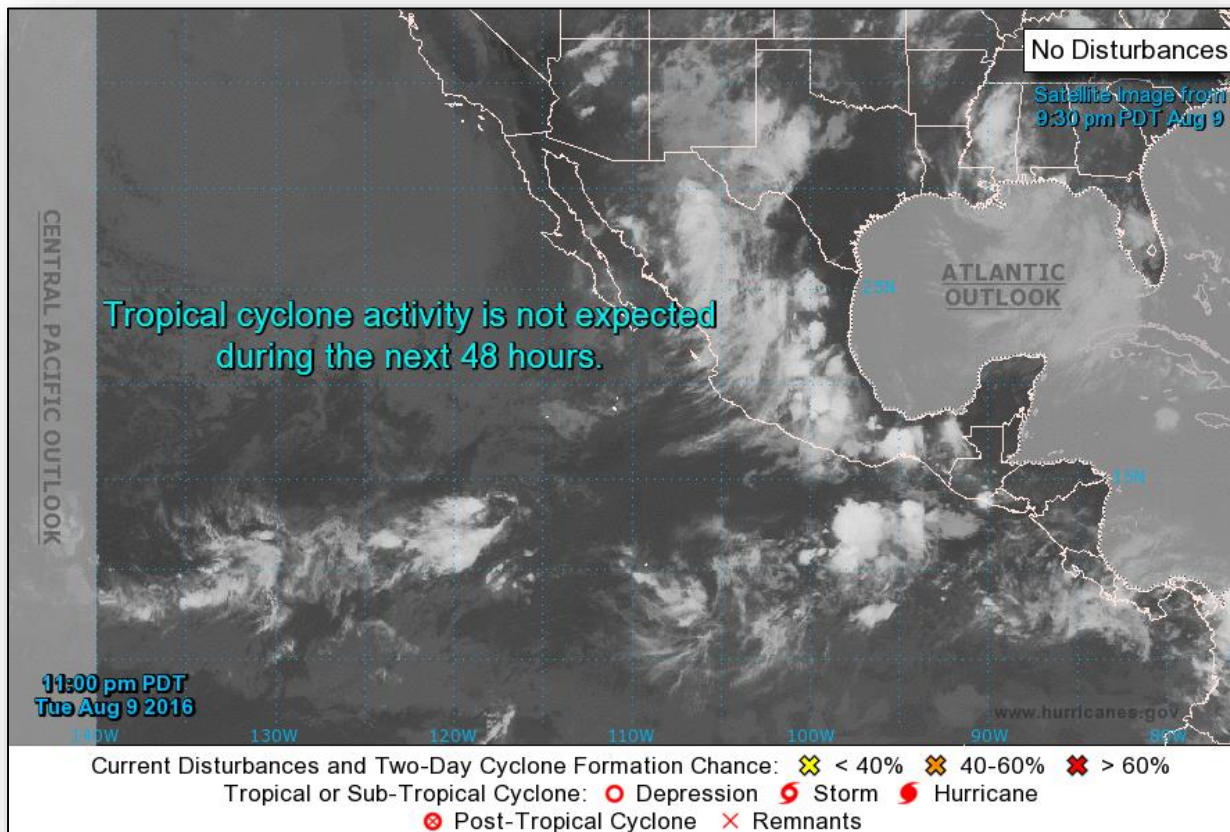

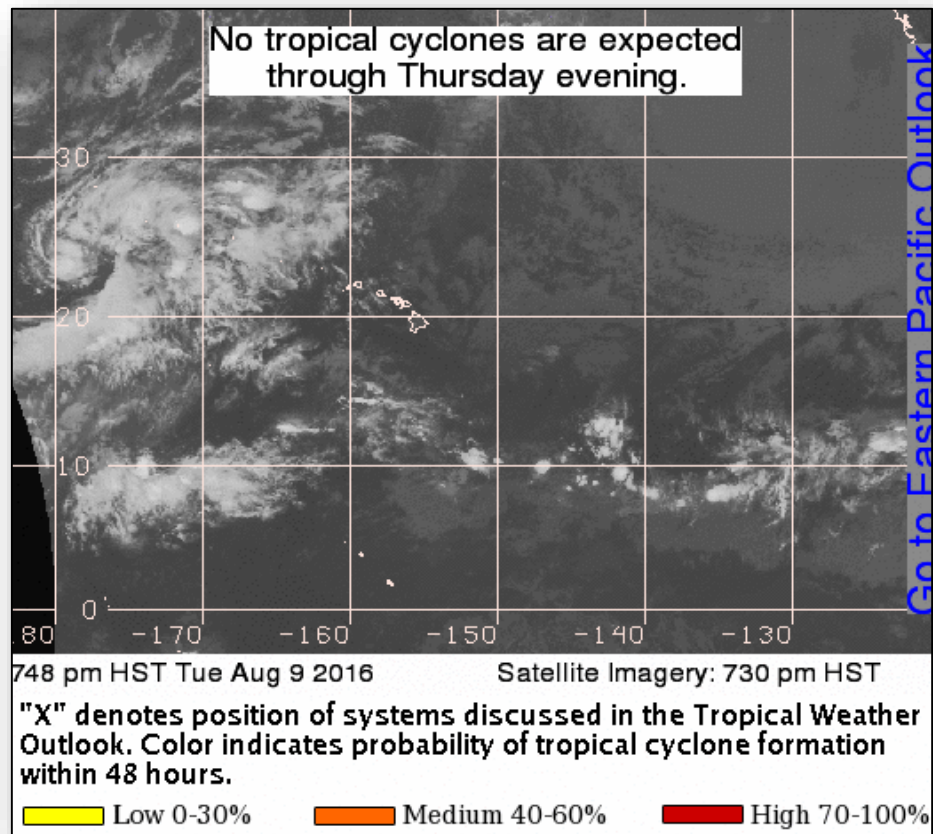
Tropical Outlook - Eastern Pacific



