- Space Weather – Past 24 hours: none observed; next 24 hours: none predicted

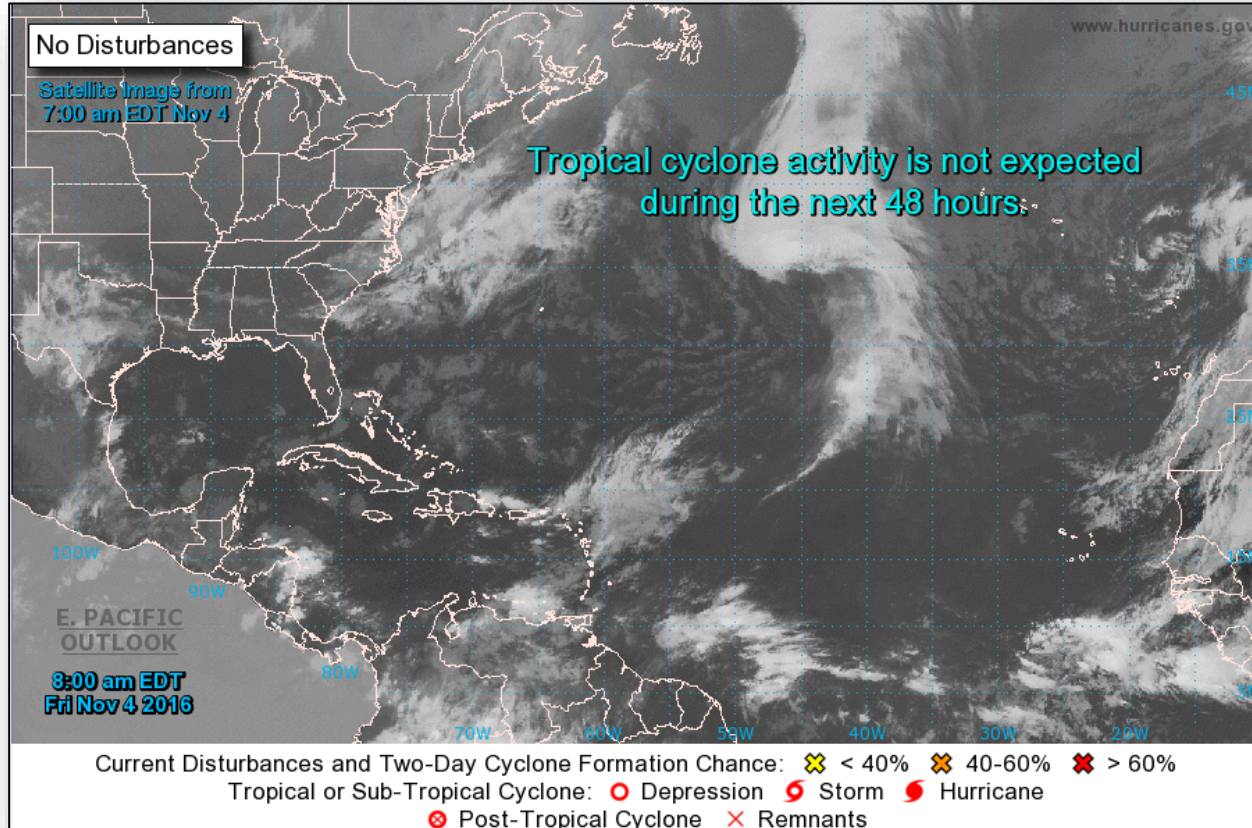

