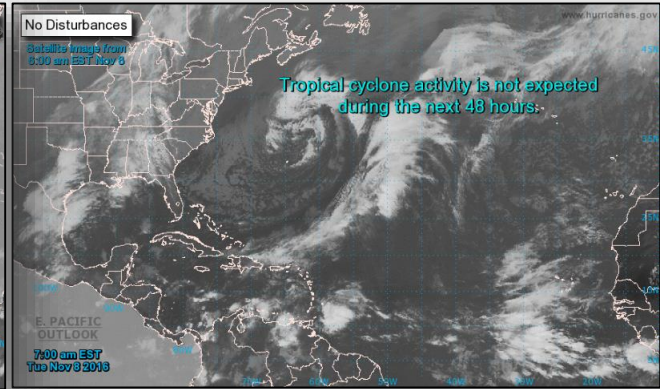

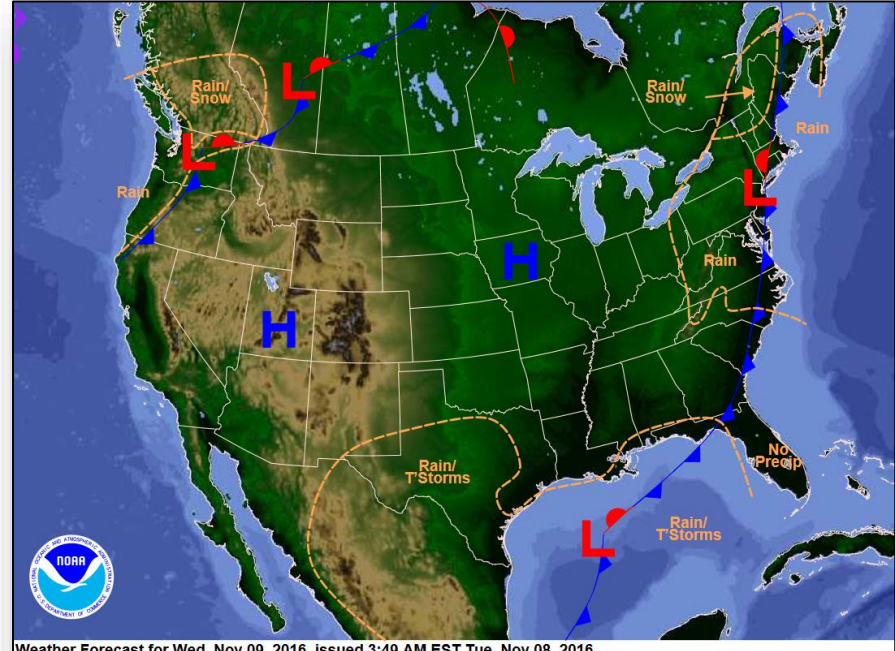


National Weather Forecast

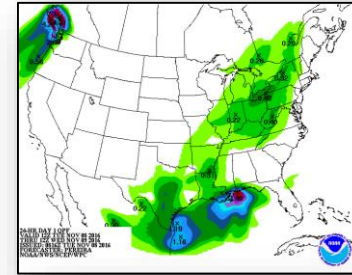
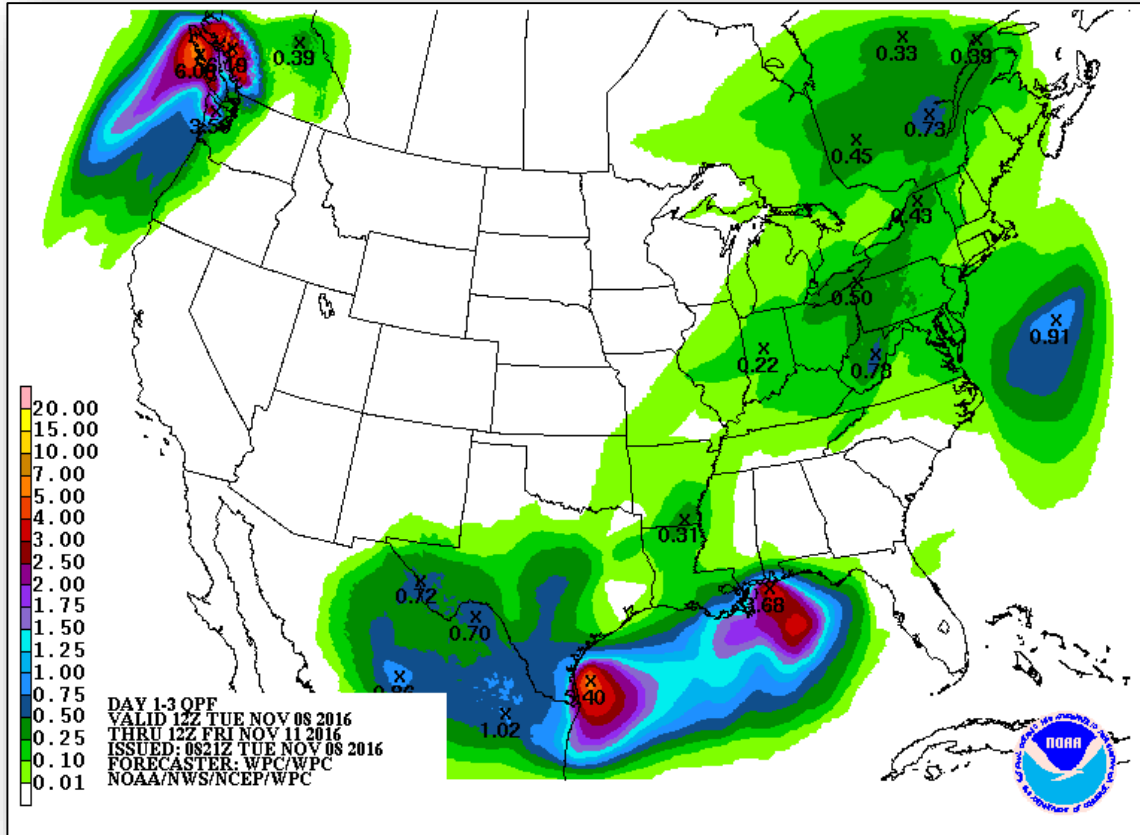