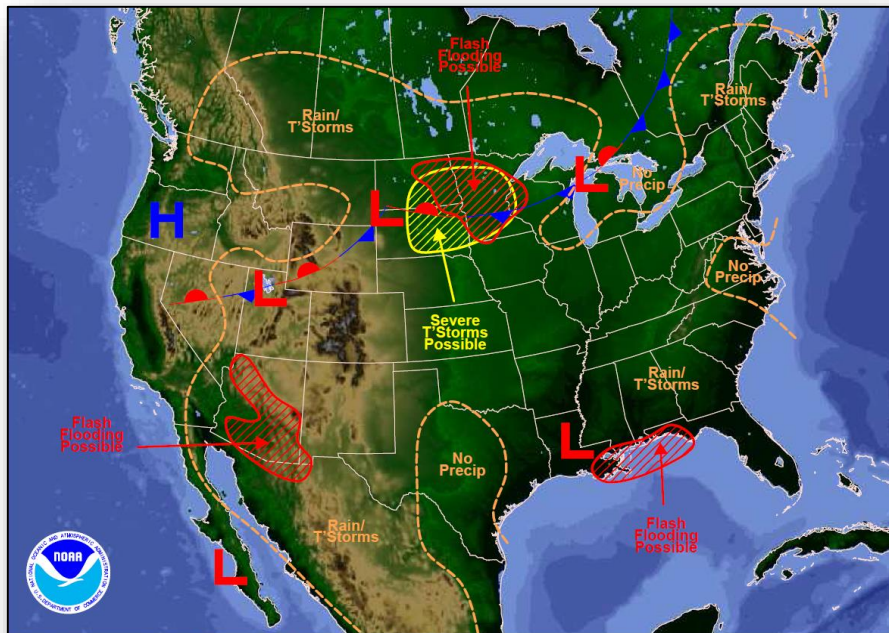
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Tropical Outlook - Central Pacific

