- Heavy Snow – Pacific Northwest, Northern Intermountain and the Northern/Central Rockies
- Freezing Rain – Great Lakes into portions of the Mid-Atlantic and the Northeast
- Snow – Southern Rockies, Northern Plains,
- Rain and Snow – Pacific Northwest, Upper Mississippi Valley, Great Lakes and Northeast

## Situation:

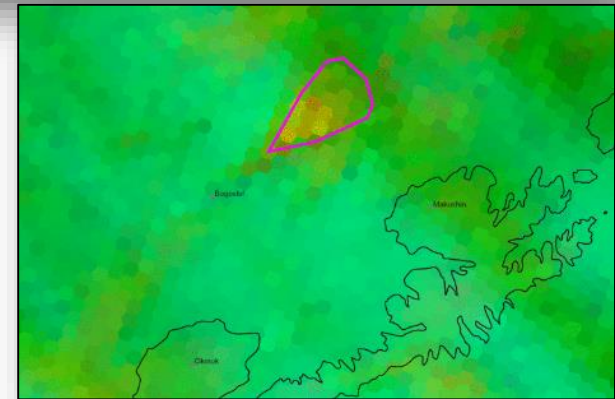
- Eruptions occurred on December 20, 21, and 24, 2016
- Ground-based Volcano Alert Level and Aviation Color Code was set at **WARNING / RED** (USGS as of 5:00 p.m. EST, December 24, 2016)
  - Alert Status **WARNING**: Hazardous eruption is imminent, underway, or suspected
  - Aviation Color Code **RED**: Eruption is imminent with significant emission of volcanic ash into the atmosphere likely or eruption is underway or suspected with significant emission of volcanic ash into the atmosphere
- **Updates ( no further as emissions have occurred since the eruption on the 24th); Aviation Color Code lowered to ORANGE and the Alert Level lowered to WATCH on December 25** (RX DSAR as of 2:47 p.m. EST, December 25, 2016)