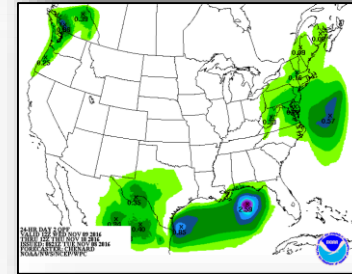
Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3



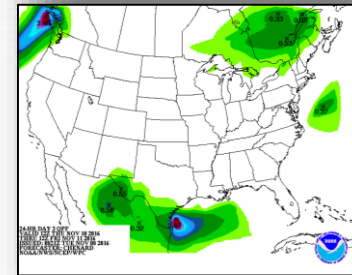

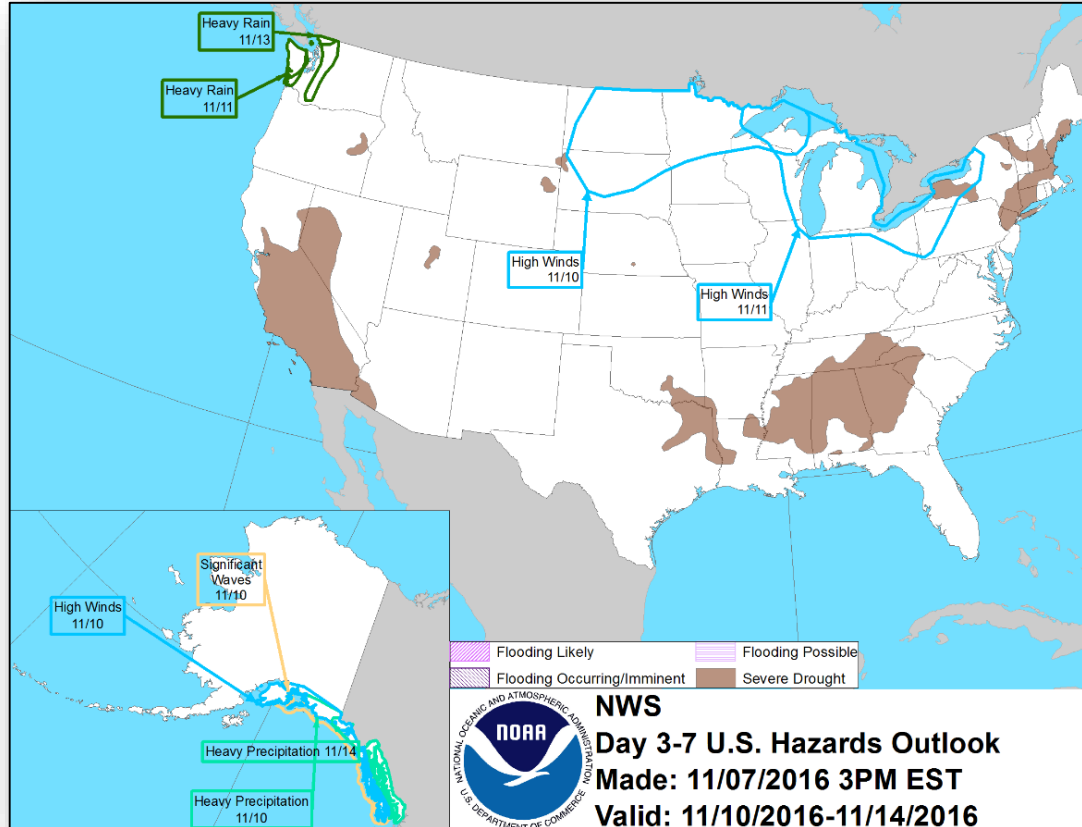

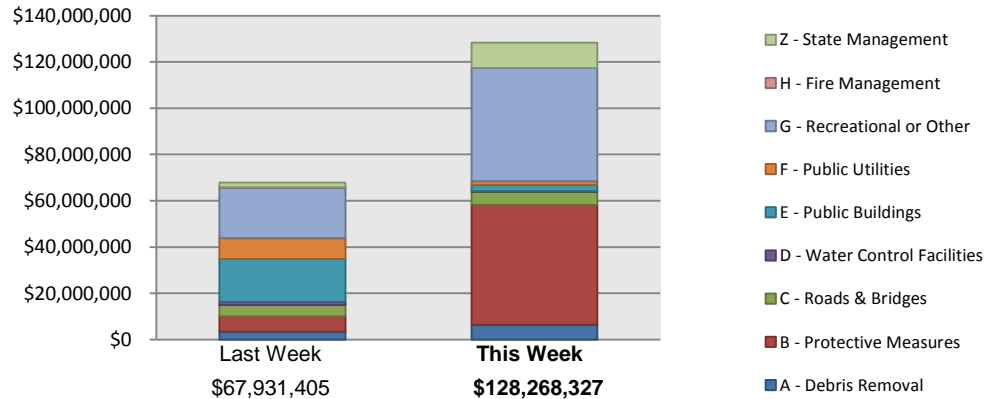

Public Assistance Obligated per Category In the Past 2 Weeks – 10/24/2016 through 11/07/2016