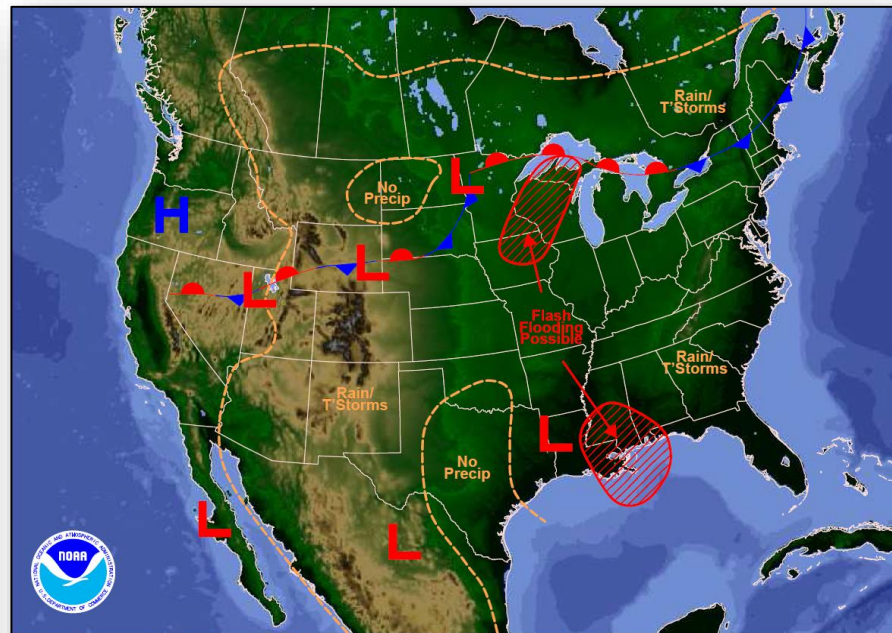

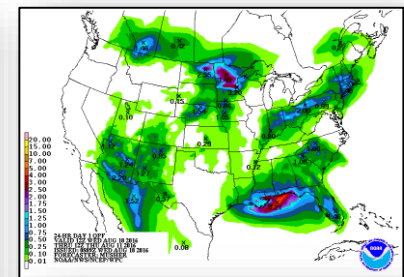
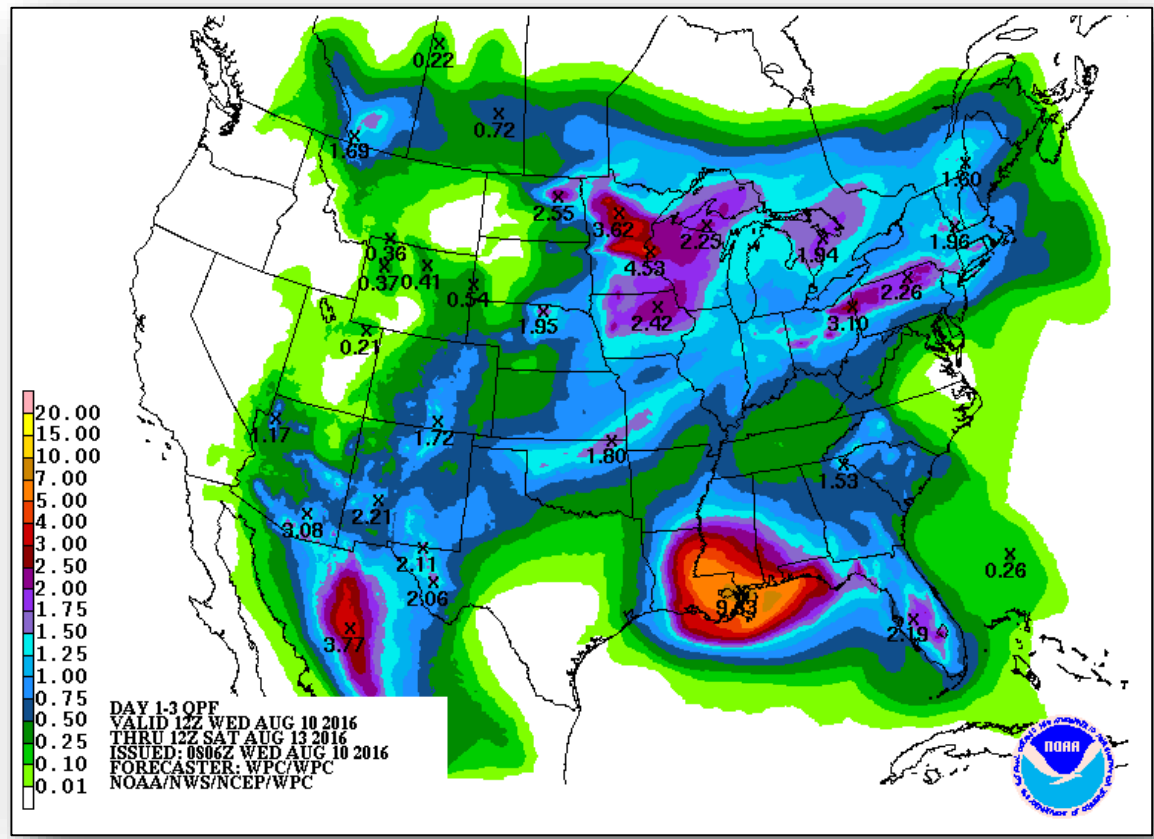
Severe Weather Outlook - Days 1-3