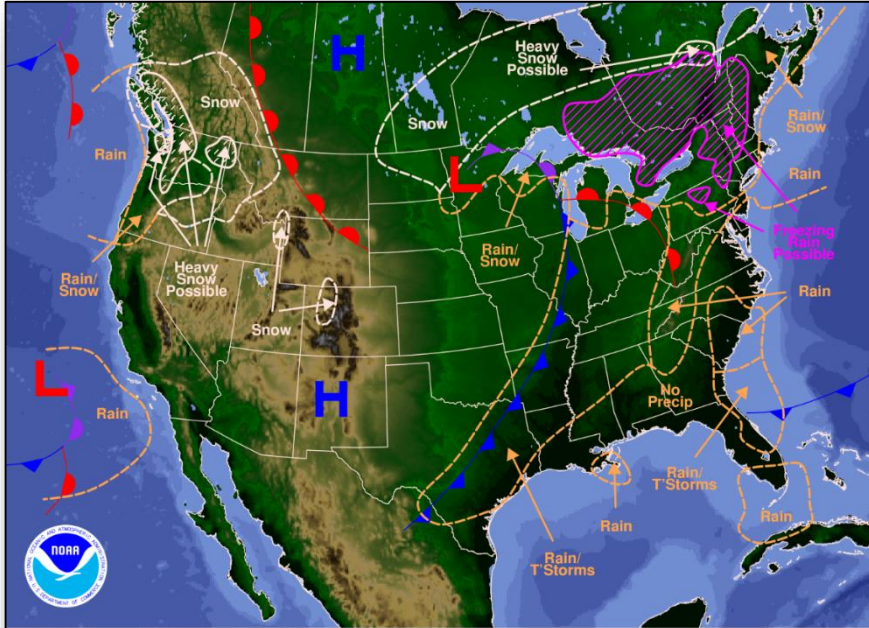

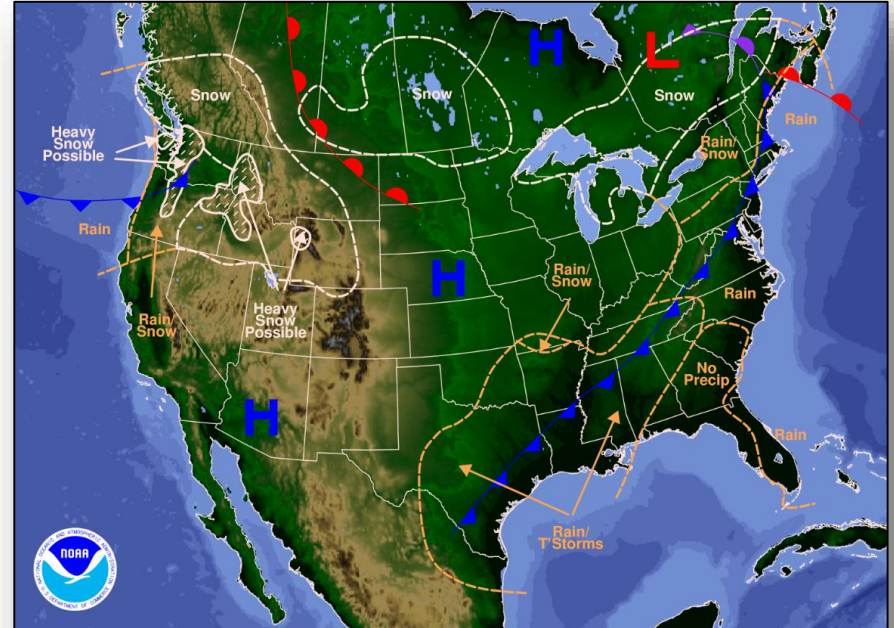
Analysis of GOES-R imagery indicating Bogoslof ash and dust cloud after the December 22 eruption