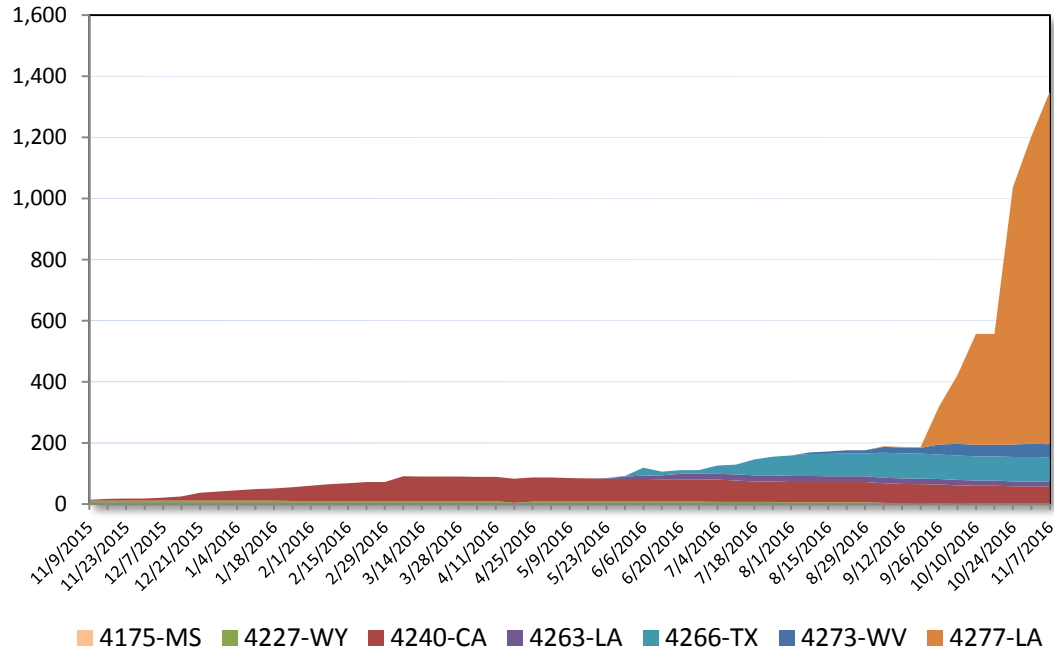

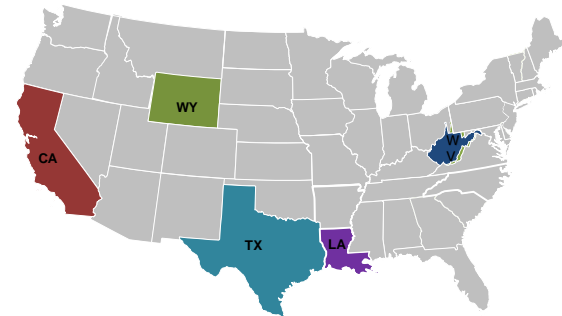

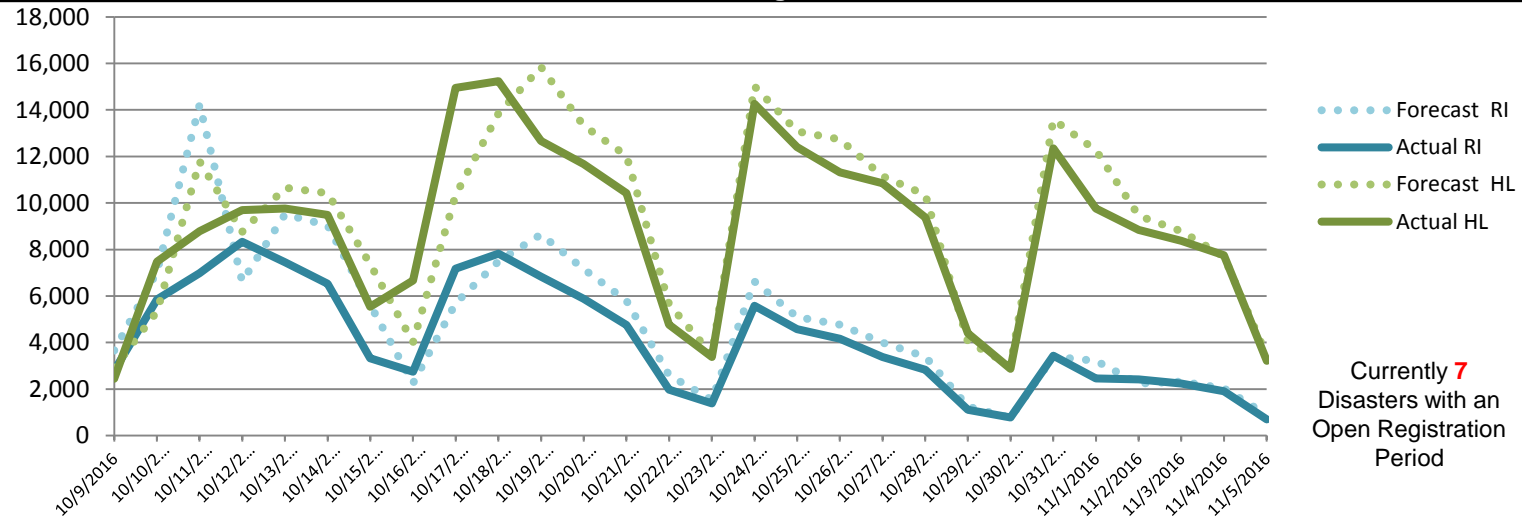