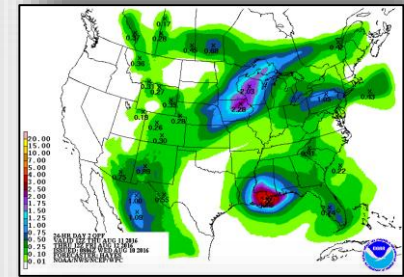
Precipitation Forecast - Days 1-3



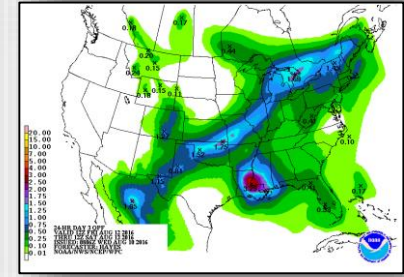

Excessive Rainfall Outlook- Days 1-3



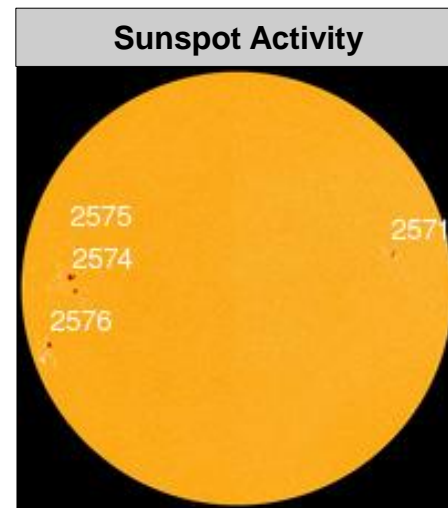
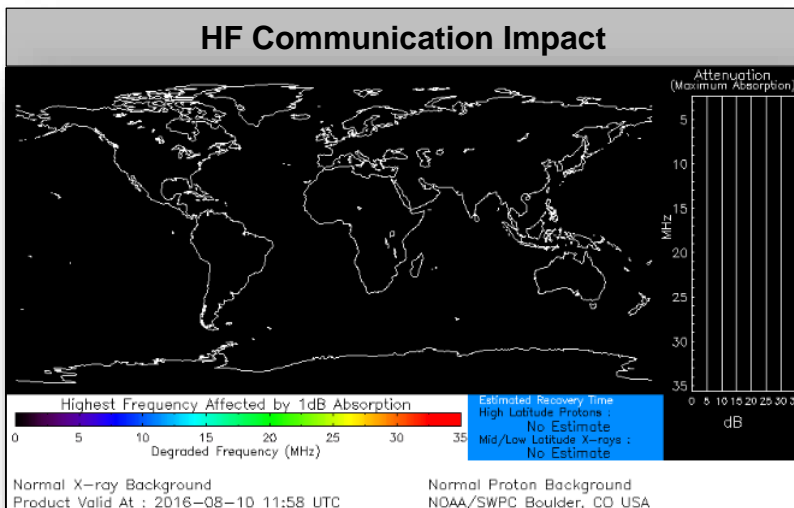