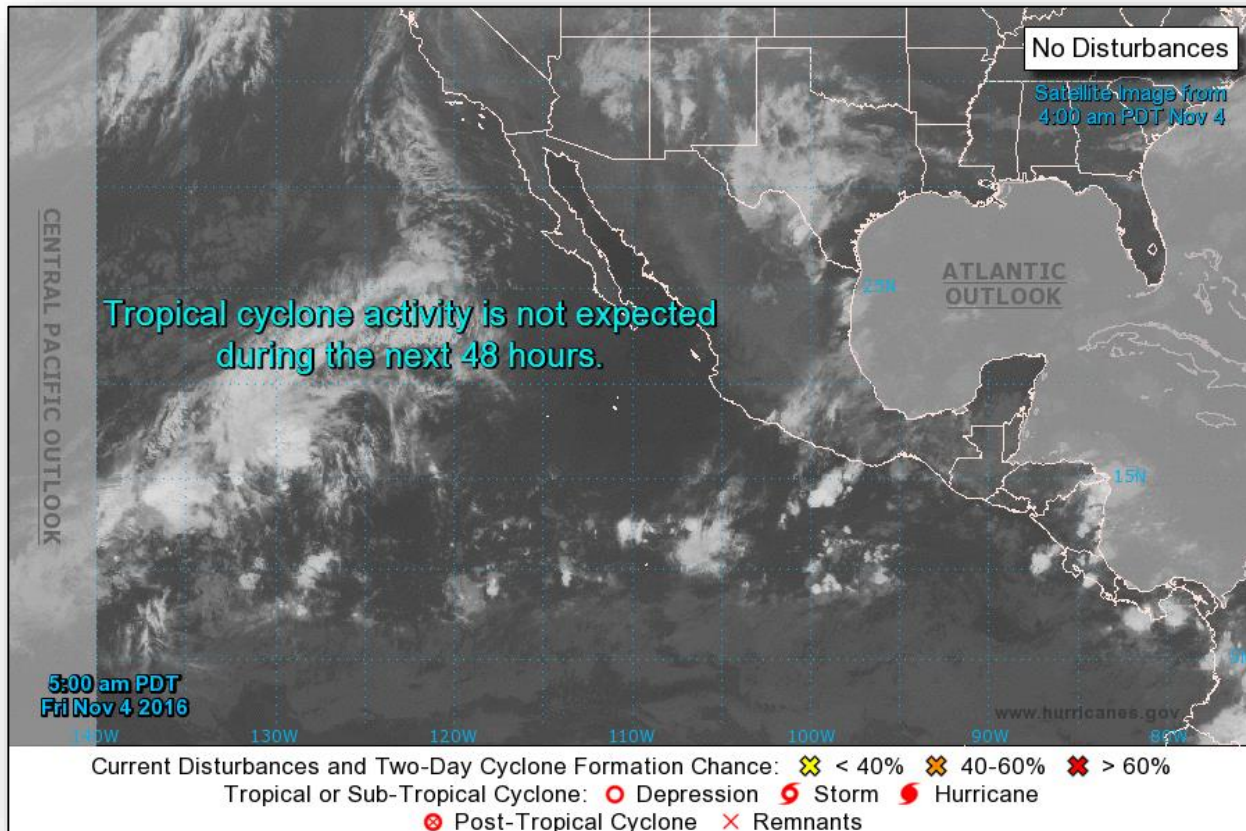

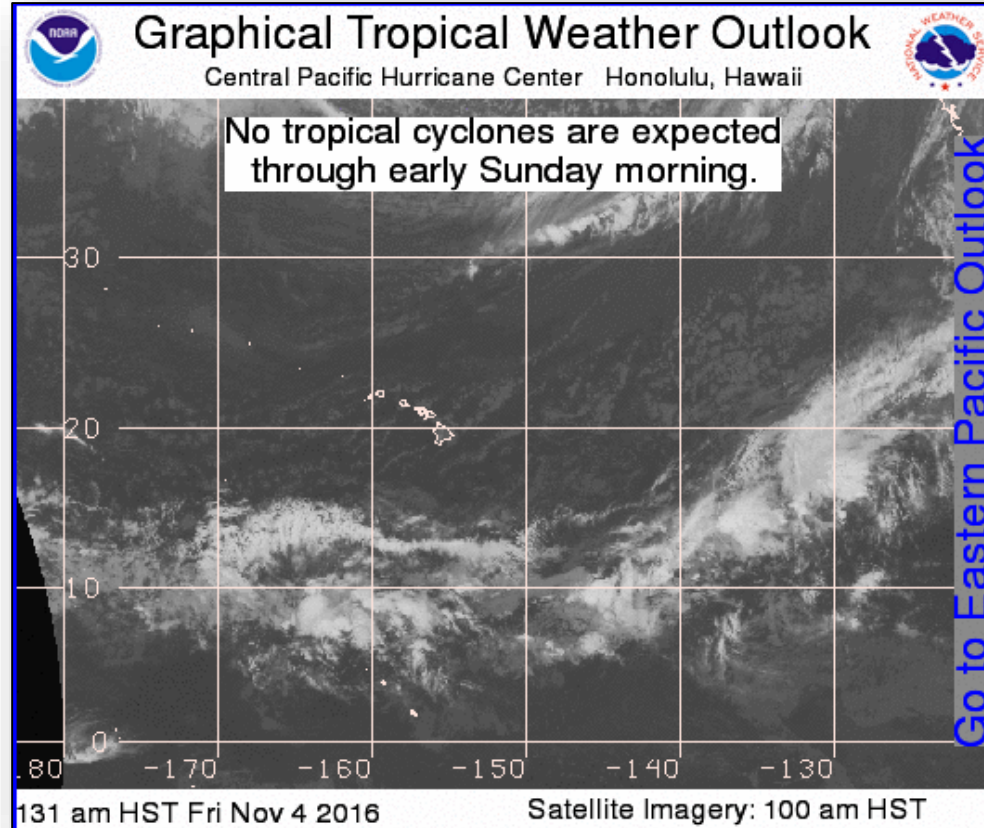
Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