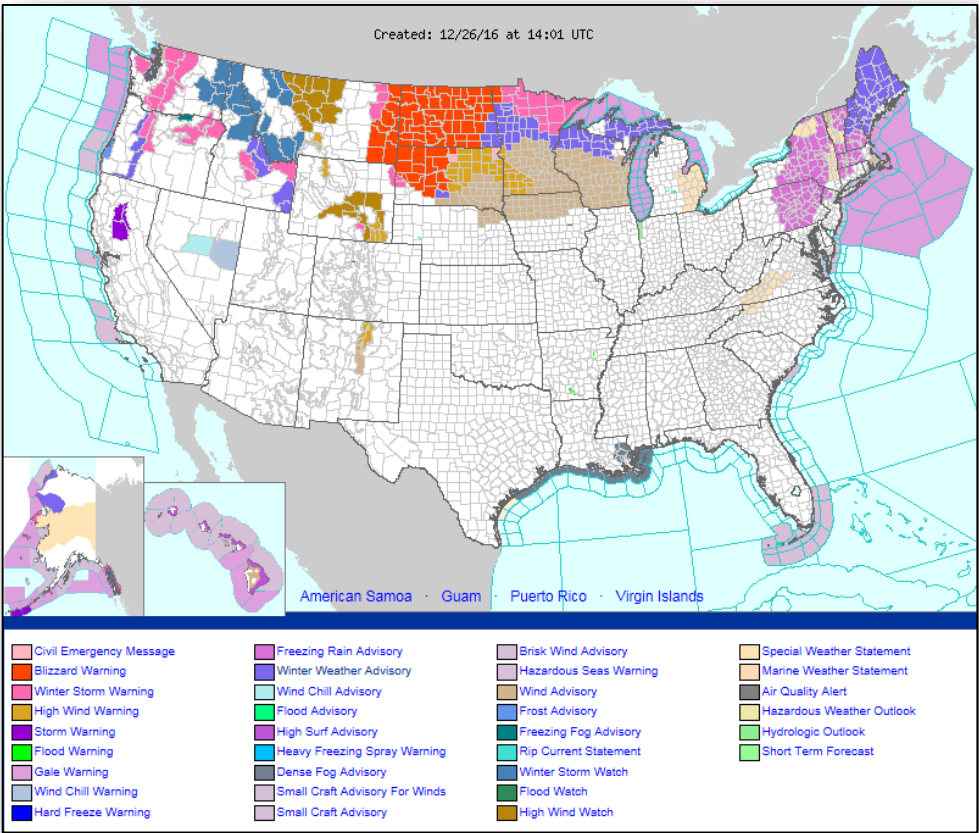

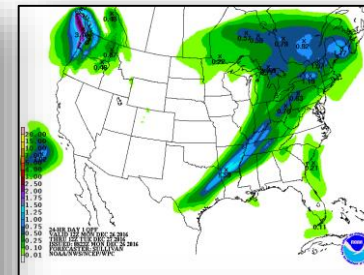

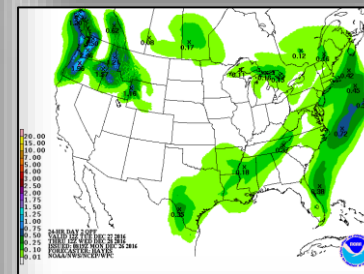
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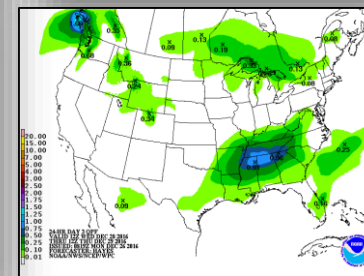
# Precipitation Forecast – Days 1-3