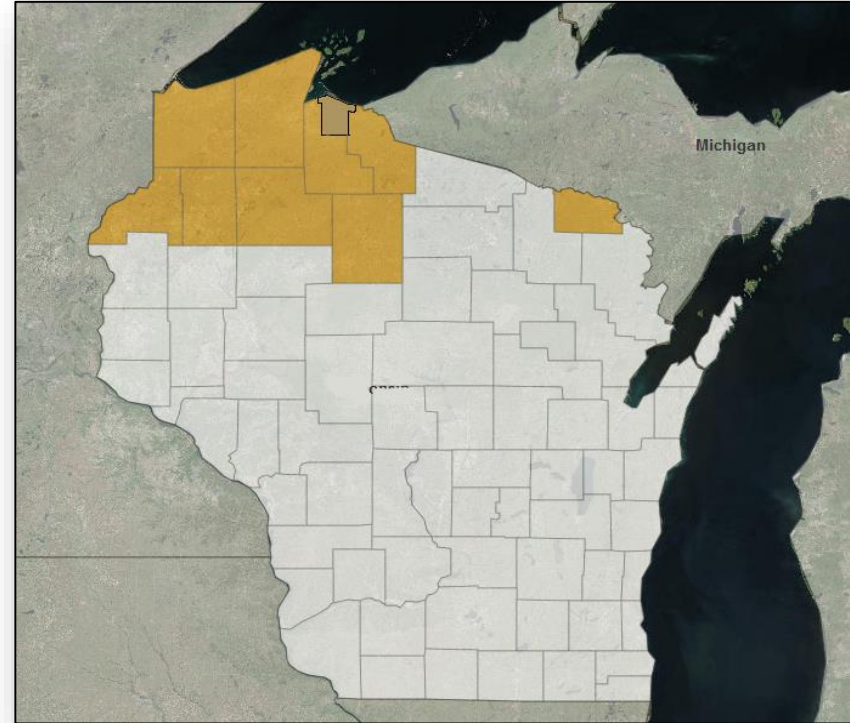

- FCO is Benigno Bern Ruiz

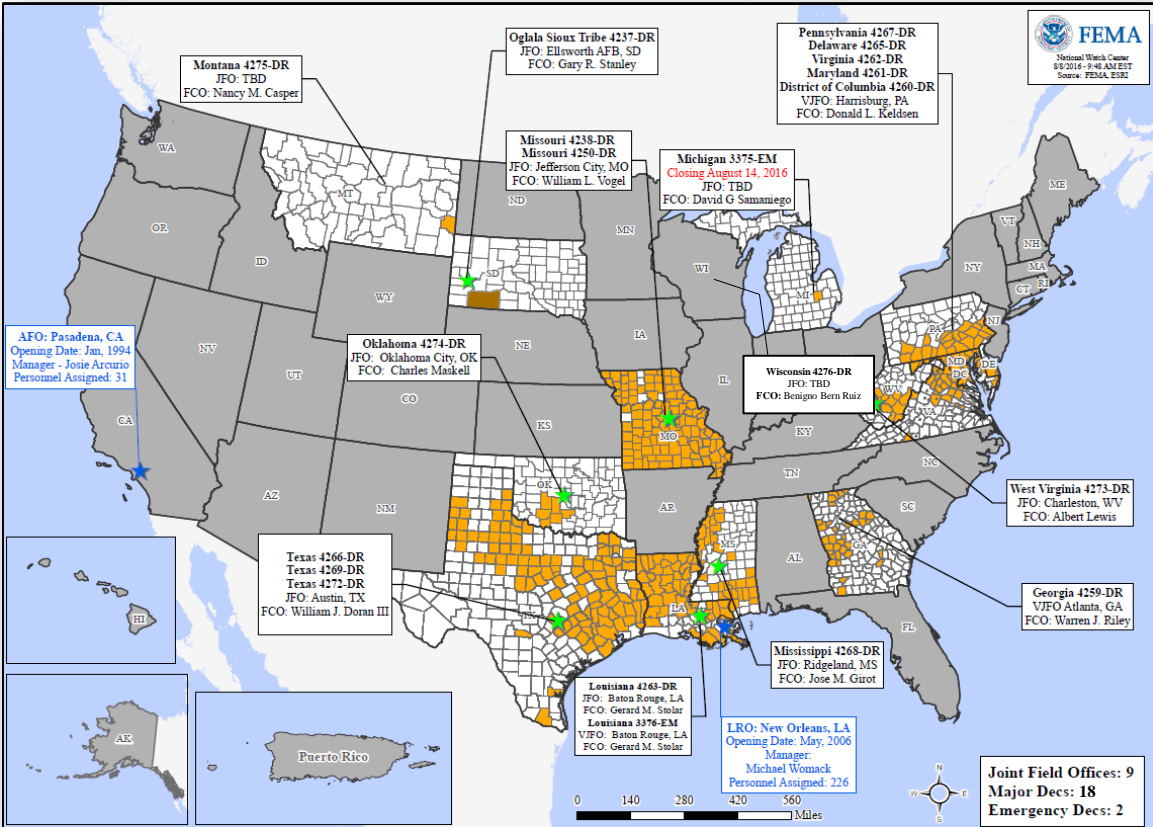

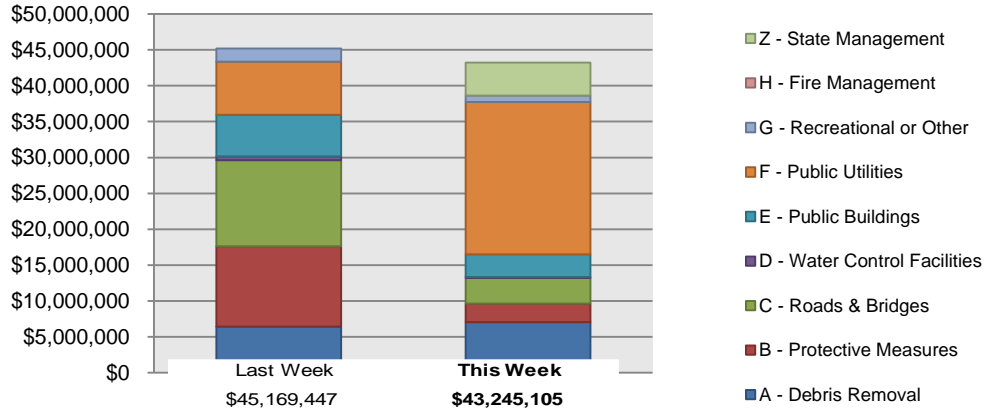

Public Assistance Obligated per Category In the Past 2 Weeks – 07/25/2016 through 08/08/2016