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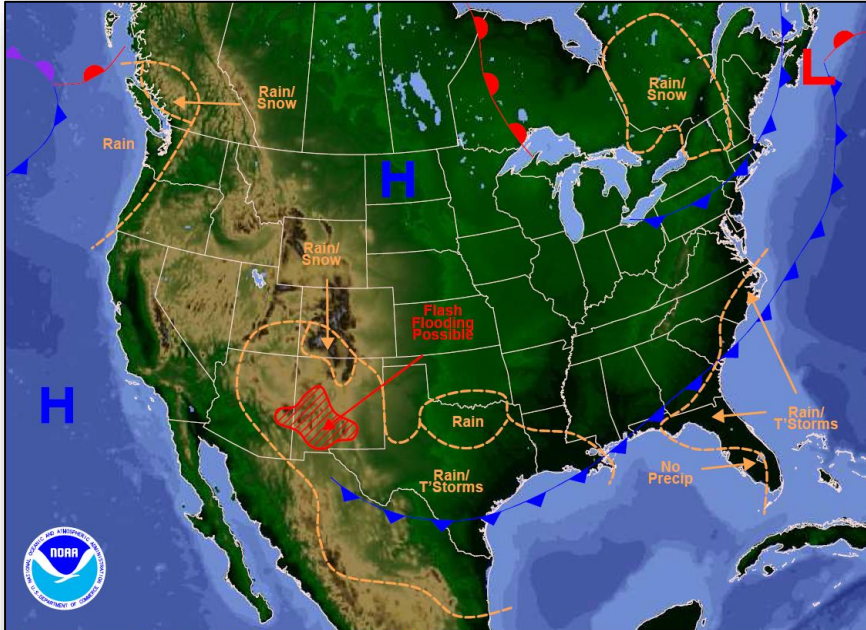
Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific