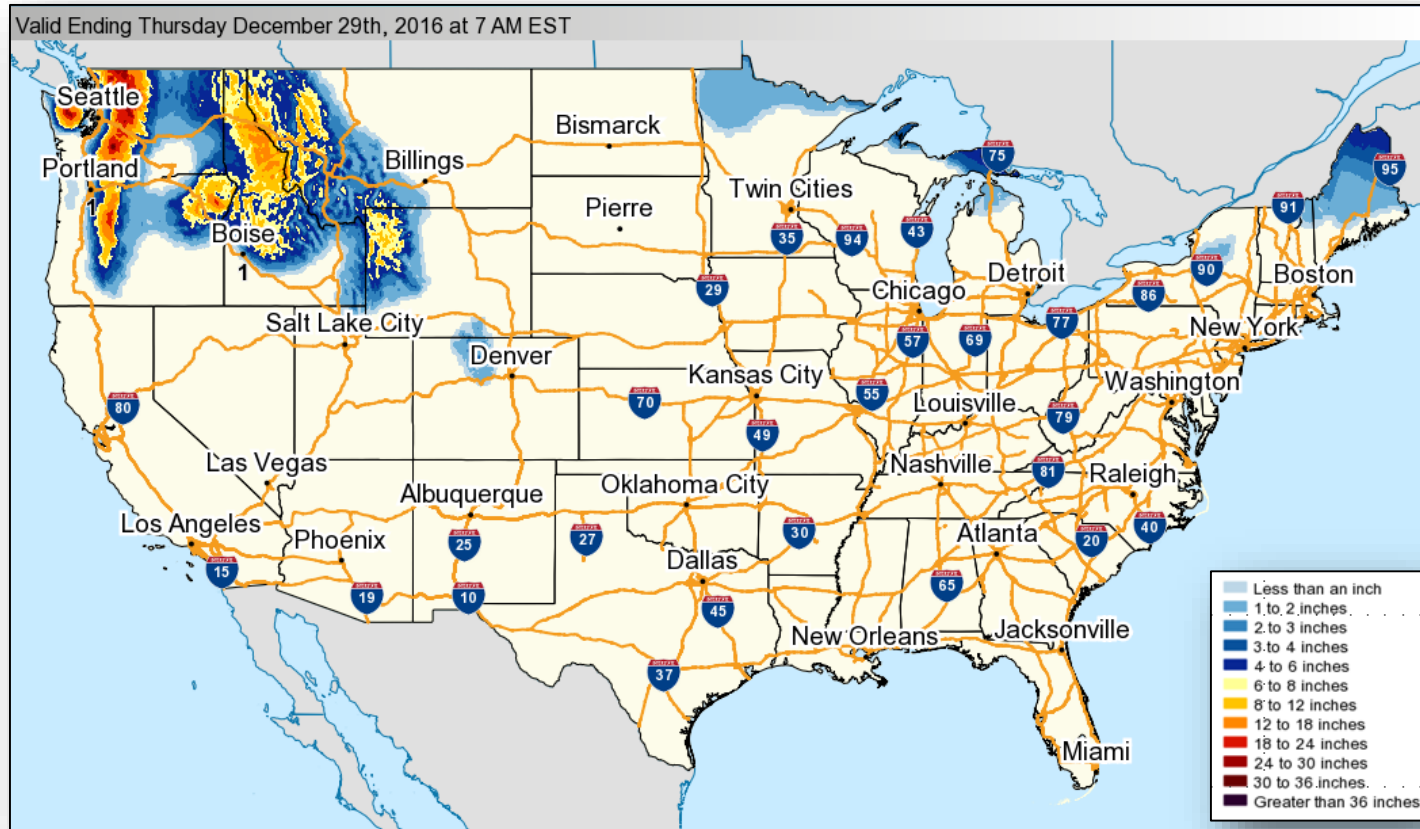

# Forecast Snowfall – Days 1-3



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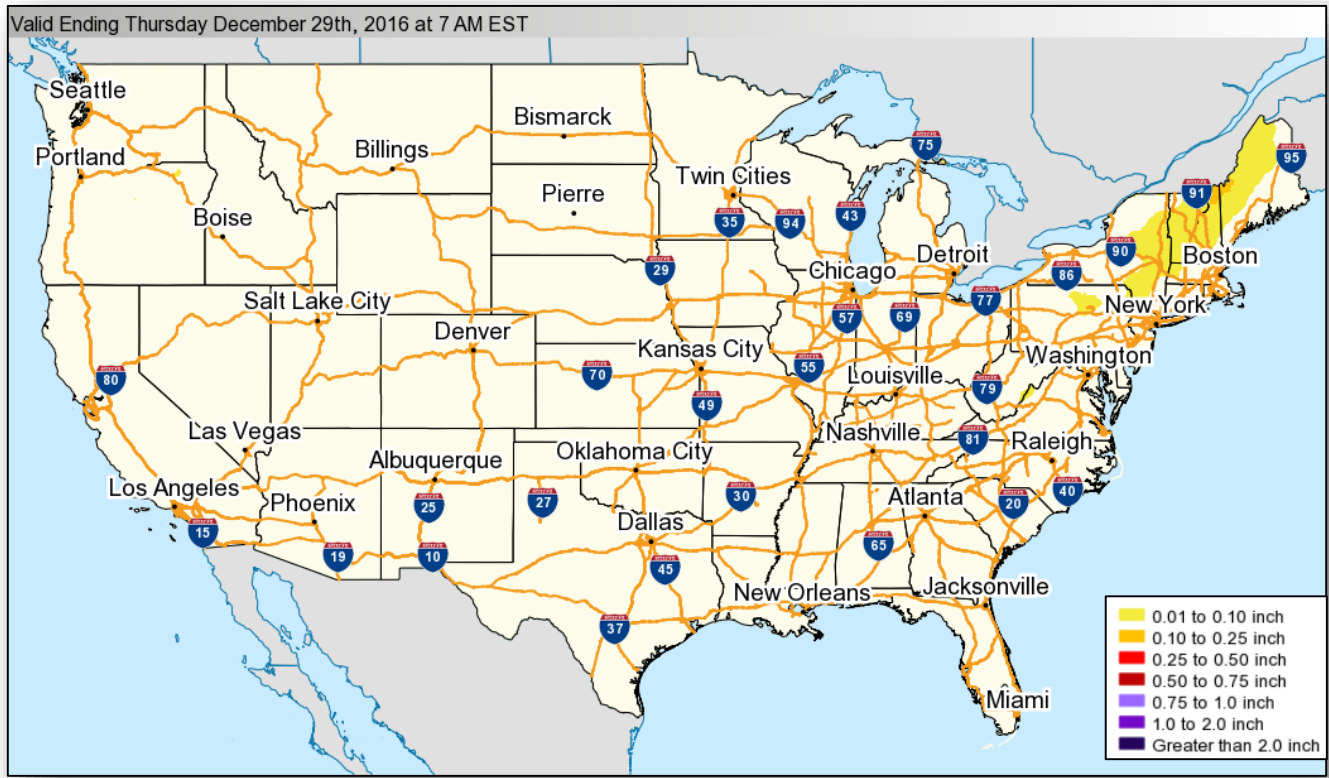