NPSC Call Forecasting and Actual Calls Over the Past 4 Weeks 10/02/2016 through 10/29/2016

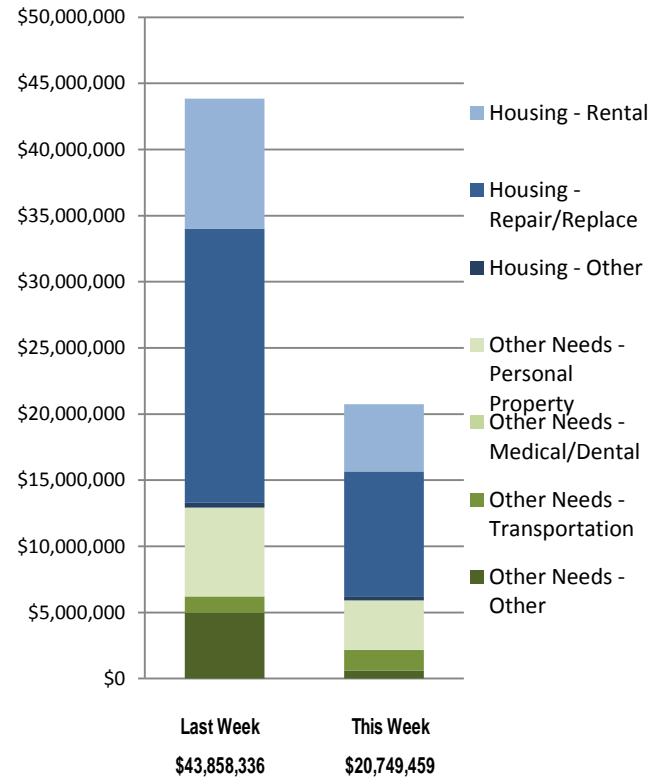