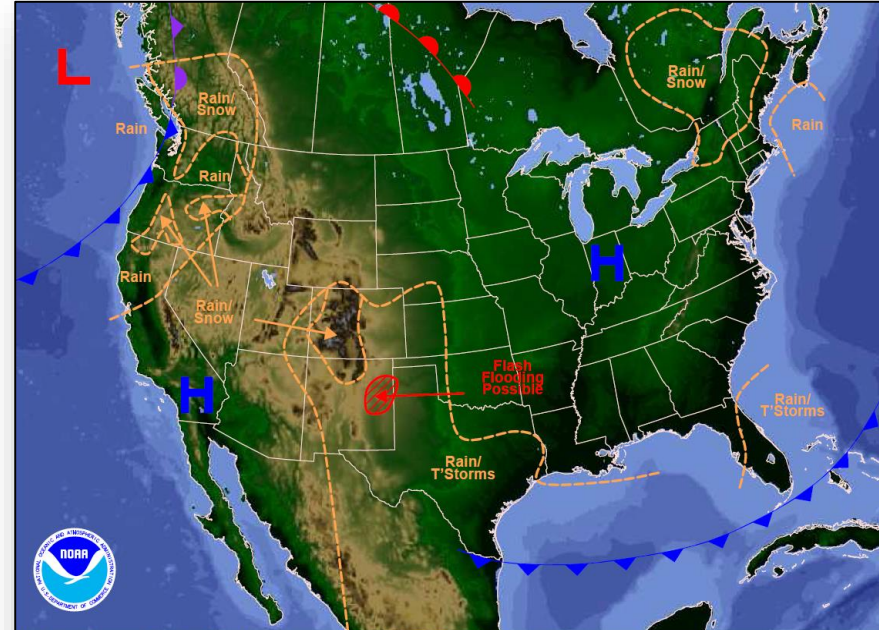

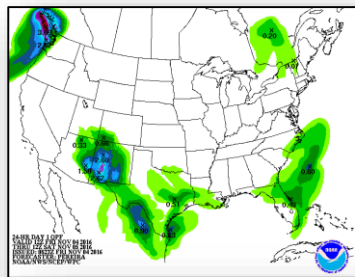
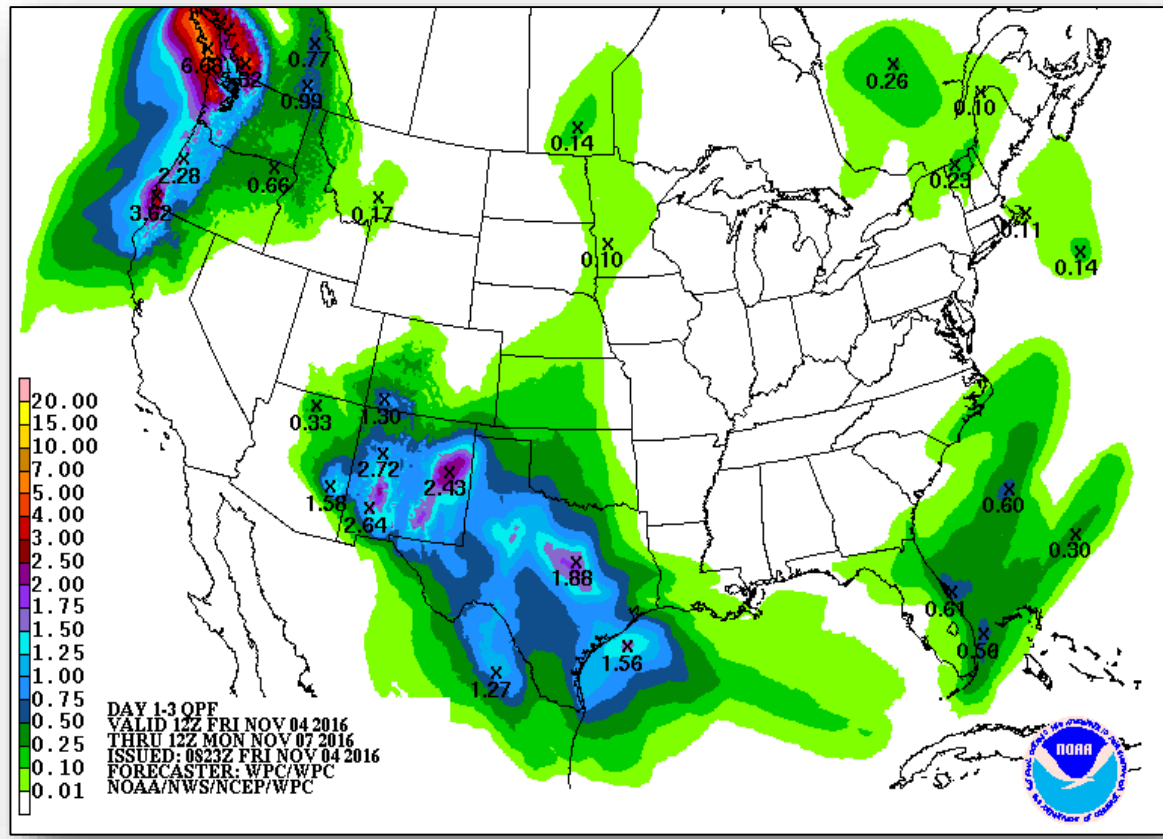


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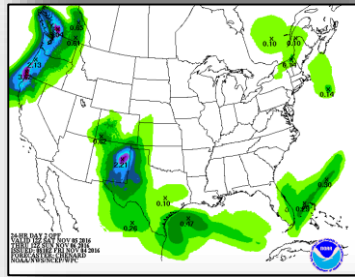




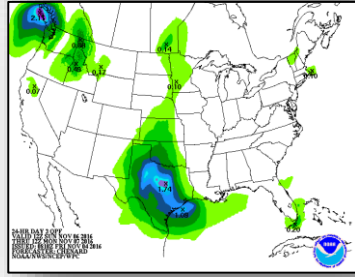
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3