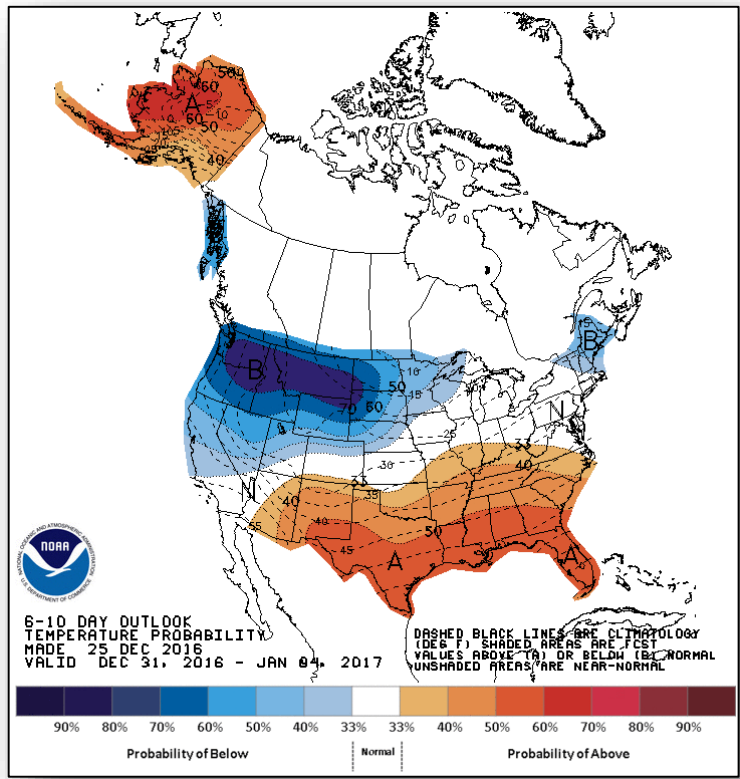

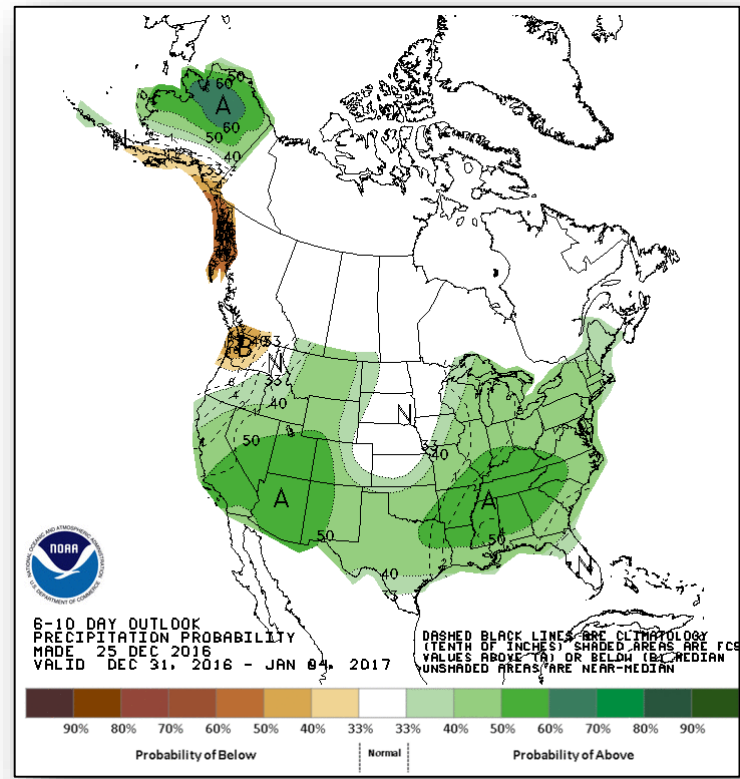
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# 6-10 Day Outlooks