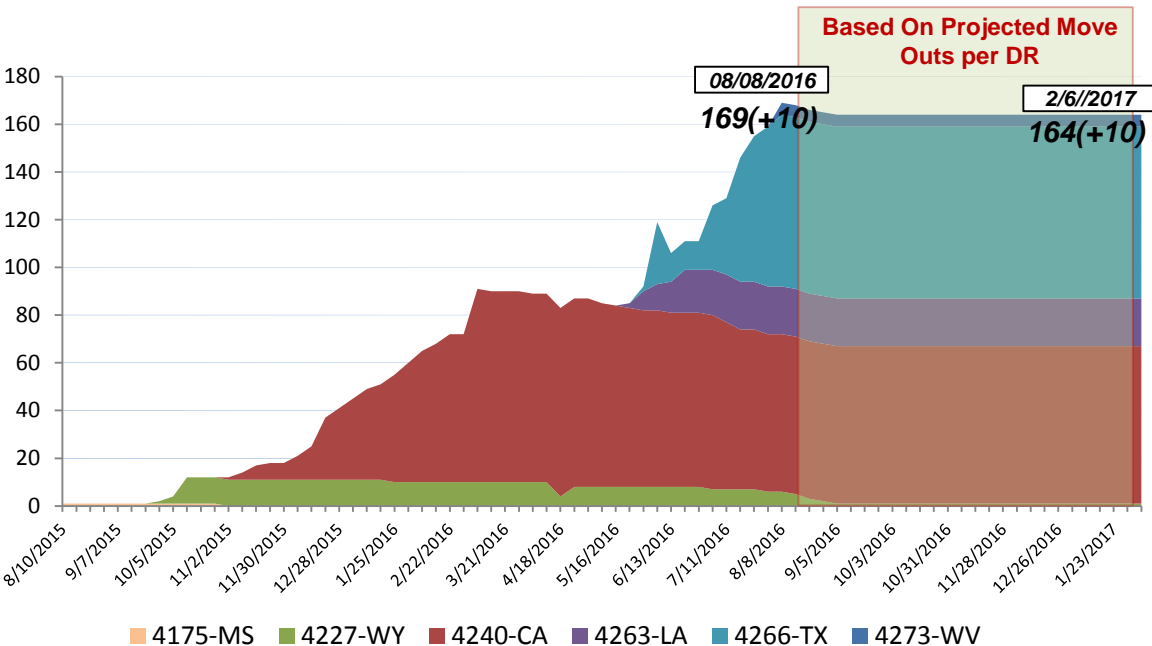

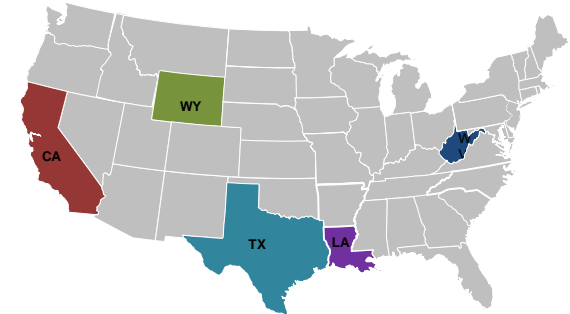

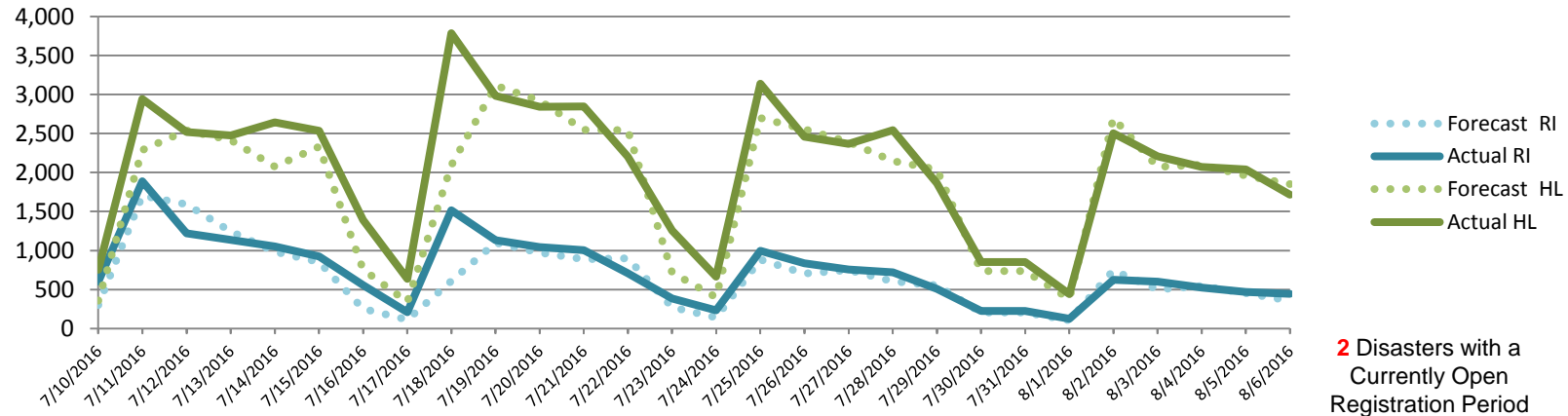

NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks

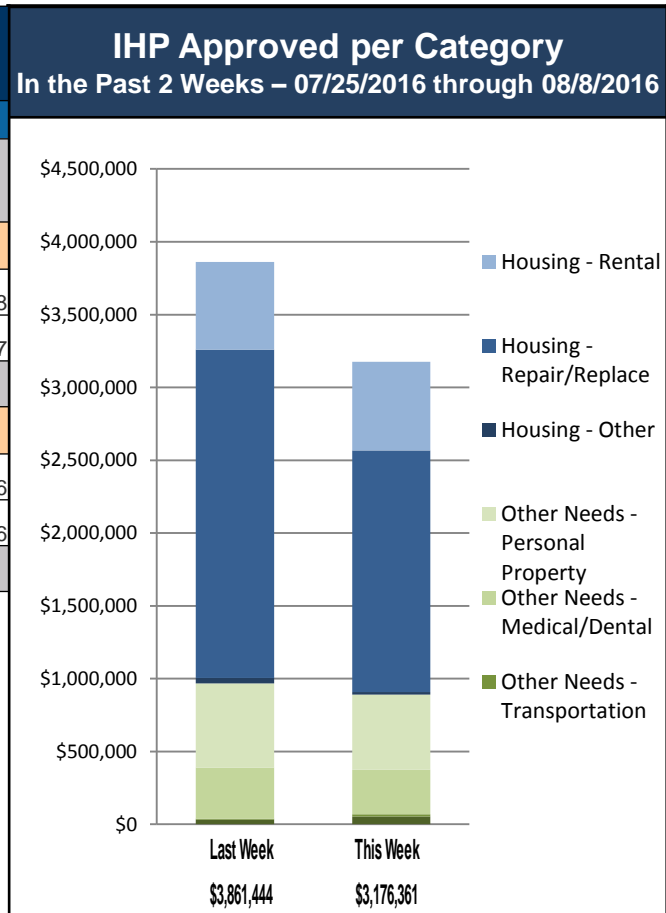