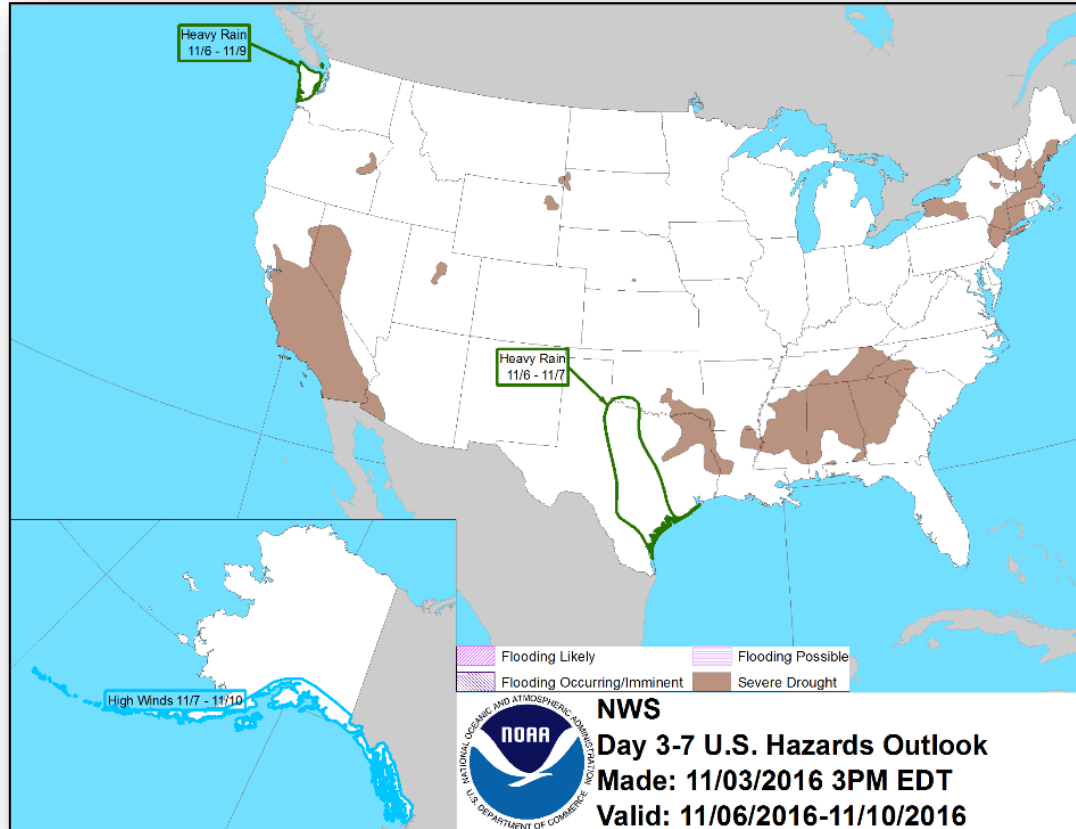

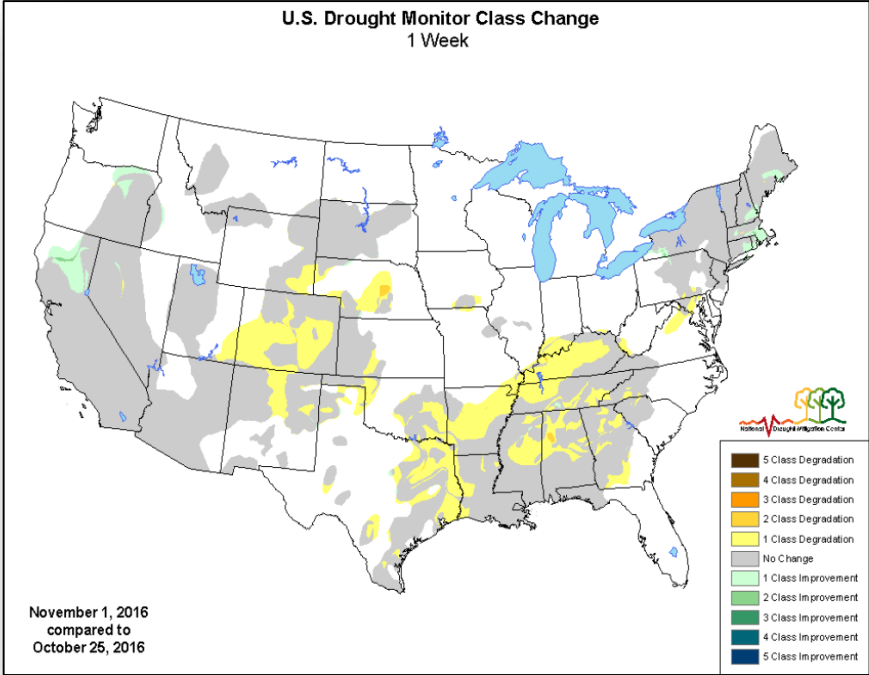