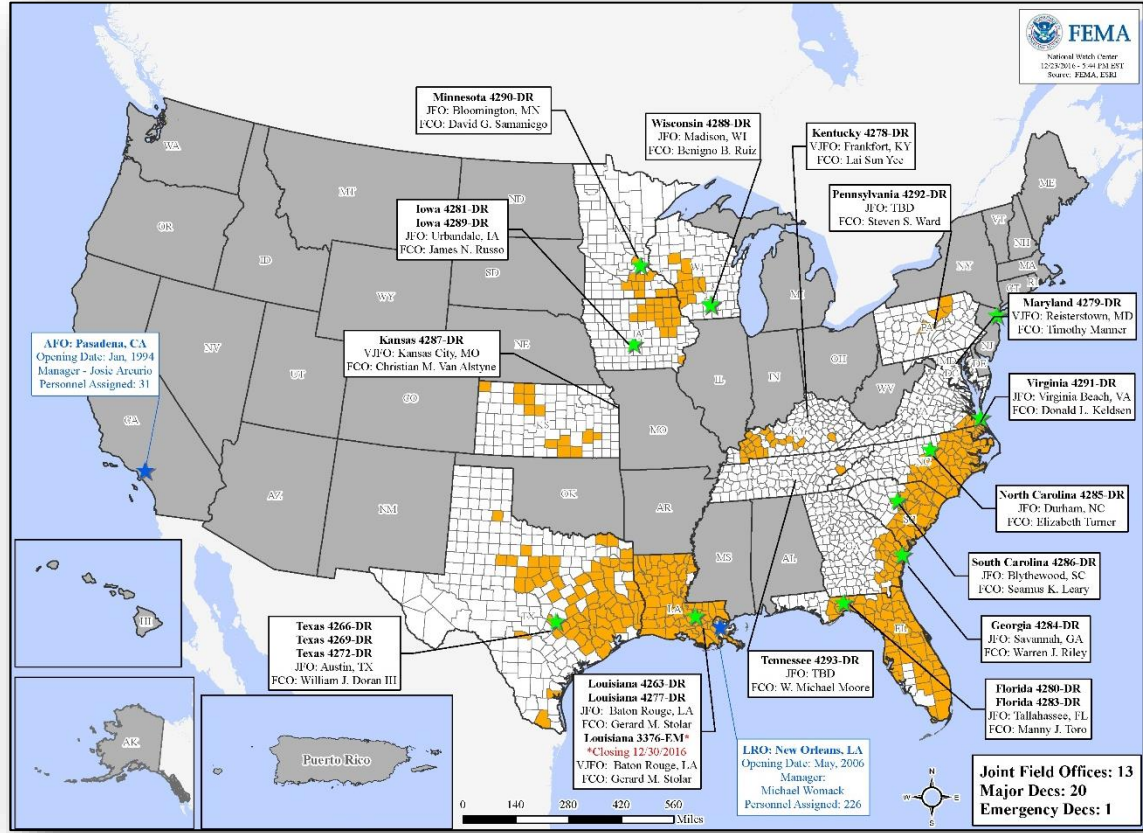
